

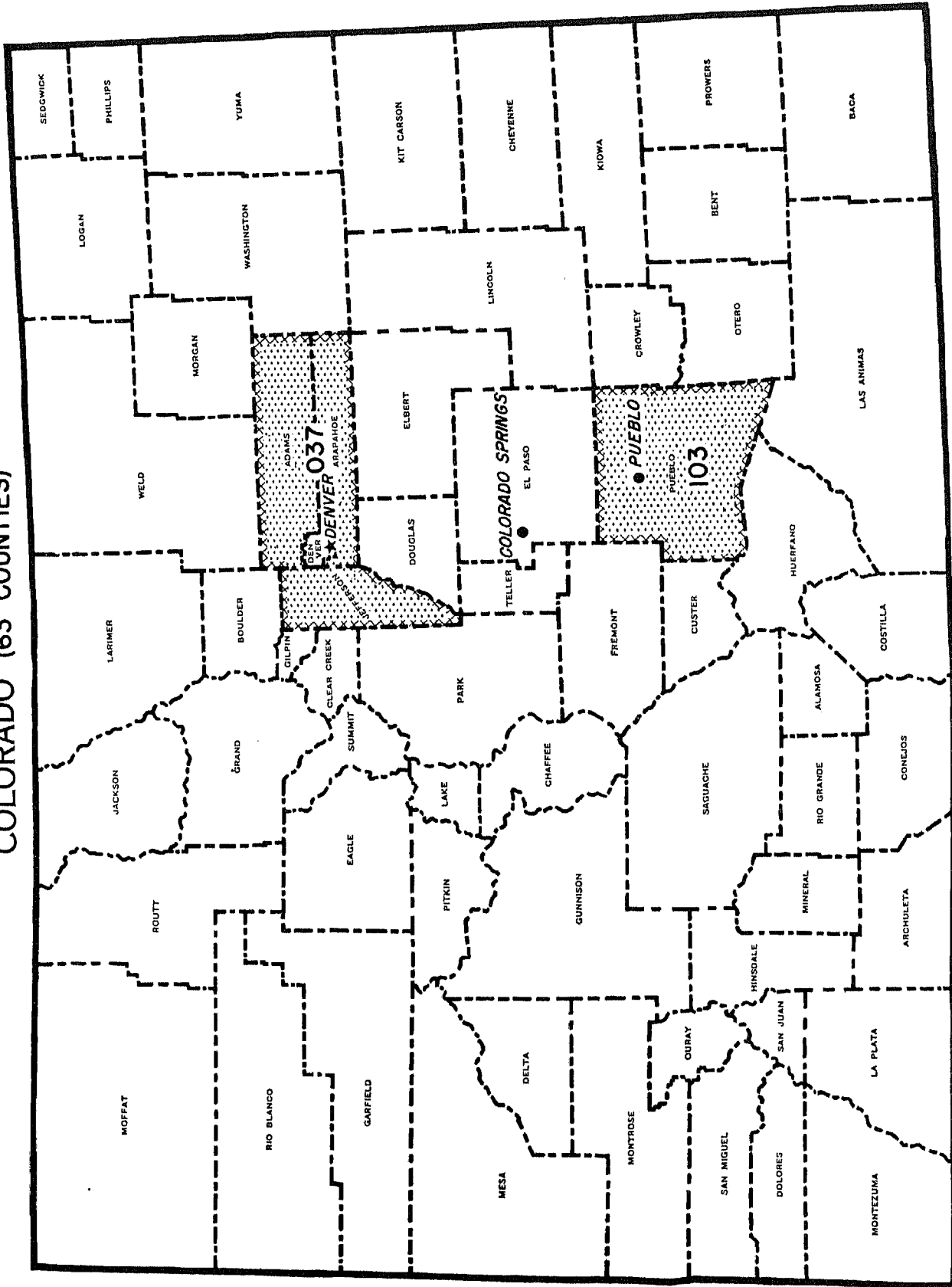

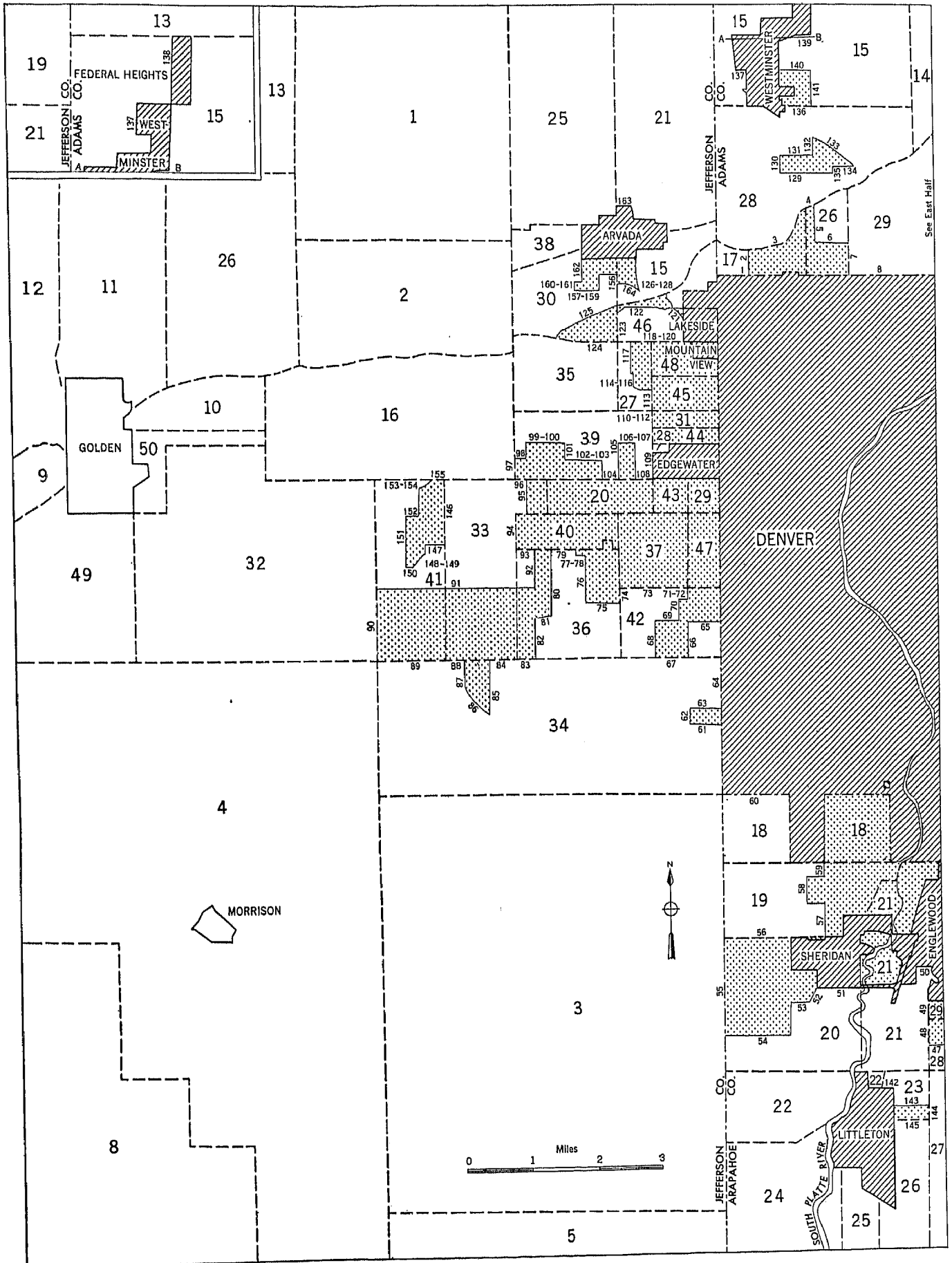

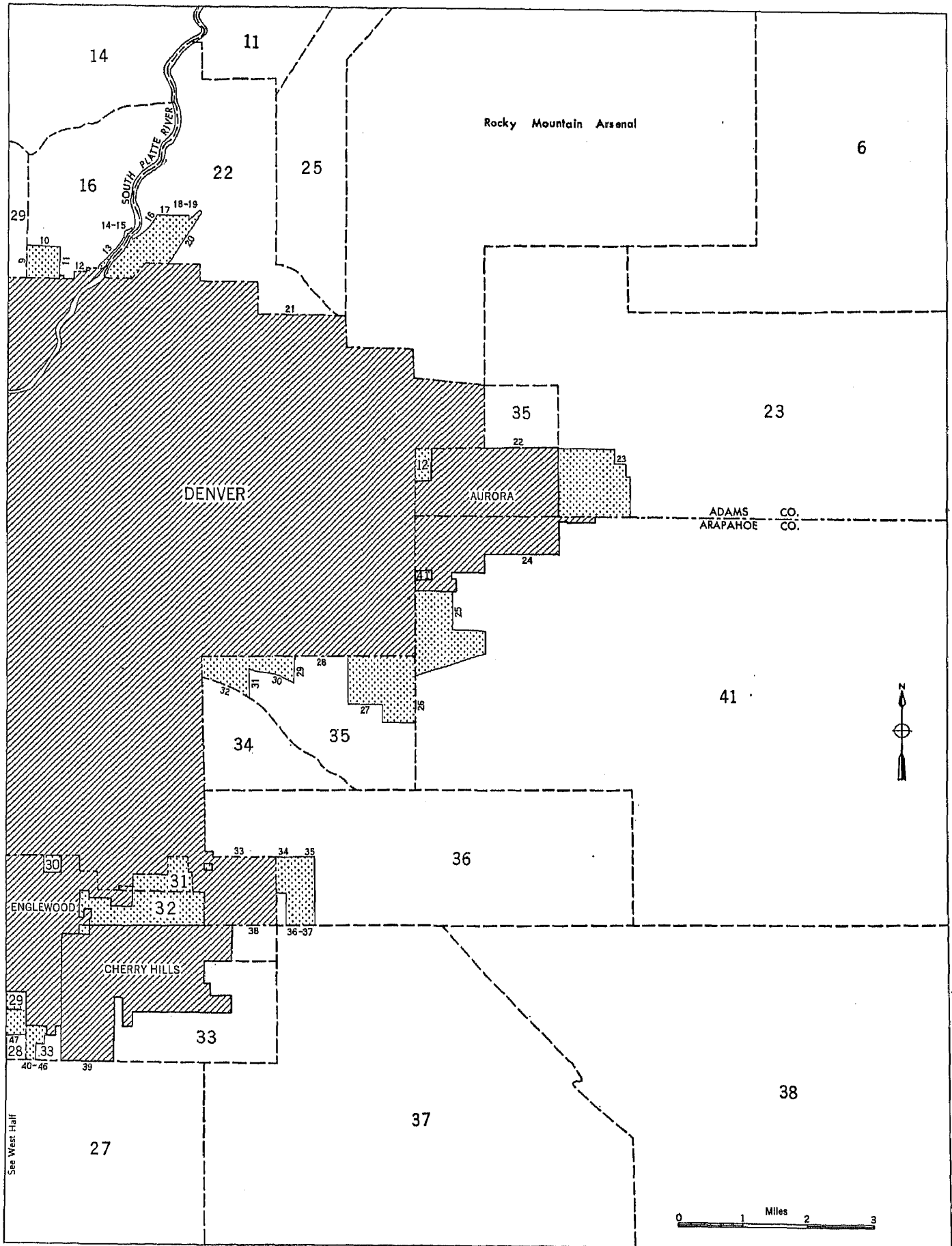

DENVER URBANIZED AREA—WESTERN PART

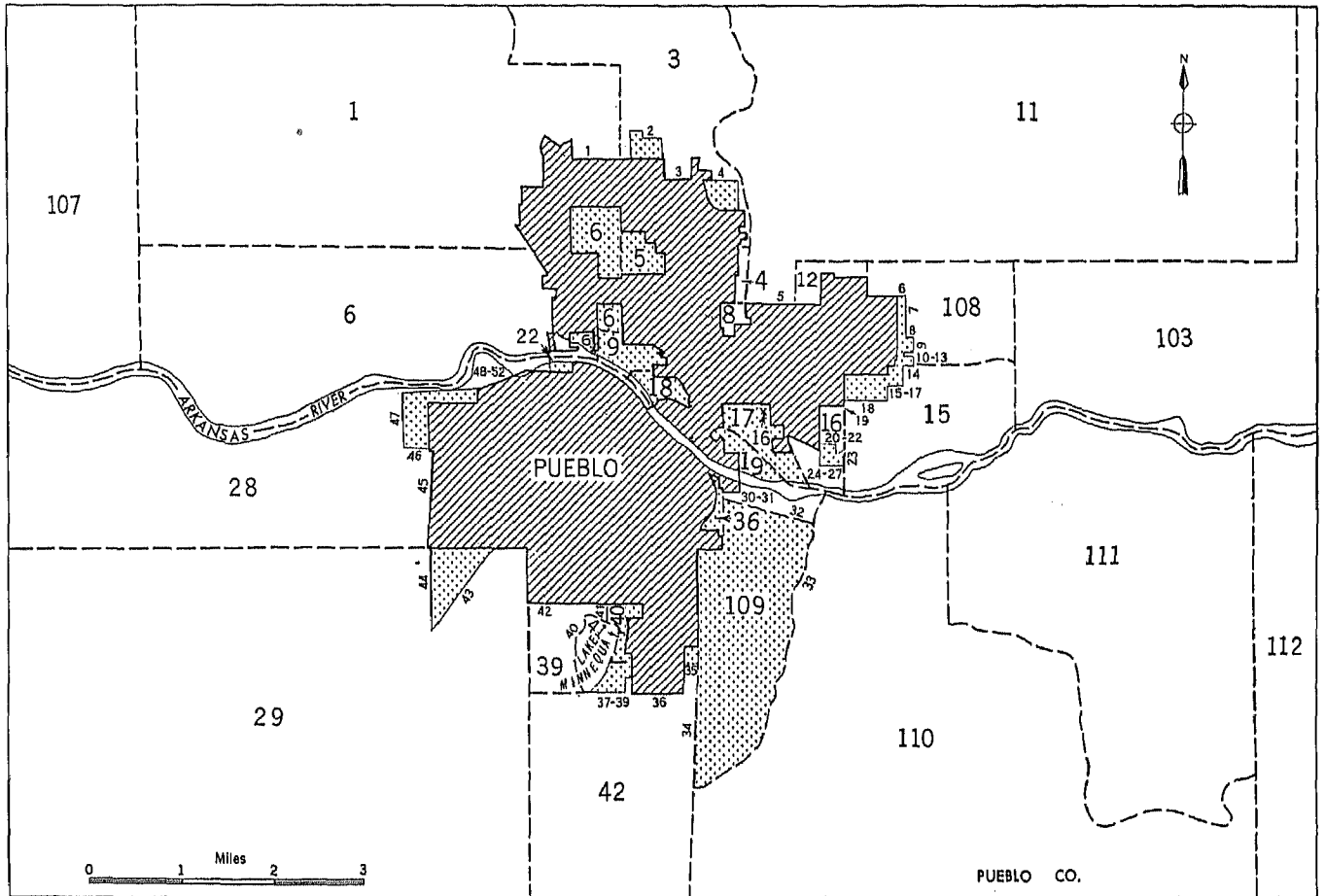

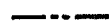
