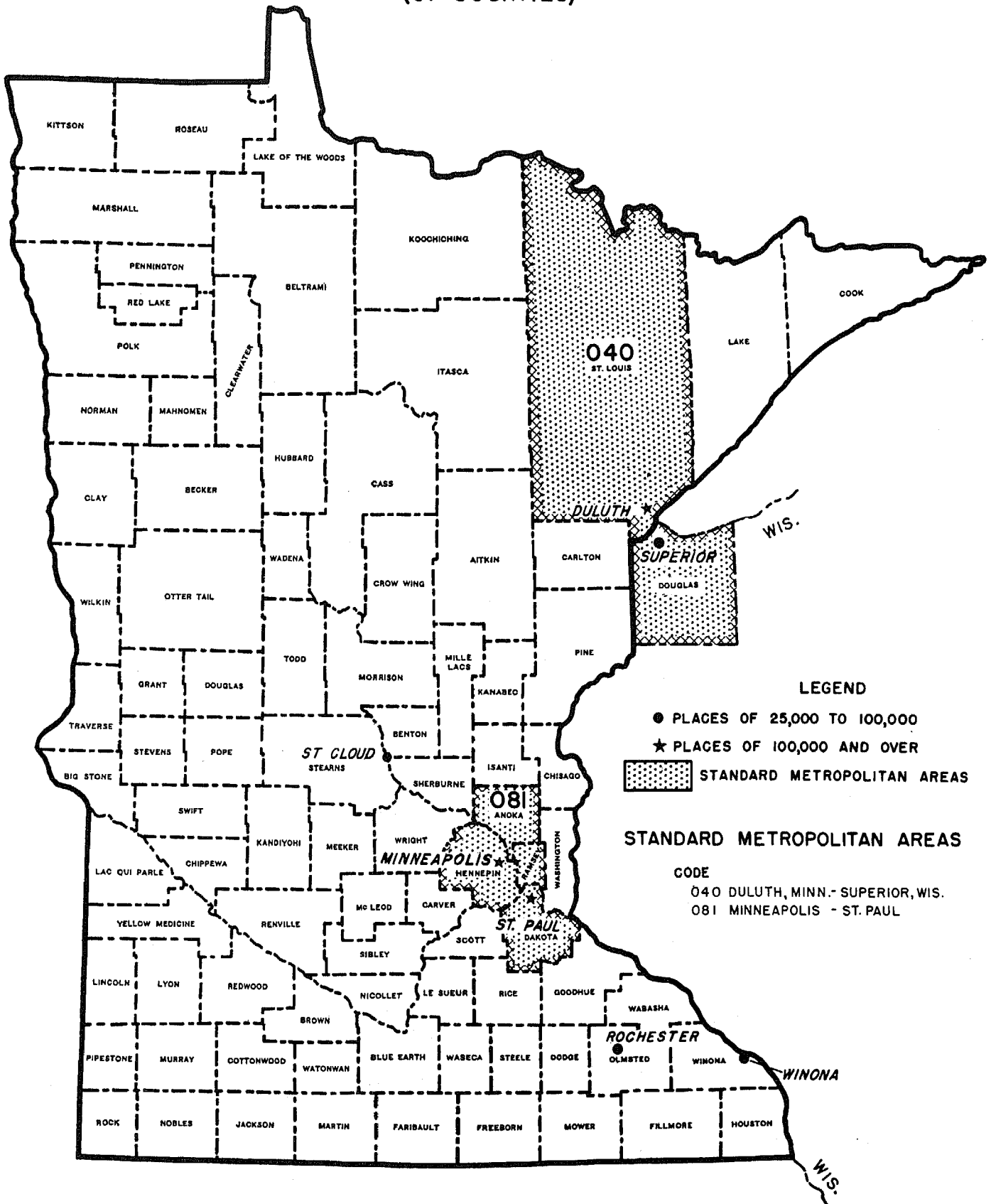

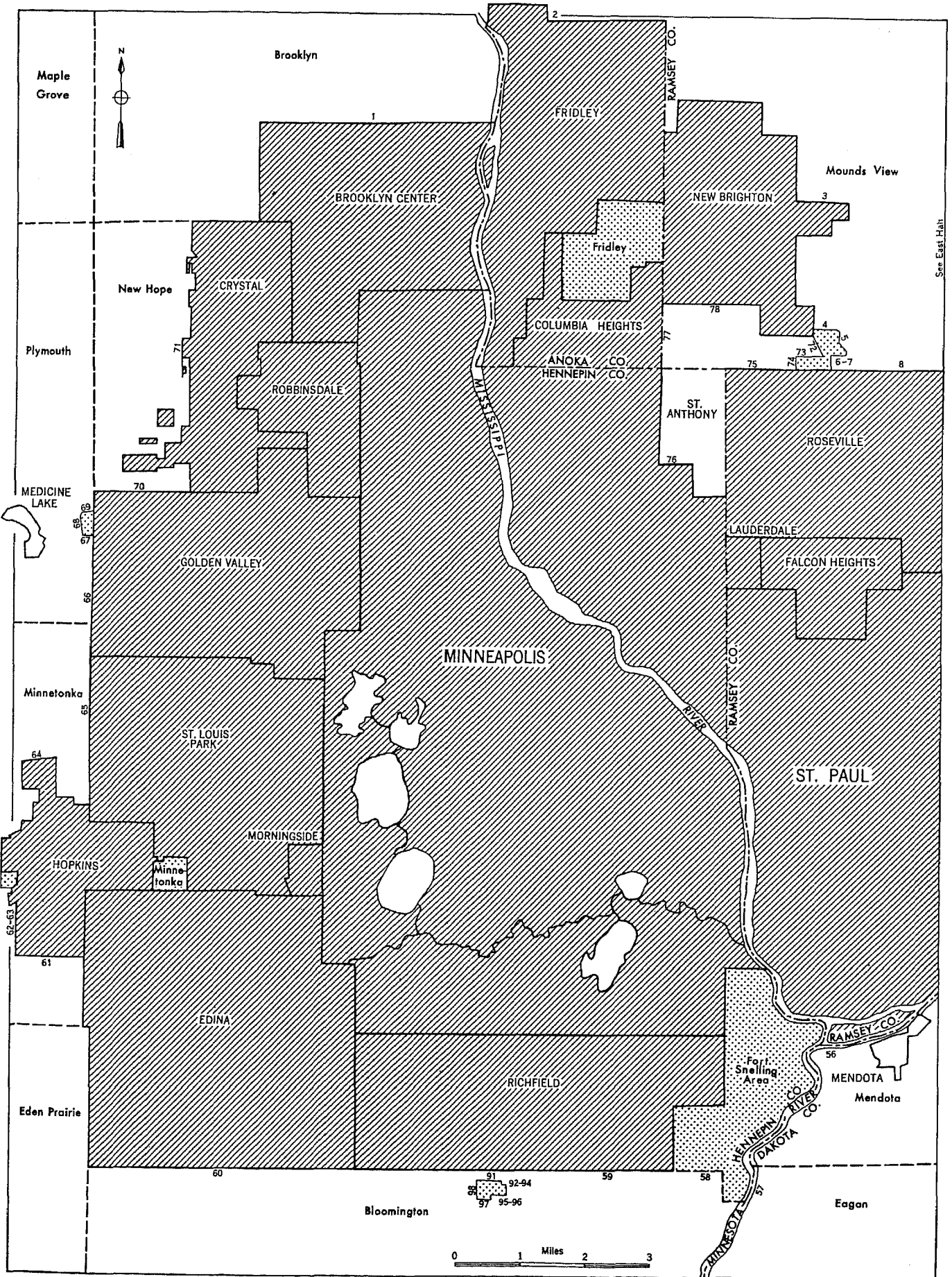

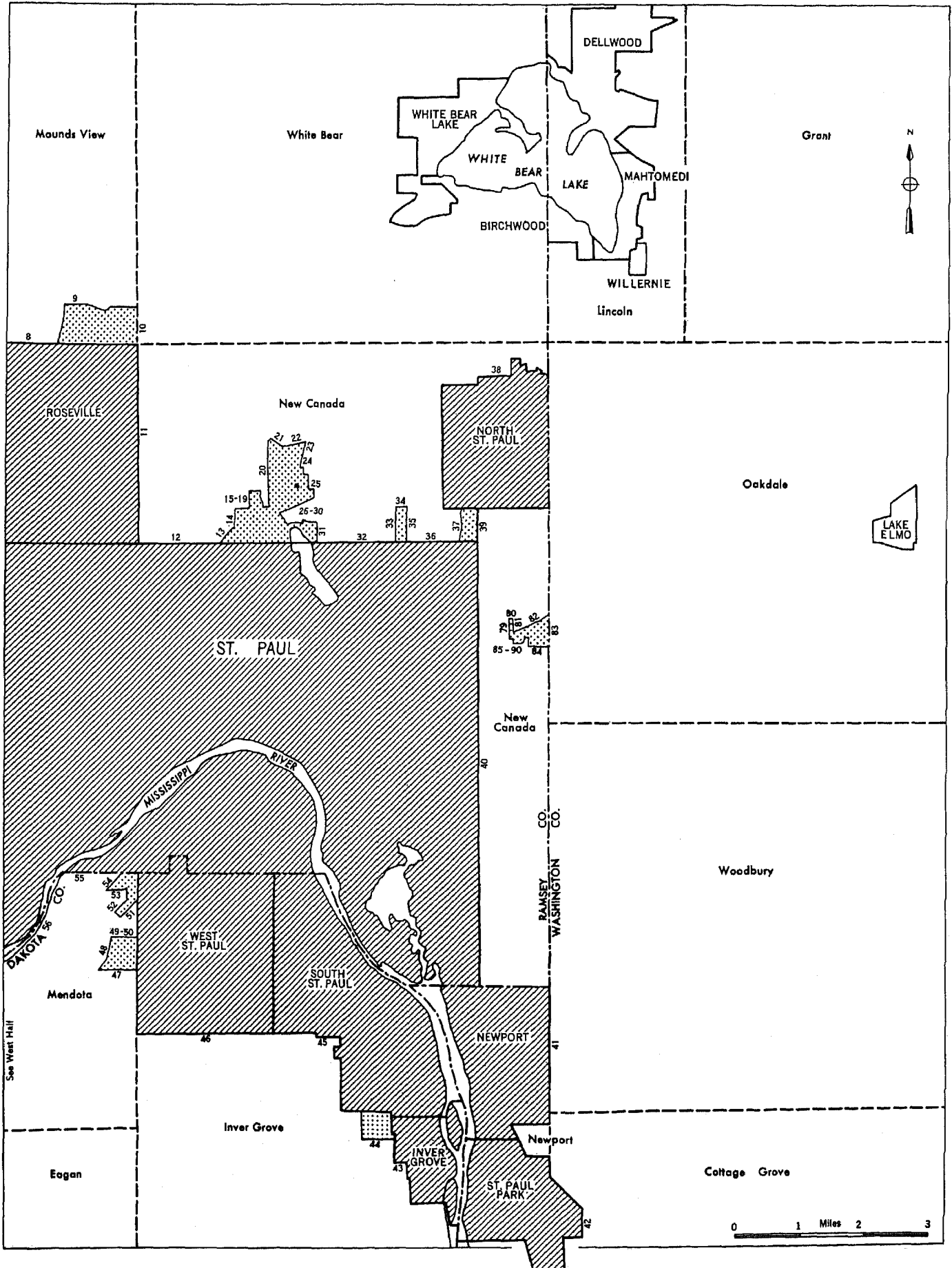
MINNEAPOLIS-ST. PAUL URBANIZED AREA—WESTERN PART

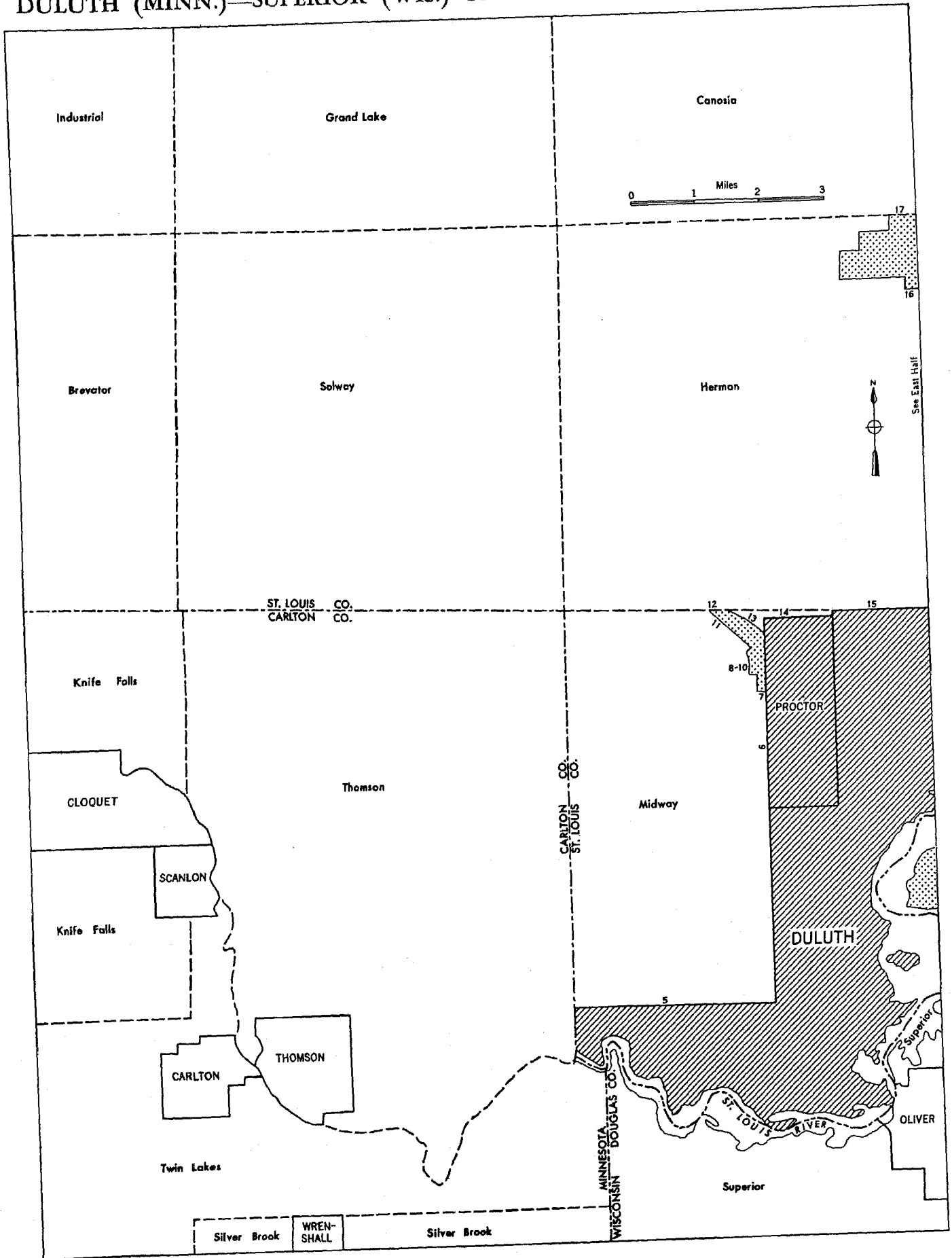


MINNEAPOLIS-ST. PAUL URBANIZED AREA—EASTERN PART
