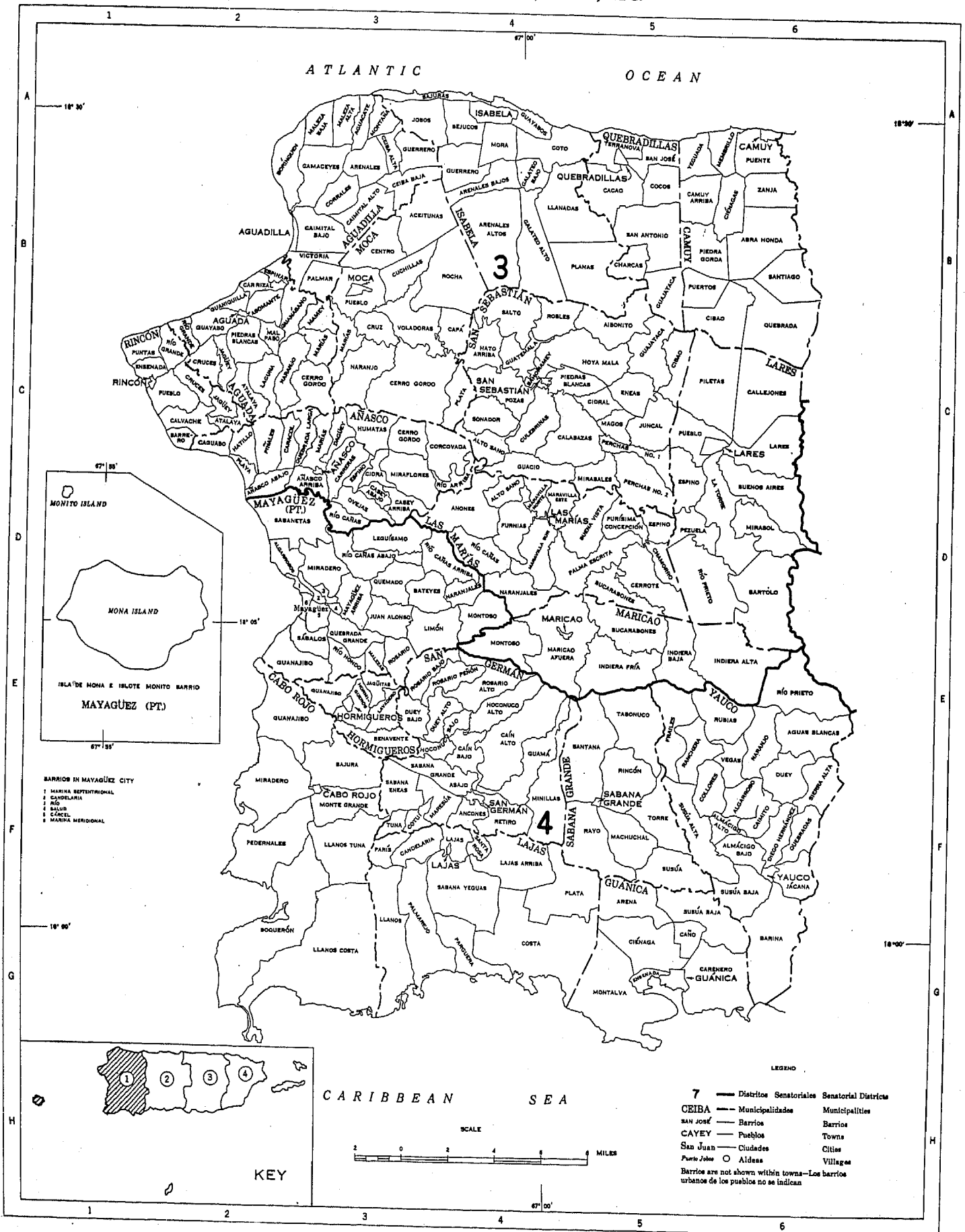
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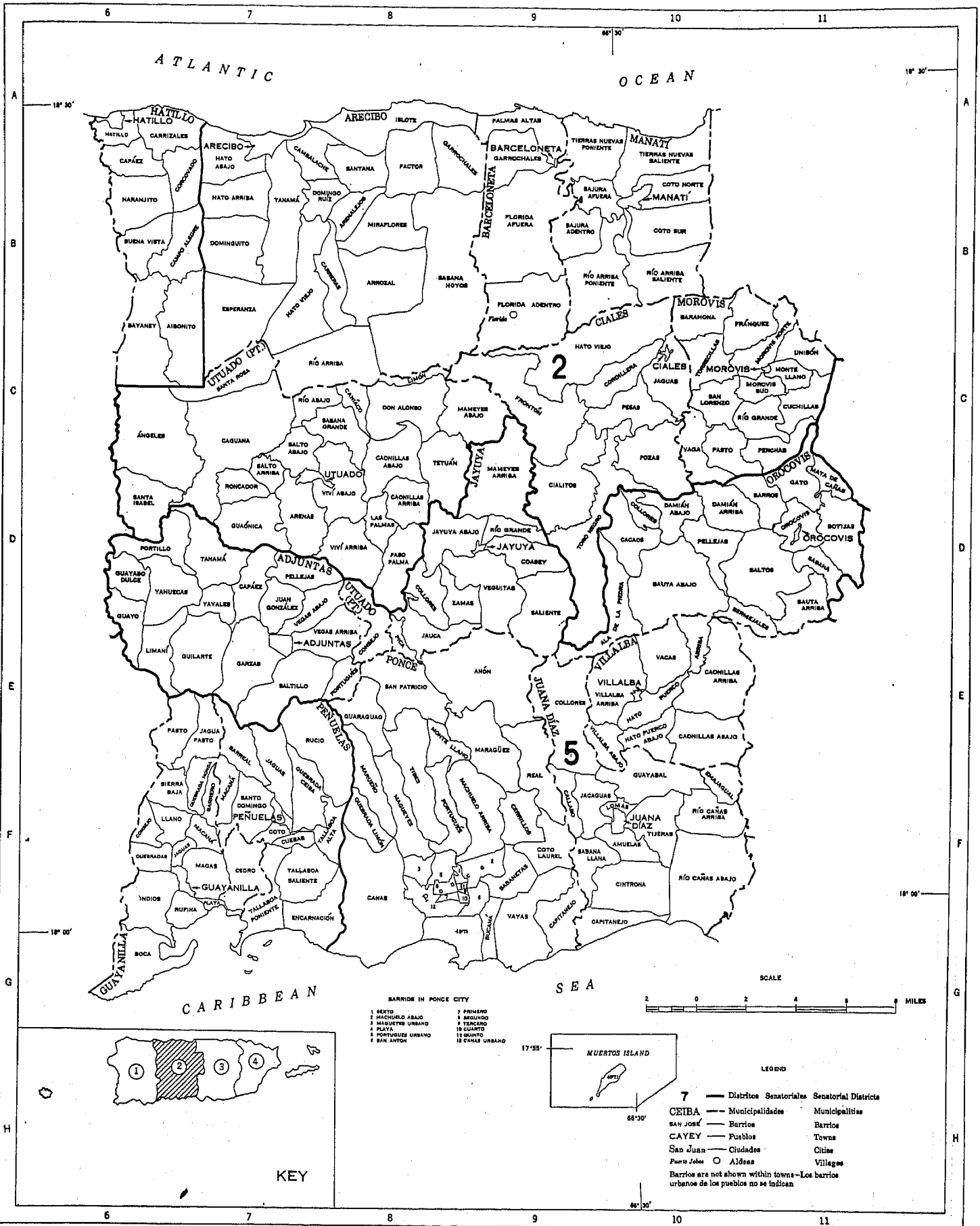
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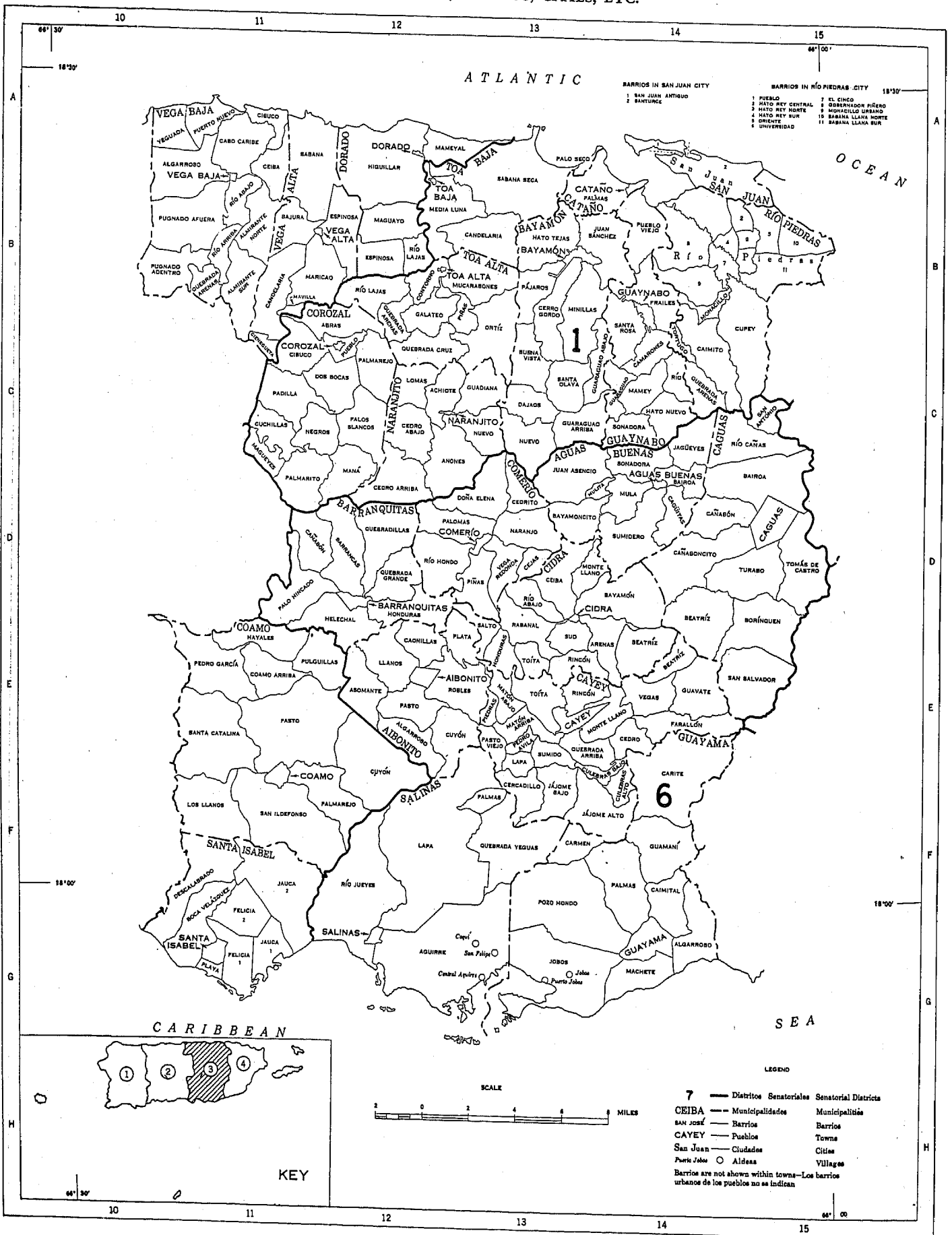
PUERTO RICO—SECTION 1, WESTERN PART
MUNICIPALITIES, BARRIOS, CITIES, ETC.



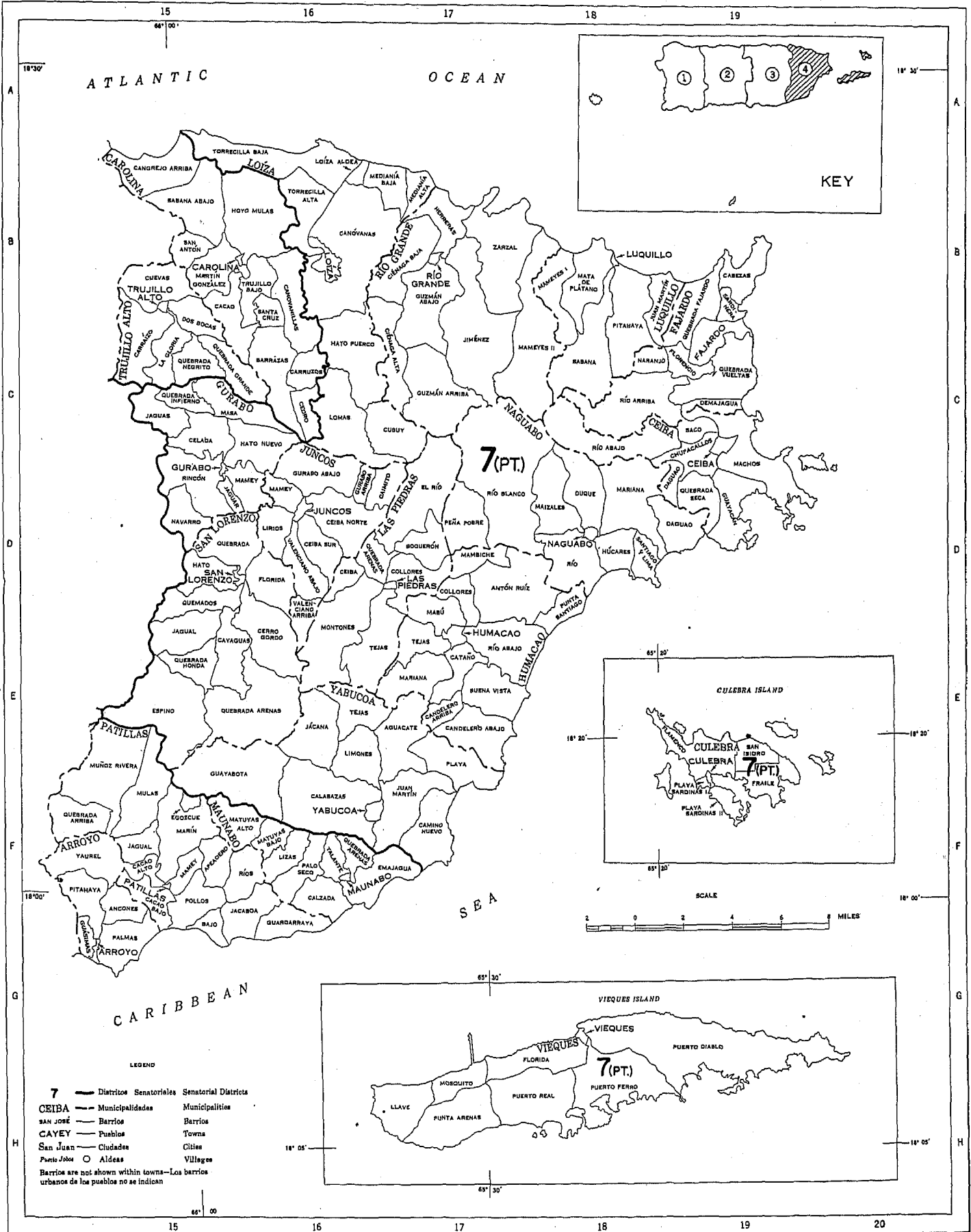
PUERTO RICO—SECTION 2, WEST CENTRAL PART

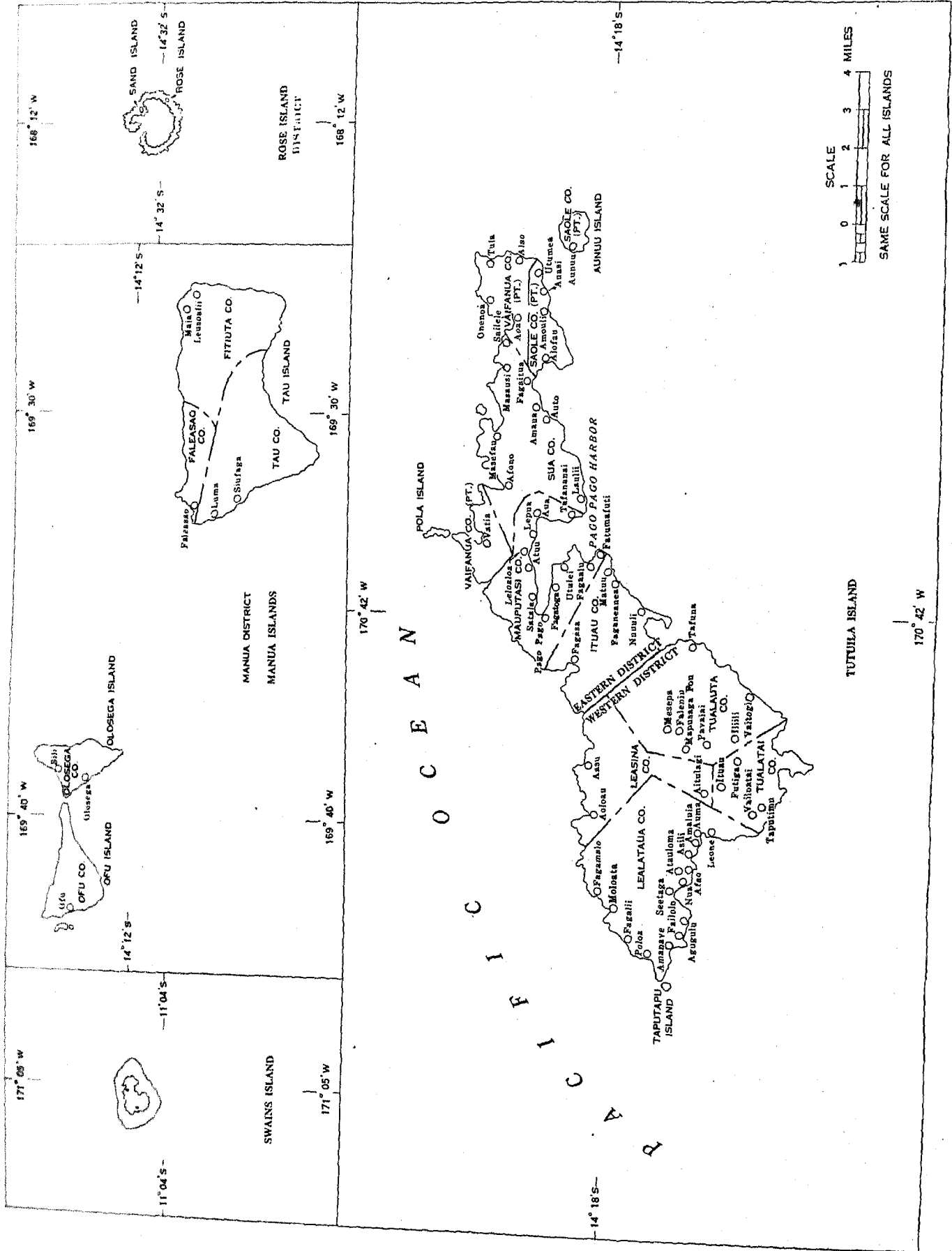

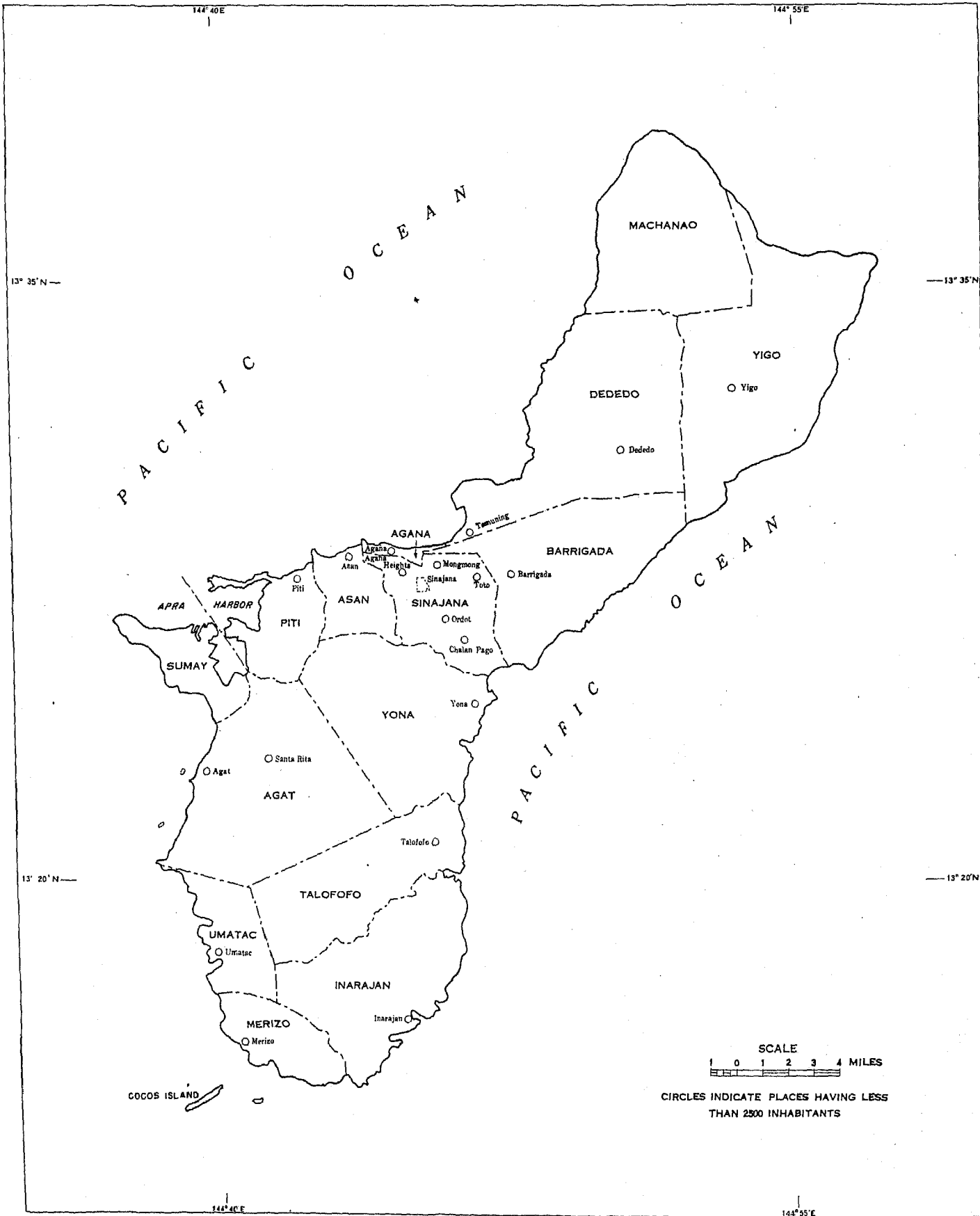

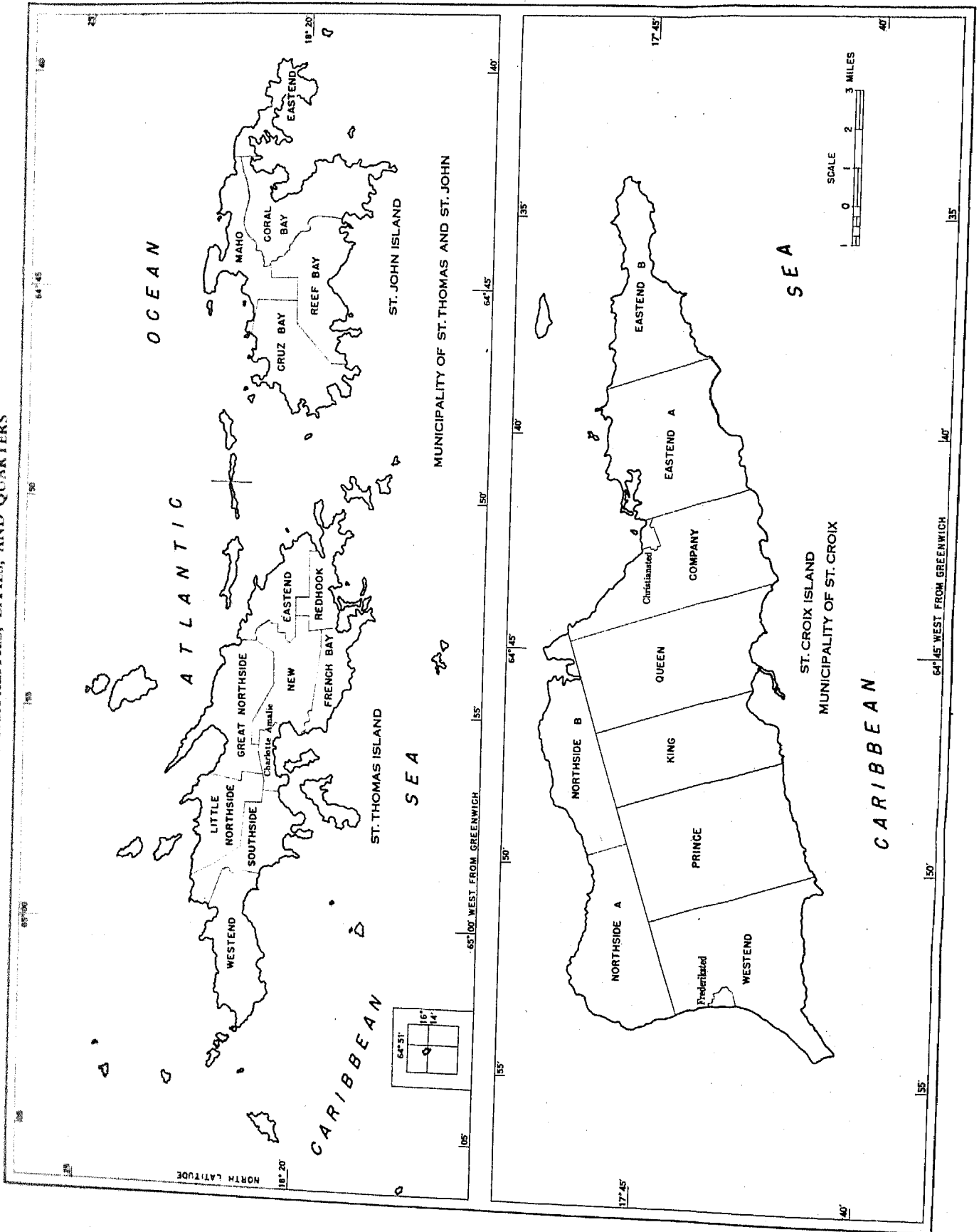
