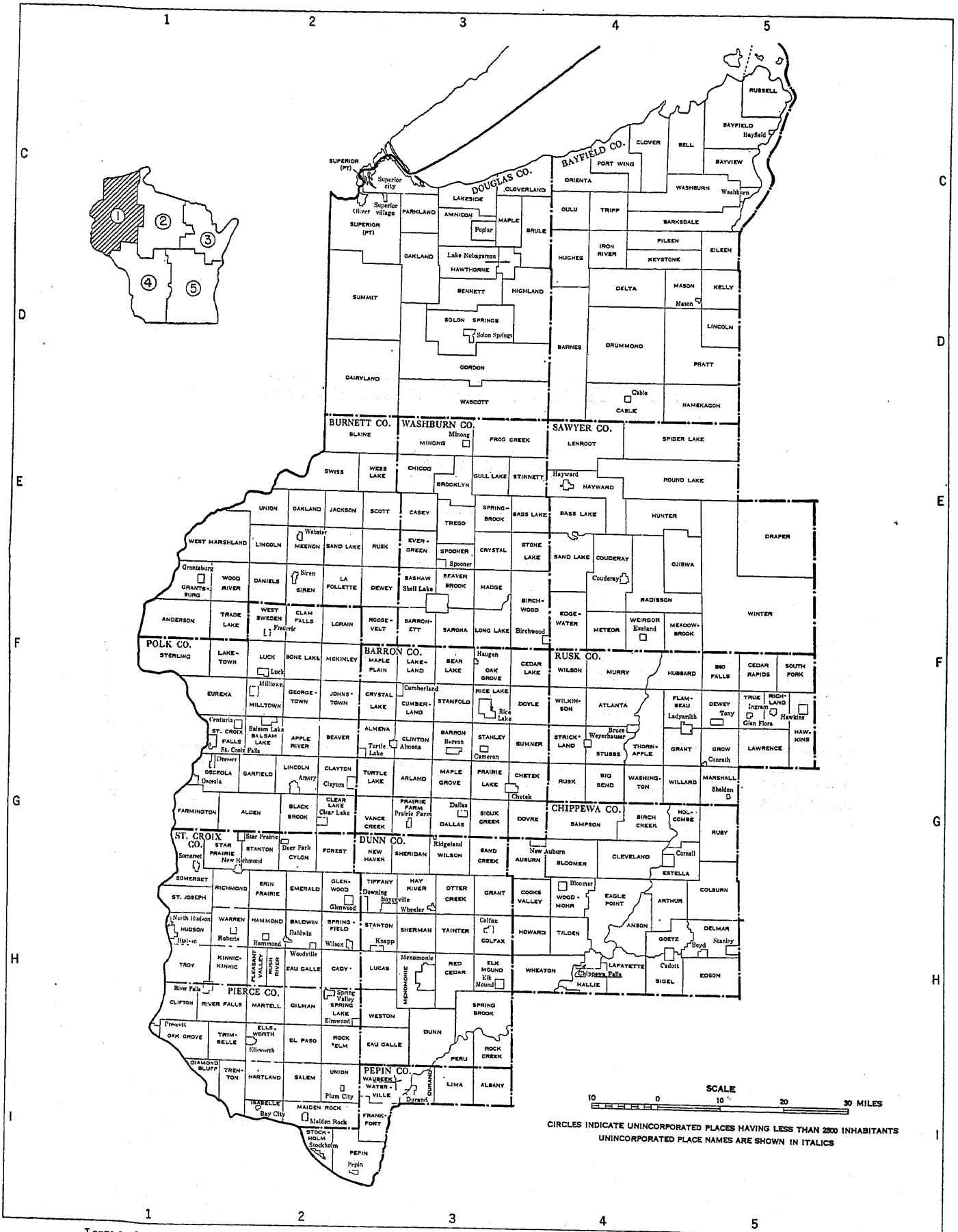

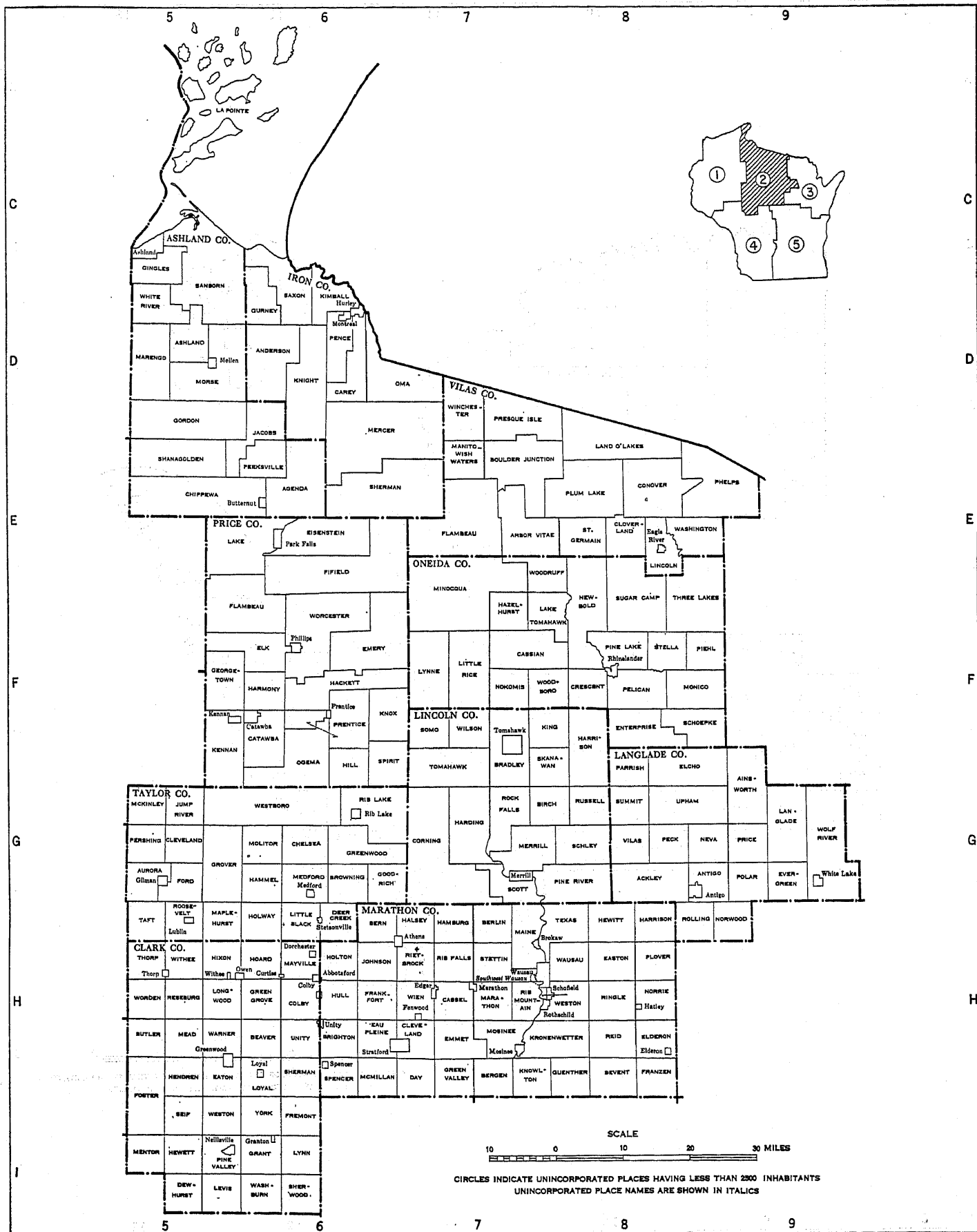
WISCONSIN—SECTION 1, NORTHWESTERN PART

MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNS, CITIES, AND VILLAGES



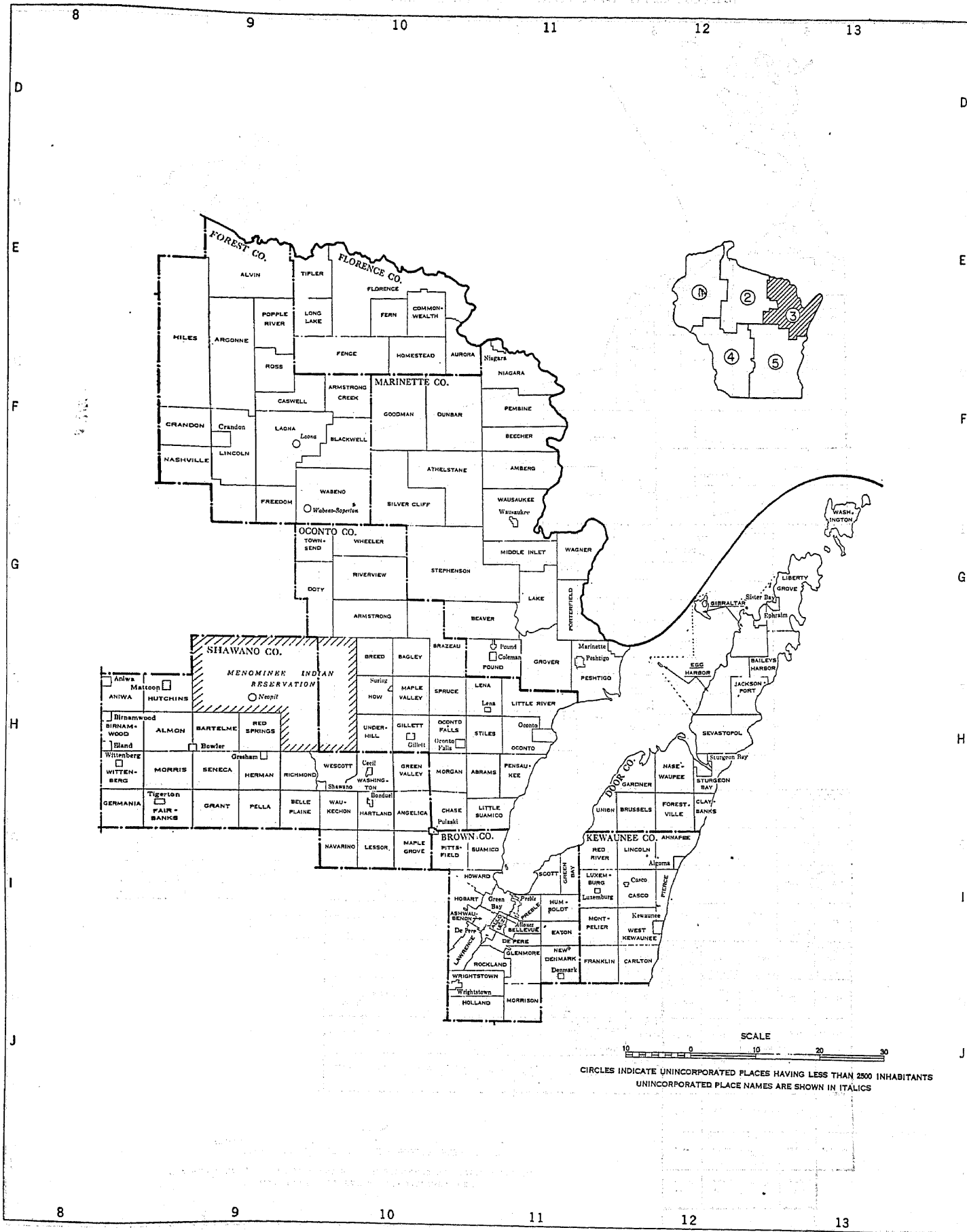

MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNS, CITIES, AND VILLAGES



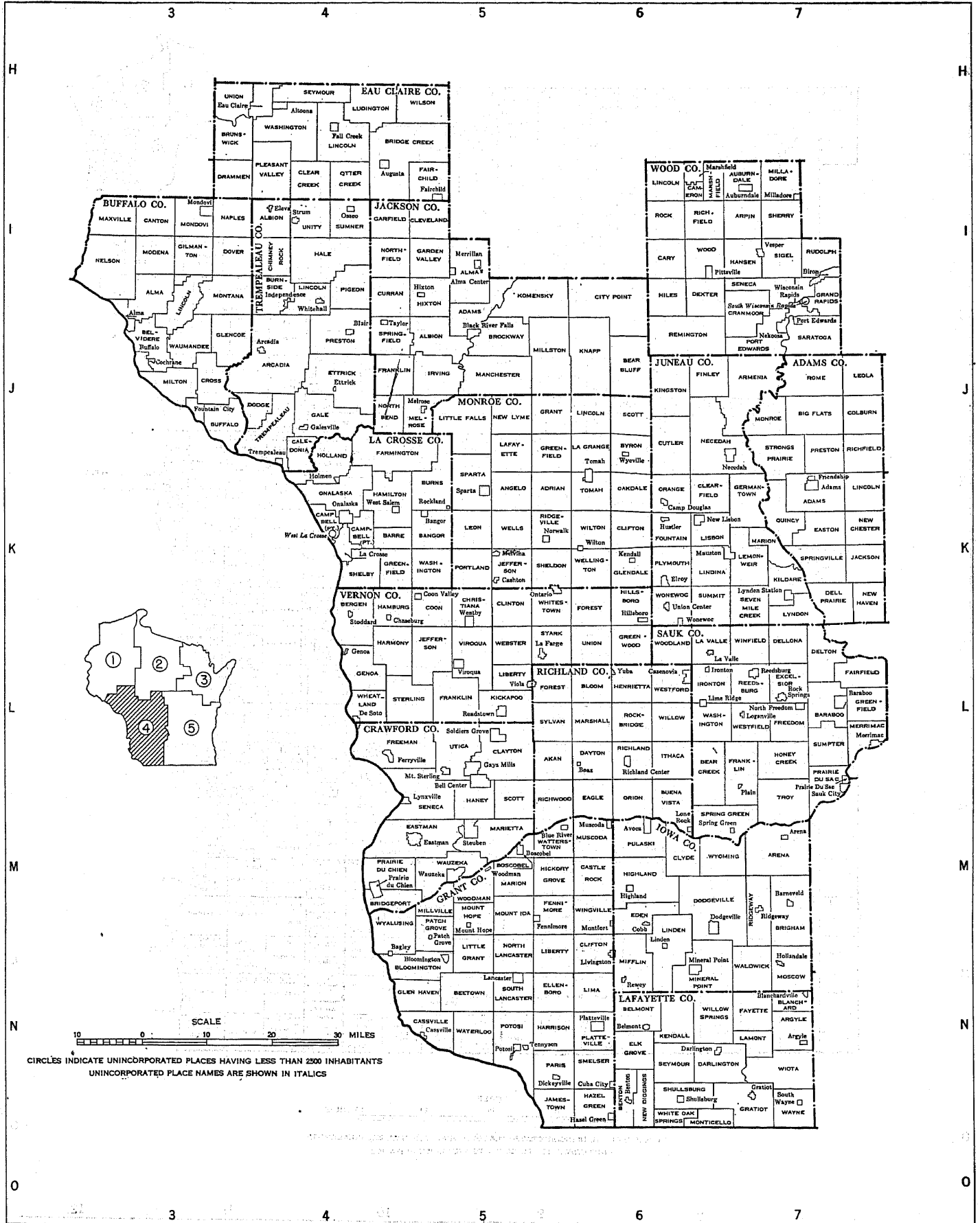
WISCONSIN—SECTION 3, NORTHEASTERN PART

MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNS, CITIES, AND VILLAGES



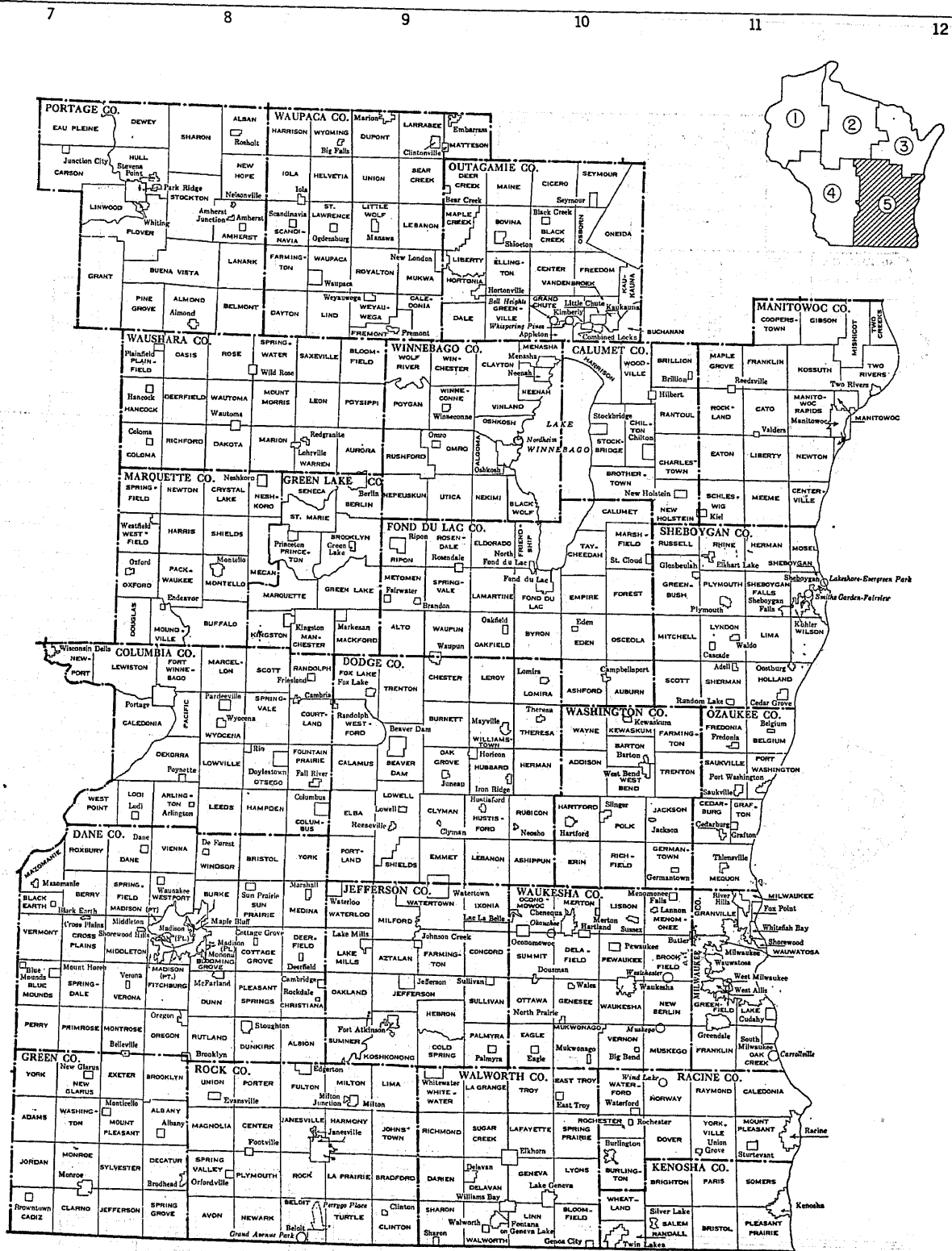
WISCONSIN—SECTION 4, SOUTHWESTERN PART

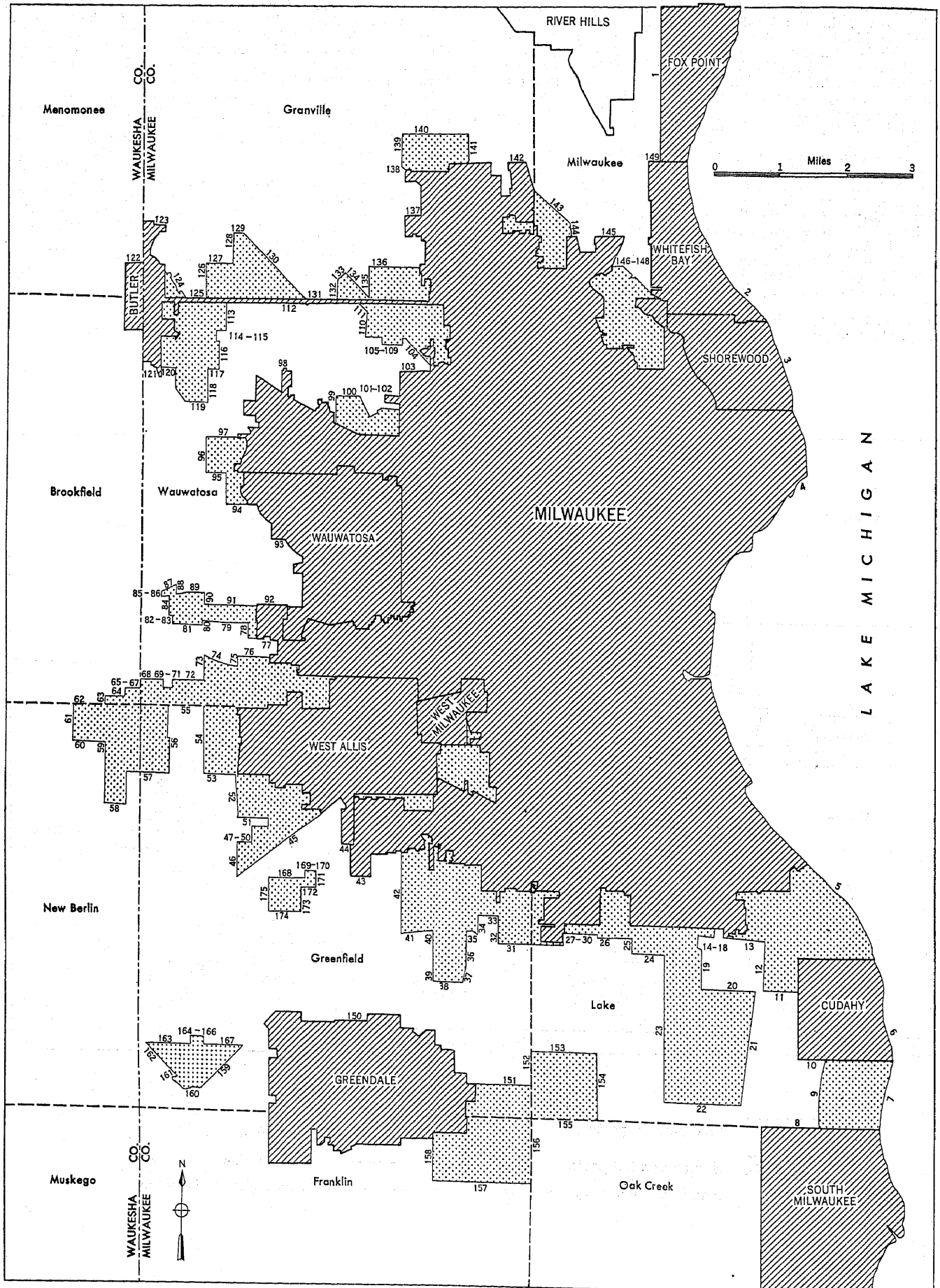

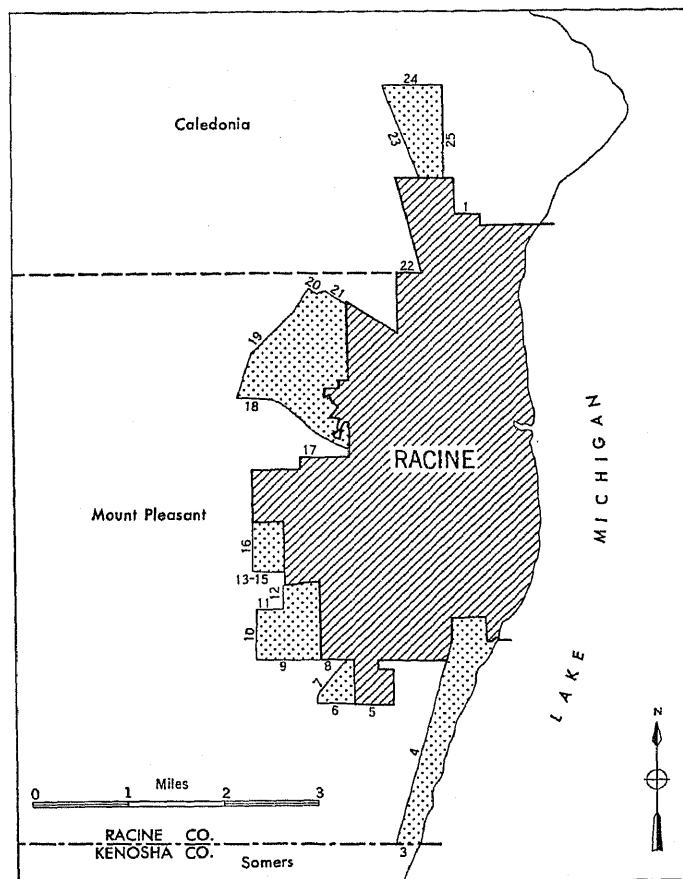
