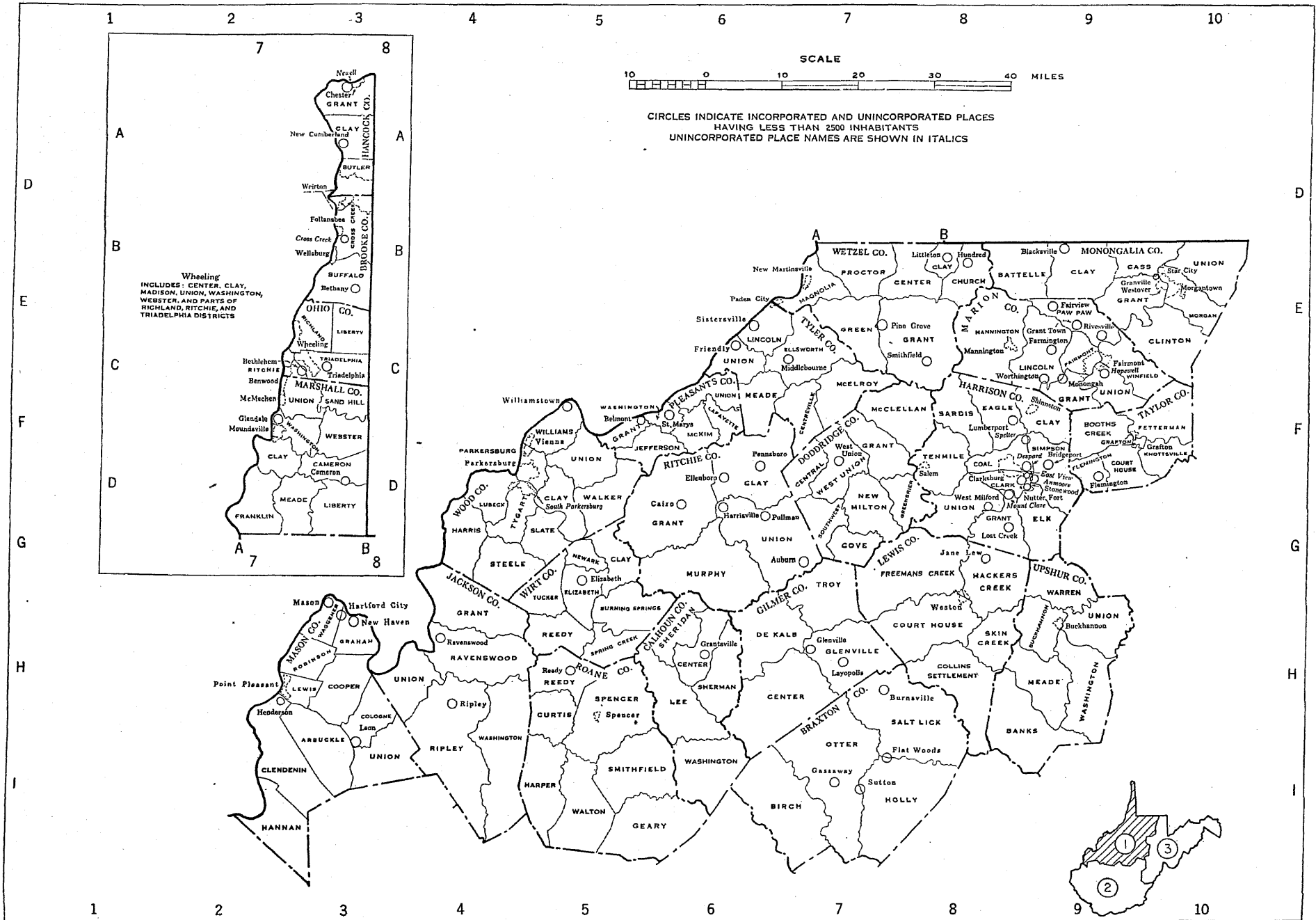

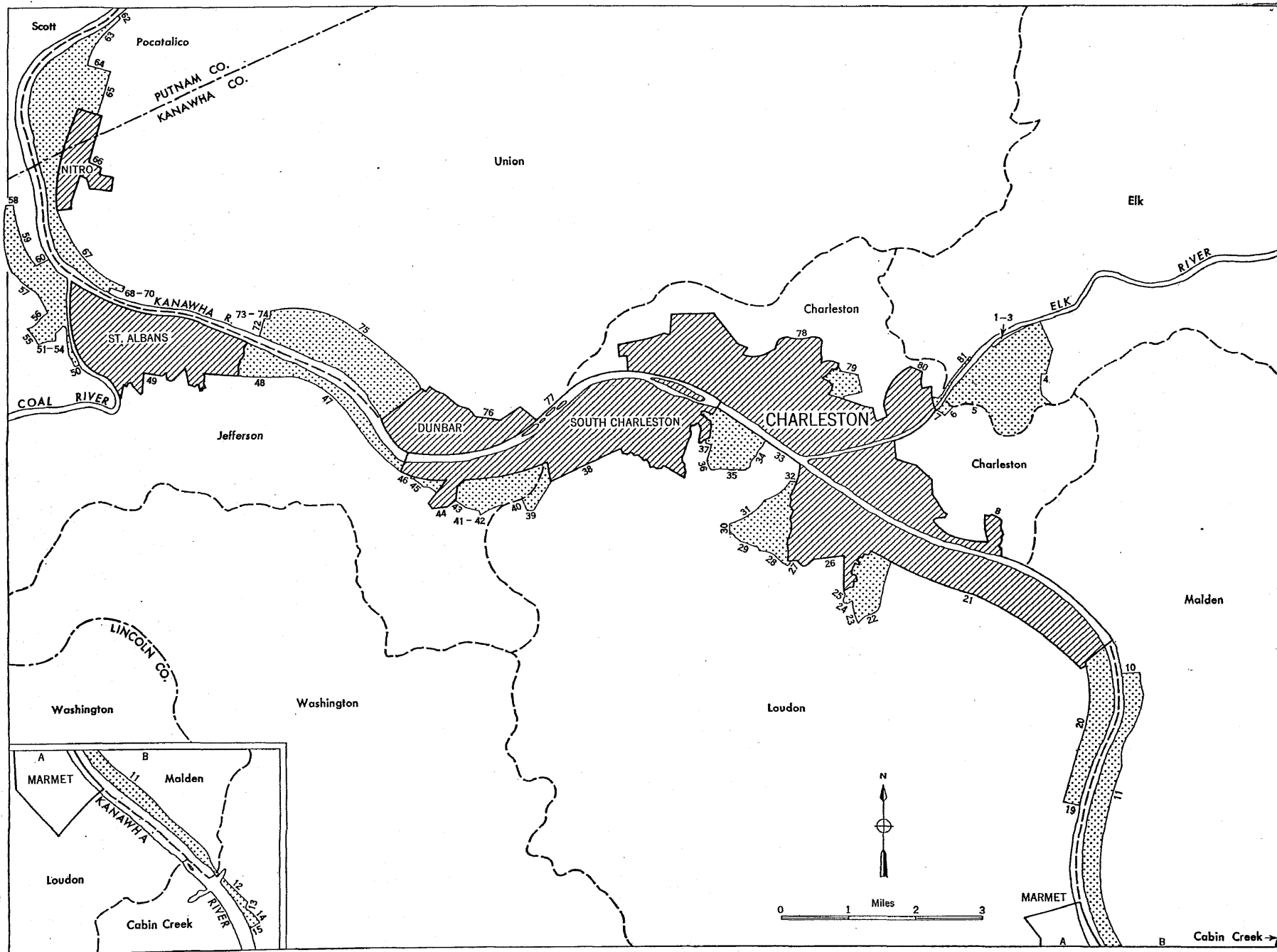

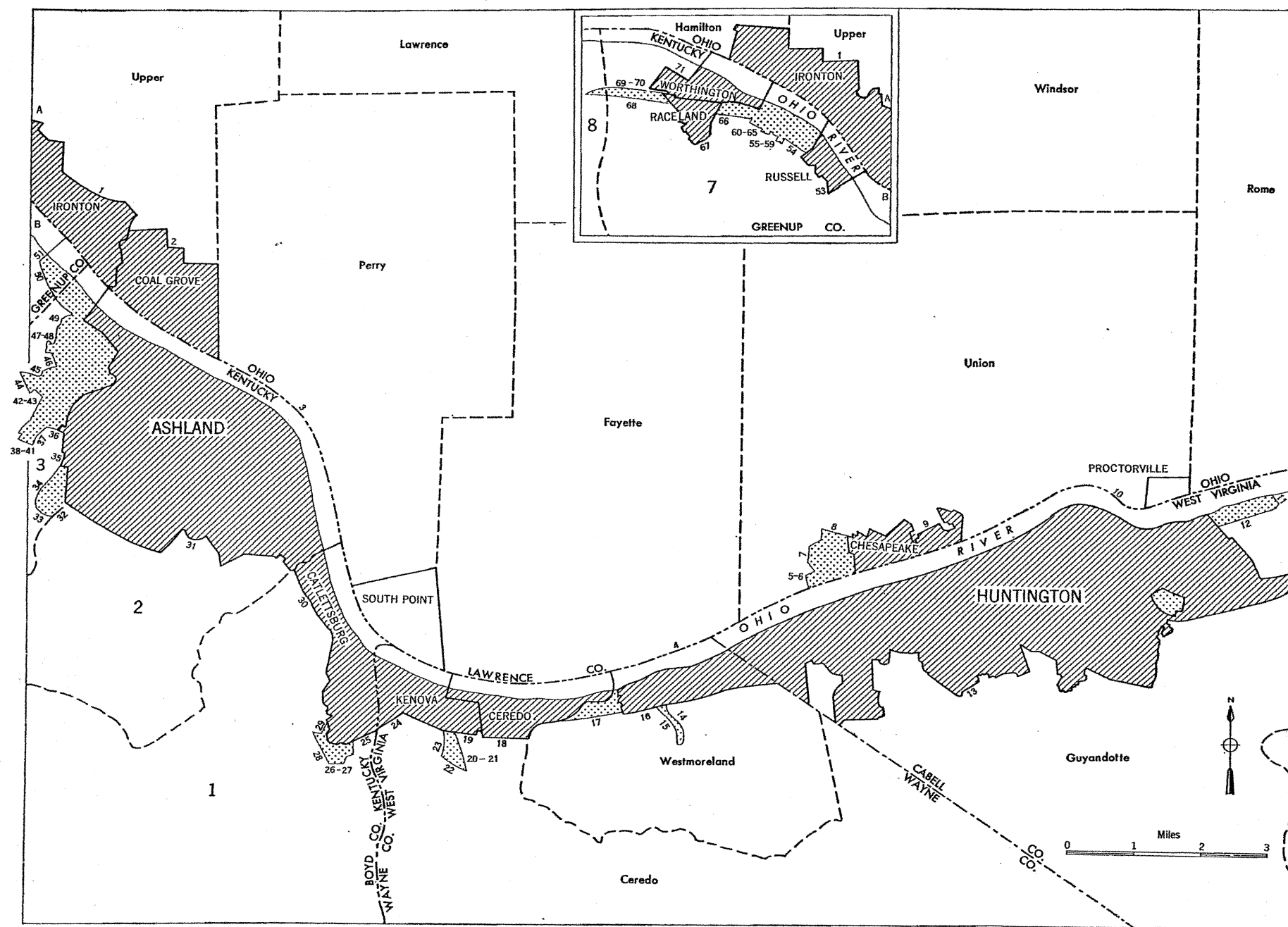
CHARLESTON, W. VA., URBANIZED AREA
