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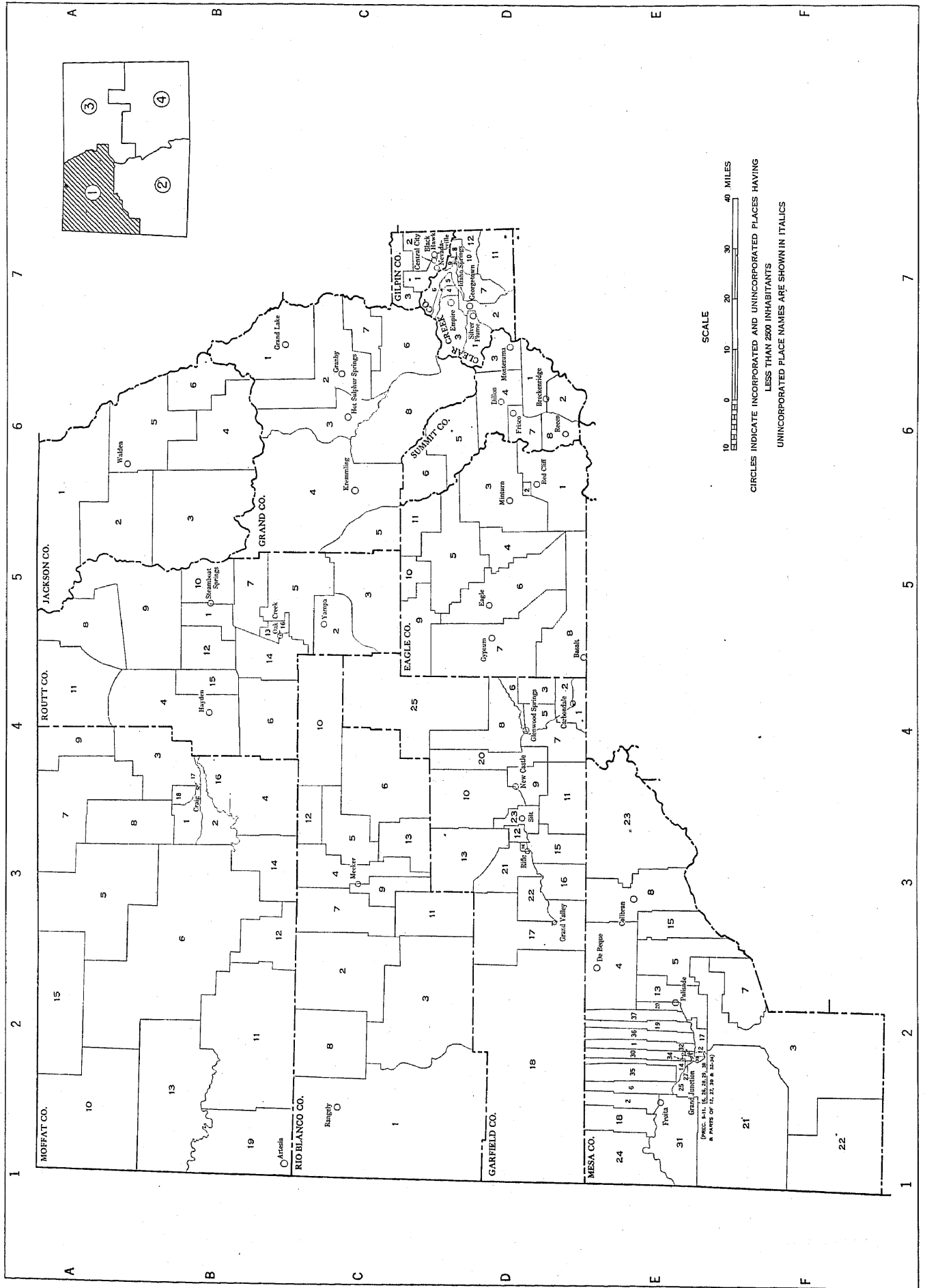

URBANIZED AREA MAPS

The Denver and Pueblo Urbanized Areas, for which statistics are shown in table 9, are depicted in the following maps. The shaded areas, in combination, comprise the urbanized areas. To assist in locating the exact external boundaries of the areas, each

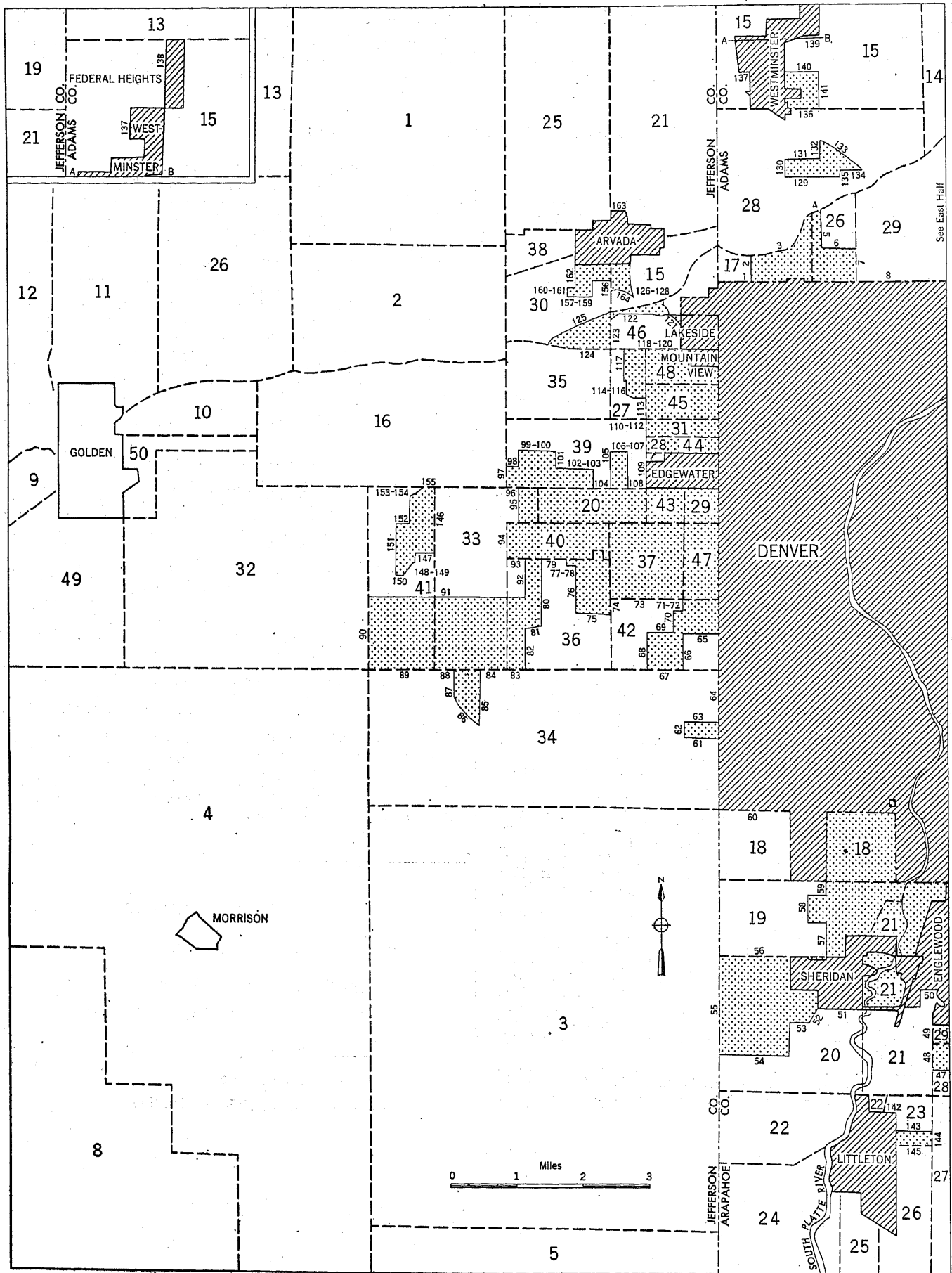

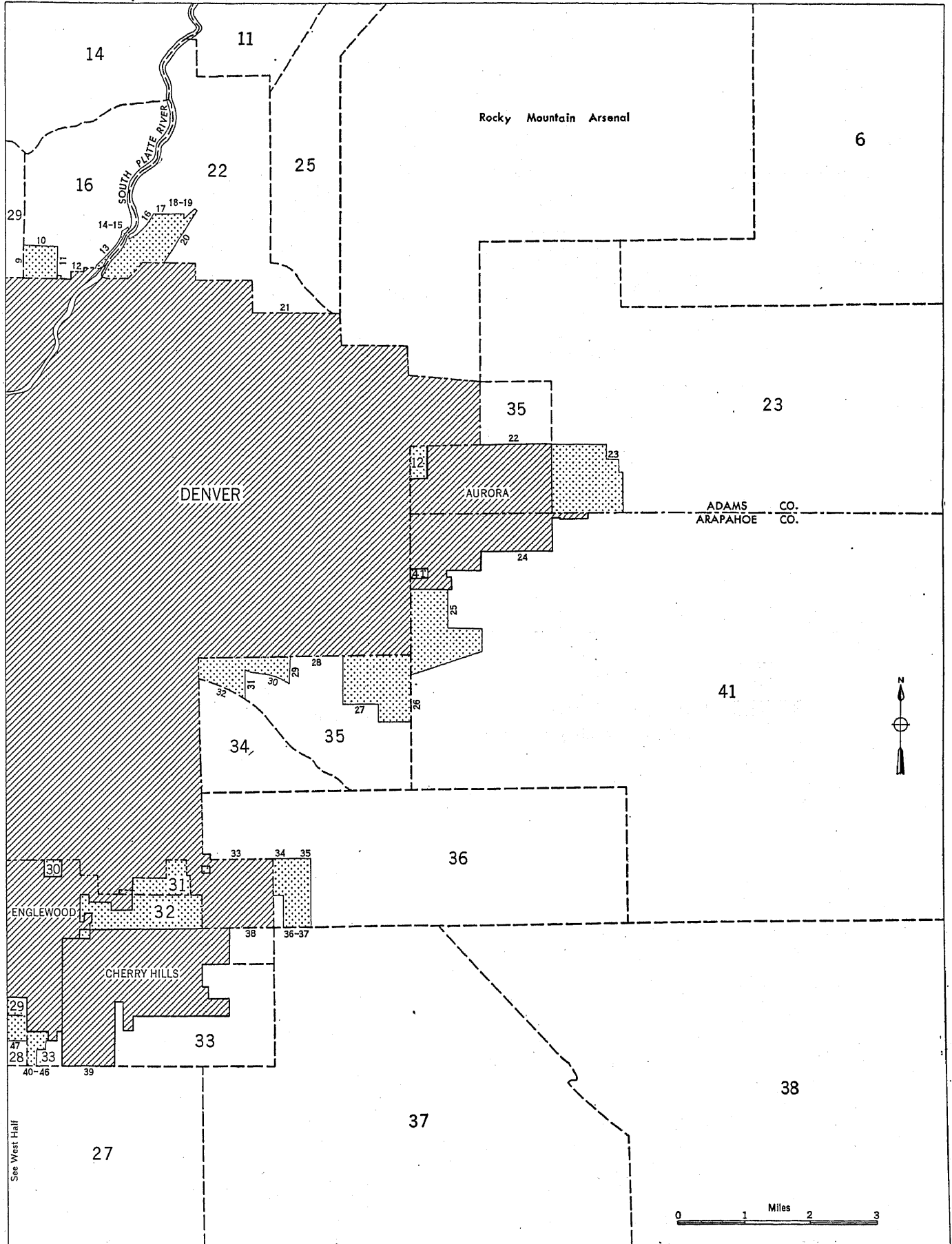

DENVER URBANIZED AREA—WESTERN PART

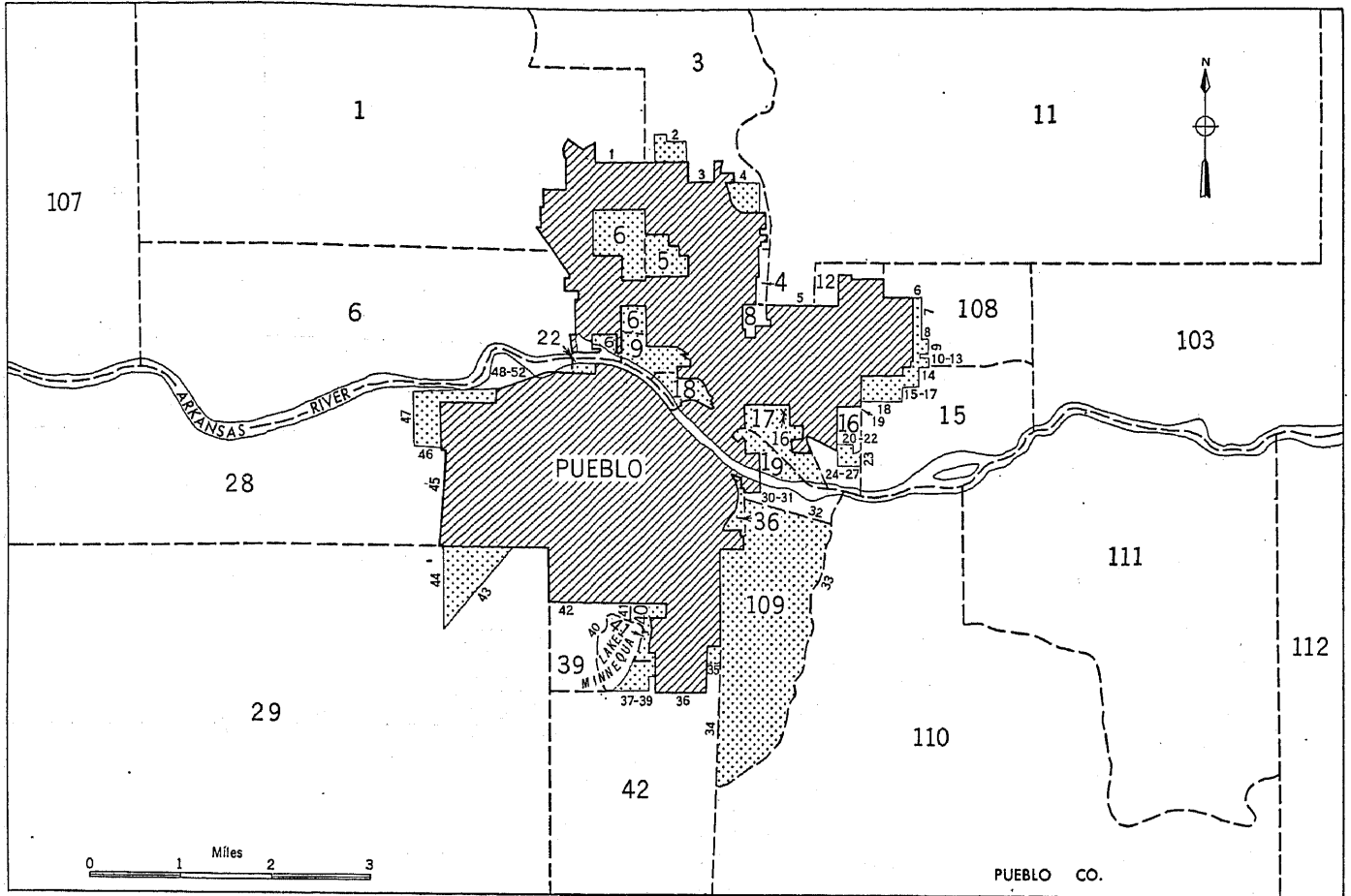


DENVER URBANIZED AREA—EASTERN PART

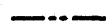

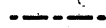

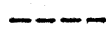
