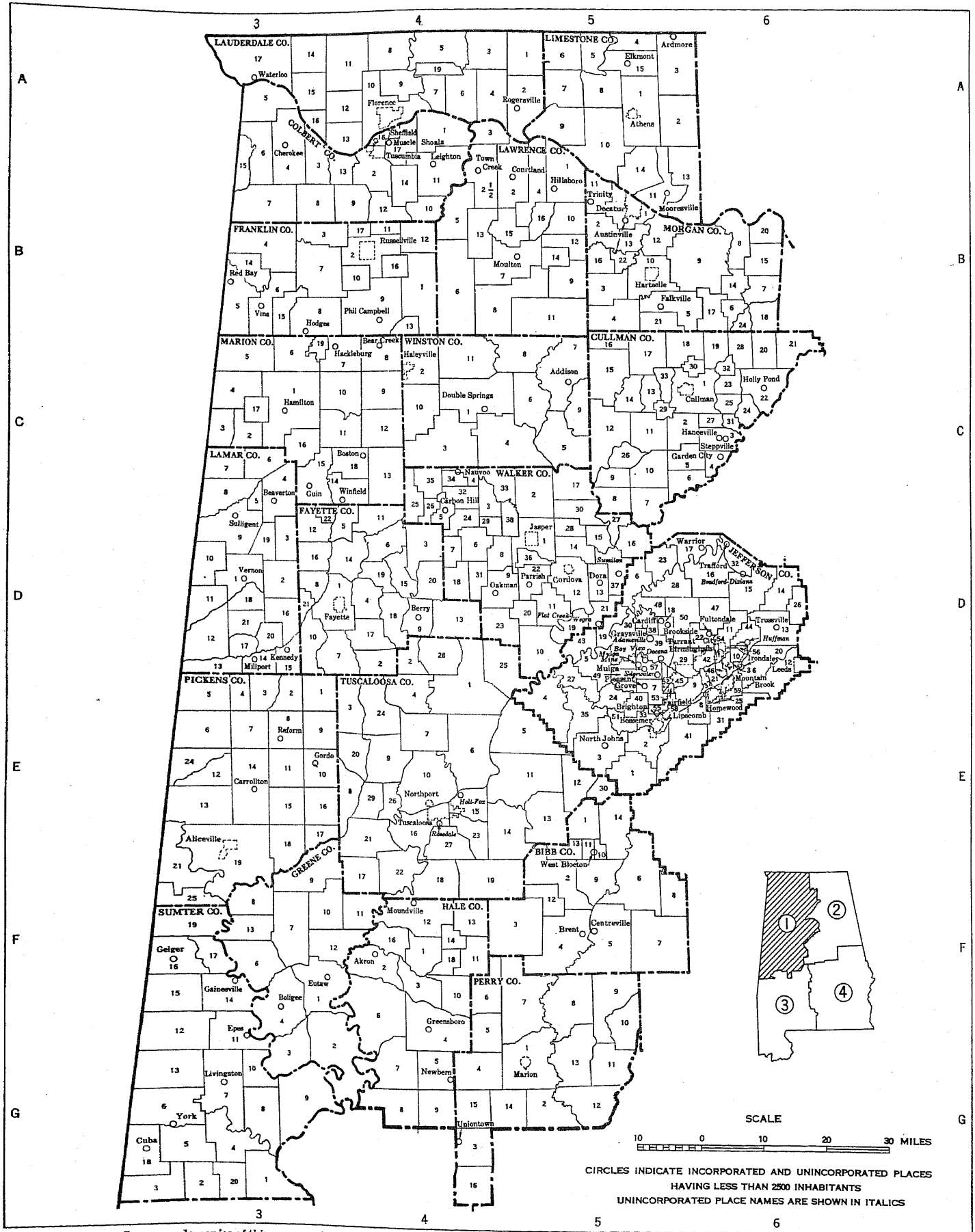
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ALABAMA—SECTION 1, NORTHWESTERN PART

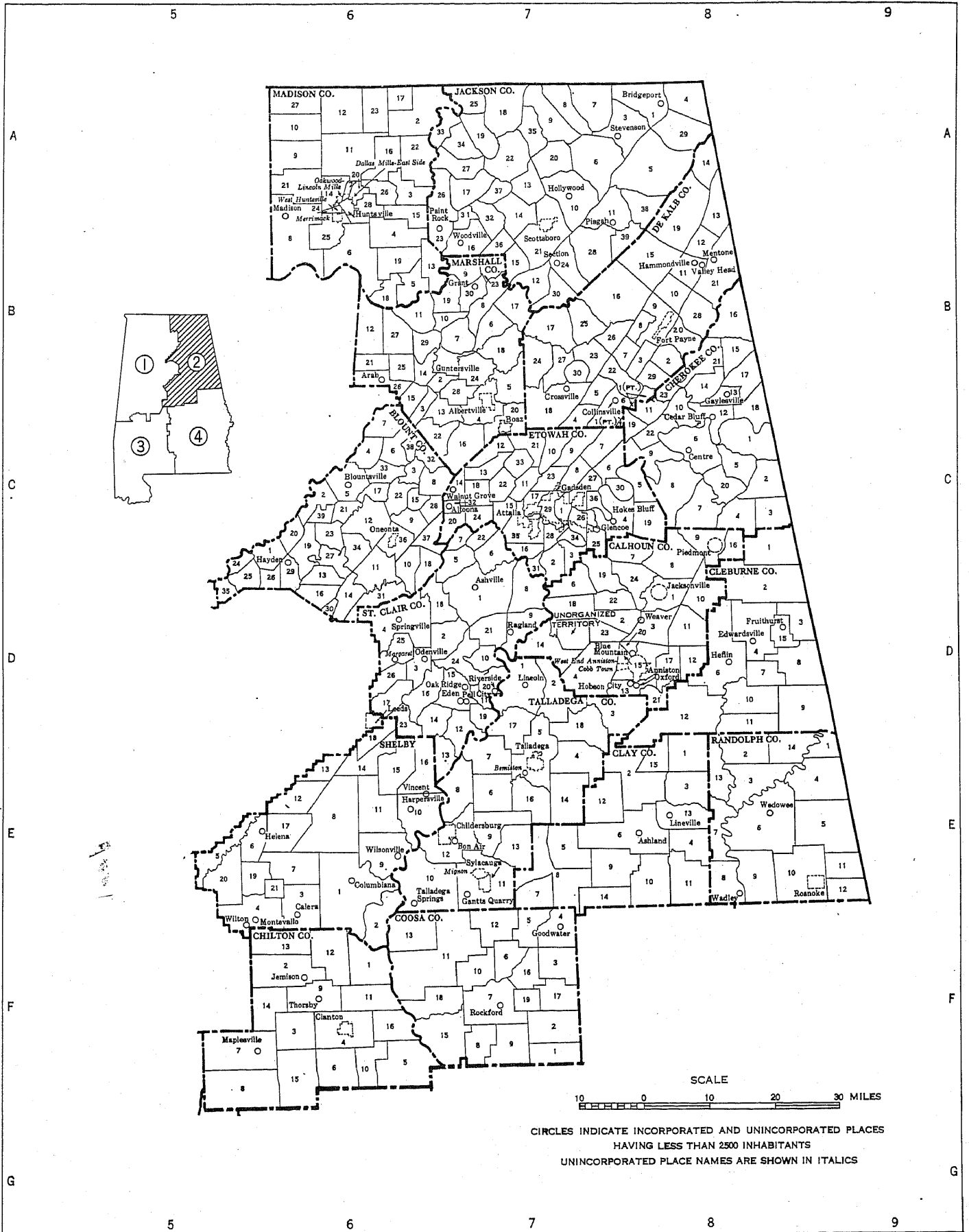
MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—ELECTION PRECINCTS

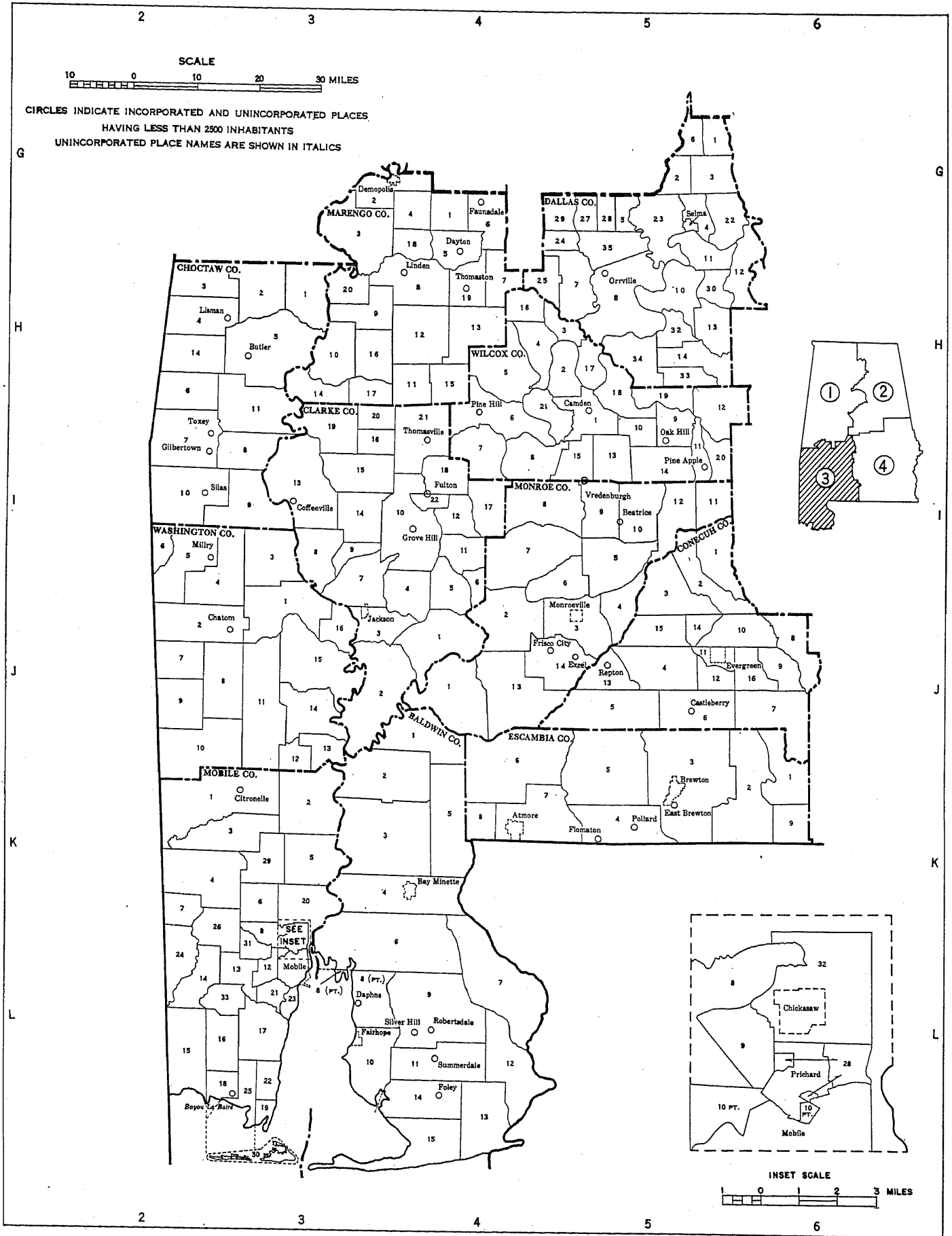
ALABAMA—SECTION 2, NORTHEASTERN PART

MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—ELECTION PRECINCTS



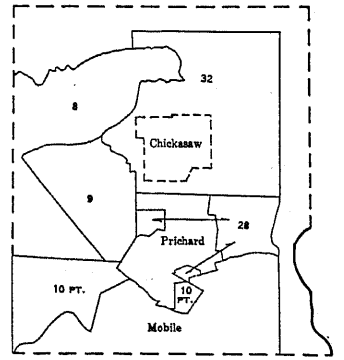
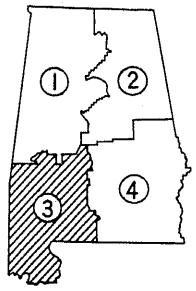
ALABAMA—SECTION 3, SOUTHWESTERN PART

MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—ELECTION PRECINCTS



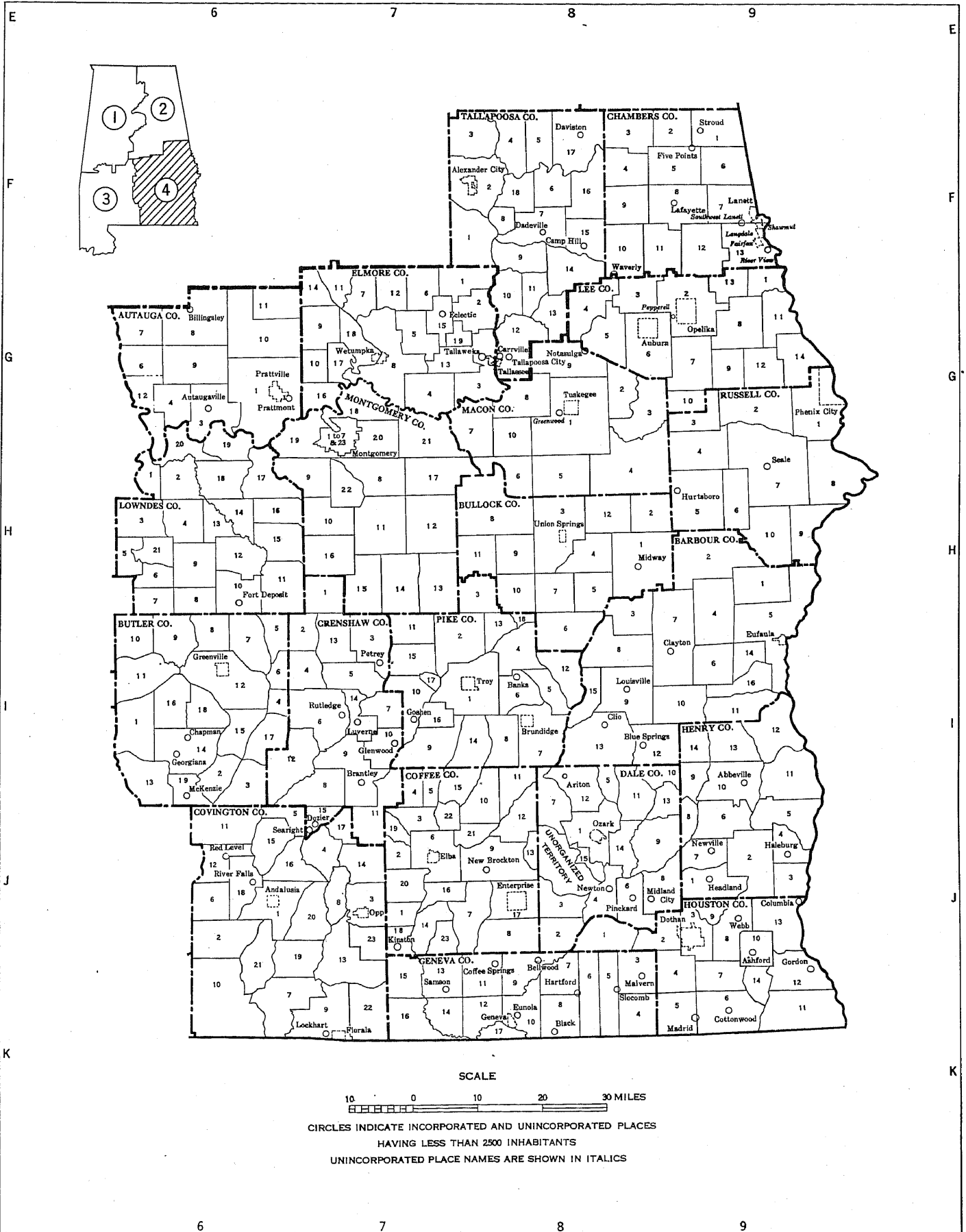

KEY TO NUMBERED BOUNDARY SEGMENTS








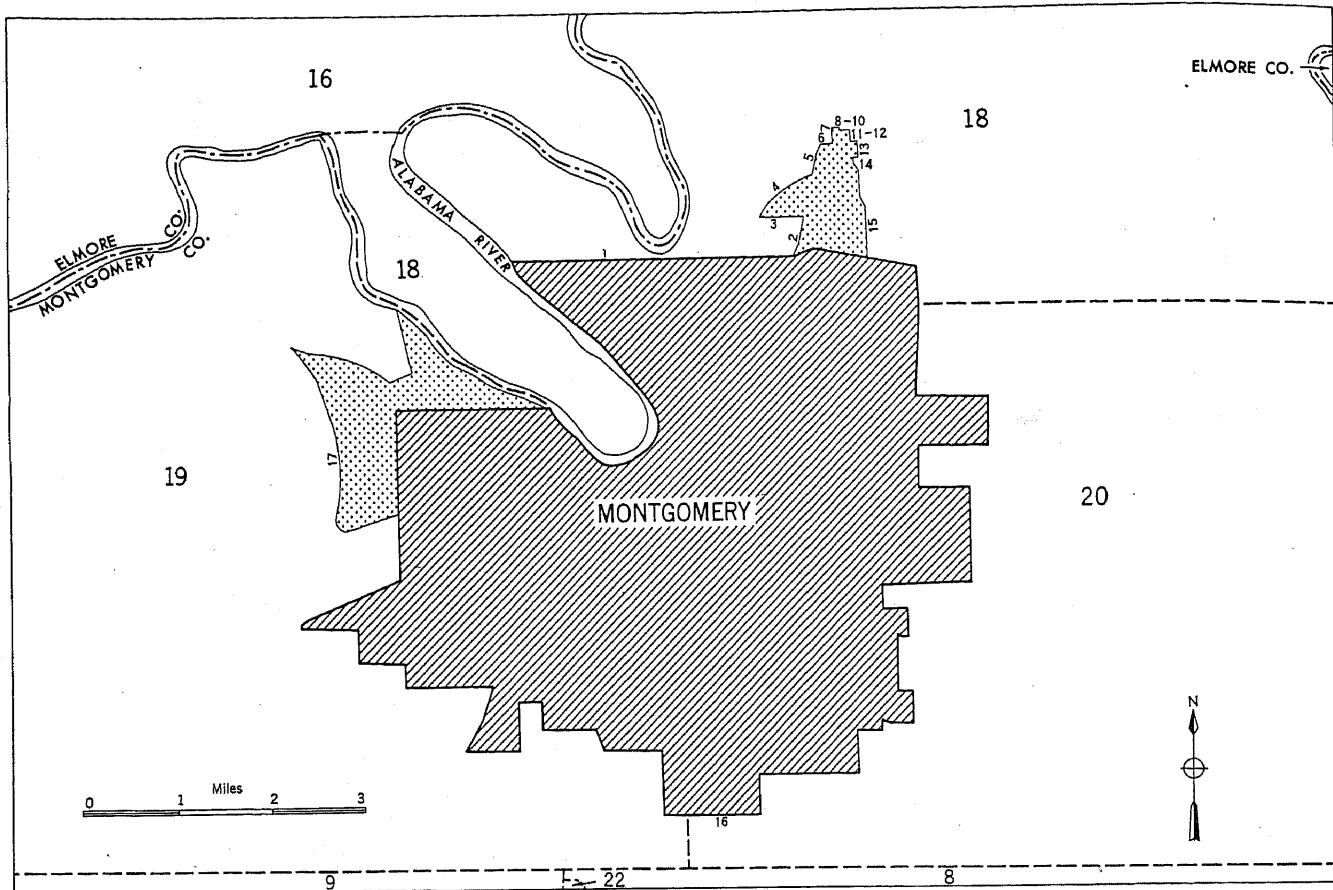








NUMBER OF INHABITANTS MOBILE URBANIZED AREA
