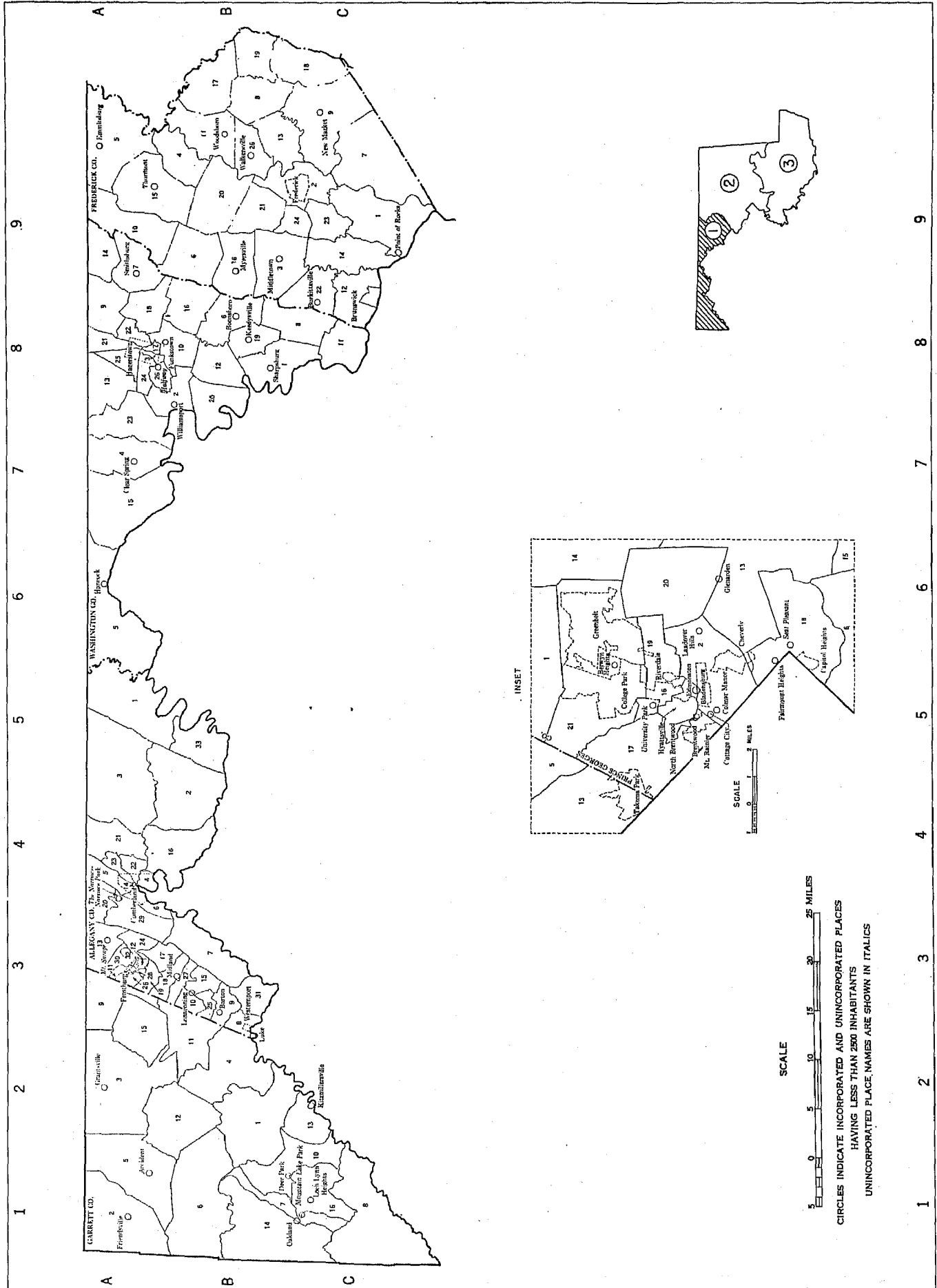
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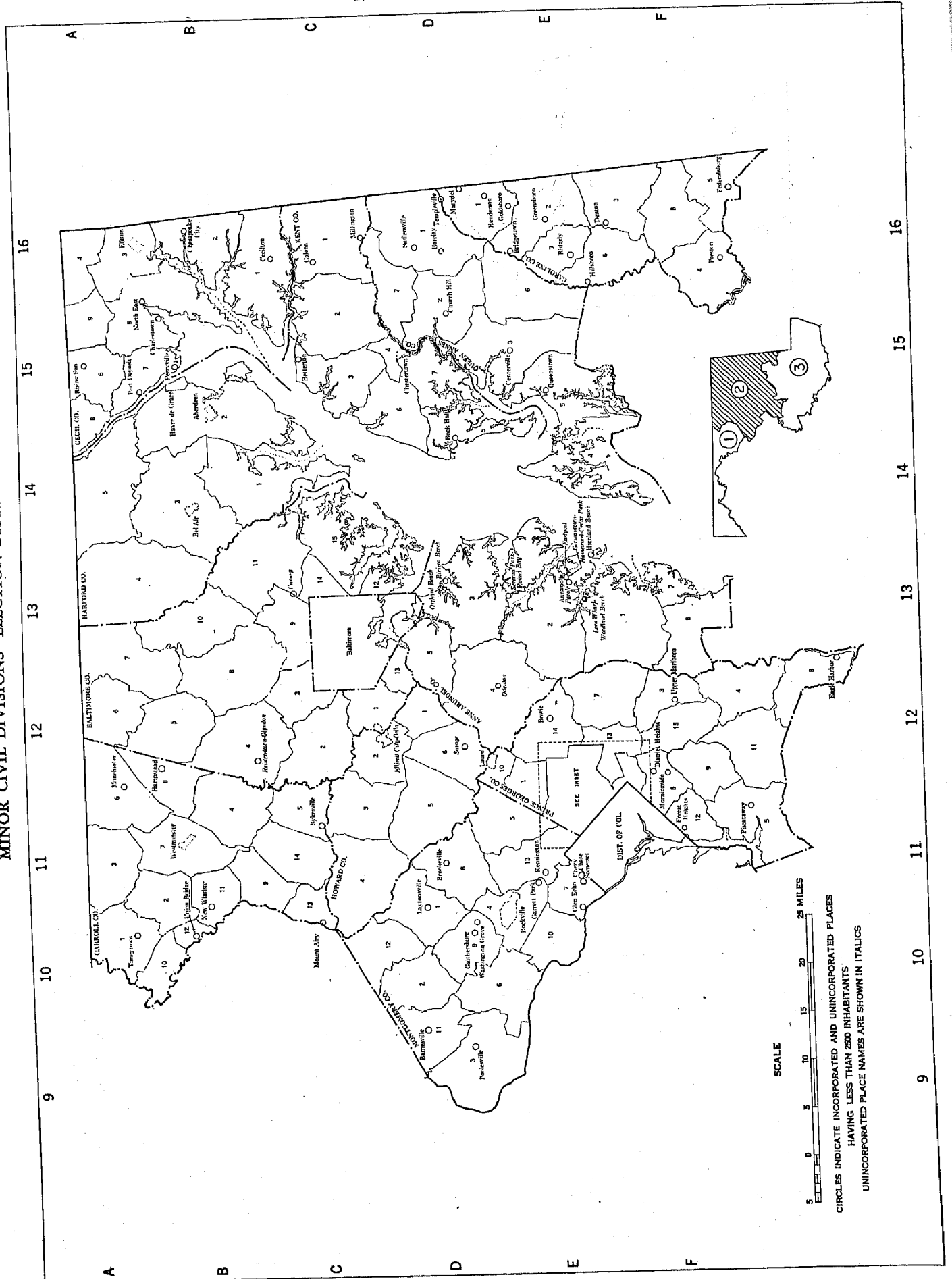
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MARYLAND—SECTION 1, WESTERN PART
MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—ELECTION DISTRICTS



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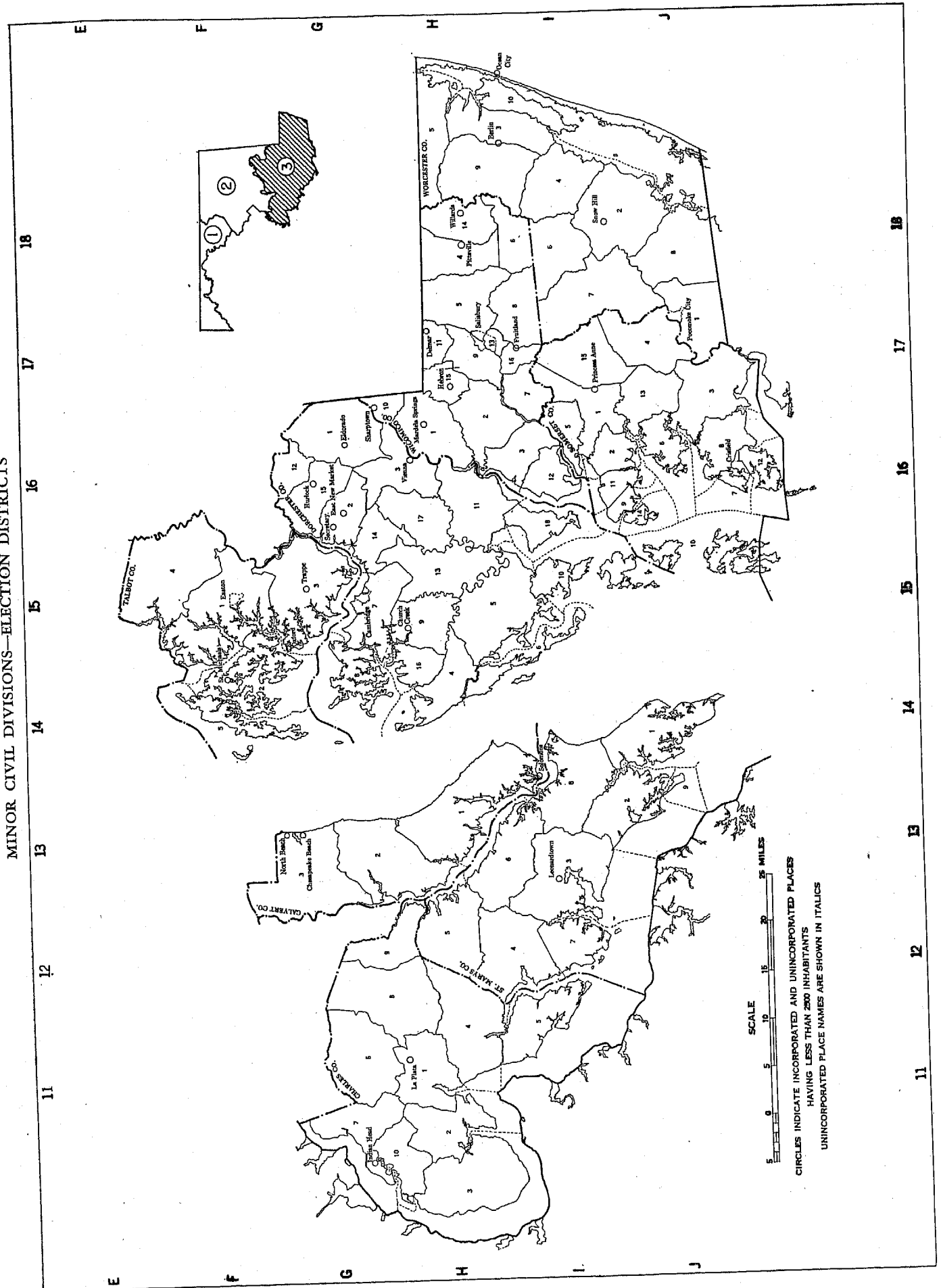
MARYLAND—SECTION 2, NORTHEASTERN PART

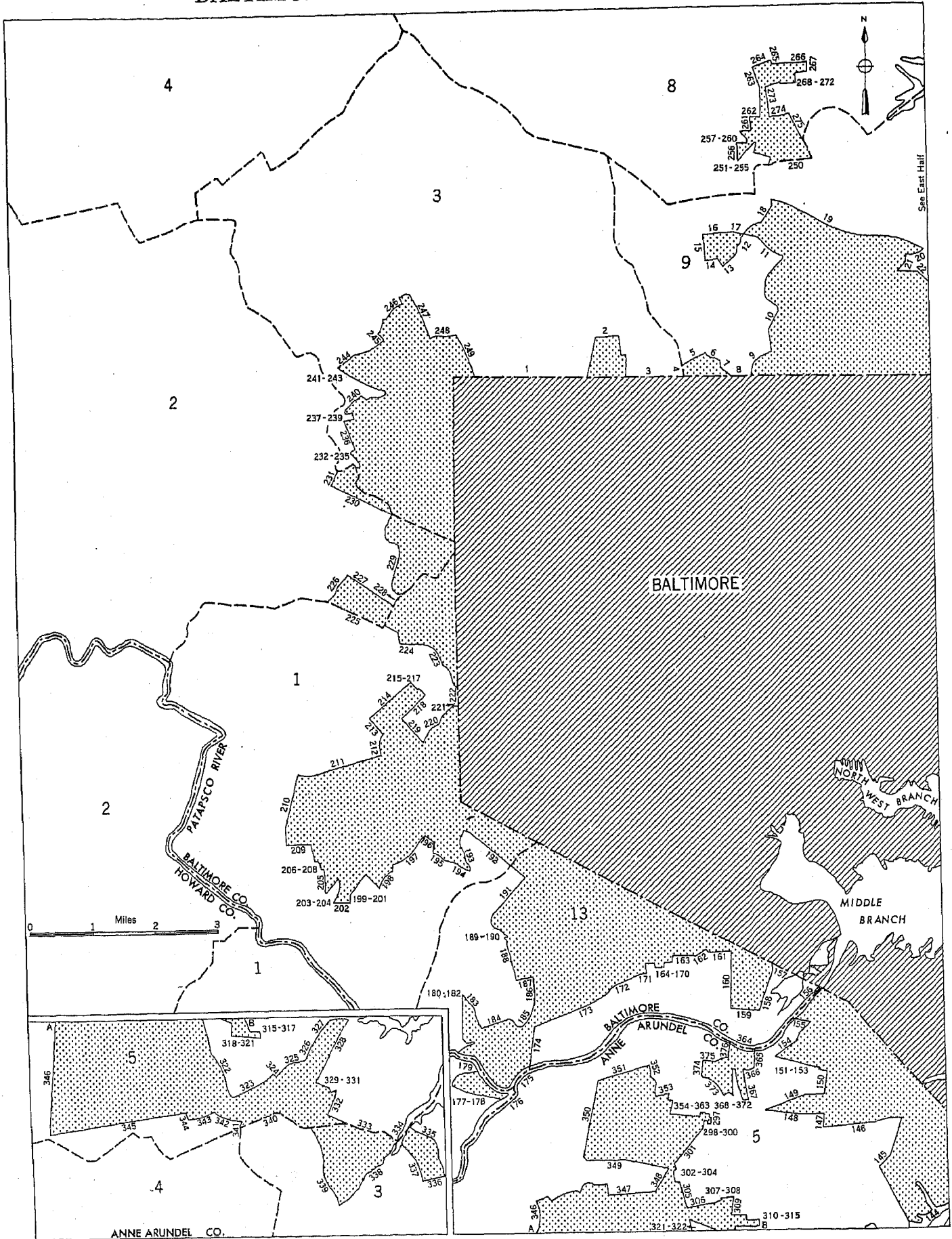

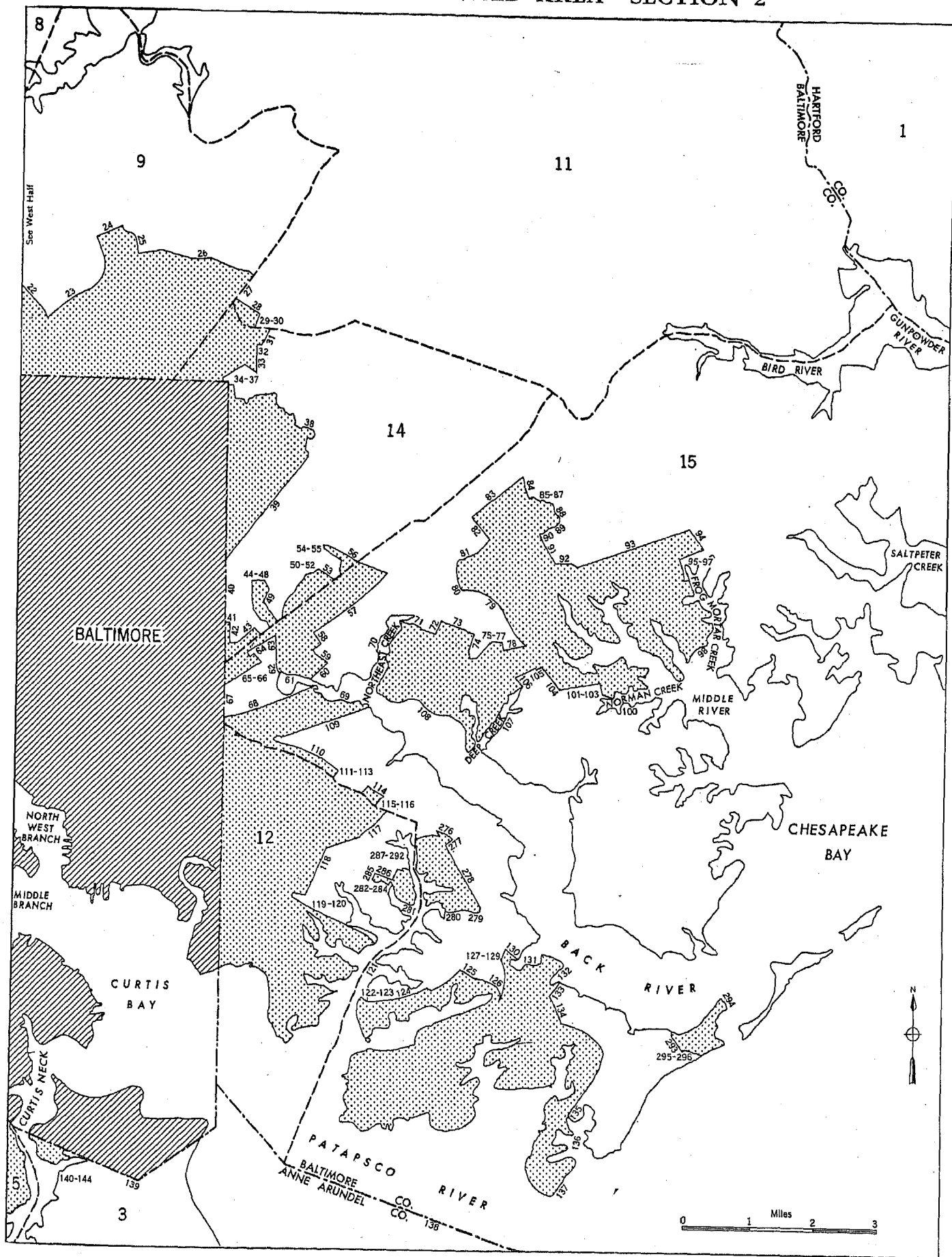
