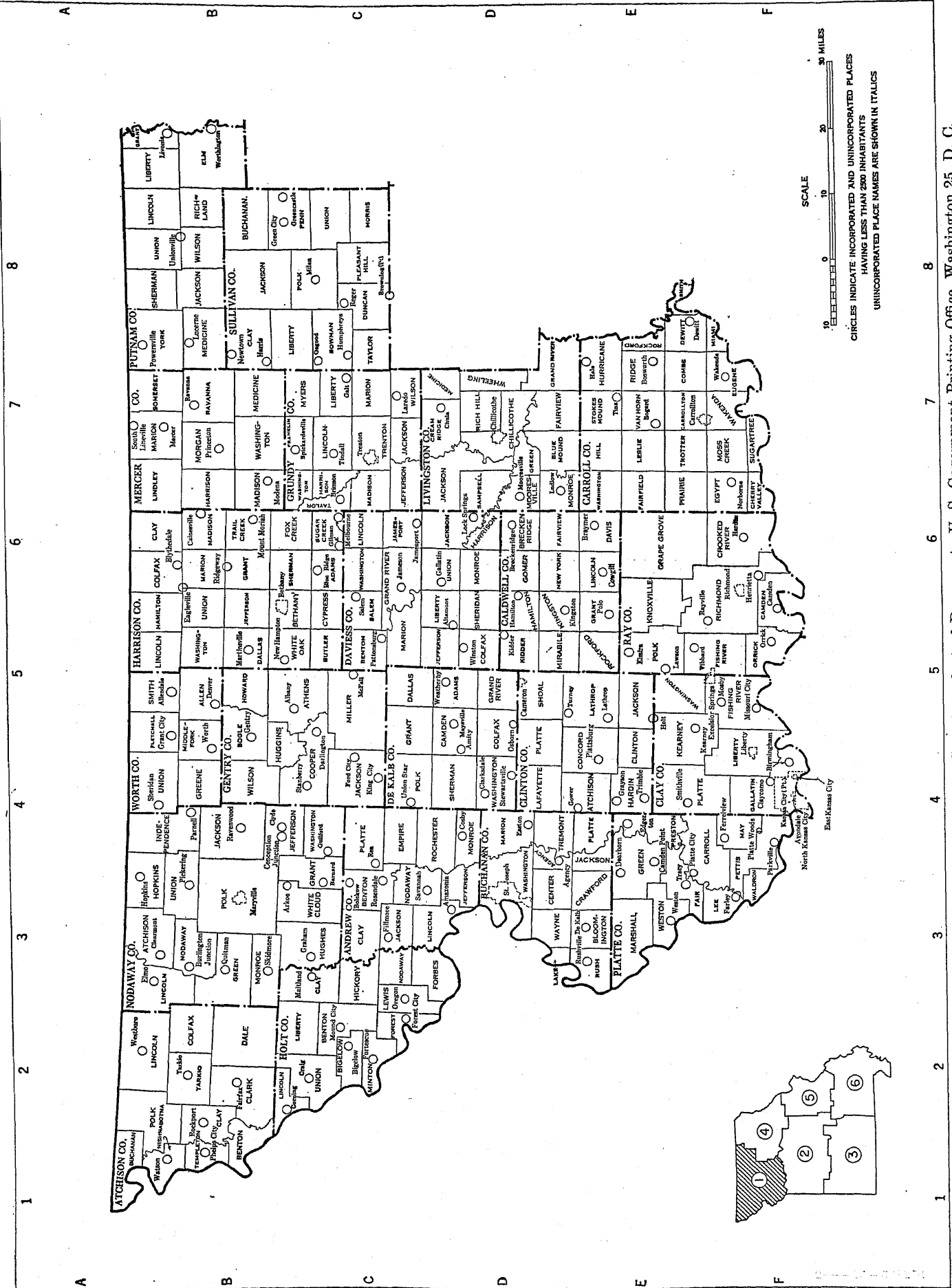
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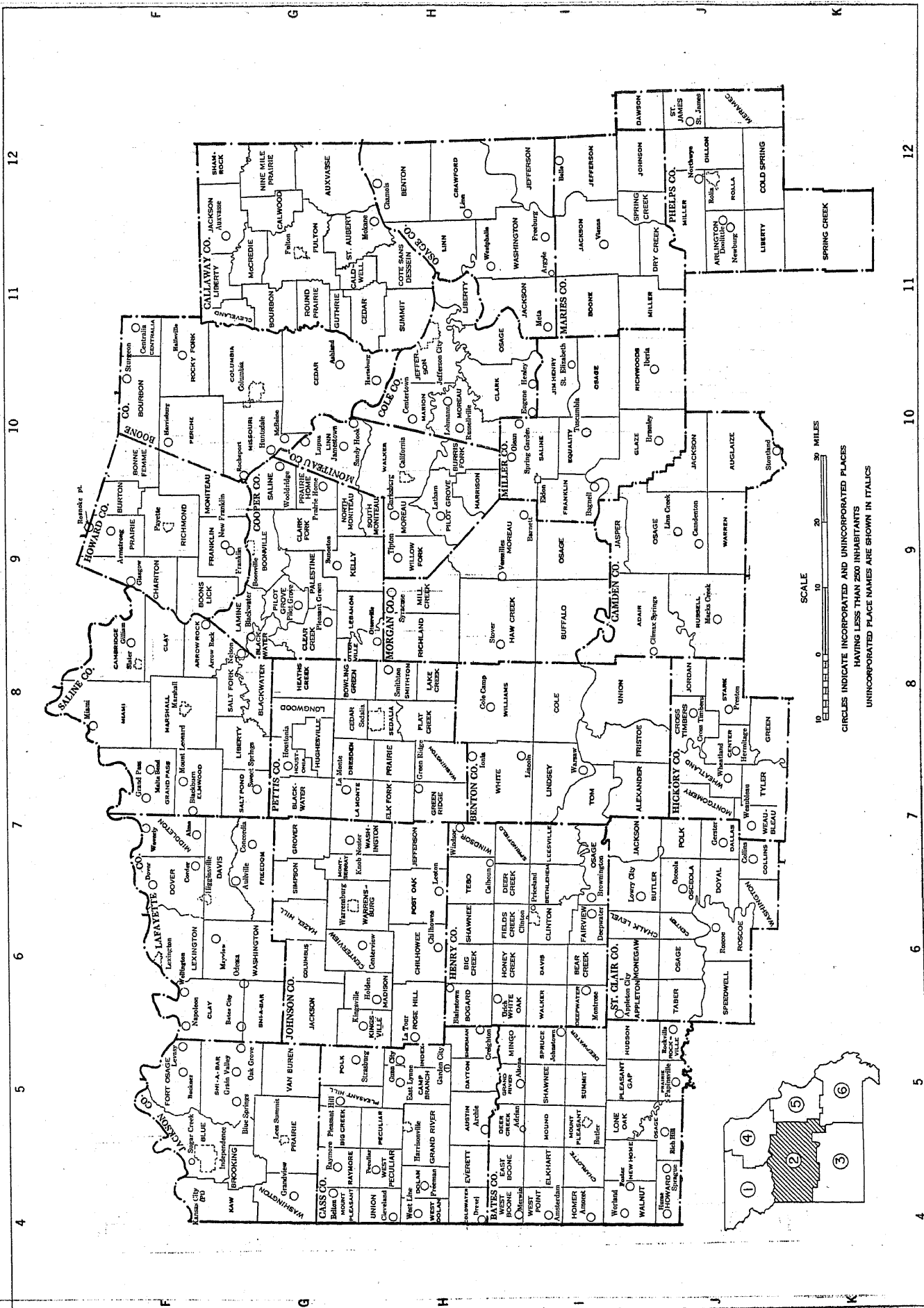
MISSOURI—SECTION 1, NORTHWESTERN PART

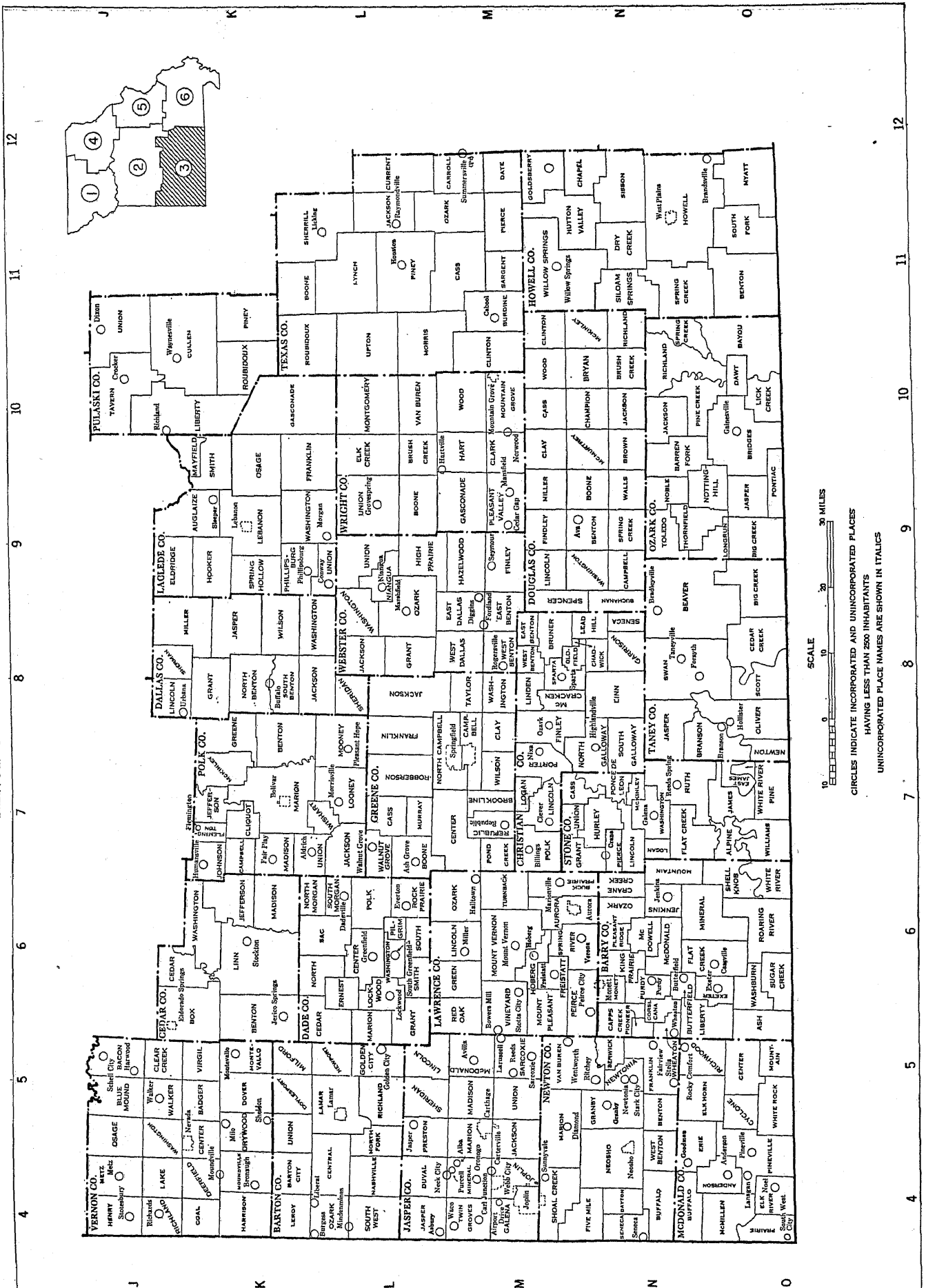
MISSOURI—SECTION 2, WEST CENTRAL PART

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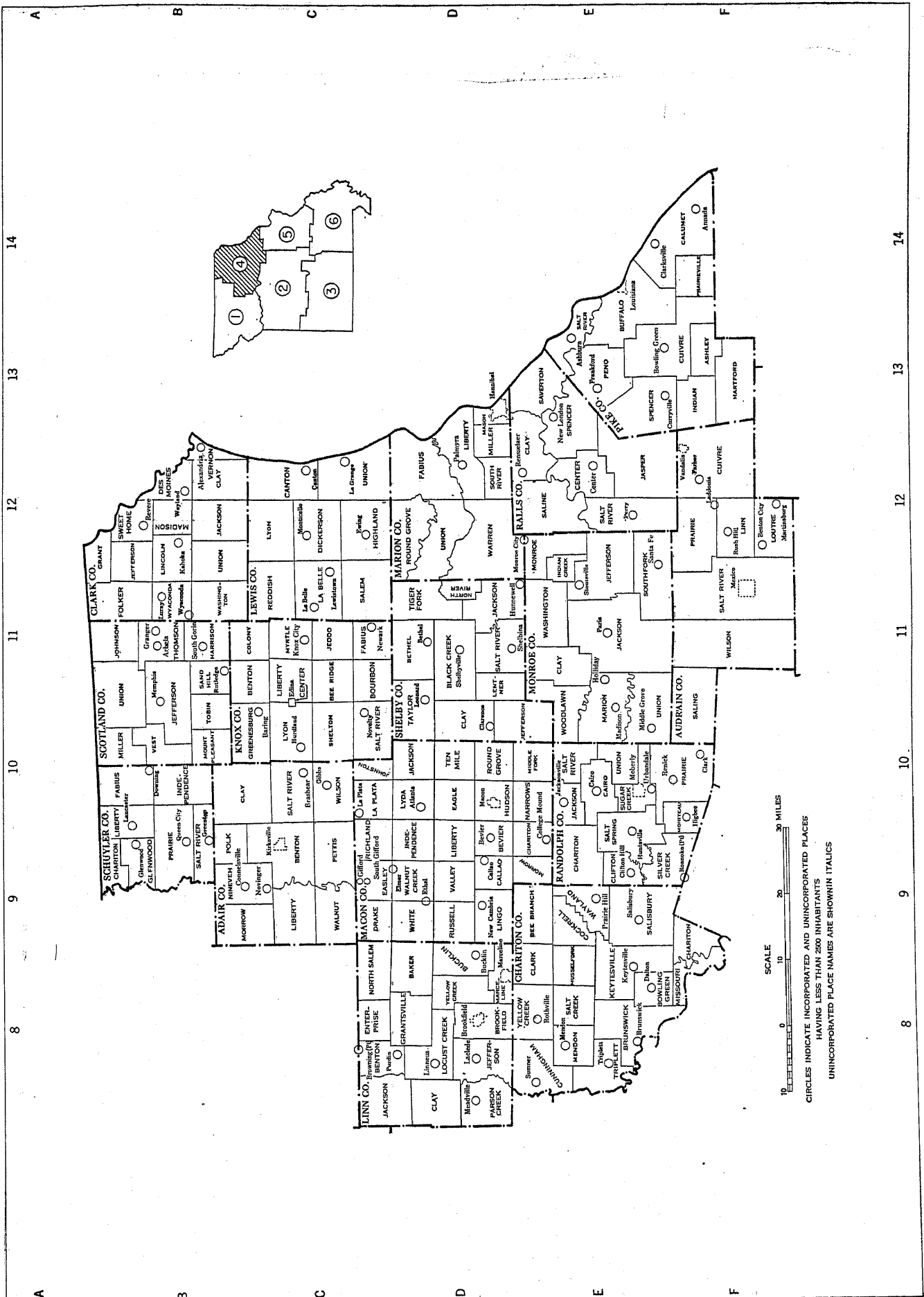

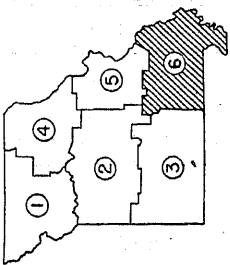
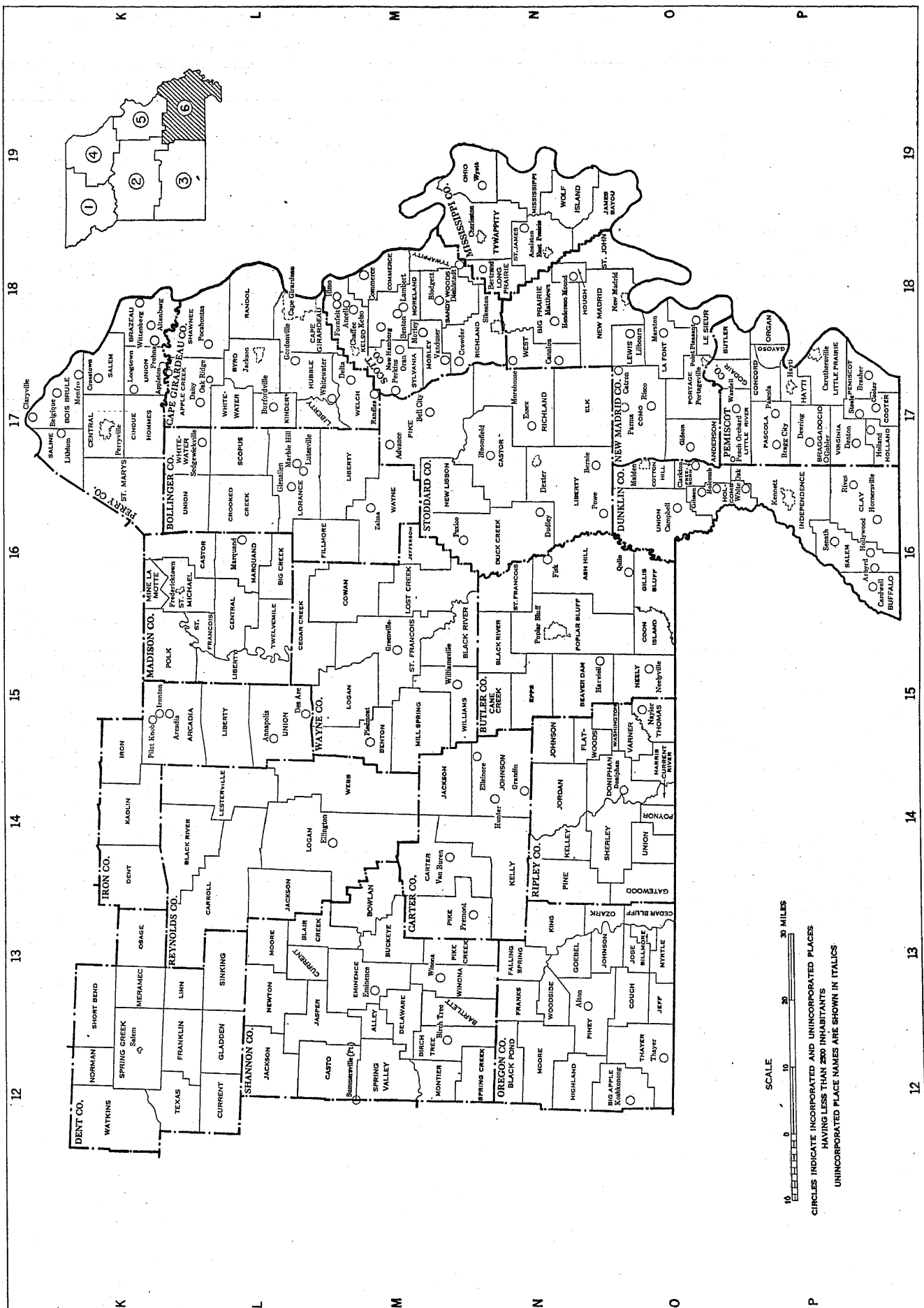

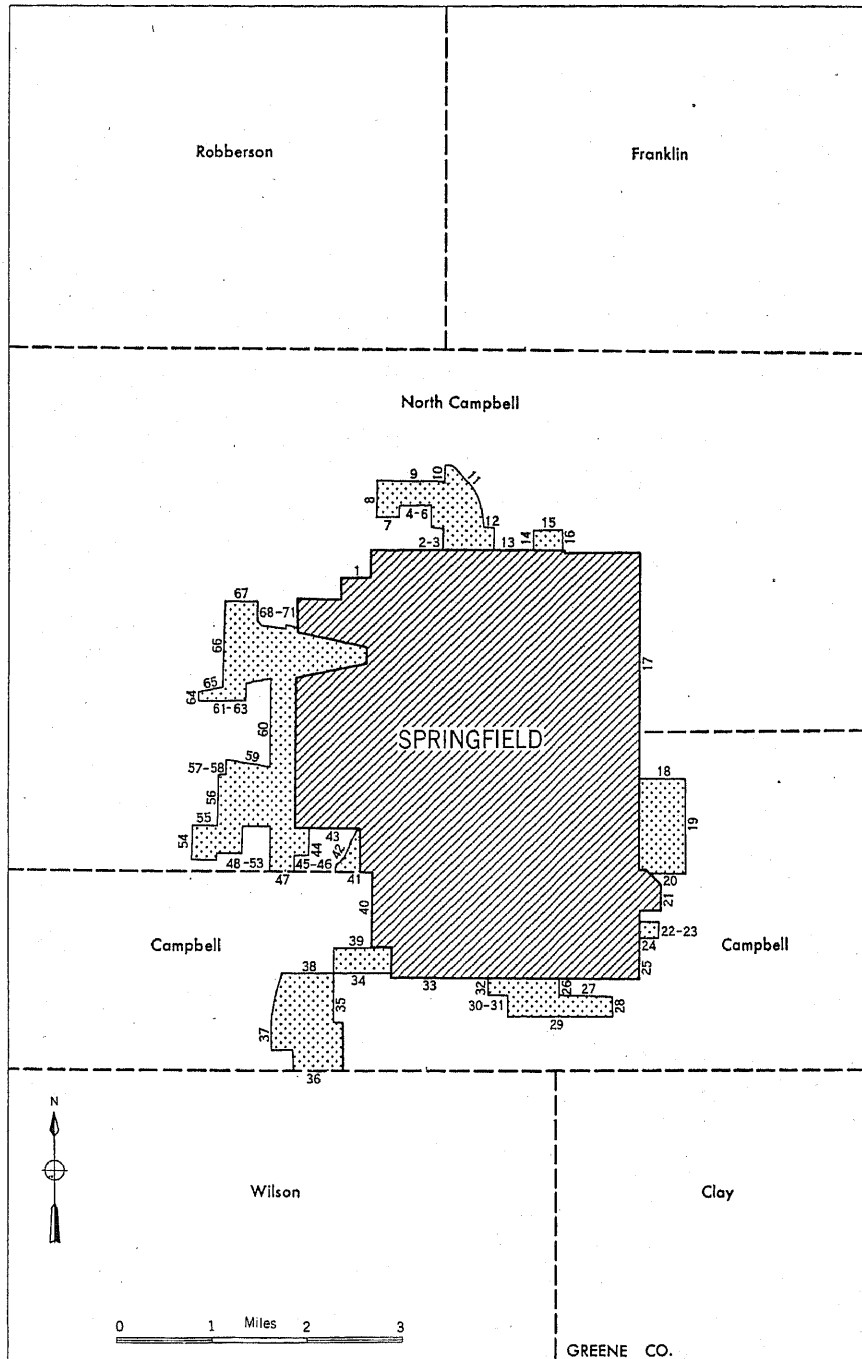







ST. JOSEPH URBANIZED AREA



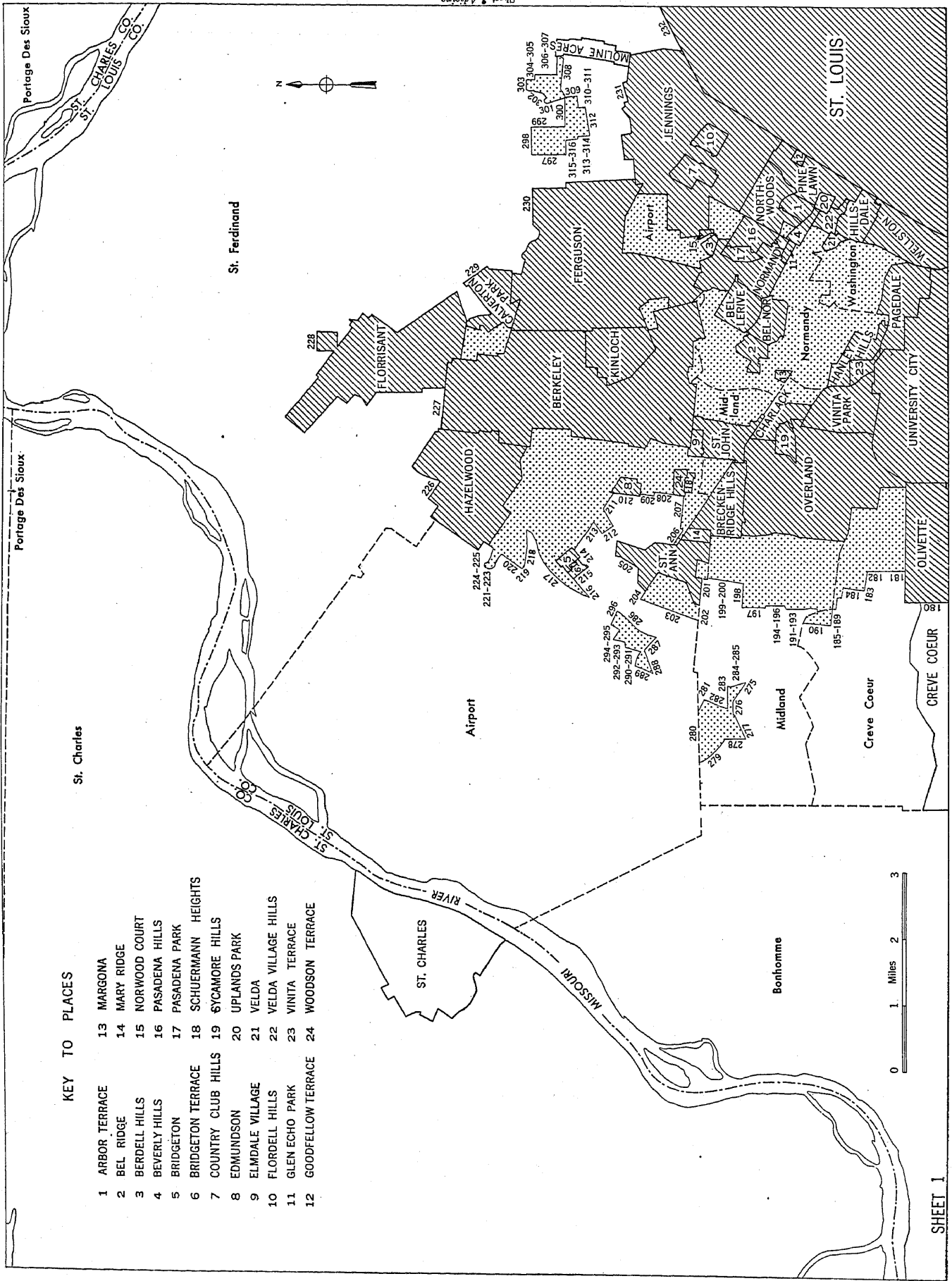
