

## CHAPTER IV.—STATISTICS BY STATES

**State tables.**—In addition to the general analytical tables presented in Chapter III of this report, summary tables of the principal data by States are given in the following pages. From the figures here set forth it is possible to make for any individual State analyses similar to those presented in Chapter III, or to compare the statistics for various States. If still more detailed statistics are desired for any particular State, these are available in complete form in the special report for that State which is issued as a separate publication, and contains detailed statistics for the State as a whole and for each city having a population of over 100,000 in 1930, as well as the allocation of the principal data by counties.

**Cross references among tabulations.**—The tables in this chapter are arranged in the same order in which the various subjects have been treated in Chapter III, rather than in the order in which the basic statistics are to be found in the standard tables presented in Chapter V of this report and in the individual State reports. In order to facilitate the location of comparable data in the tables presented in the various chapters of this report and in the State reports, the following outline of cross references may be of assistance:
