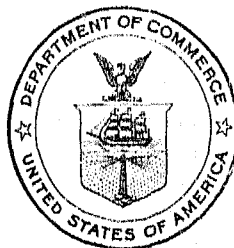

SIR:

I transmit herewith Volume IV of the Reports on Agriculture, Fifteenth Decennial Census. Volume IV presents the results of the 1930 census of agriculture by subjects. These data are shown by geographic divisions and by States.

The census of agriculture was taken in conformity with the Act providing for the fifteenth decennial census, approved June 18, 1929. The results of the census of agriculture, 1930, are contained in four volumes: Volume I, Farm acreage and farm values, by townships or other minor civil divisions; Volume II (Parts 1, 2, and 3), Reports by States, with statistics for counties, and a summary for the United States; Volume III, Type of farm (Parts 1, 2, and 3), Reports by States, with statistics for counties, and a summary for the United States; Volume IV, General report, statistics by subjects; and the reports on horticulture, irrigation, and drainage, each in one volume.

The collection and compilation of these statistics and the preparation of this volume were under the supervision of William Lane Austin, chief statistician for agriculture, assisted by Sherman S. Slick, assistant chief statistician, and Z. R. Pettet, agricultural economist.
