SIR: I transmit herewith Volume II of the reports of the Census of Manufactures for 1929. This census, which was taken in 1930 as a part of the Fifteenth Decennial Census, is also the fifth of the biennial series of censuses of manufactures.

The manufactures reports for 1929 comprise three volumes. Volume I is a general report giving statistics for the United States as a whole, by industries and by States; Volume II (the first to be issued) is an assembly of the detailed reports for the 326 manufacturing and printing and publishing industries covered by the census; and Volume III will be an assembly of detailed reports for the 48 States and the District of Columbia. Each of these volumes includes a summary covering all industries and all States.

Preliminary statistics for the individual industries covered by this report were issued in the form of press releases in 1930; and later the complete and detailed statistics were published in a series of separate reports in pamphlet form.

The statistics were compiled and published under the supervision of LeVerne Beales, chief statistician for manufactures, assisted by John F. Daly, executive chief of division. Certain special features of the General Summary section were prepared by Tracy E. Thompson, of the Ohio State University, temporarily employed in the Bureau of the Census as expert on the presentation and analysis of manufactures-census data.
