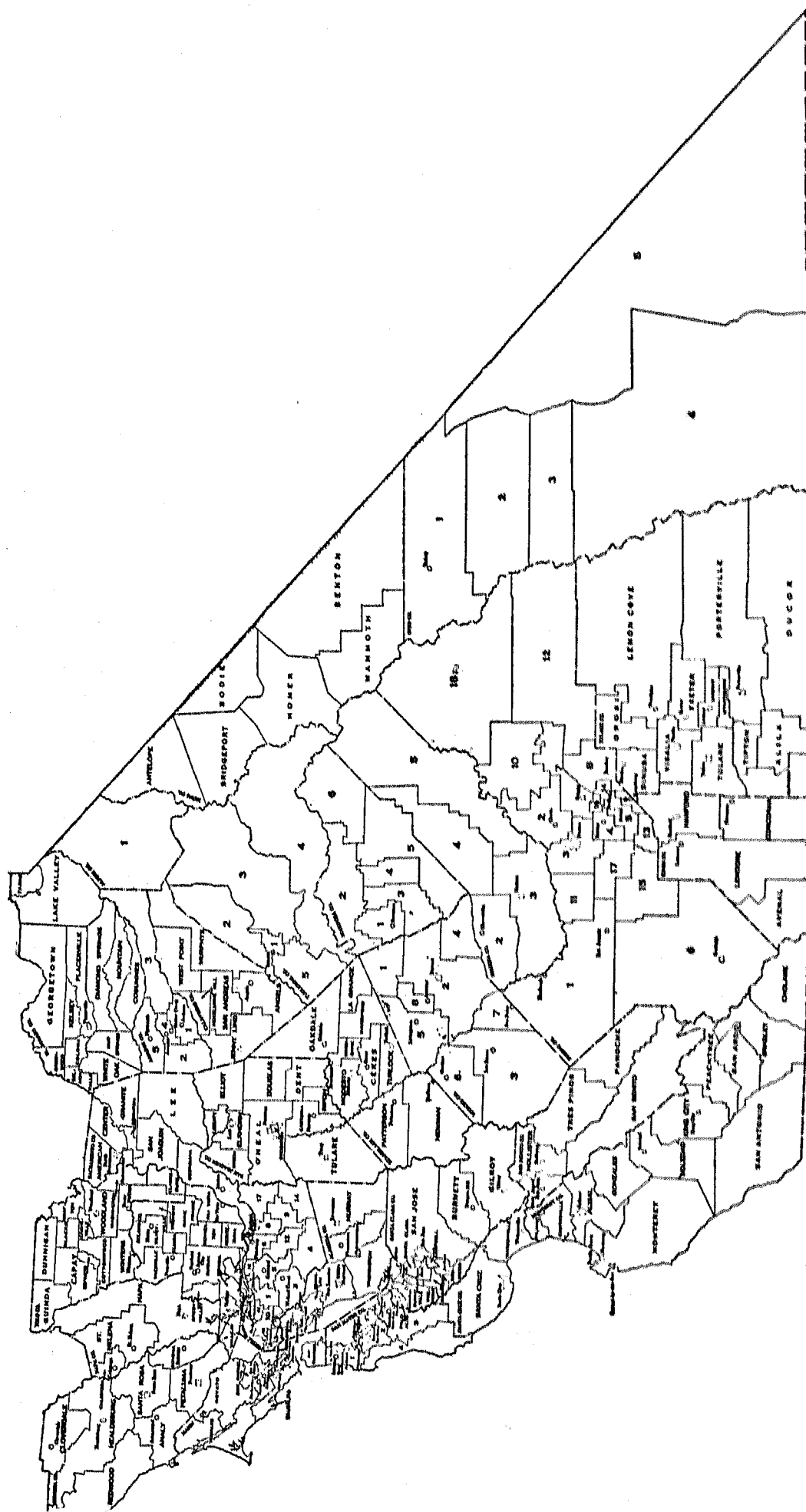


CALIFORNIA—NORTHERN AND CENTRAL PARTS

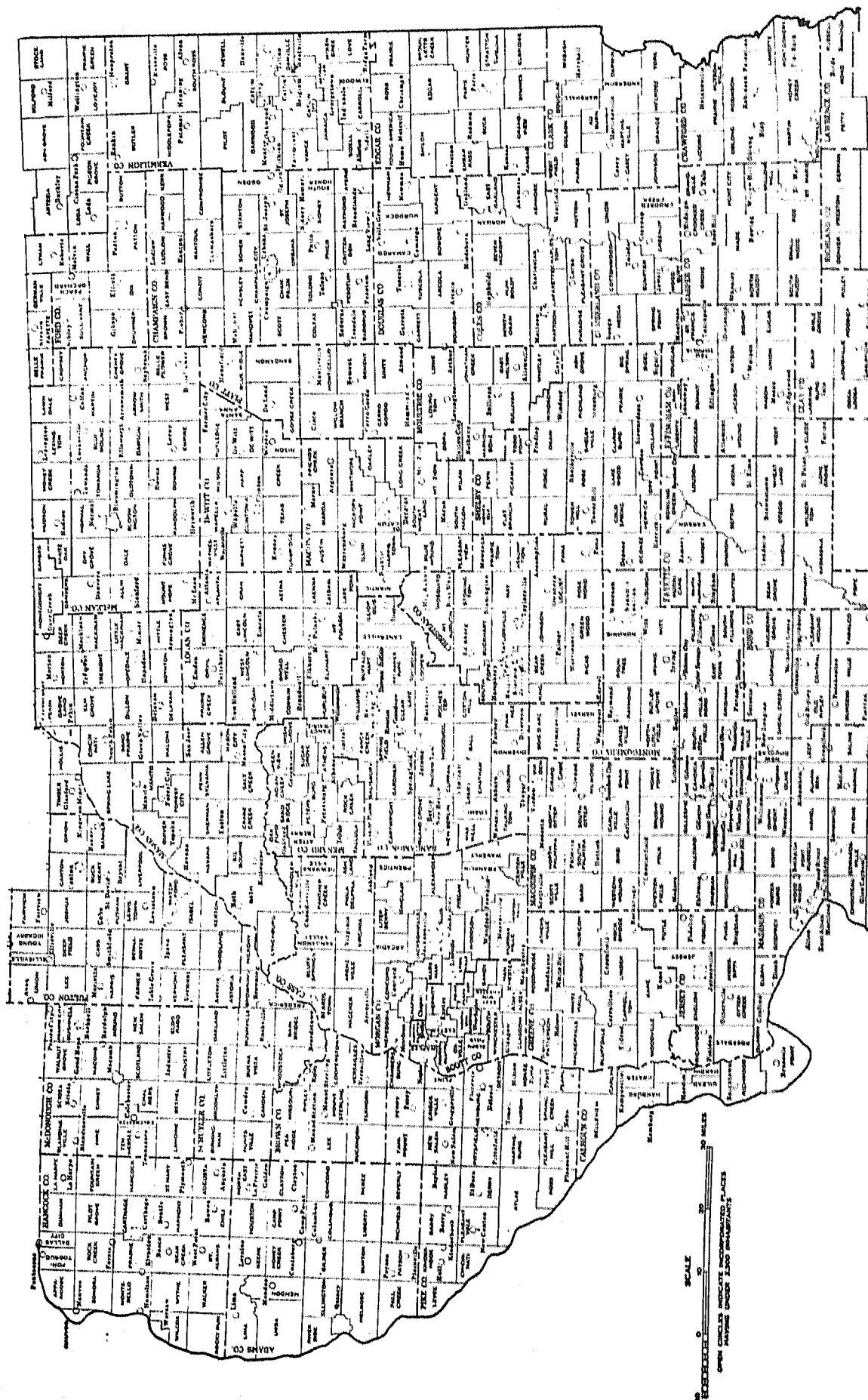


ILLINOIS—NORTHERN AND CENTRAL PARTS

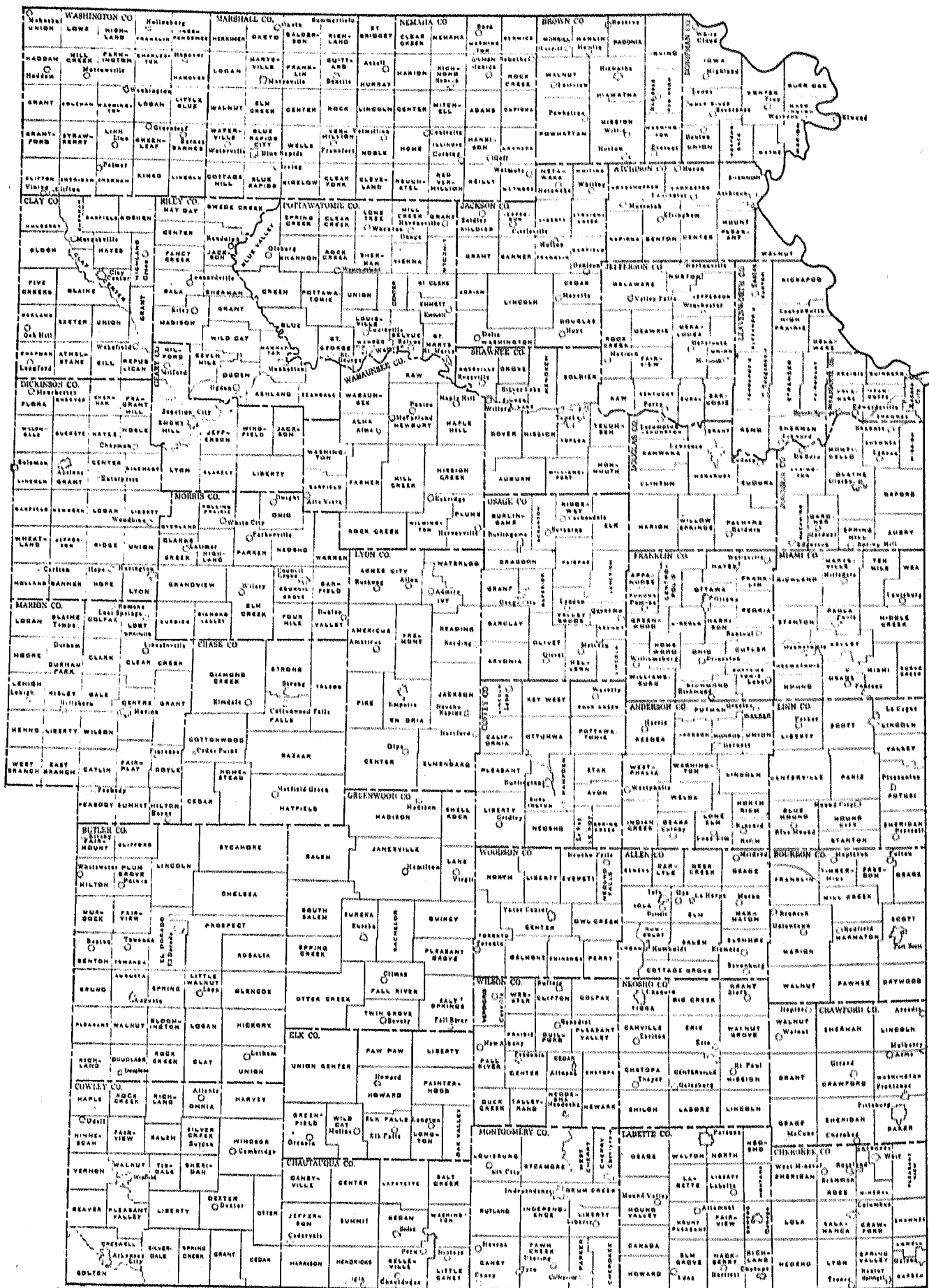


KANSAS—CENTRAL PART

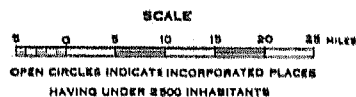




MARYLAND—WESTERN PART

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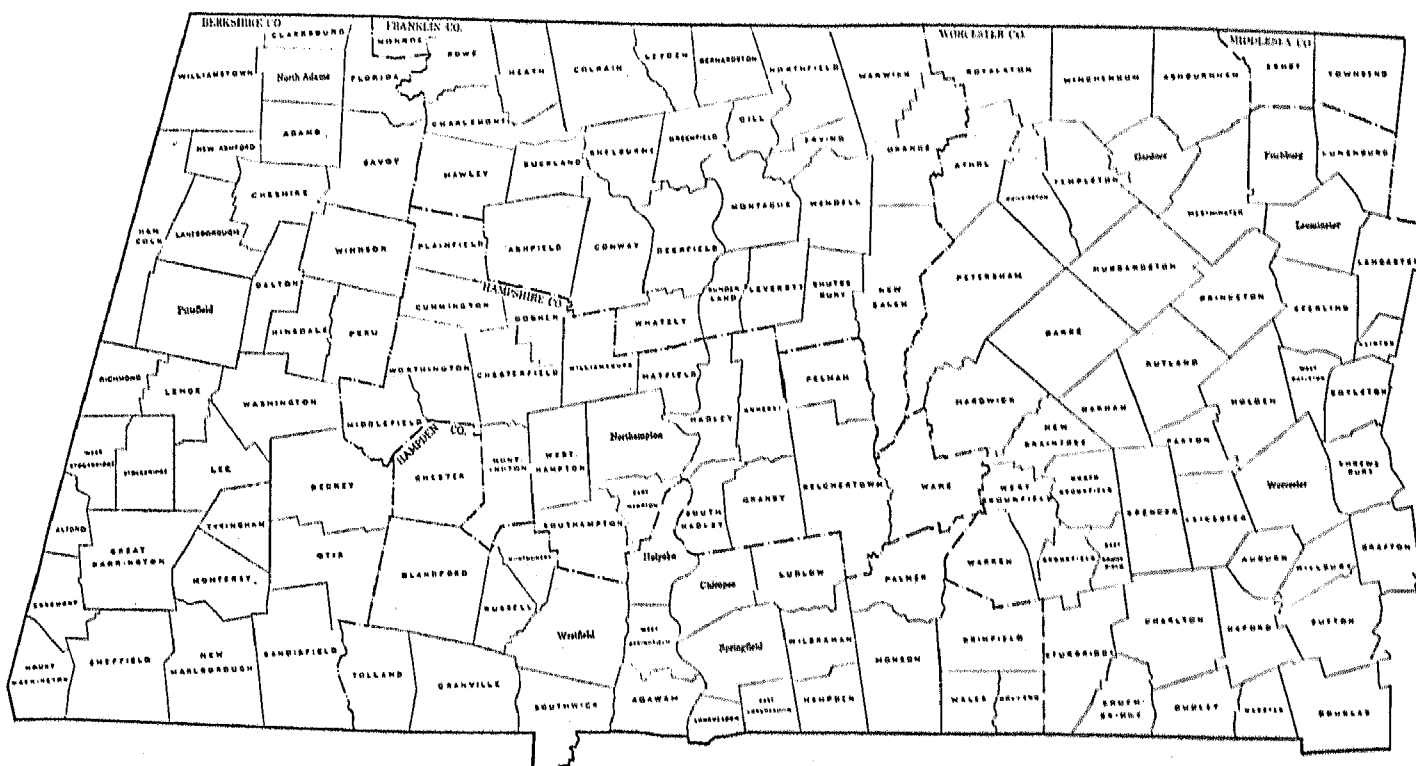


MARYLAND—EASTERN PART MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—ELECTION DISTRICTS
