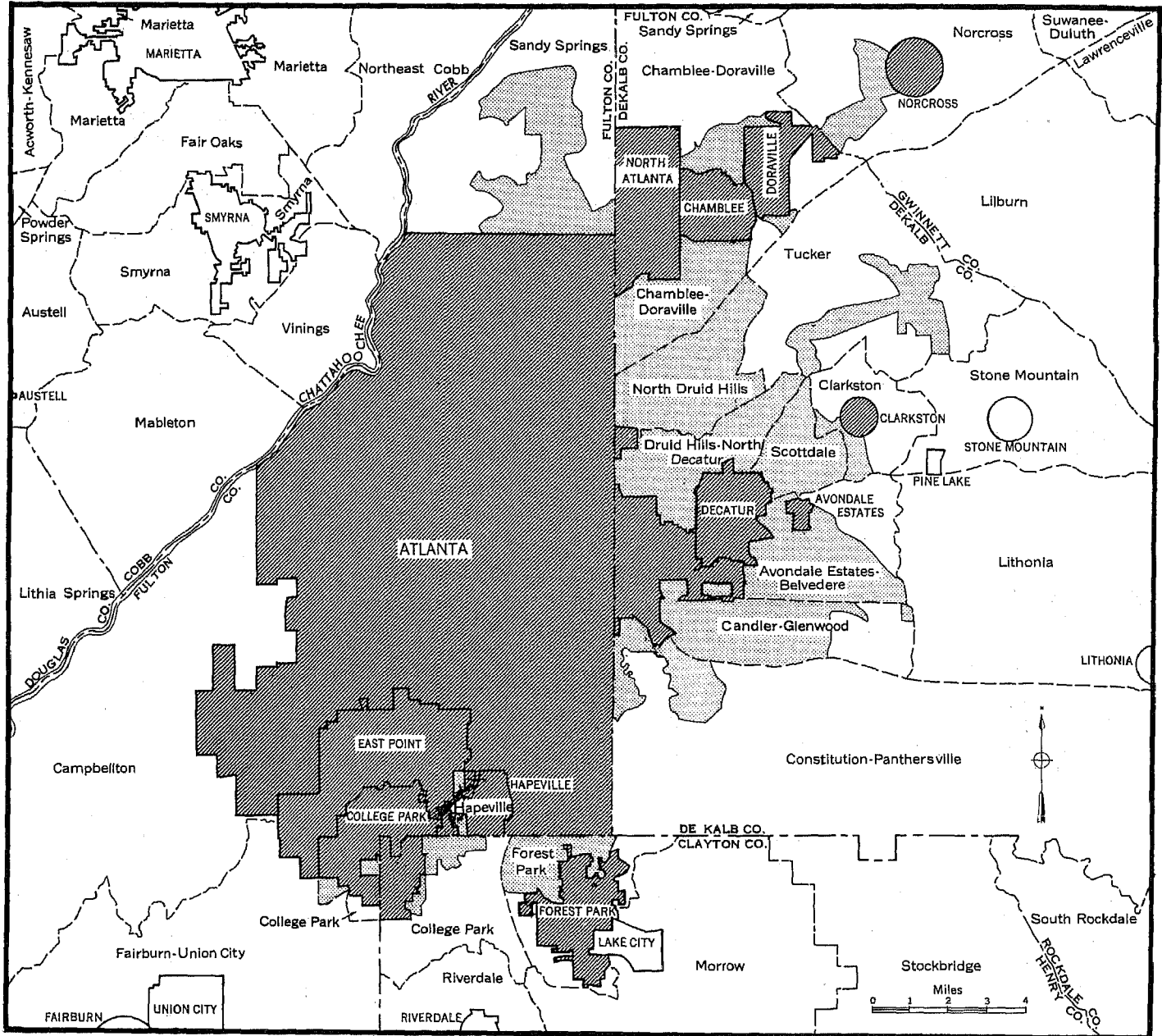



ATLANTA URBANIZED AREA
