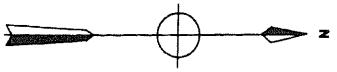




INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, BY CENSUS TRACTS AND BLOCKS: 1960

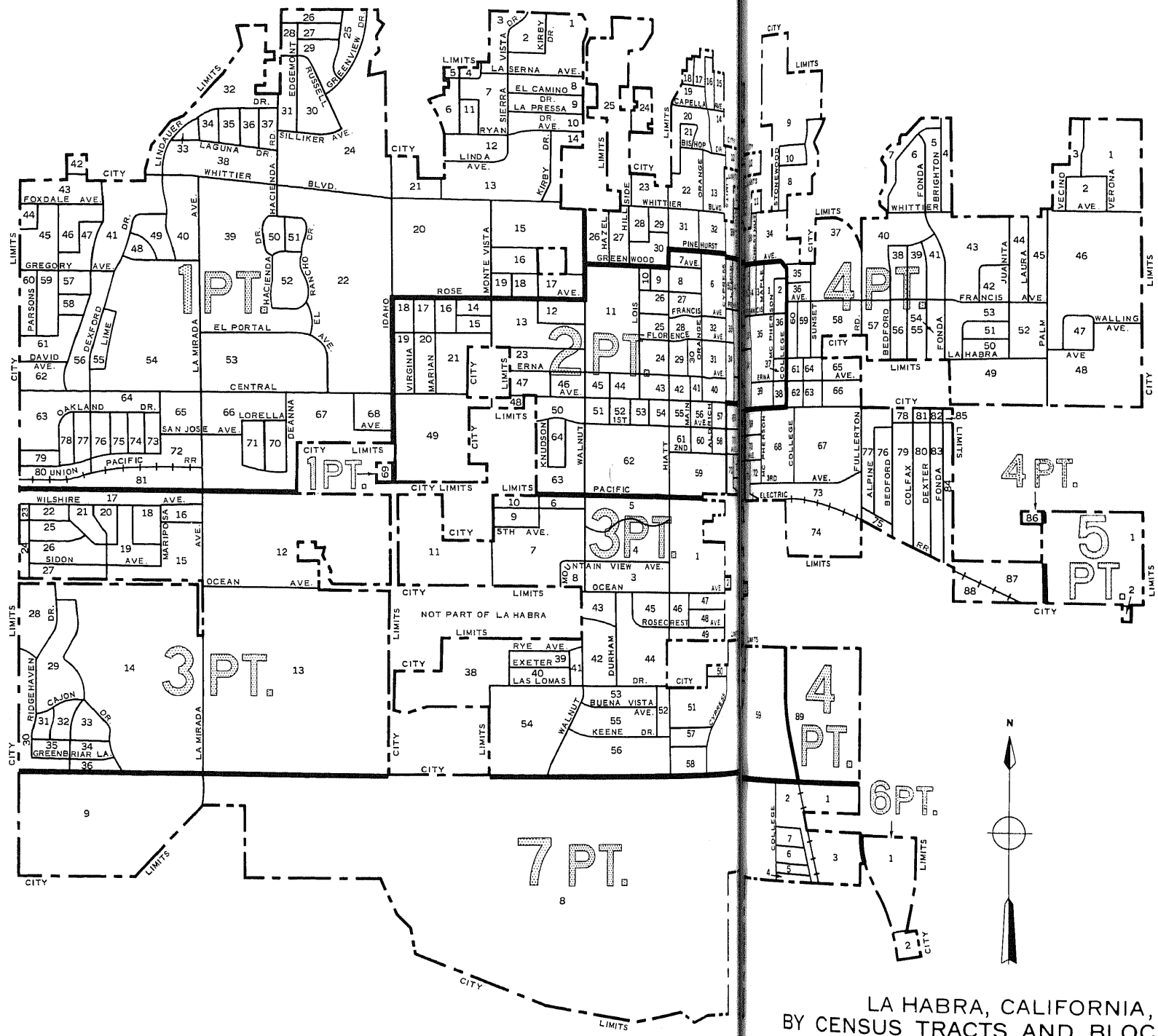

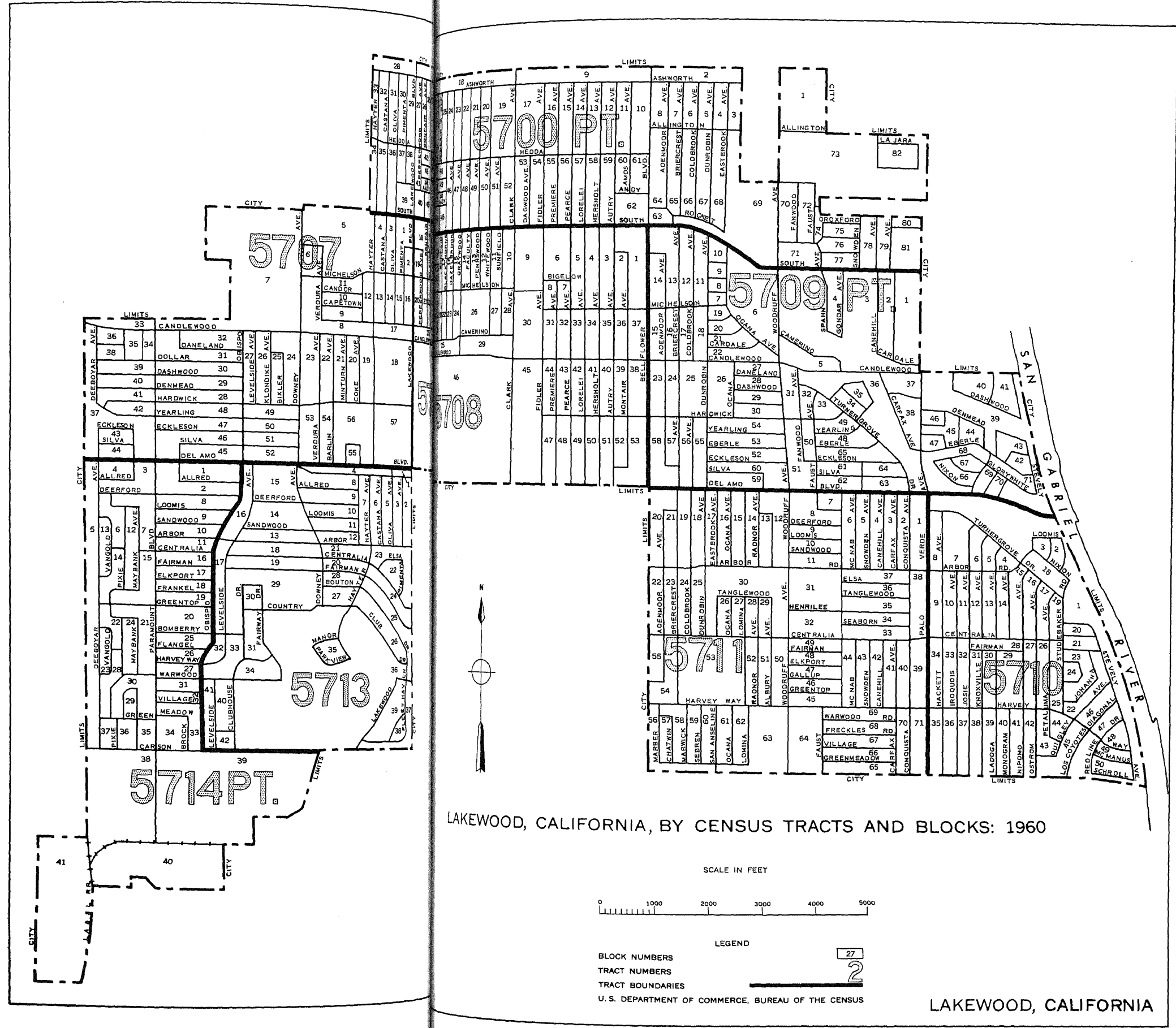
