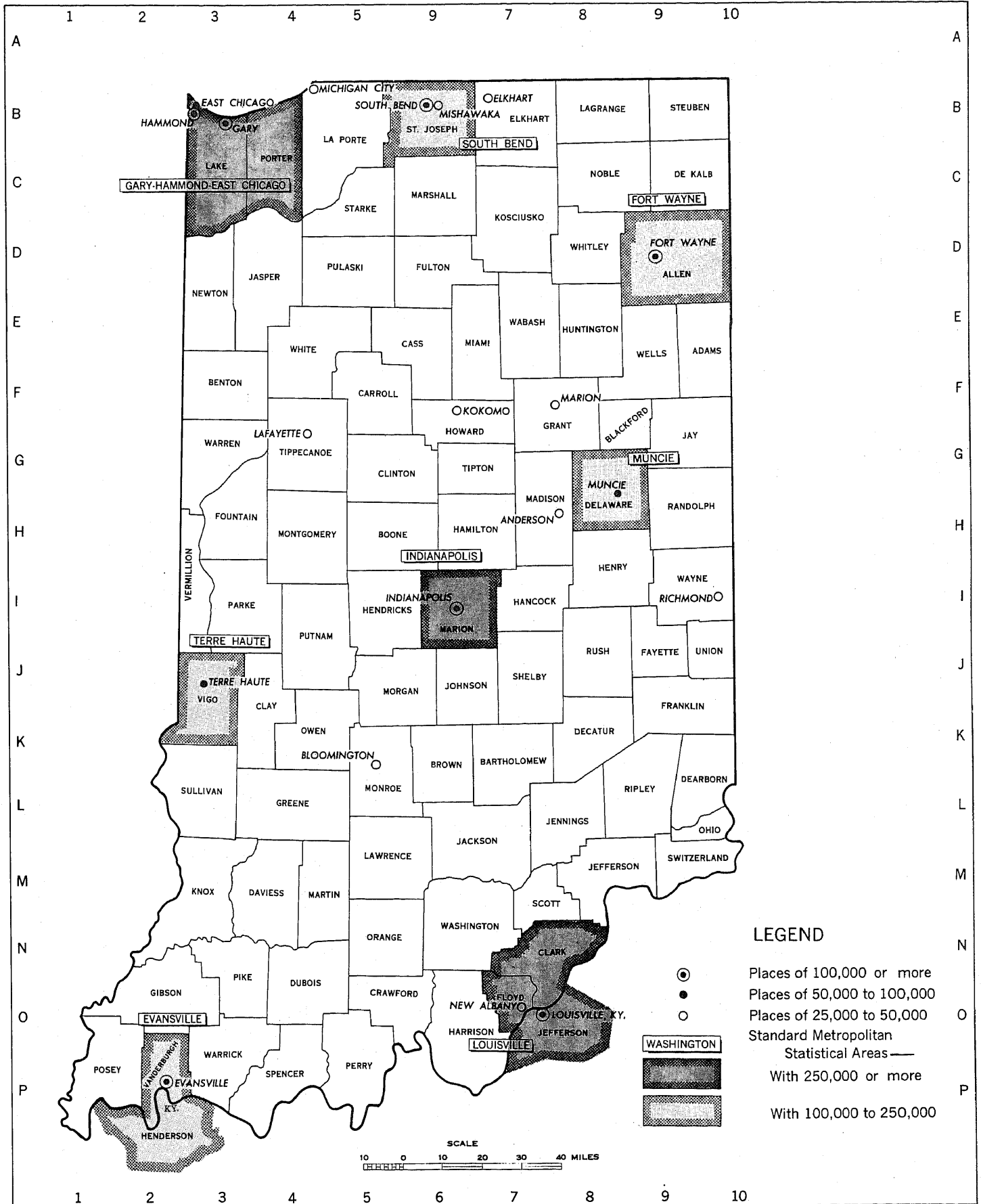

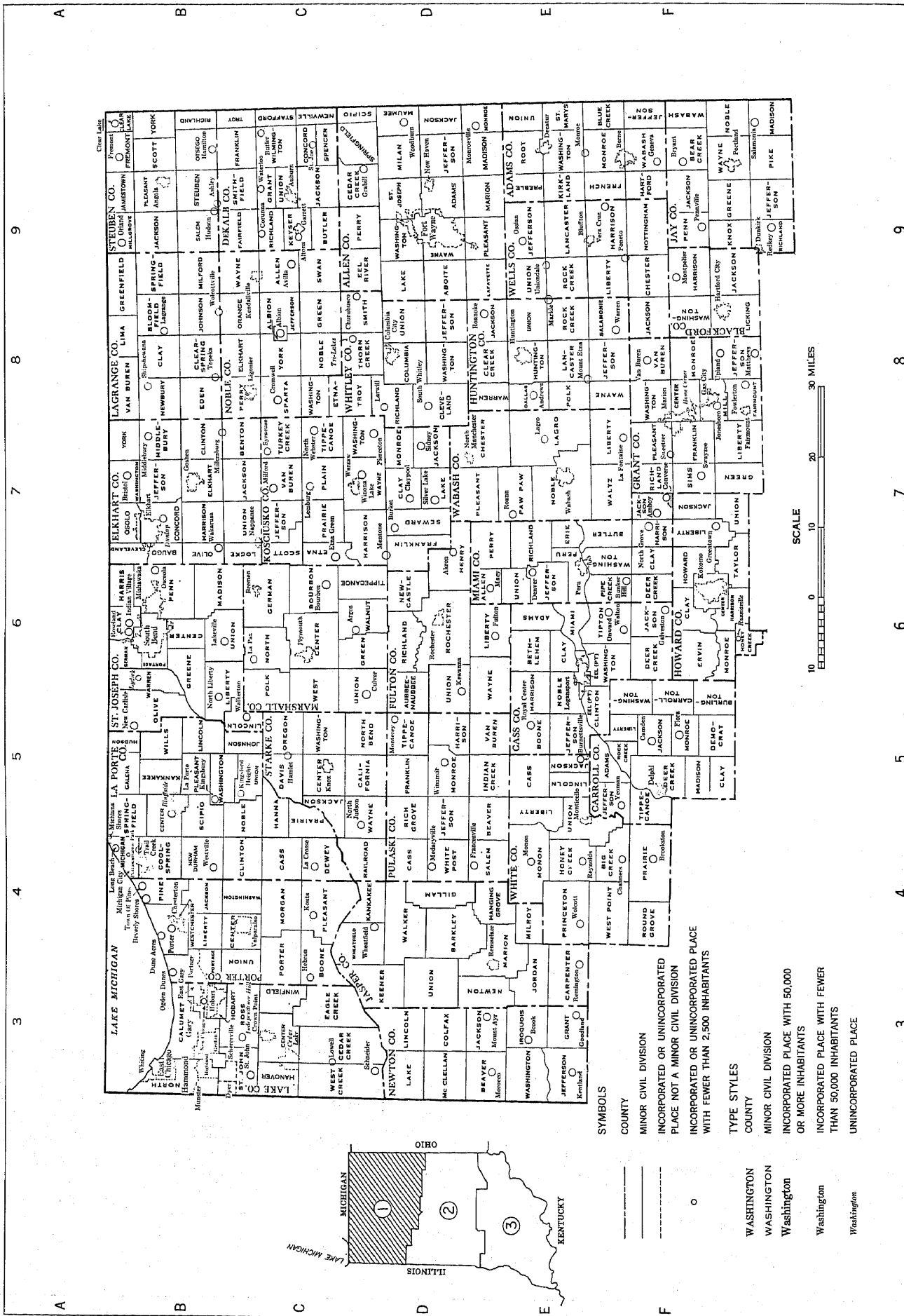

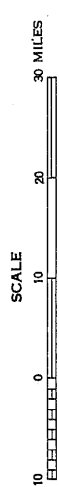
# INDIANA— COUNTIES, PLACES OF 25,000 OR MORE, AND STANDARD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREAS

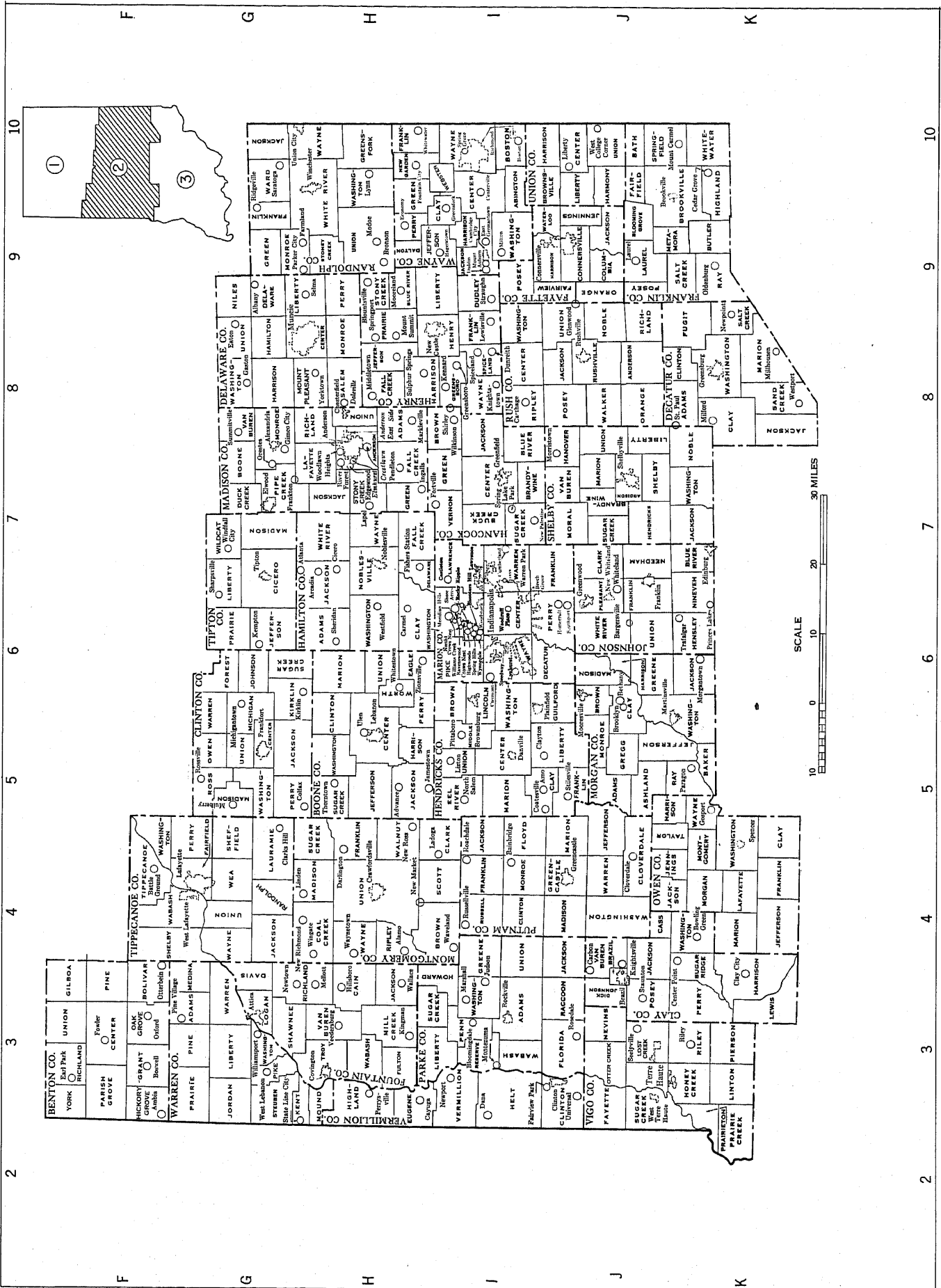


INDIANA—SECTIONS 1 AND 2

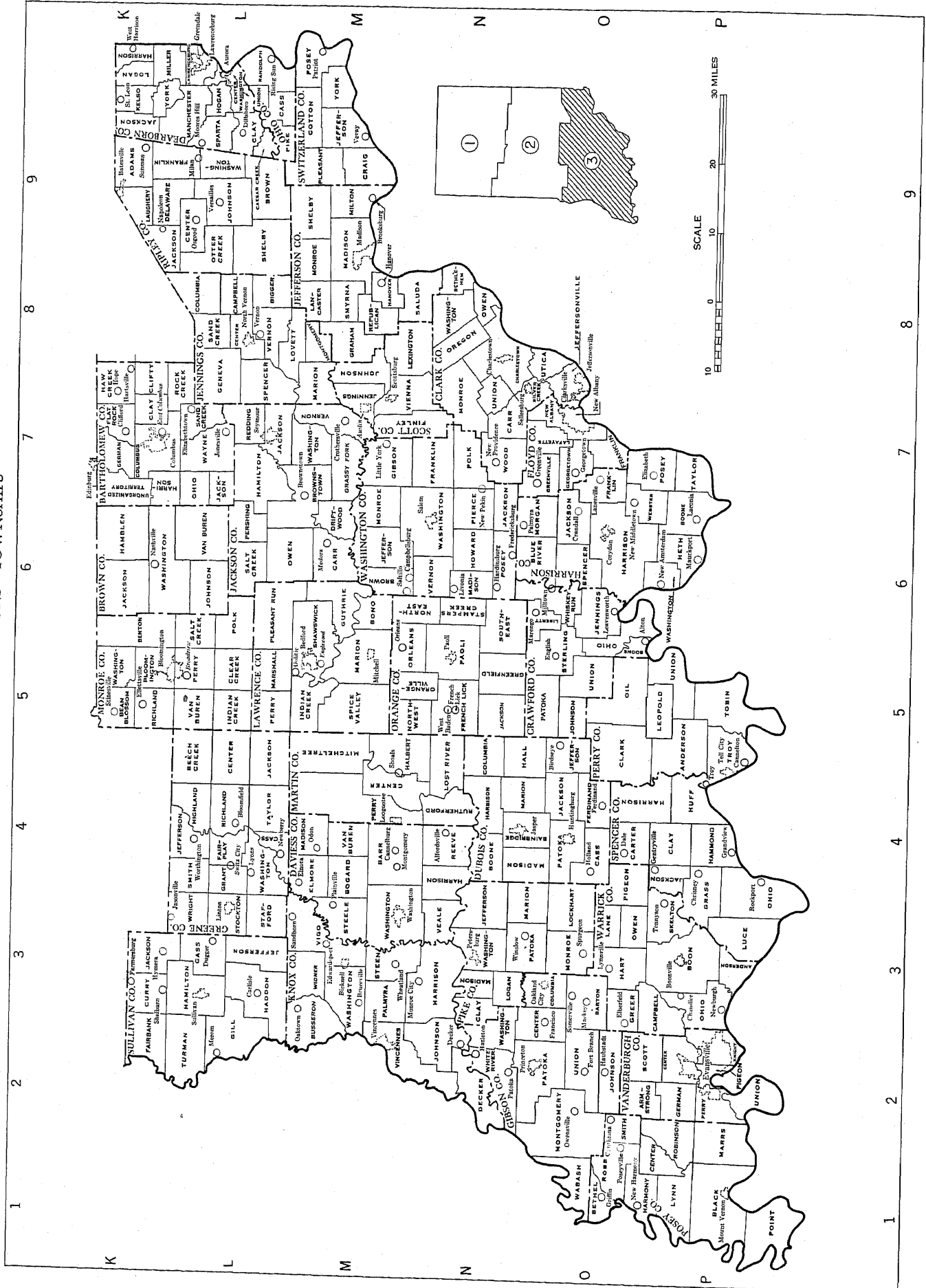

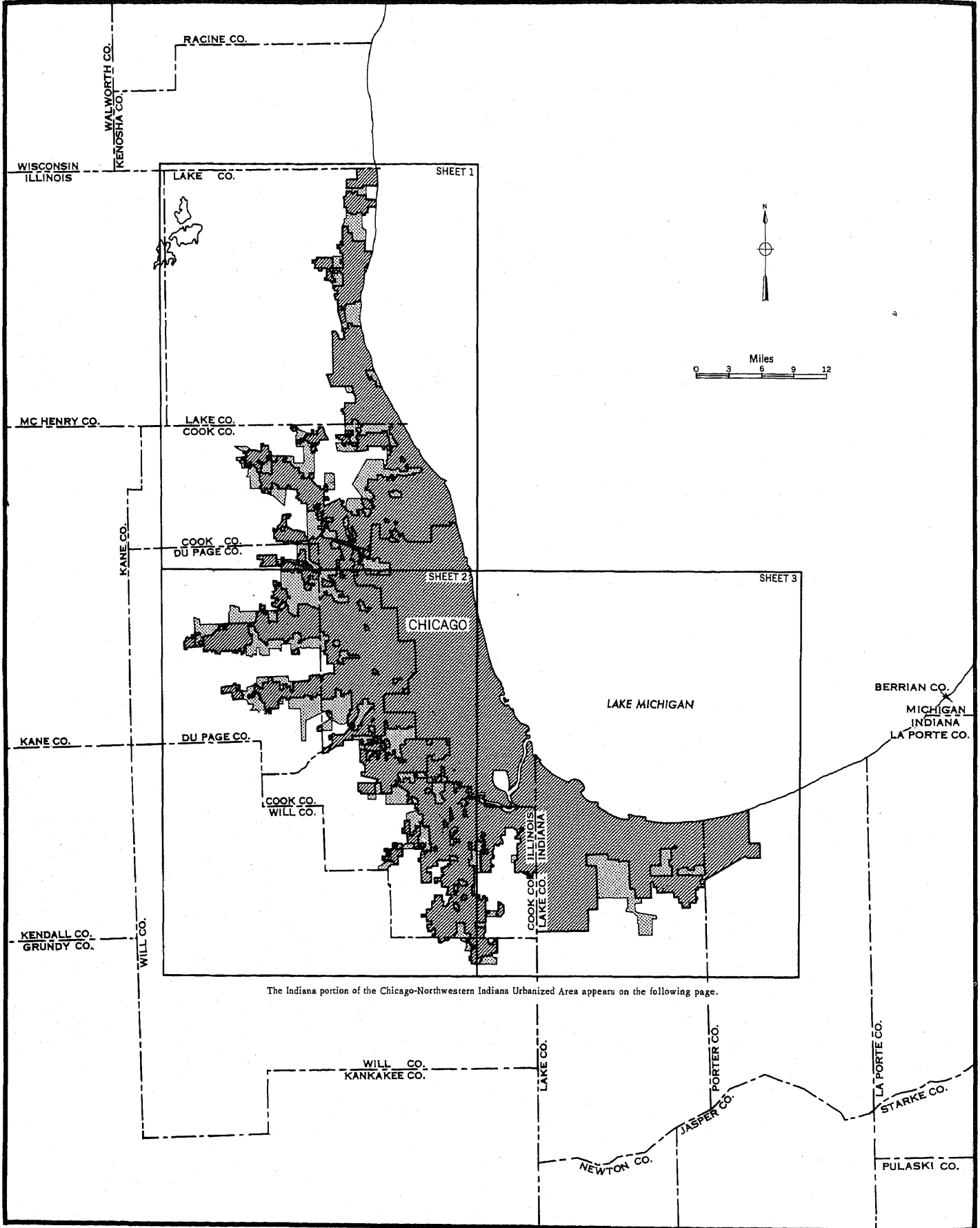

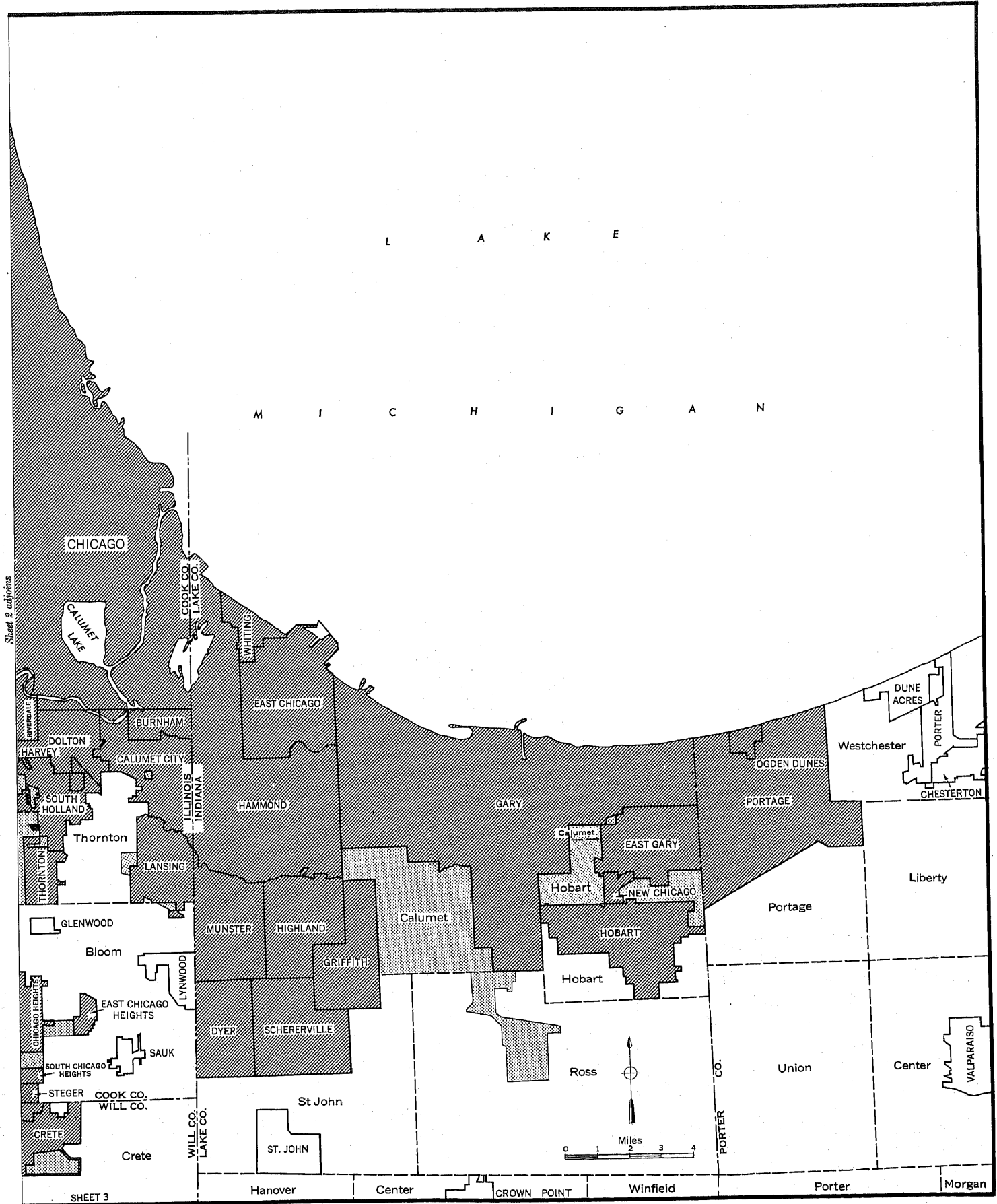

# INDEX MAP FOR CHICAGO-NORTHWESTERN INDIANA URBANIZED AREA

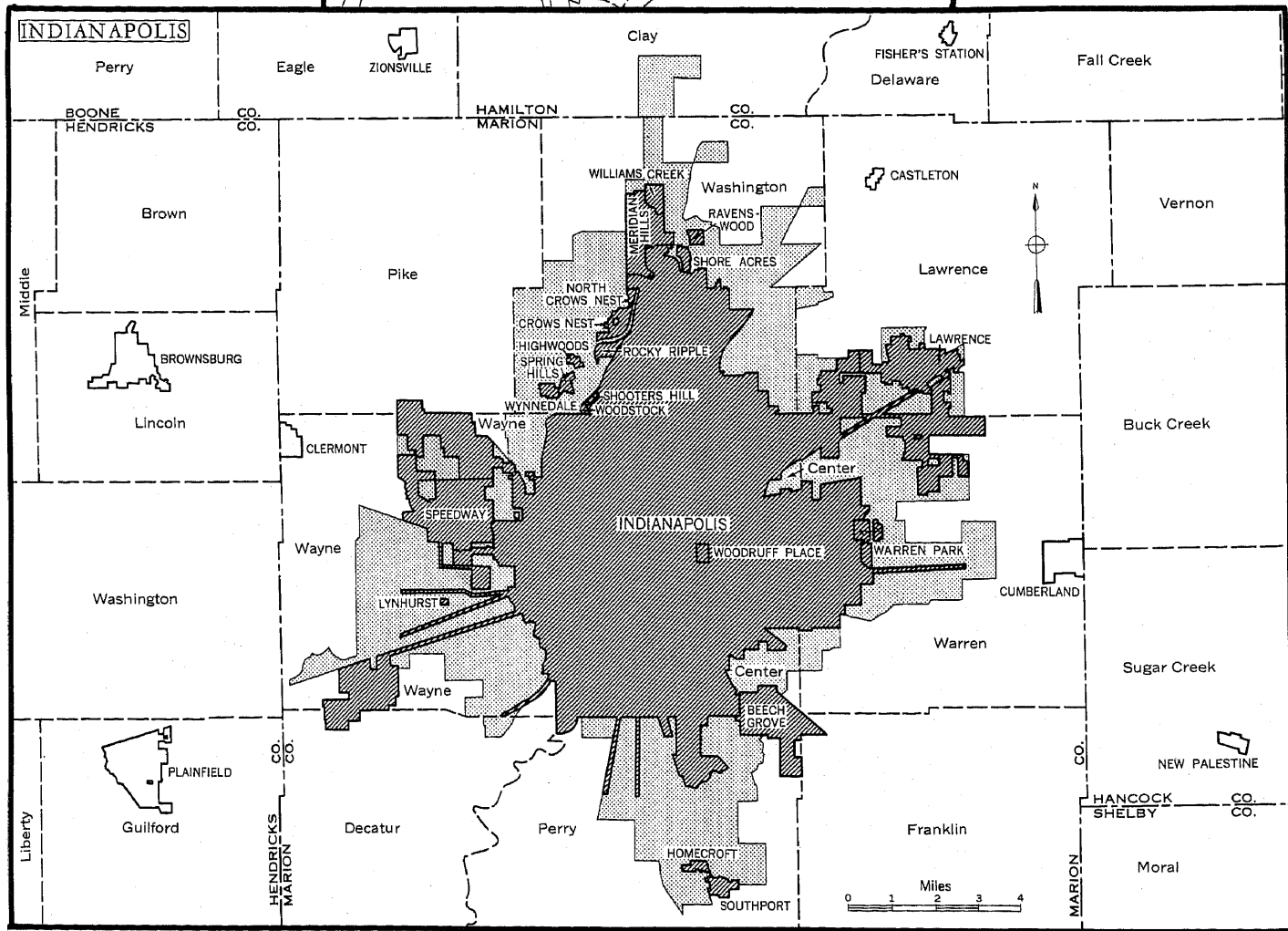
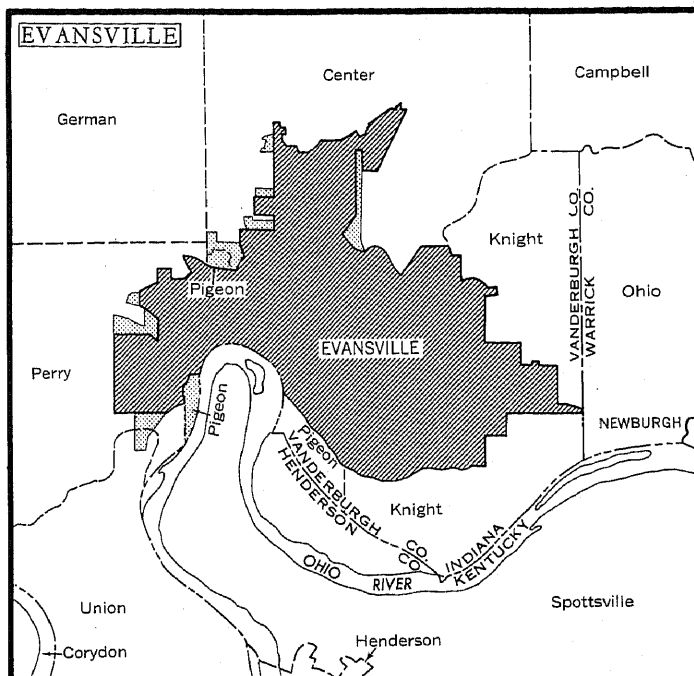
