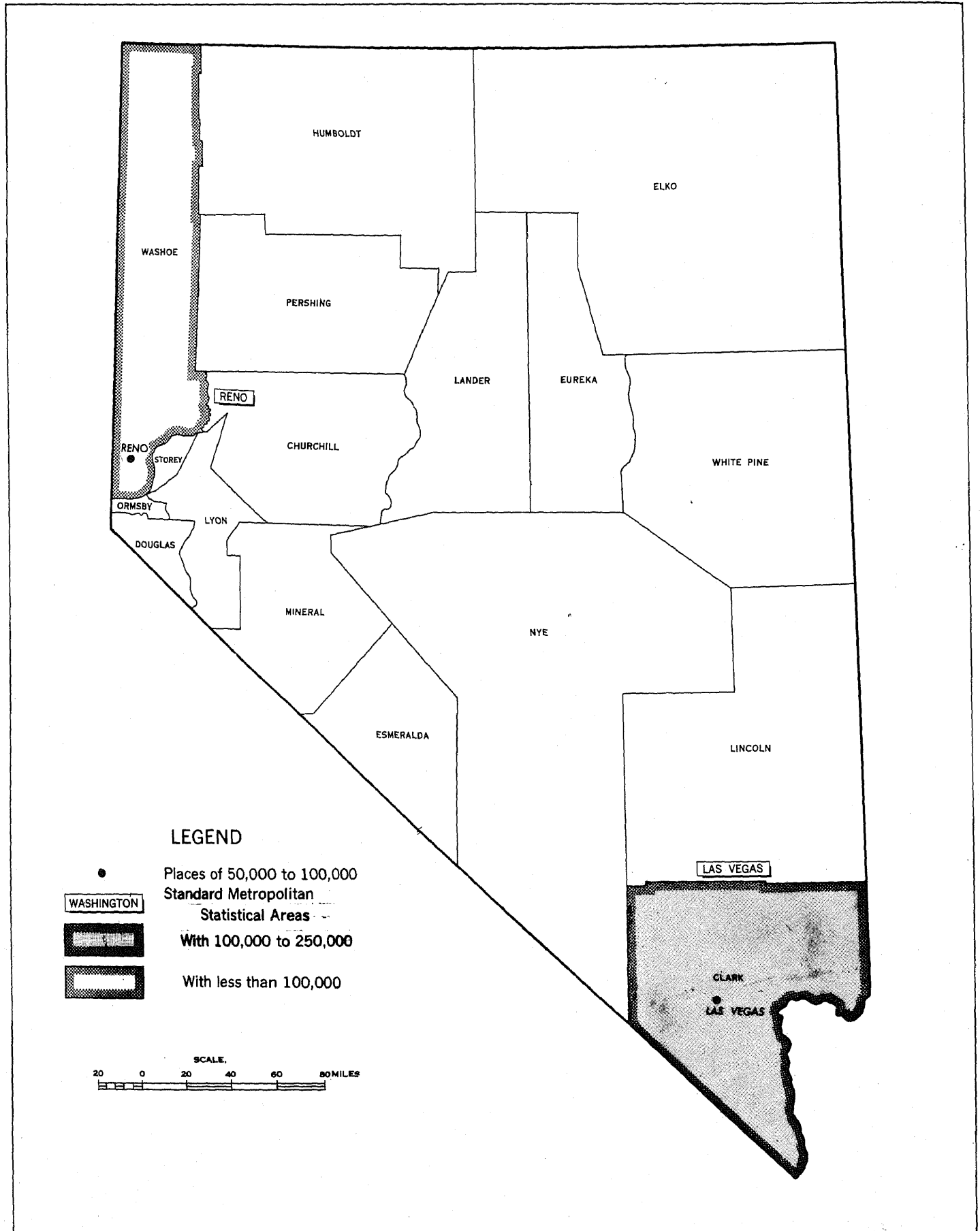

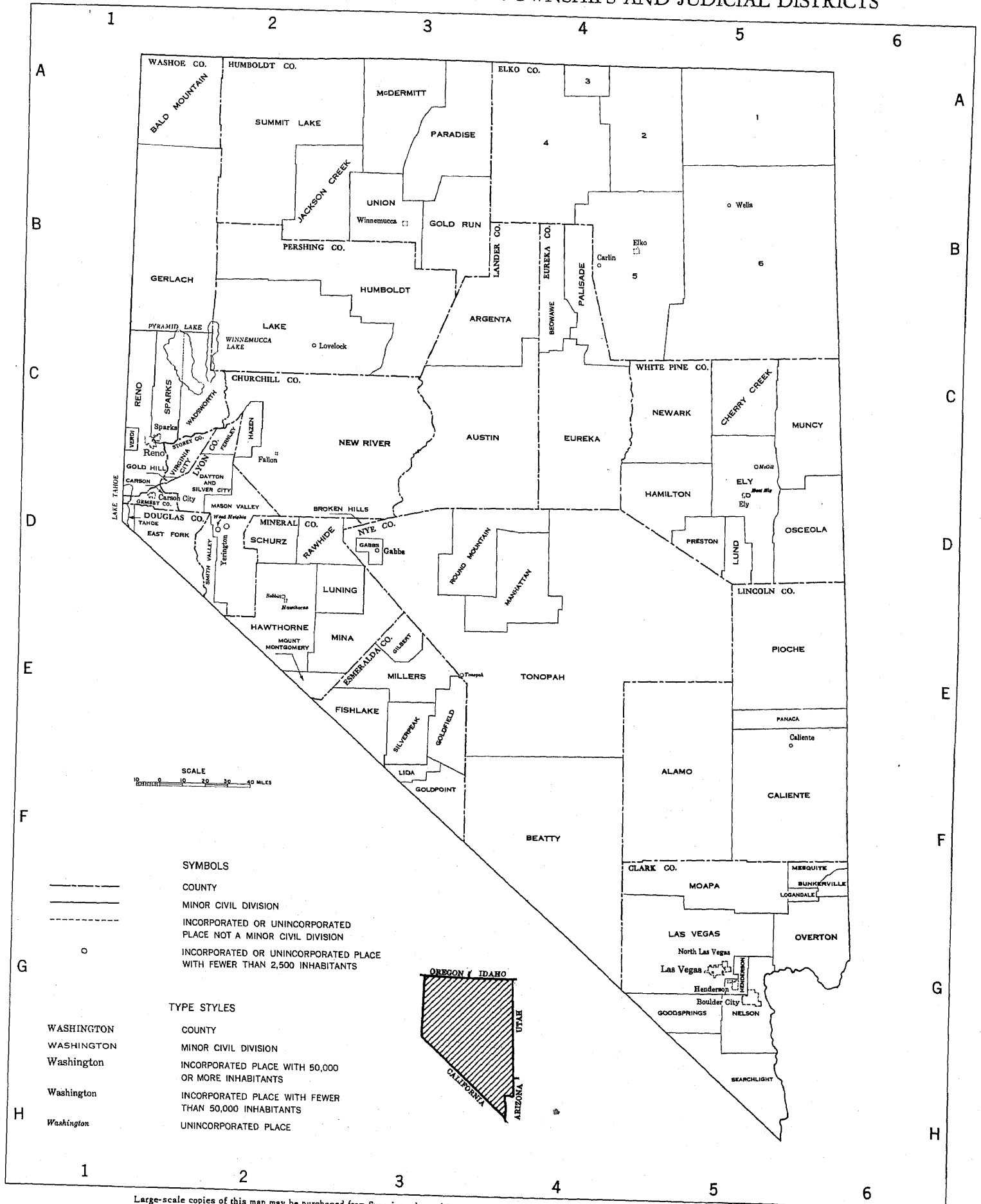

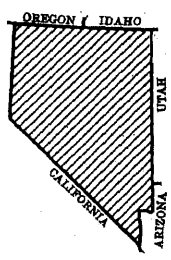

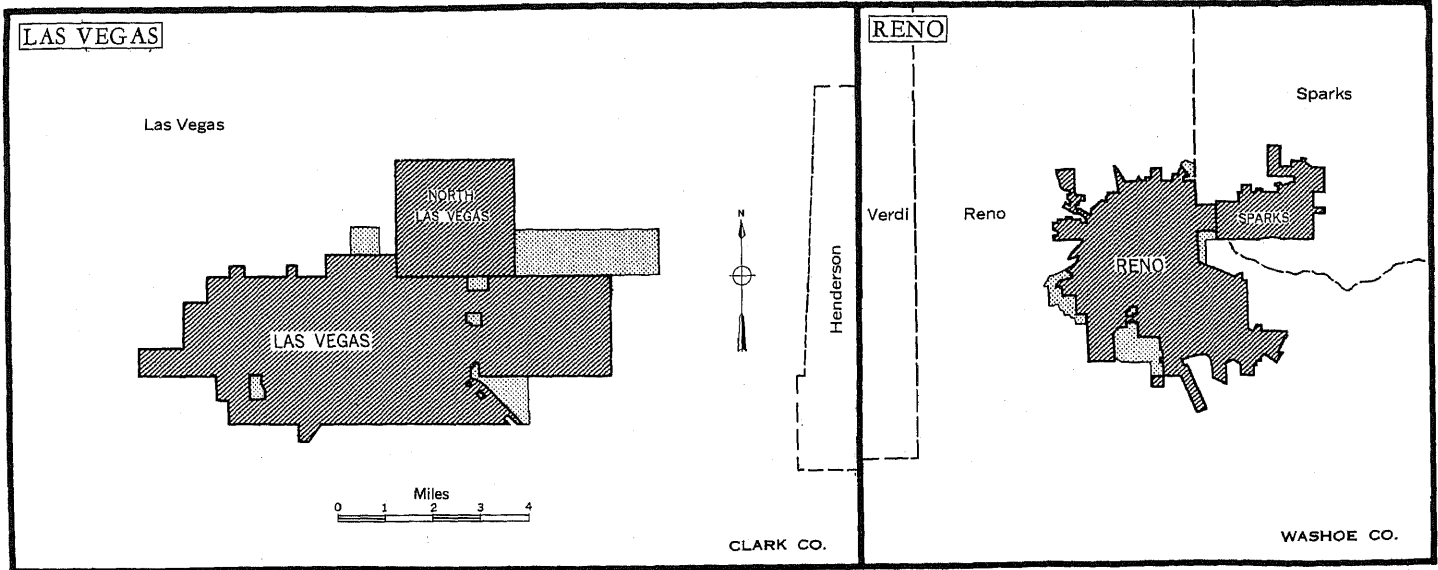




URBANIZED AREAS—NEVADA
