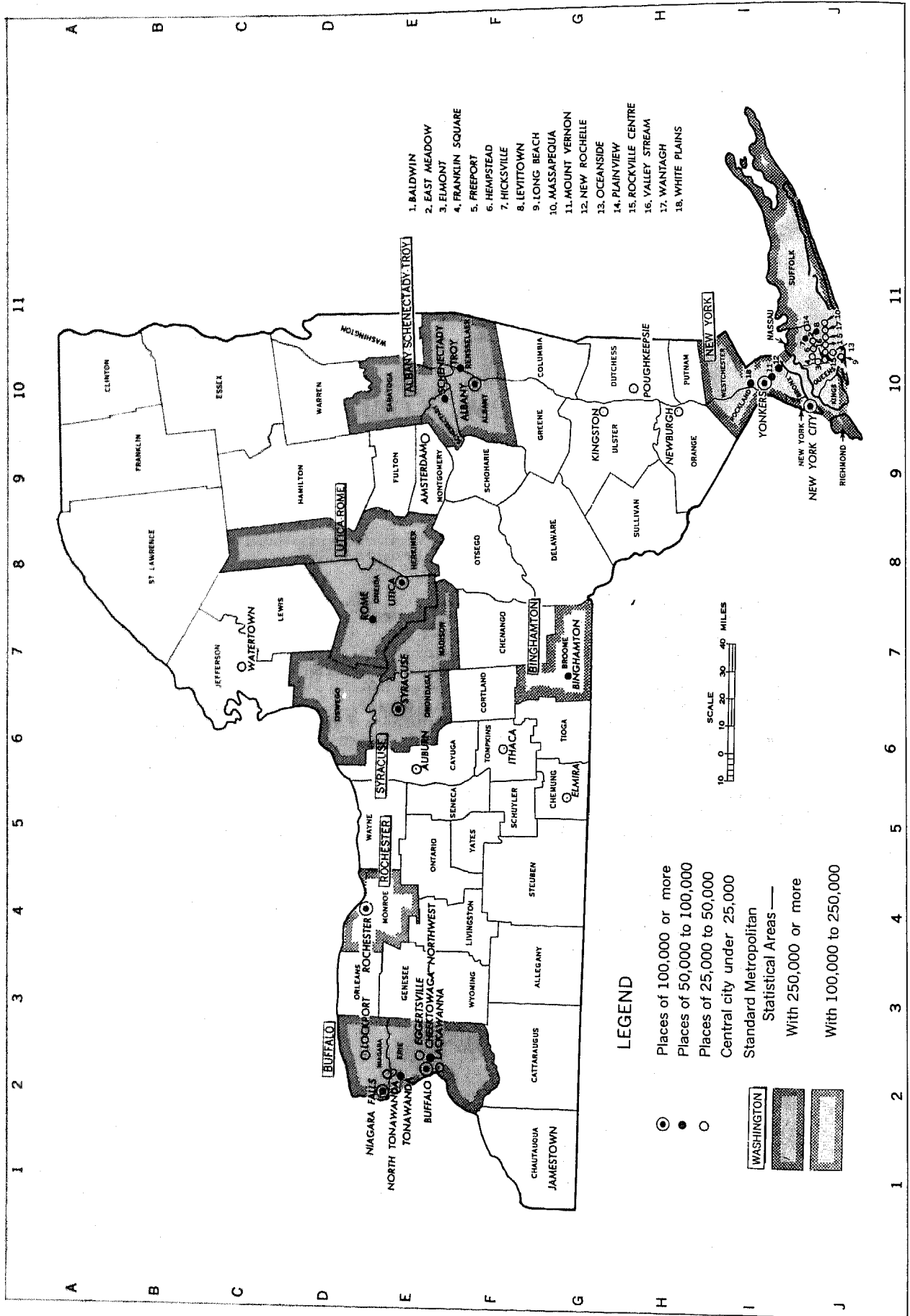

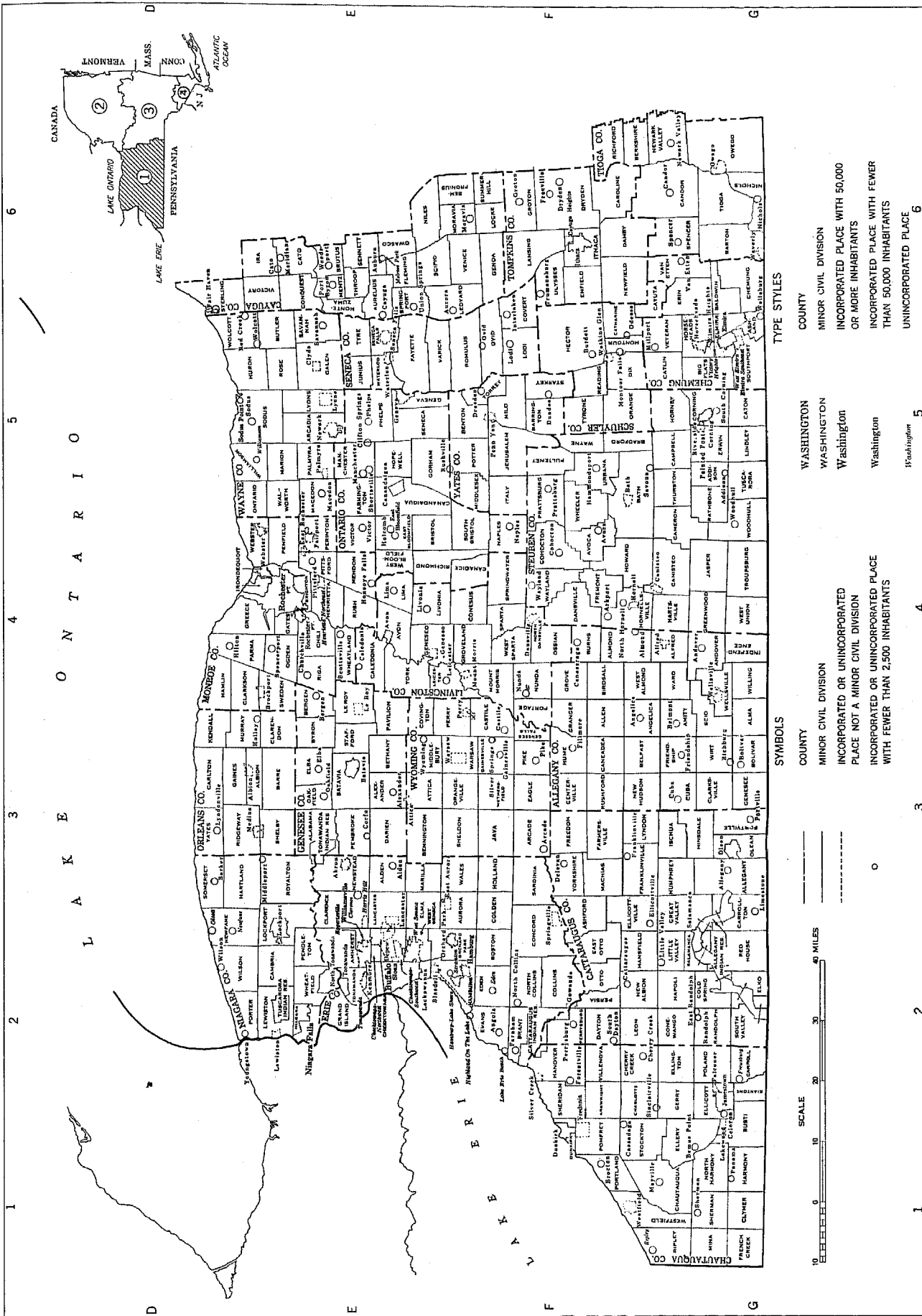

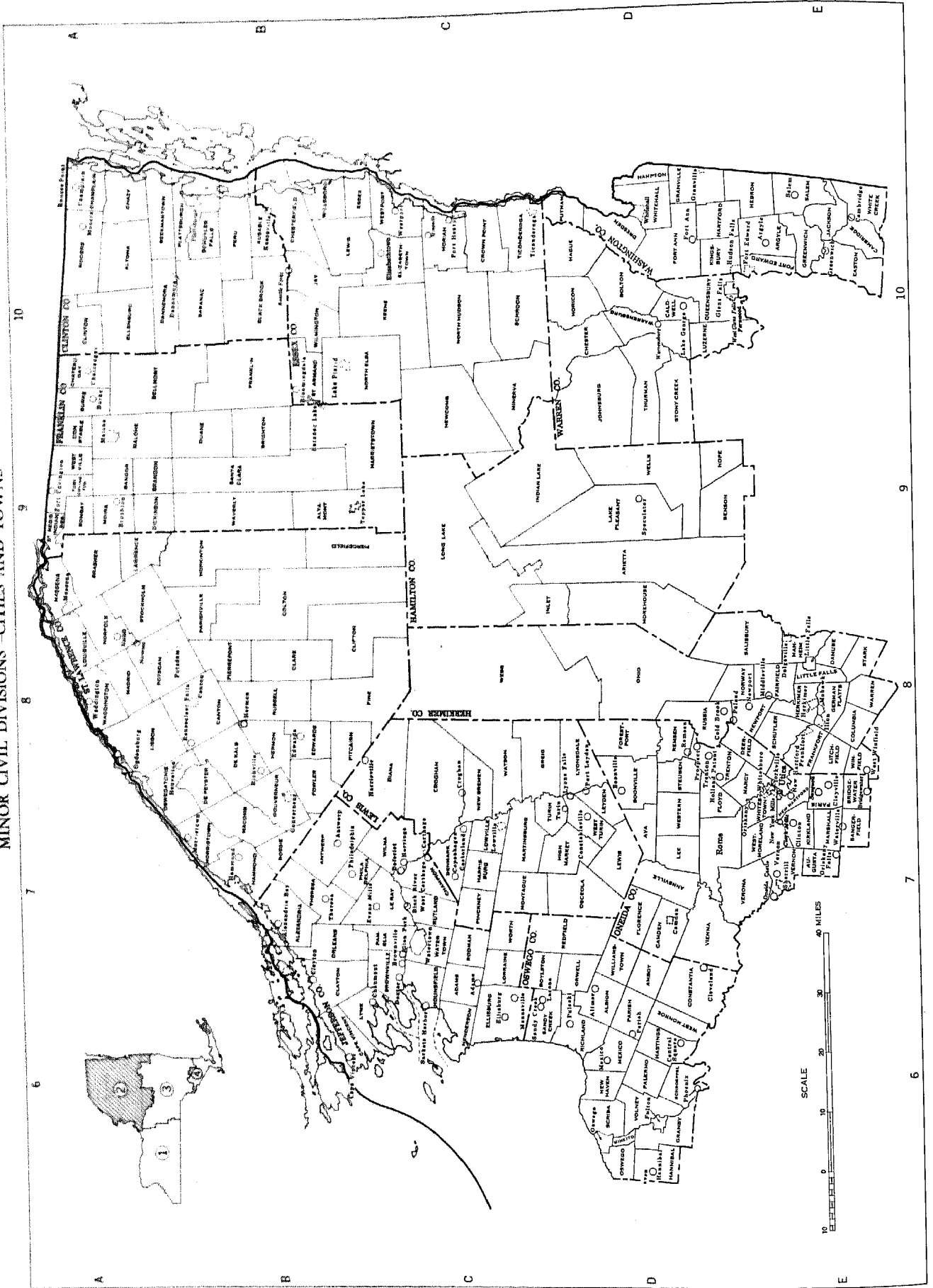


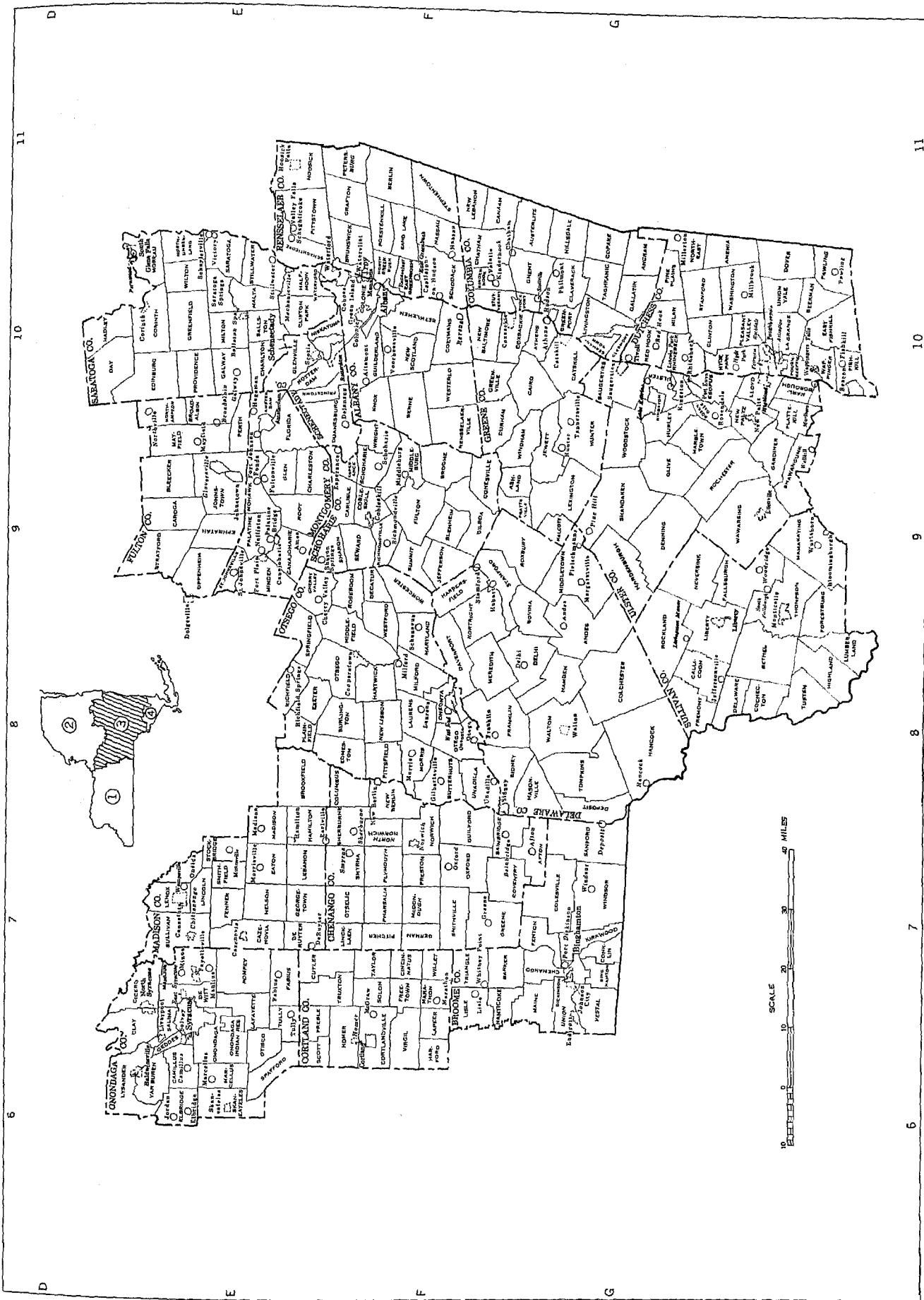

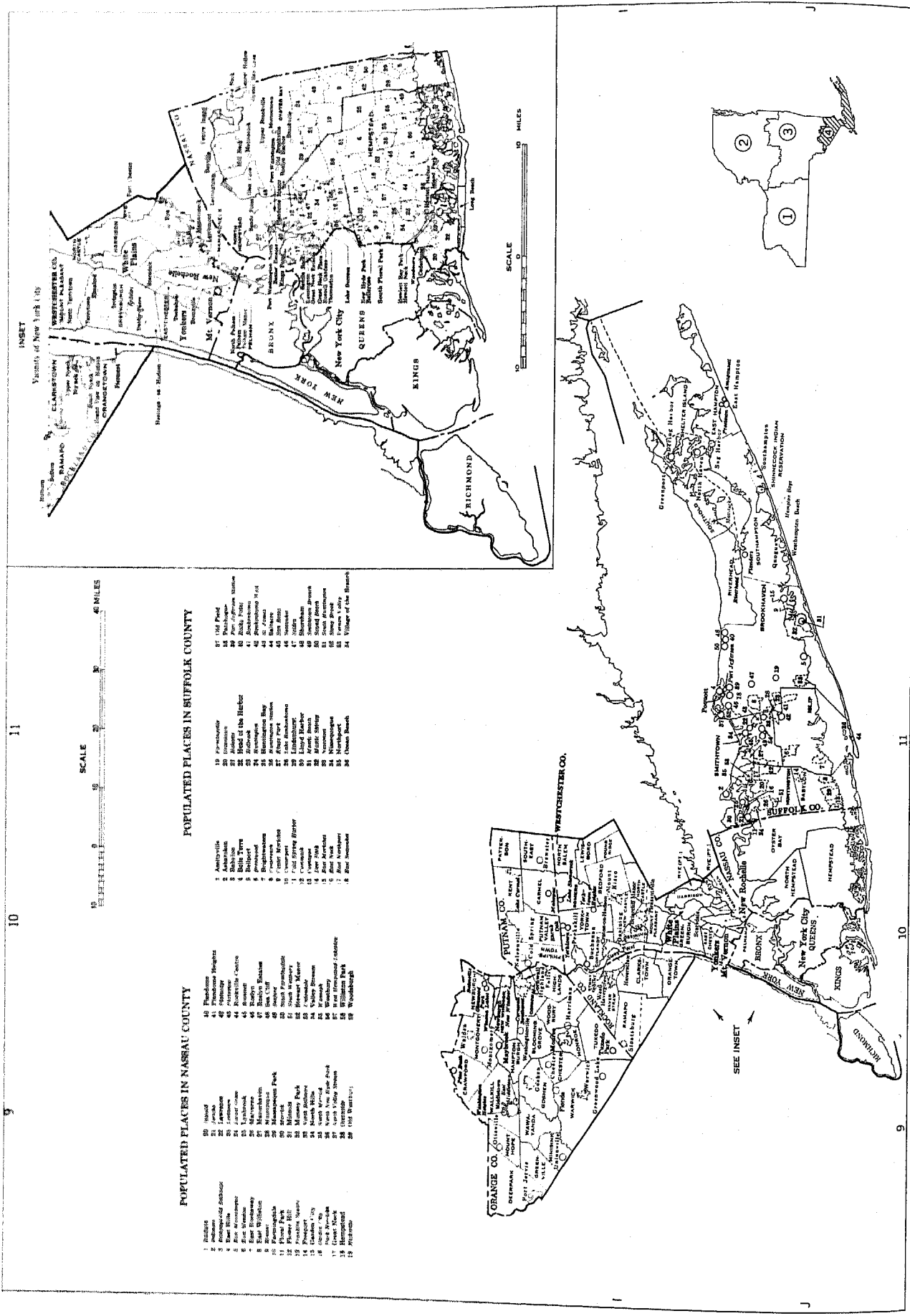
NEW YORK—SECTIONS 2 AND 3

NEW YORK—SECTION 4 MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—CITIES AND TOWNS

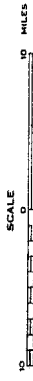

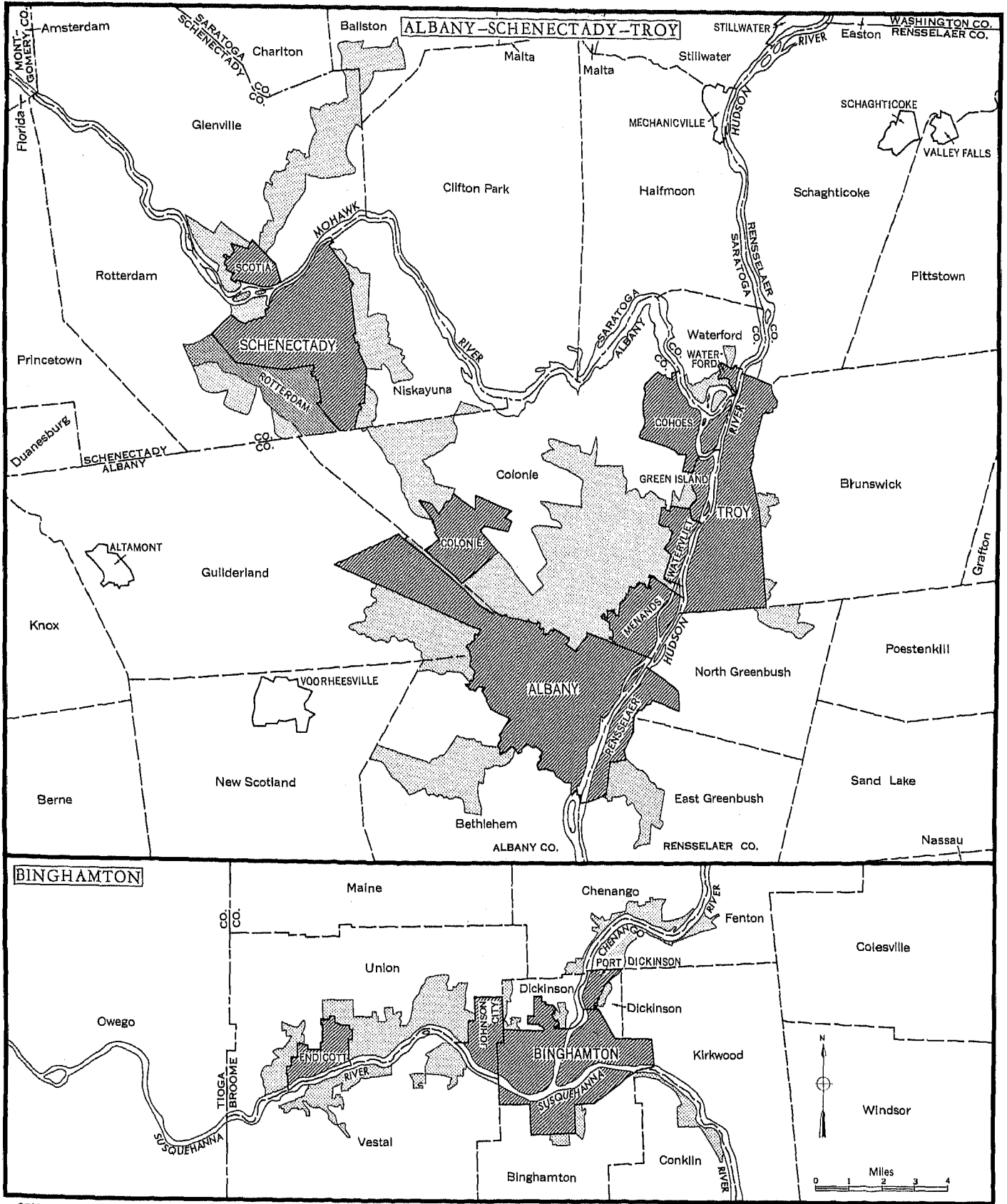



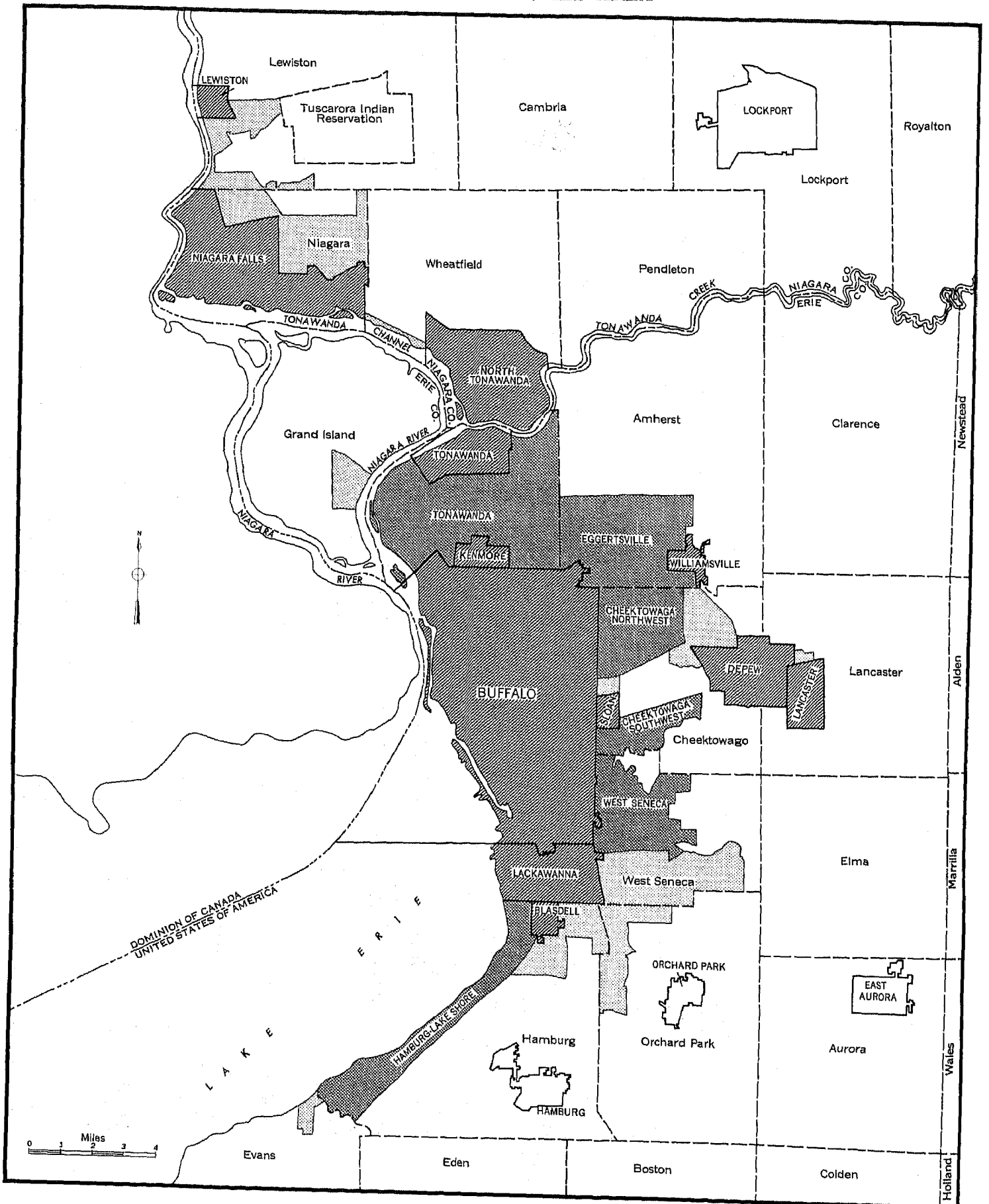

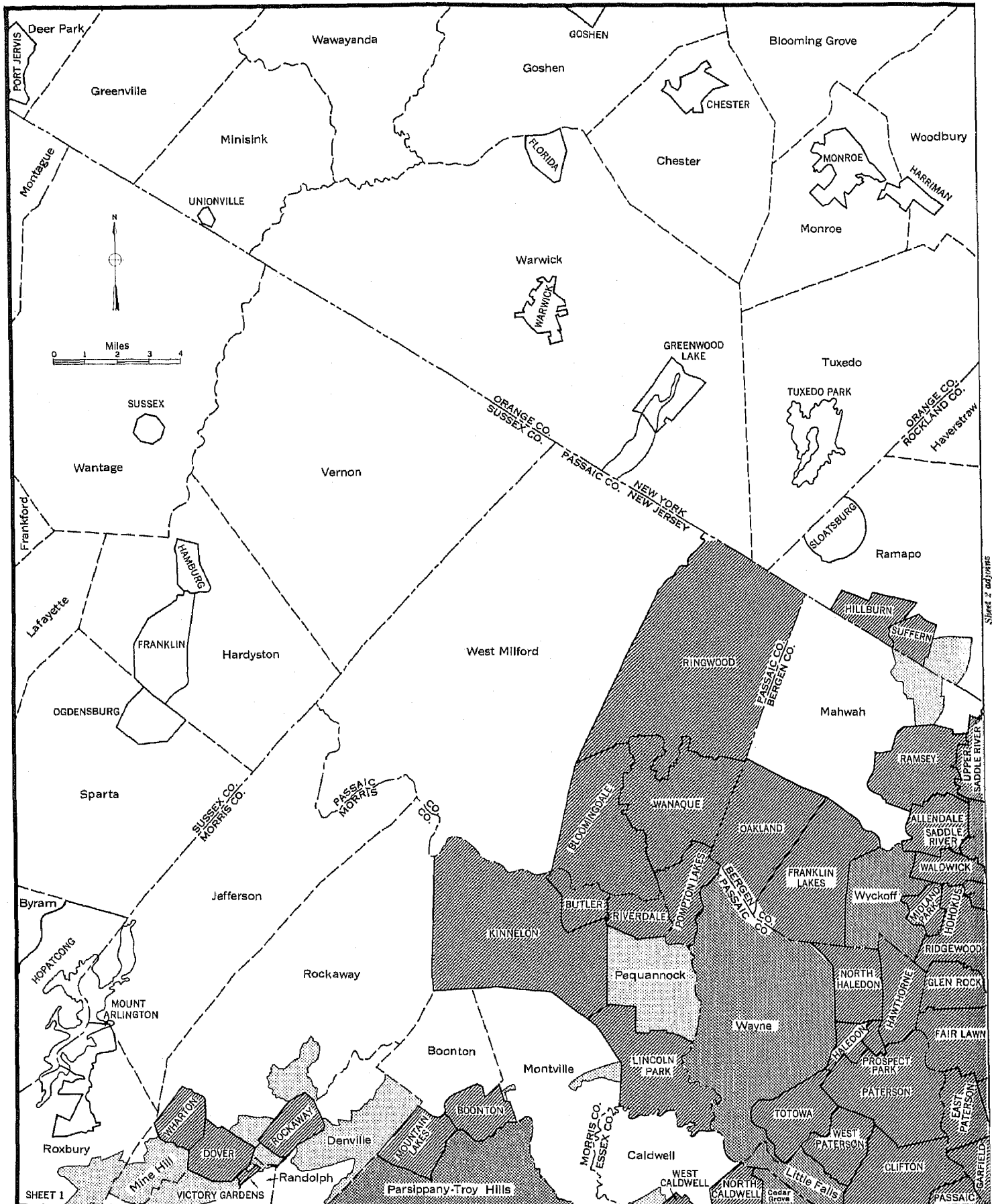
BUFFALO URBANIZED AREA

NEW YORK-NORTHEASTERN NEW JERSEY URBANIZED AREA—SECTION 1

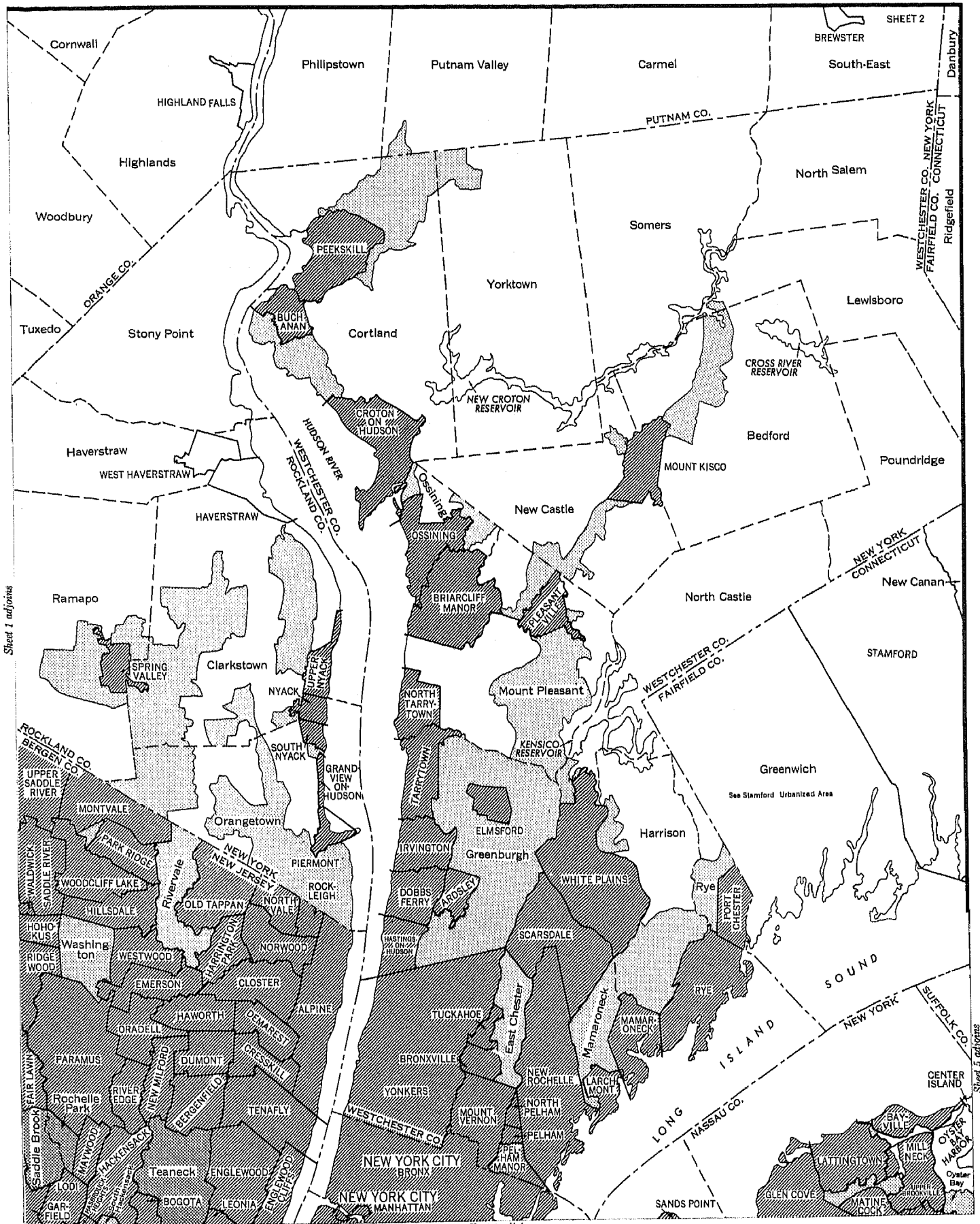

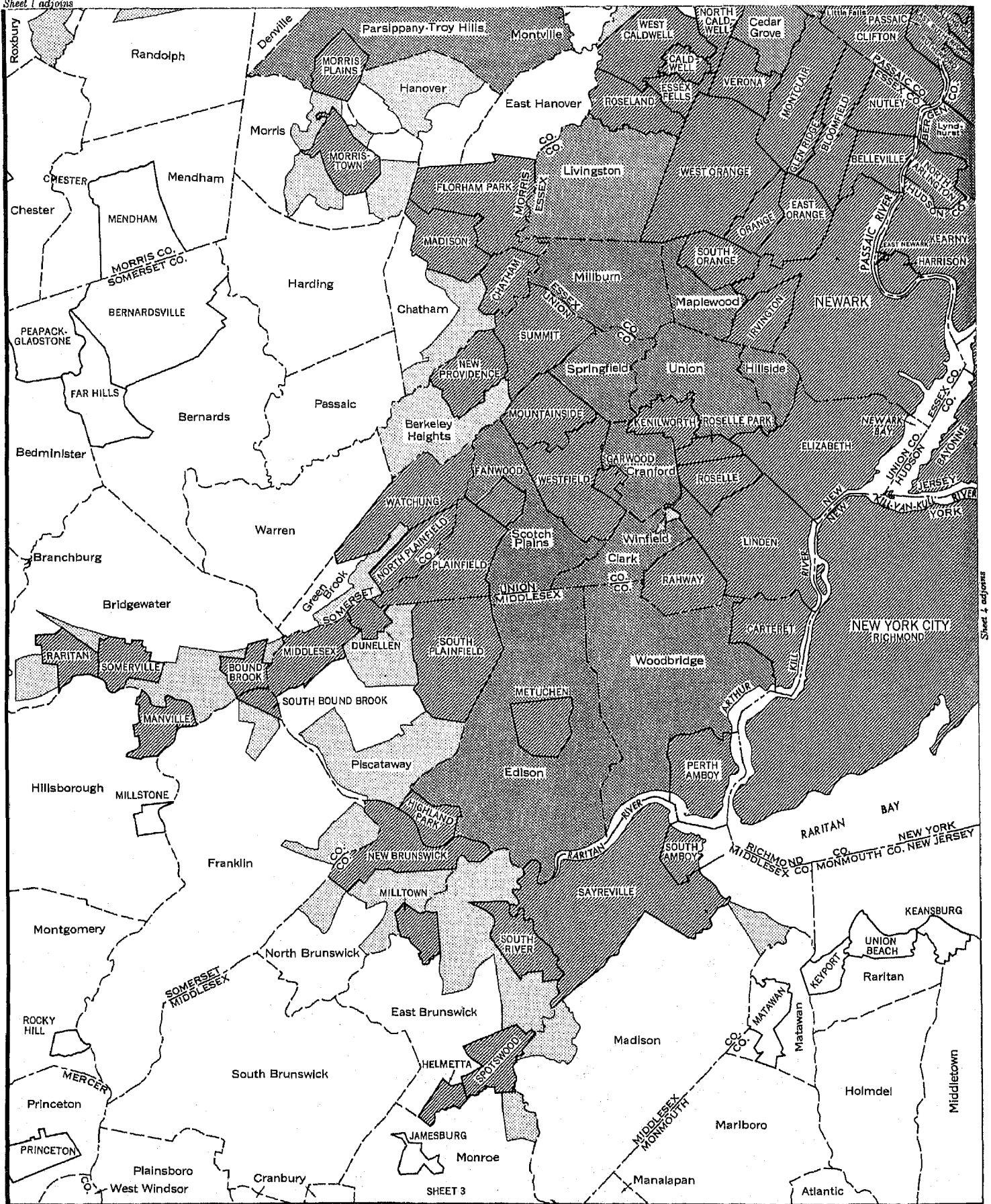

NEW YORK-NORTHEASTERN NEW JERSEY URBANIZED AREA—SECTION 3

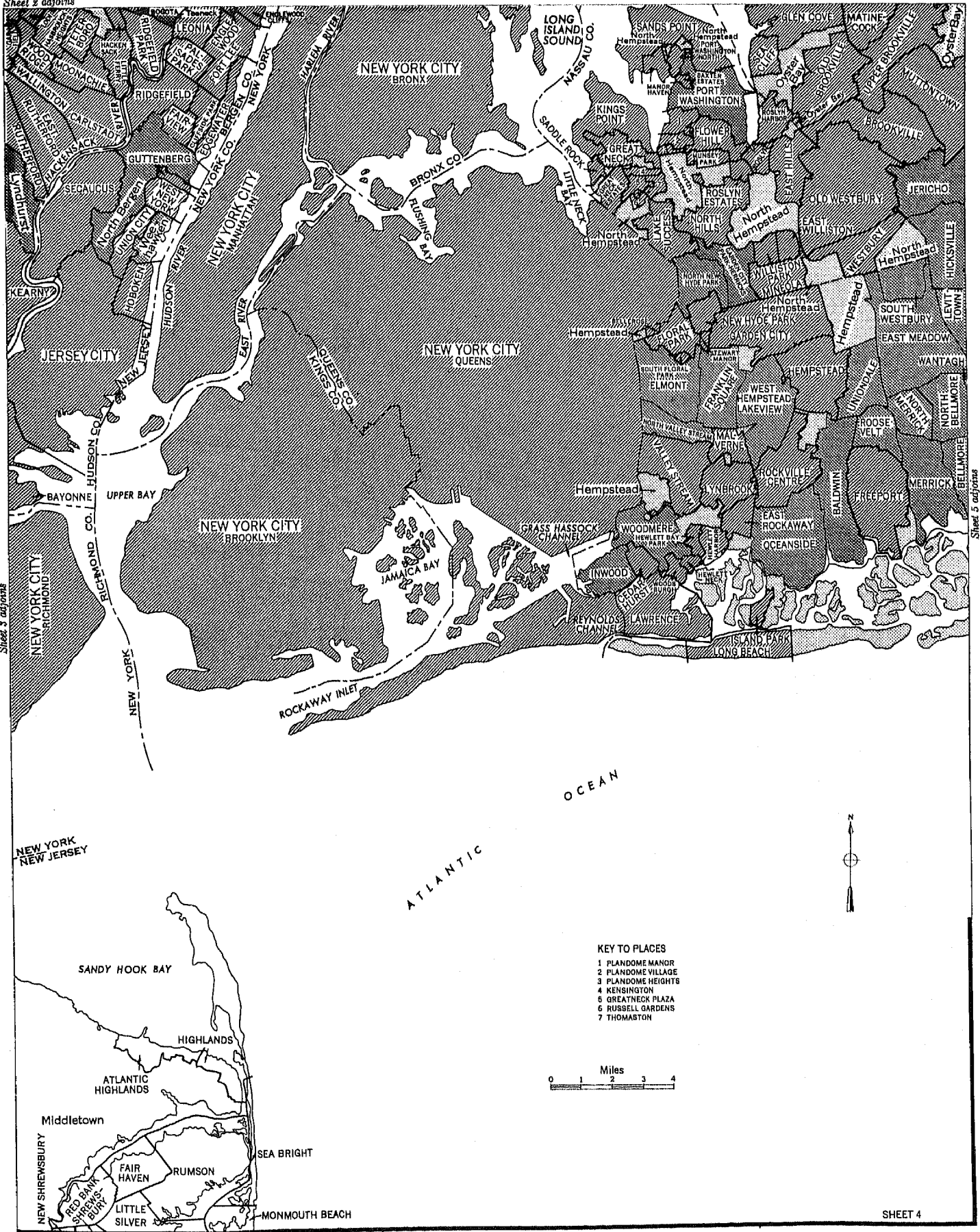

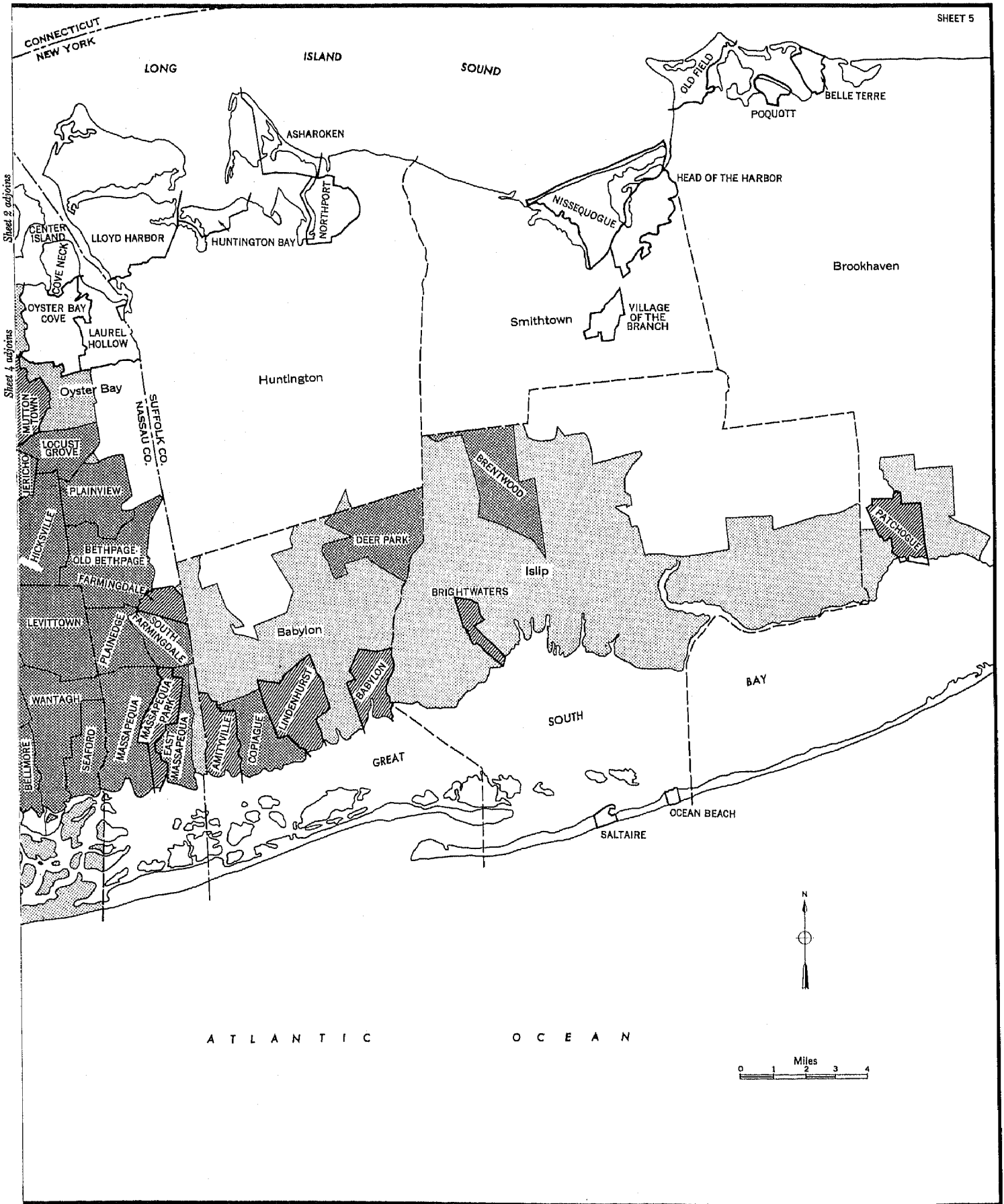
NEW YORK-NORTHEASTERN NEW JERSEY URBANIZED AREA—SECTION 4

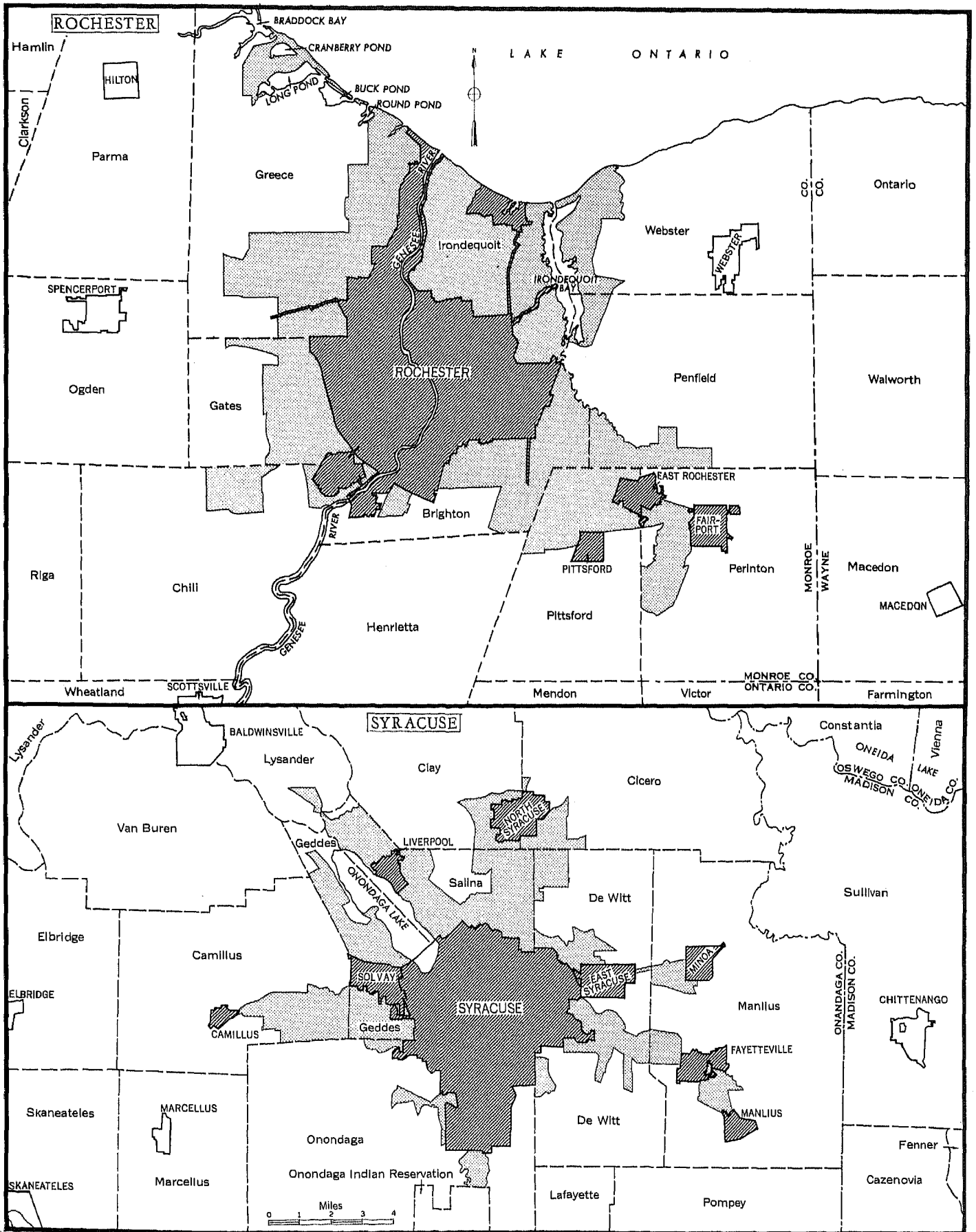
