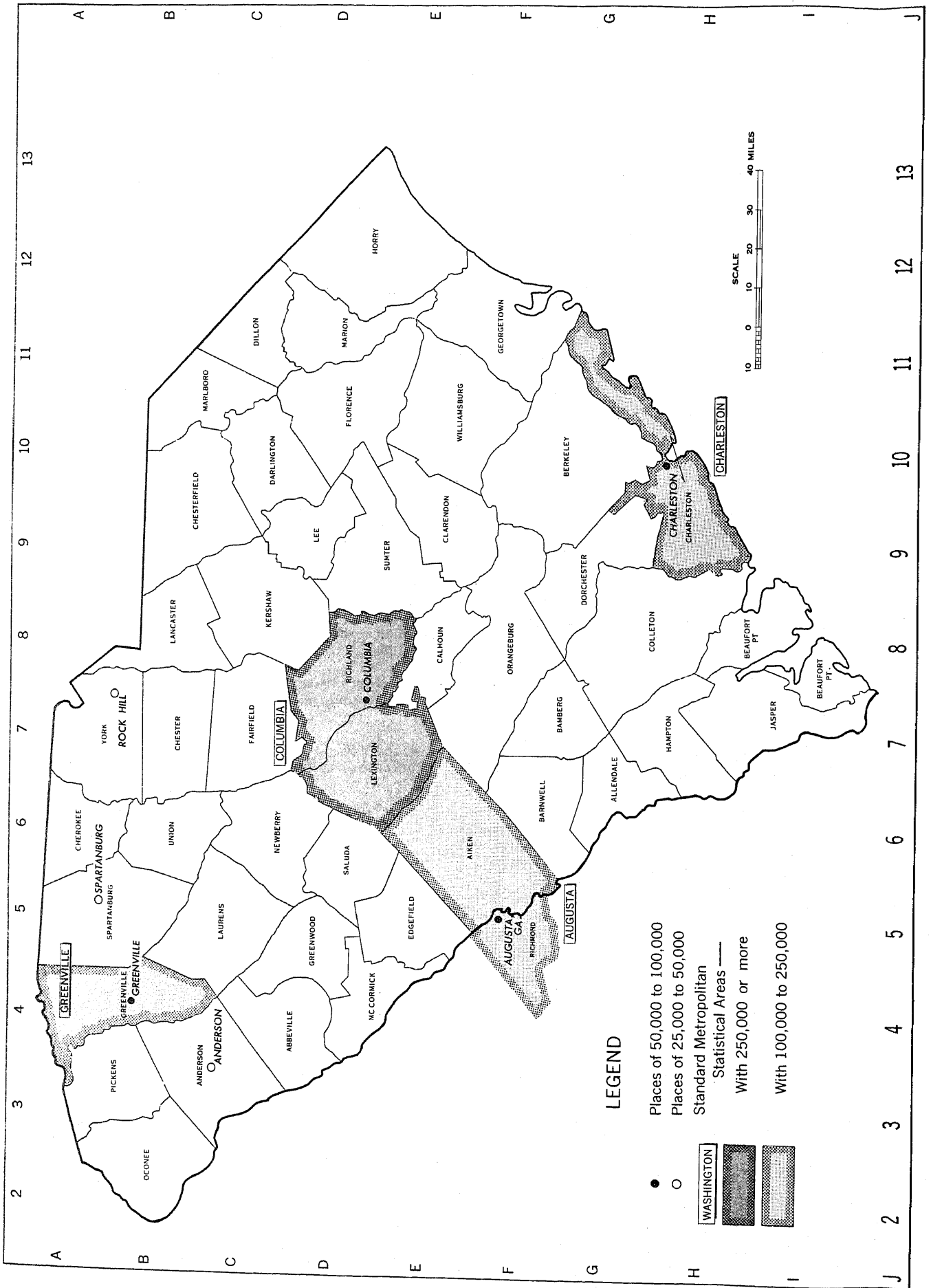

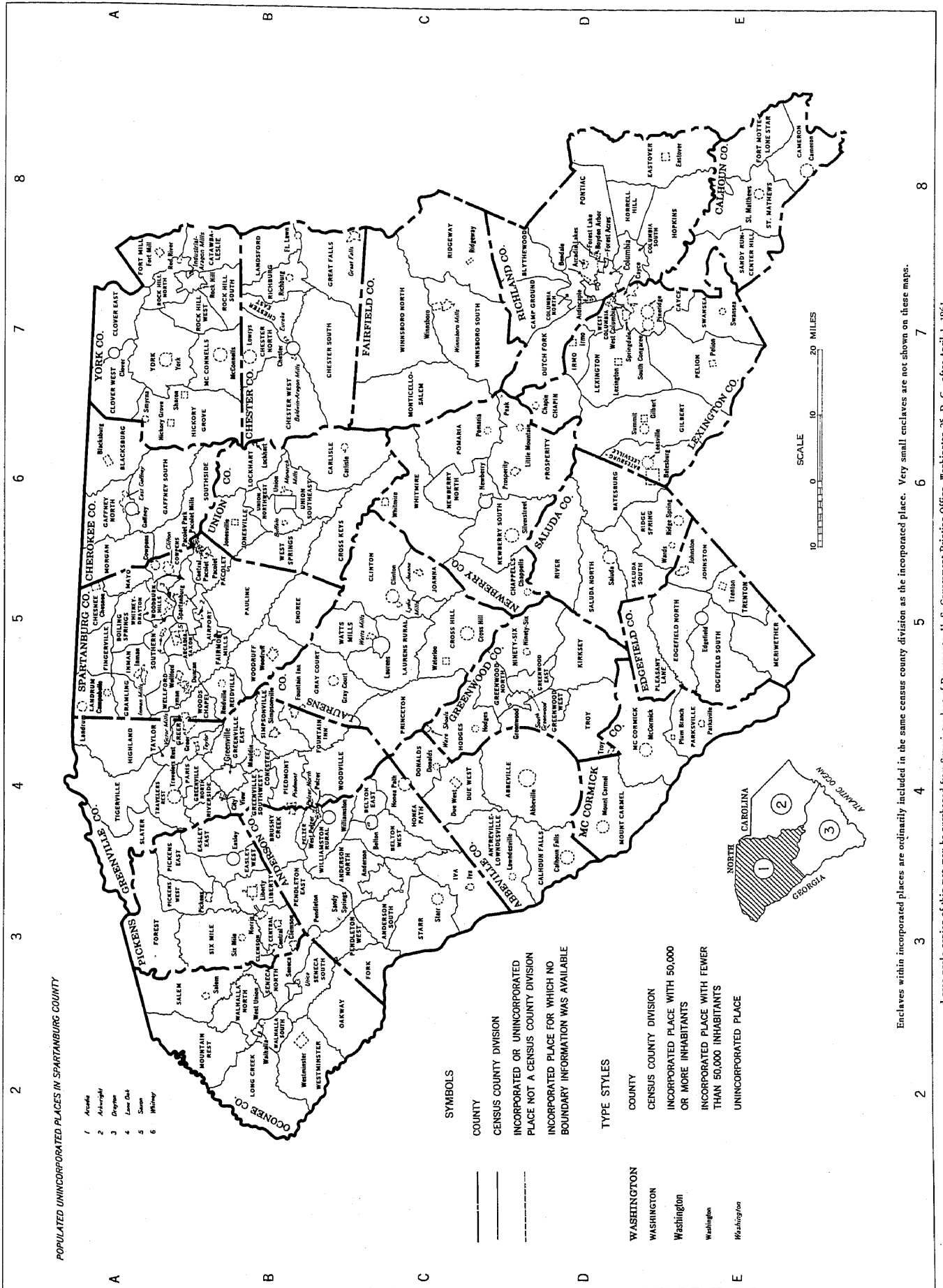

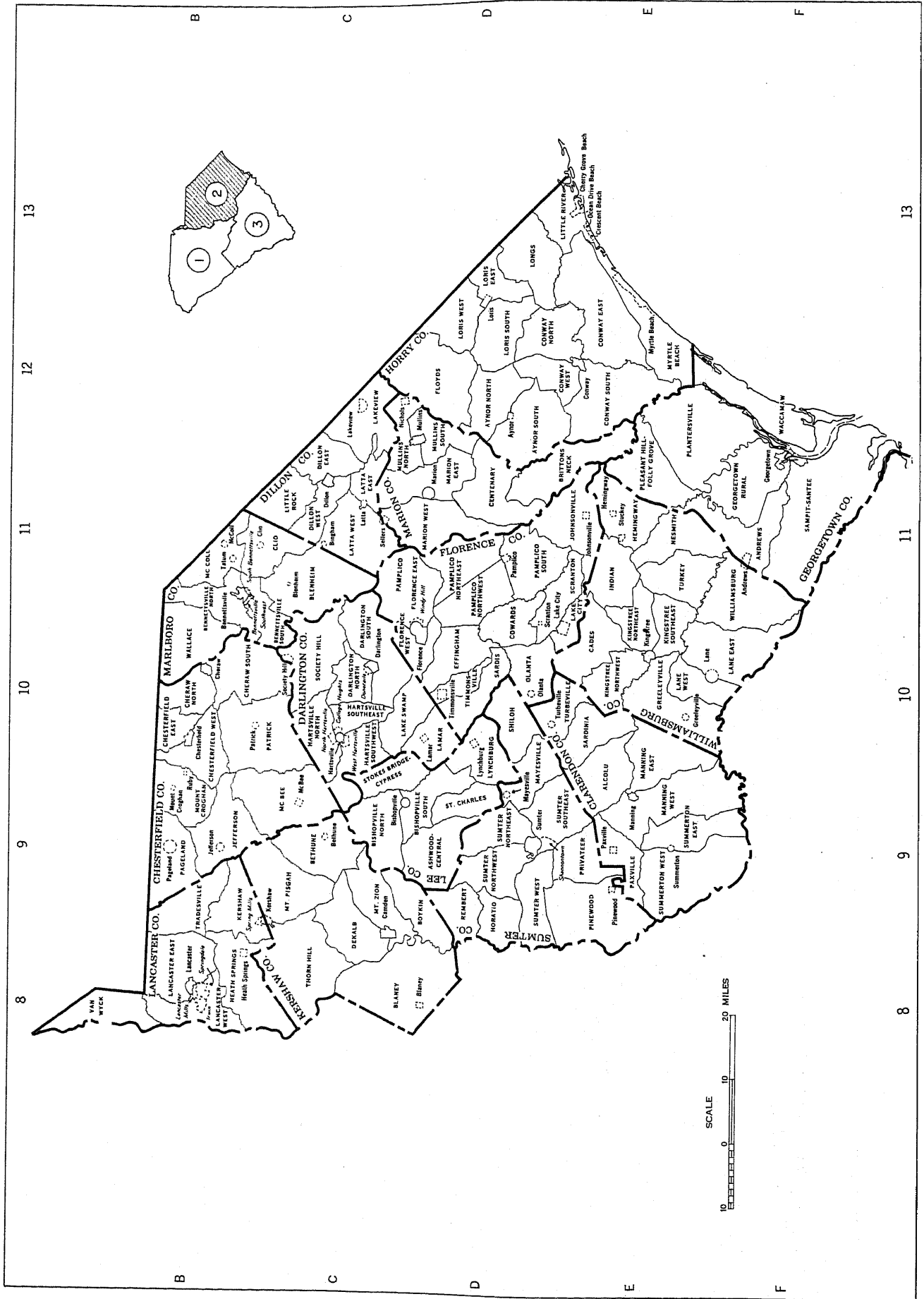
## CENSUS COUNTY DIVISIONS

CENSUS COUNTY DIVISIONS



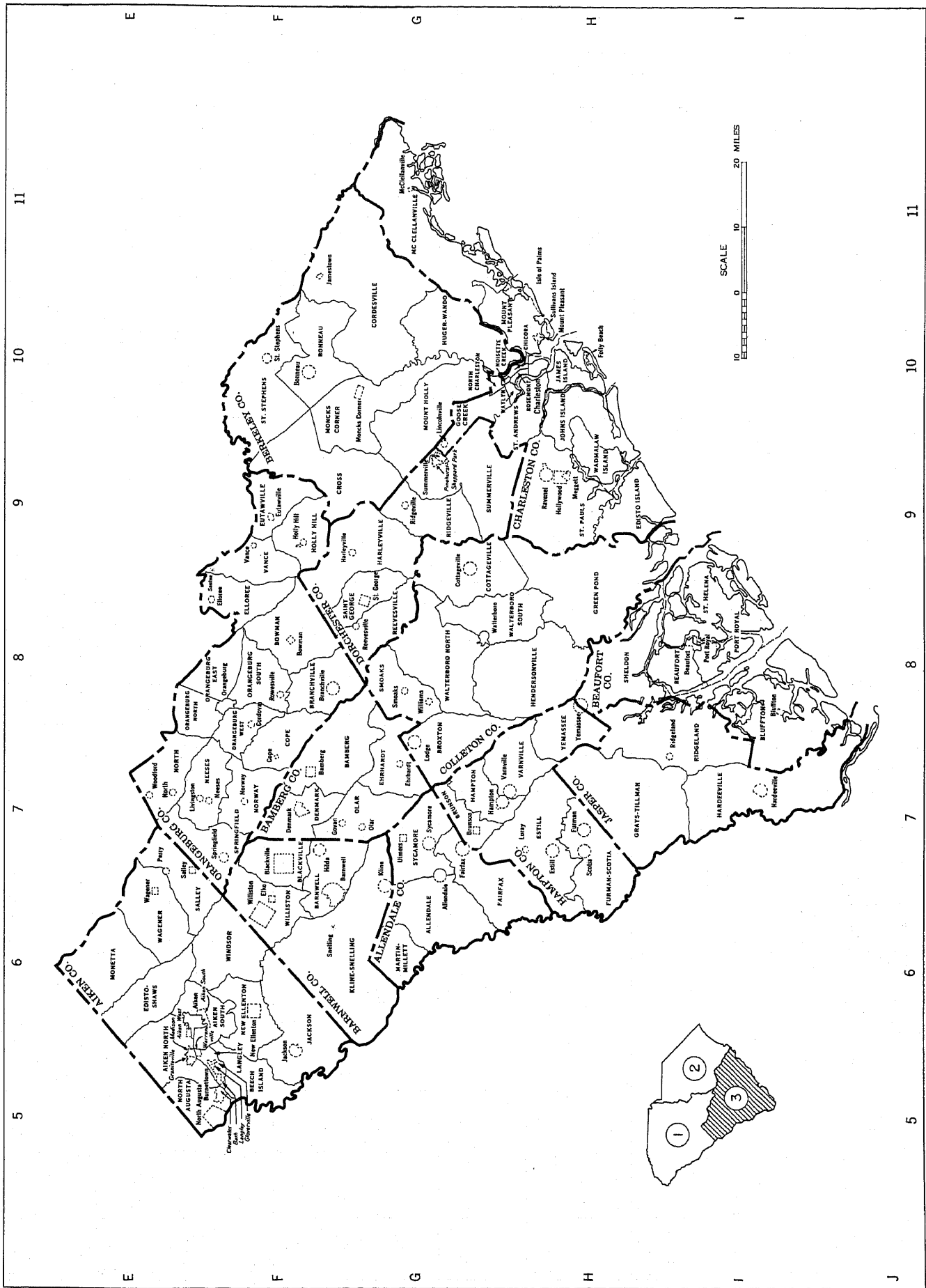

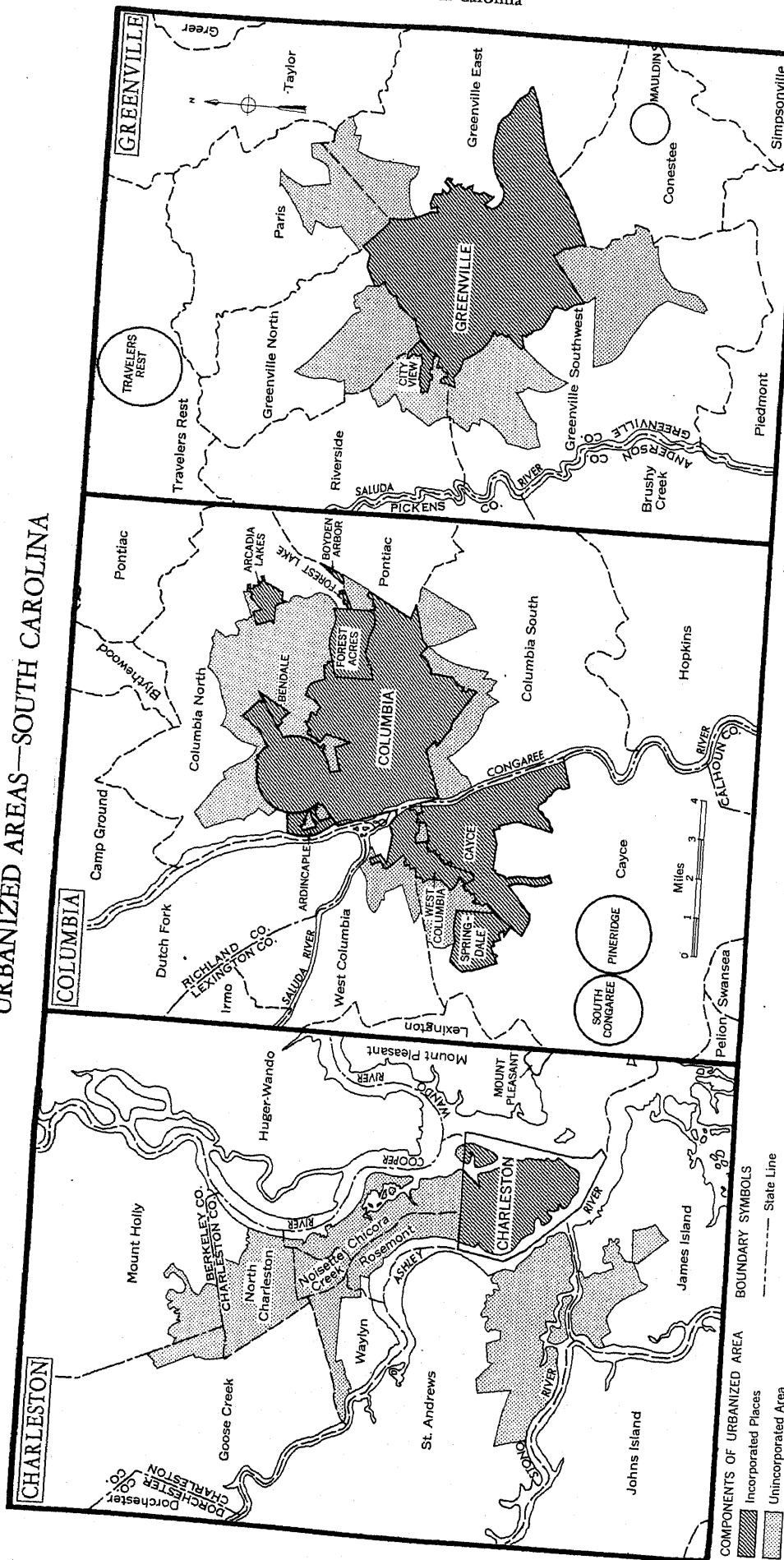
