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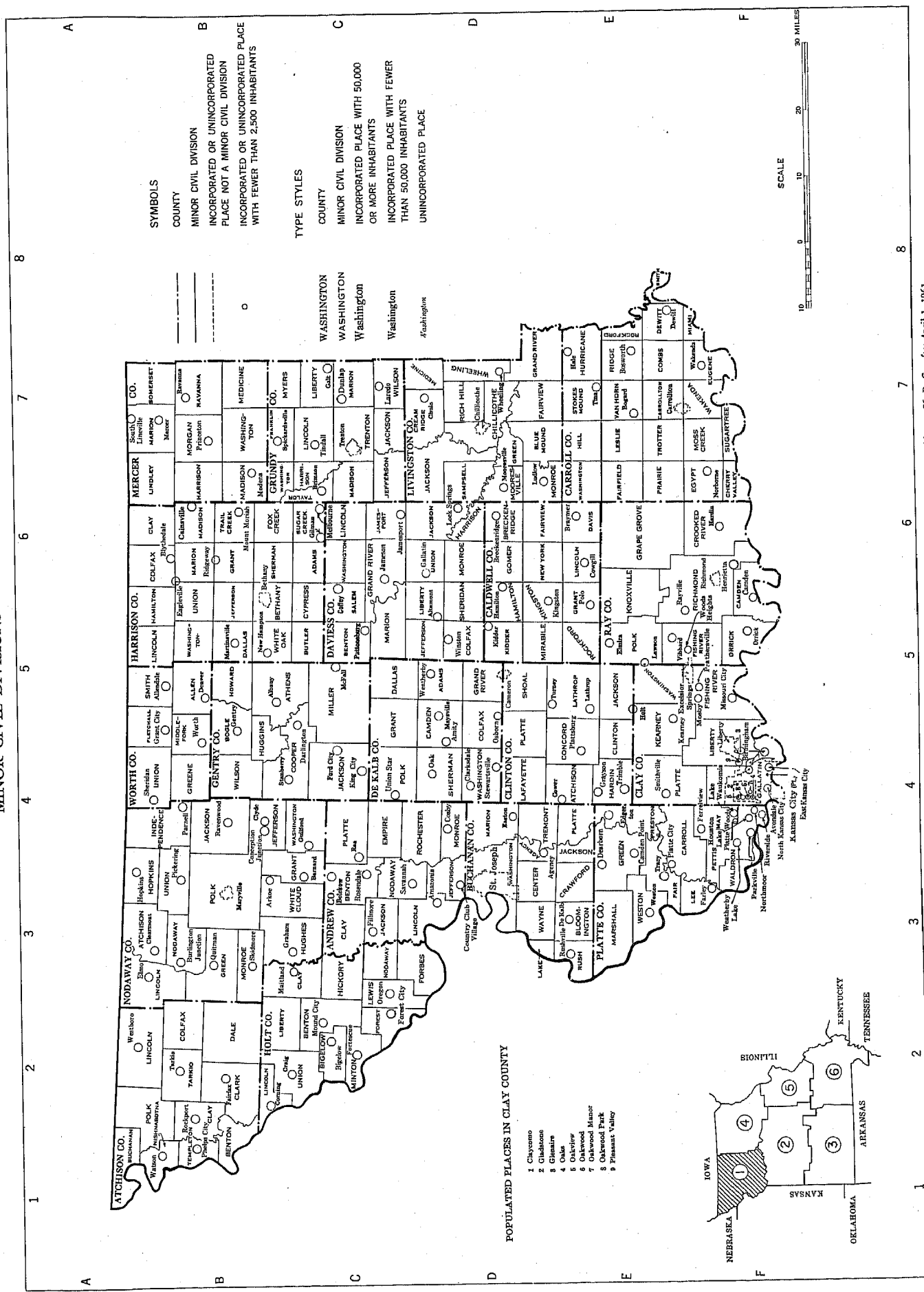
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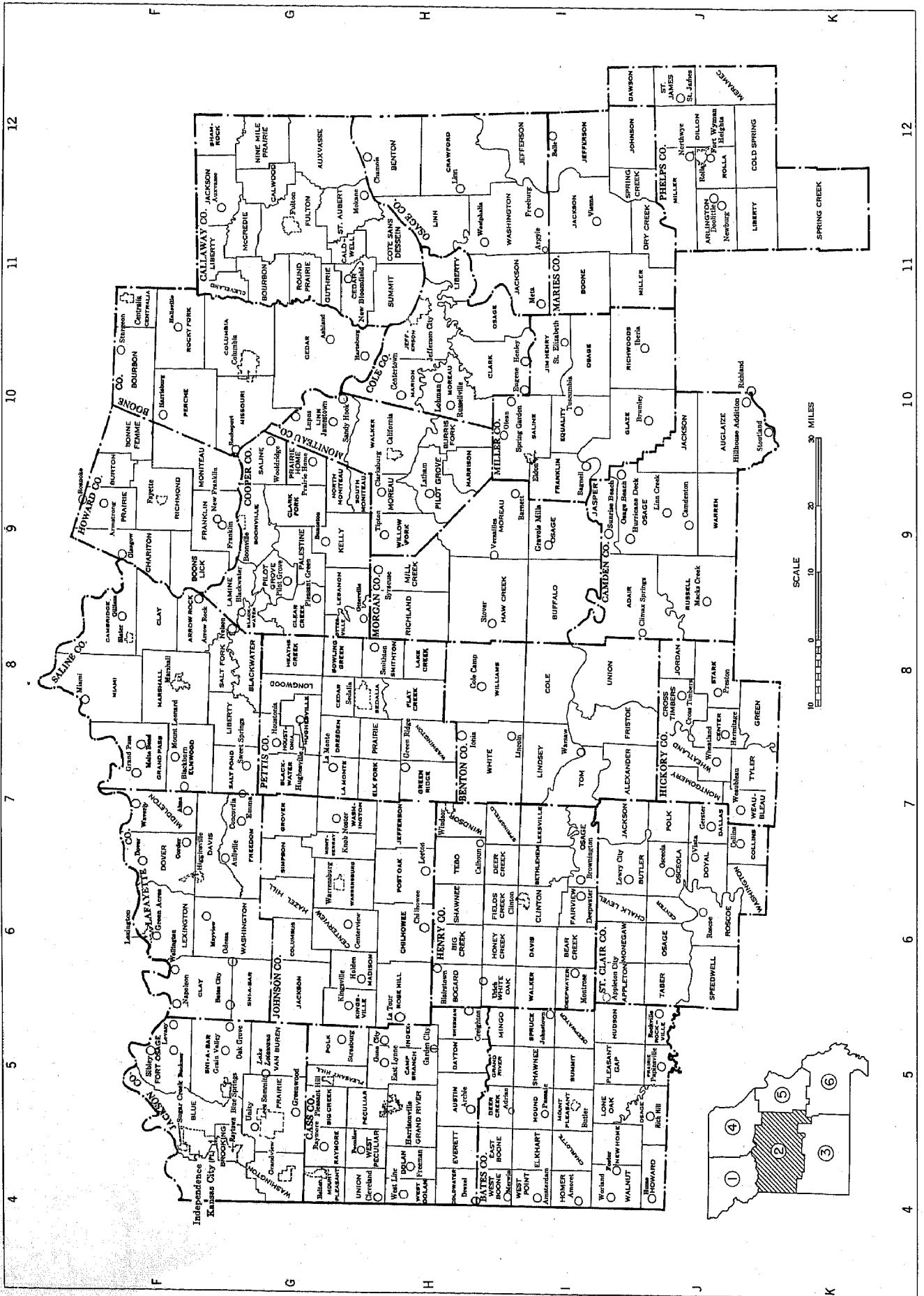
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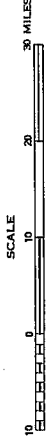
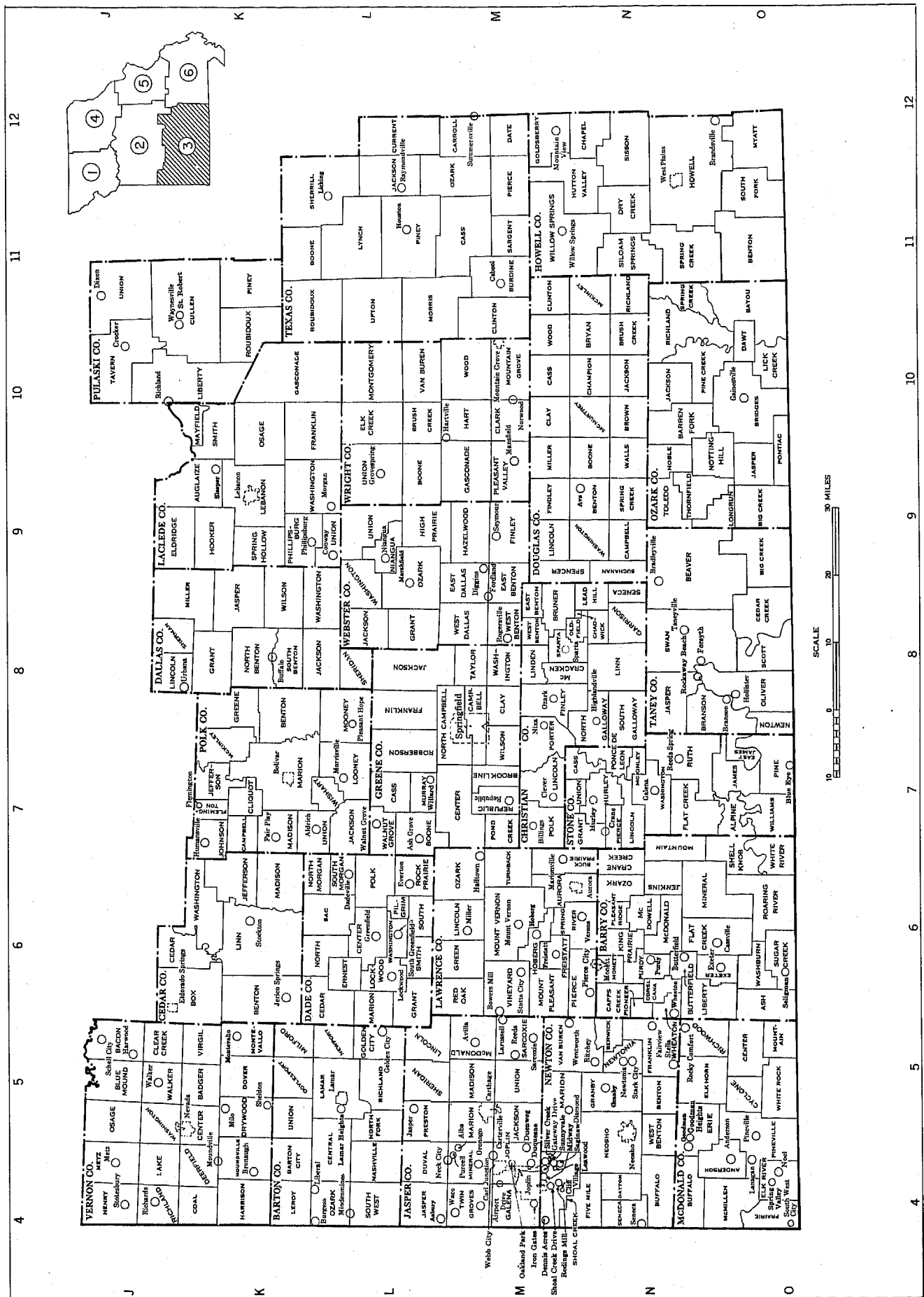
MISSOURI—SECTION 1 MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS—TOWNSHIPS



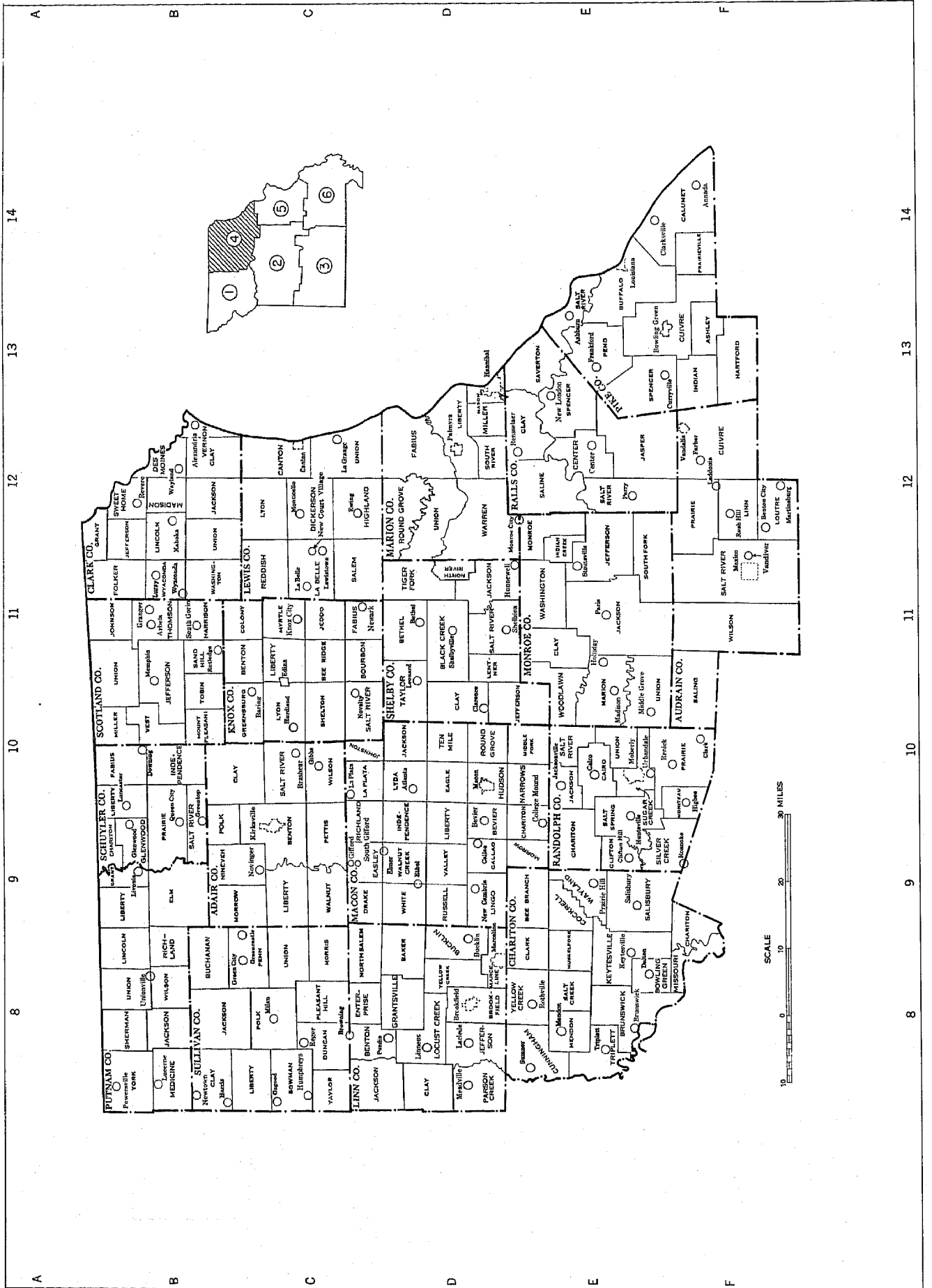
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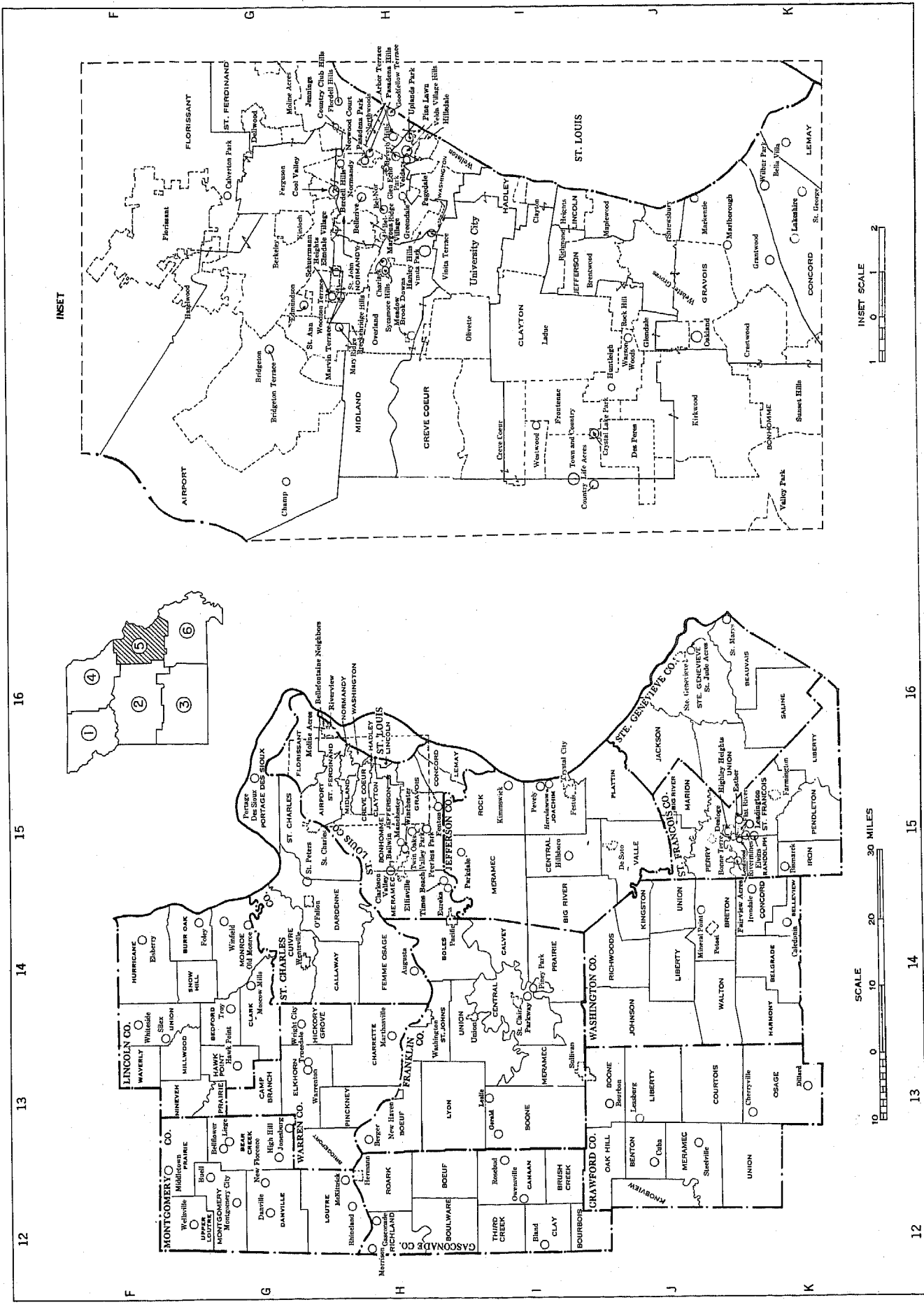
MISSOURI—SECTIONS 2 AND 3

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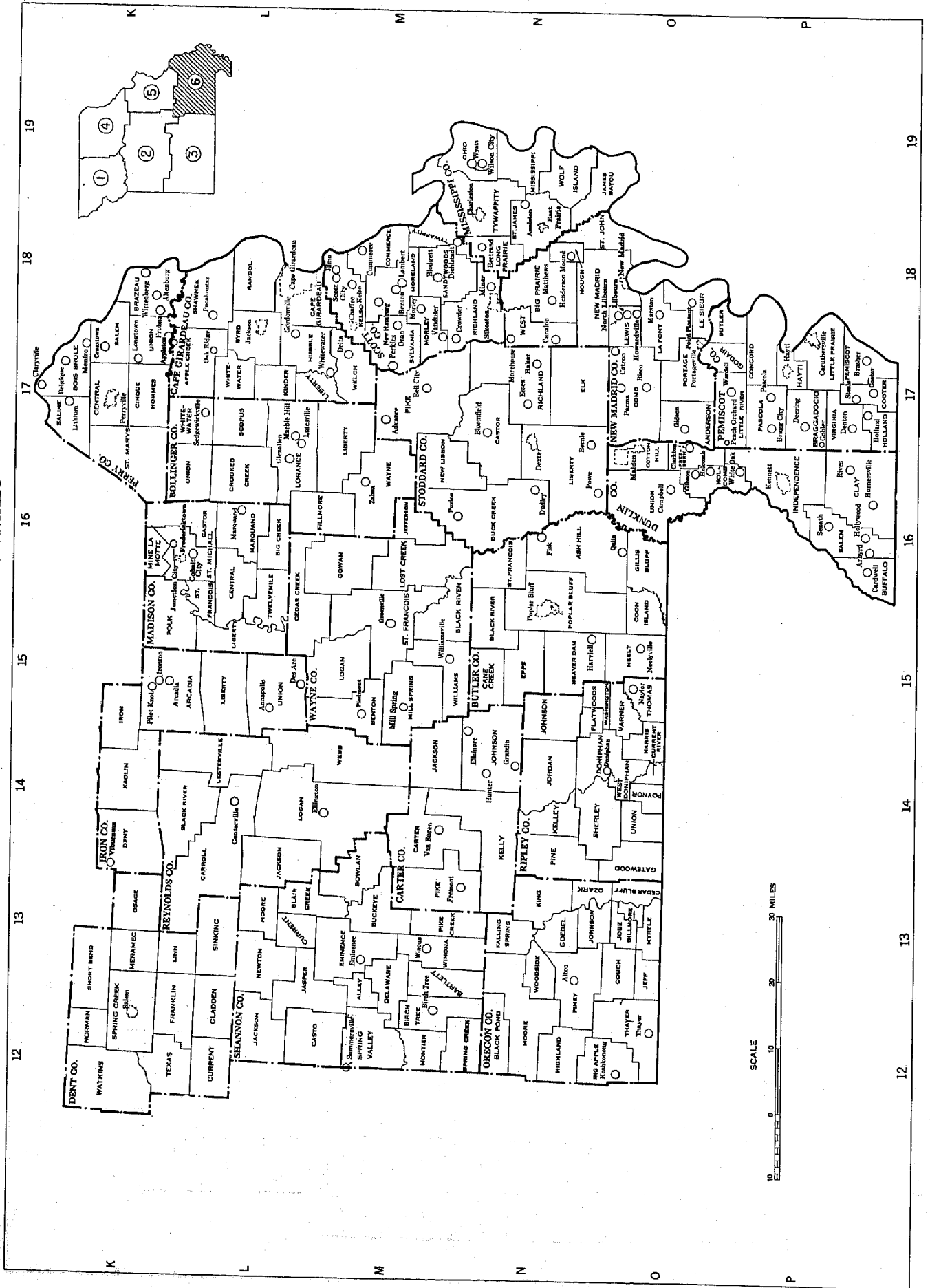

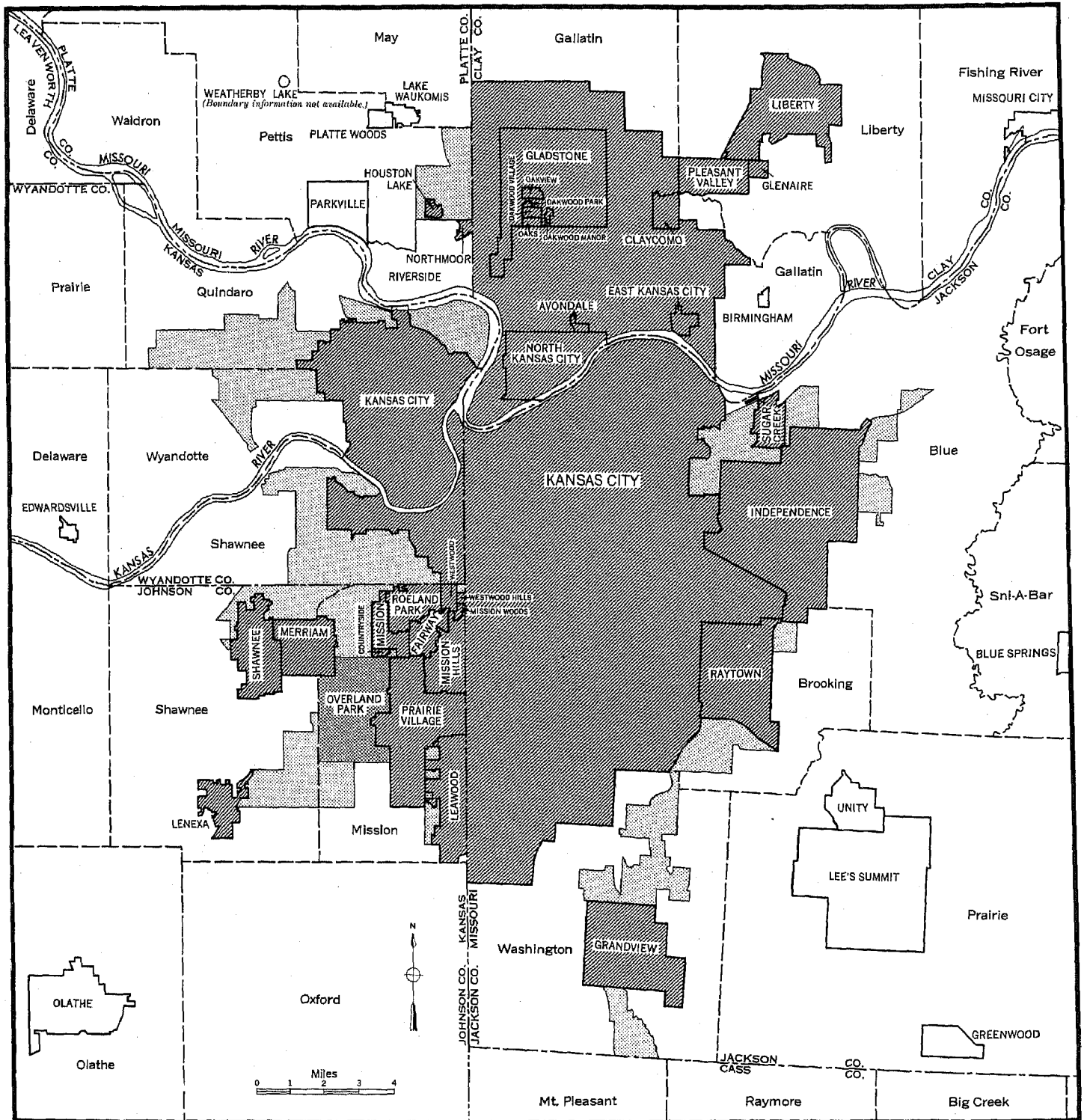
