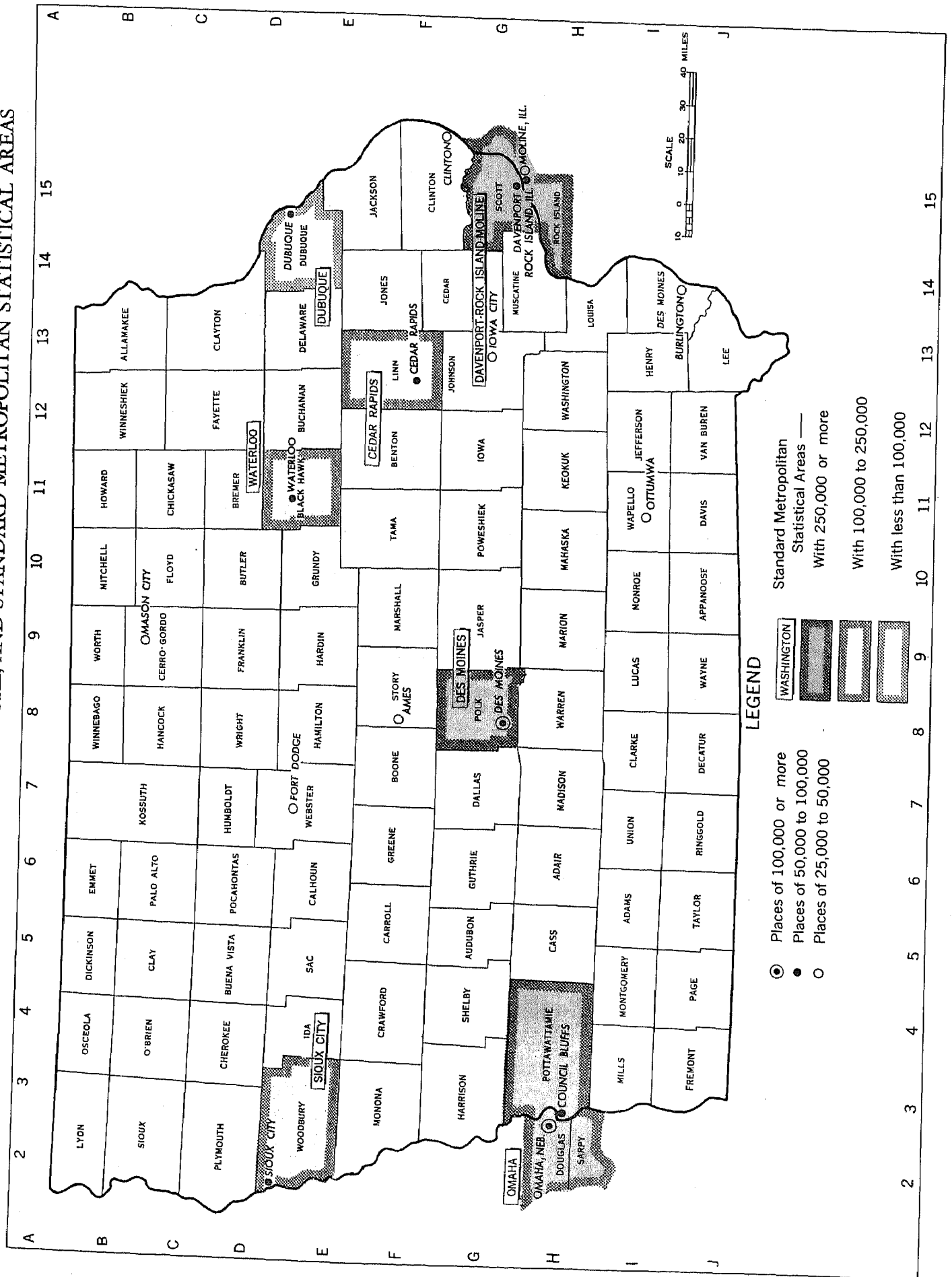

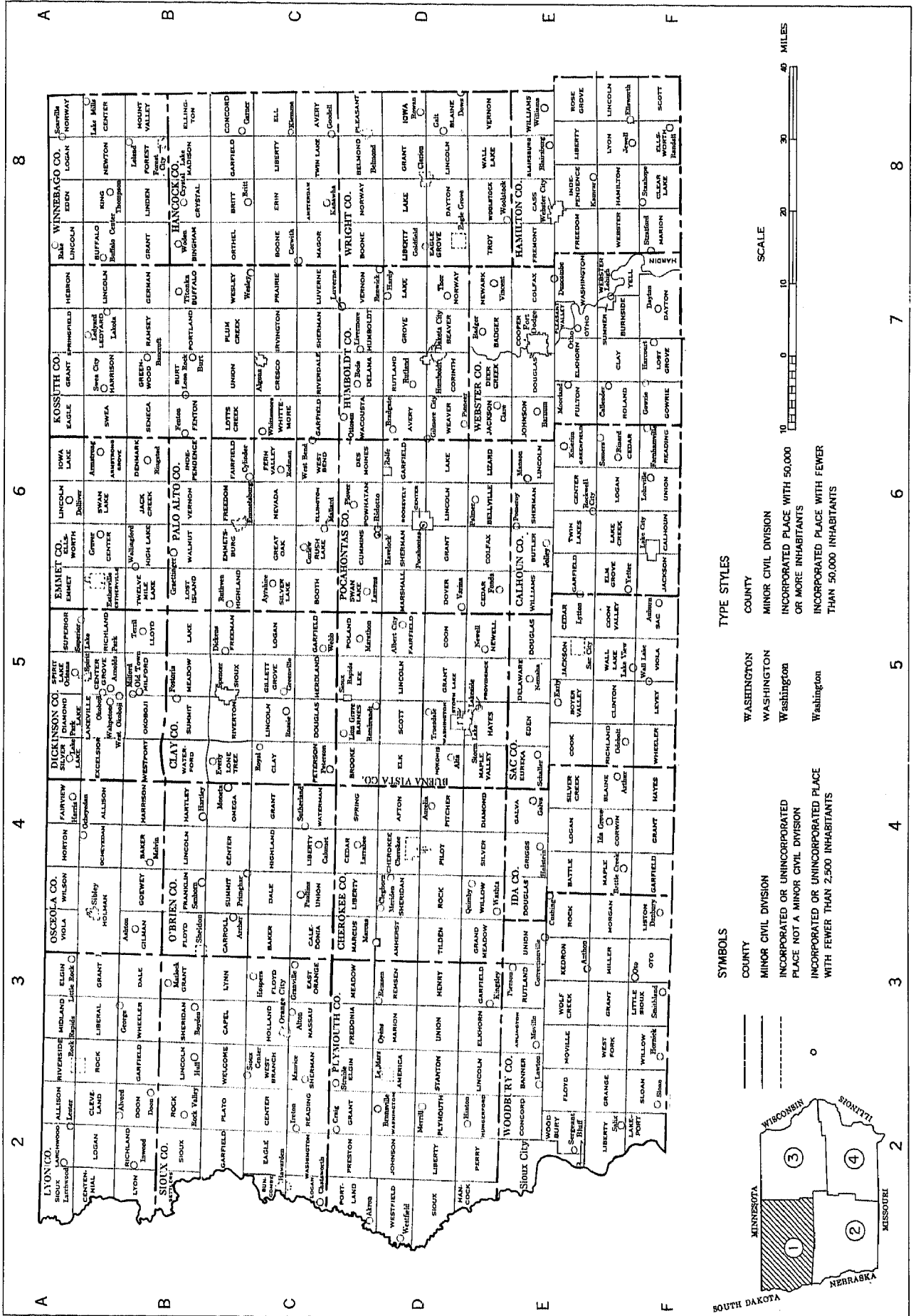

IOWA—COUNTIES, PLACES OF 25,000 OR MORE, AND STANDARD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREAS

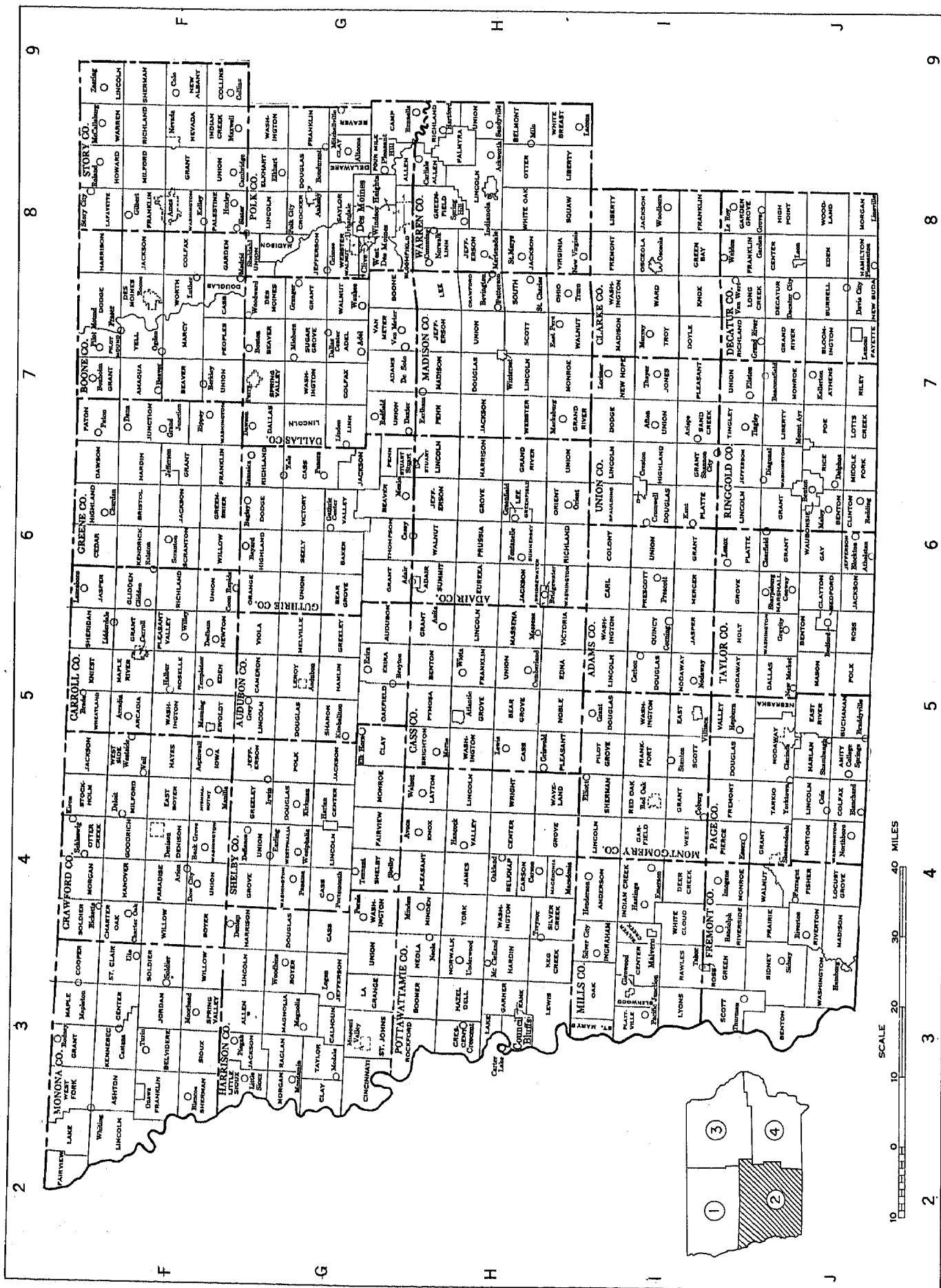


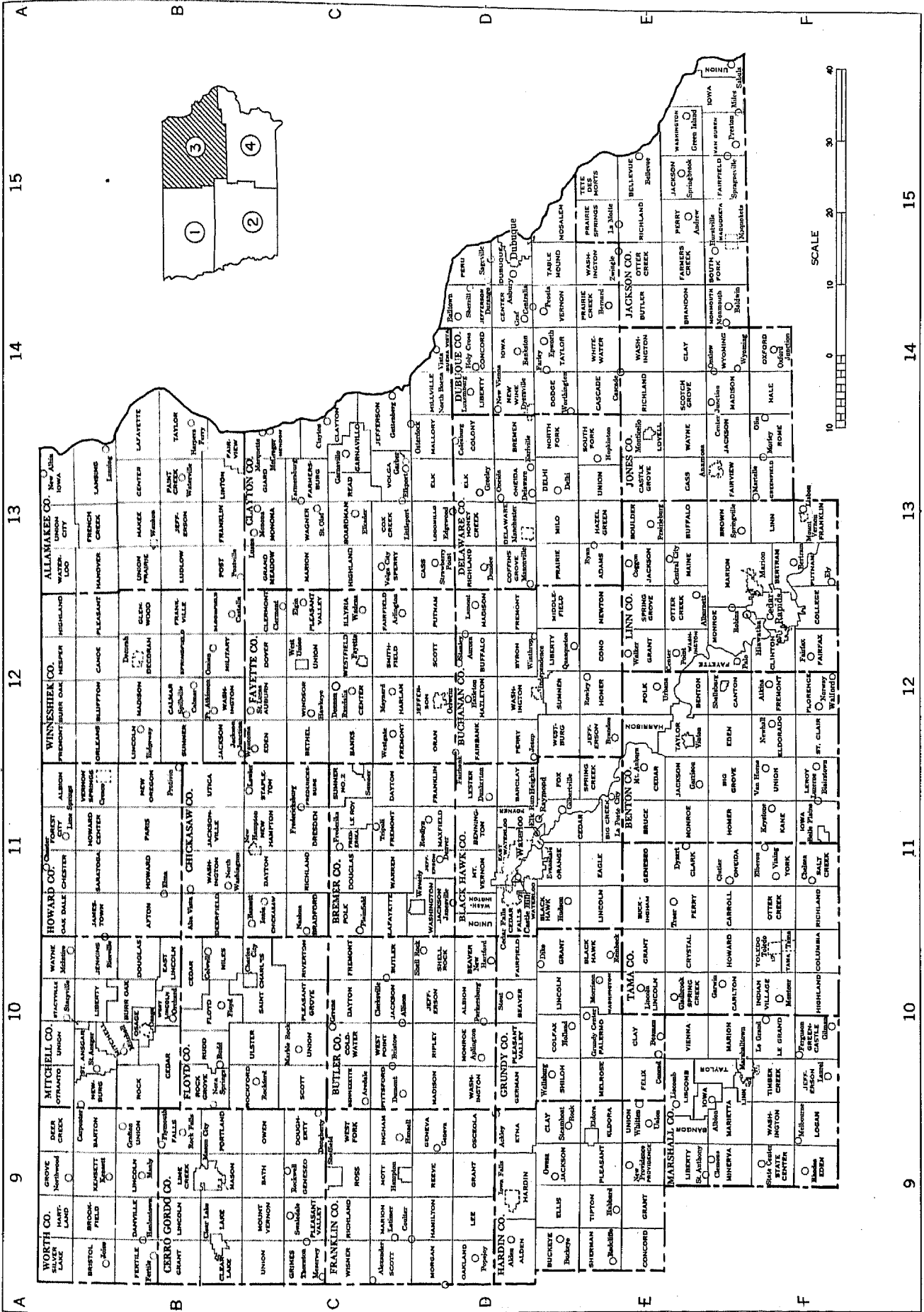
IOWA—SECTION 1

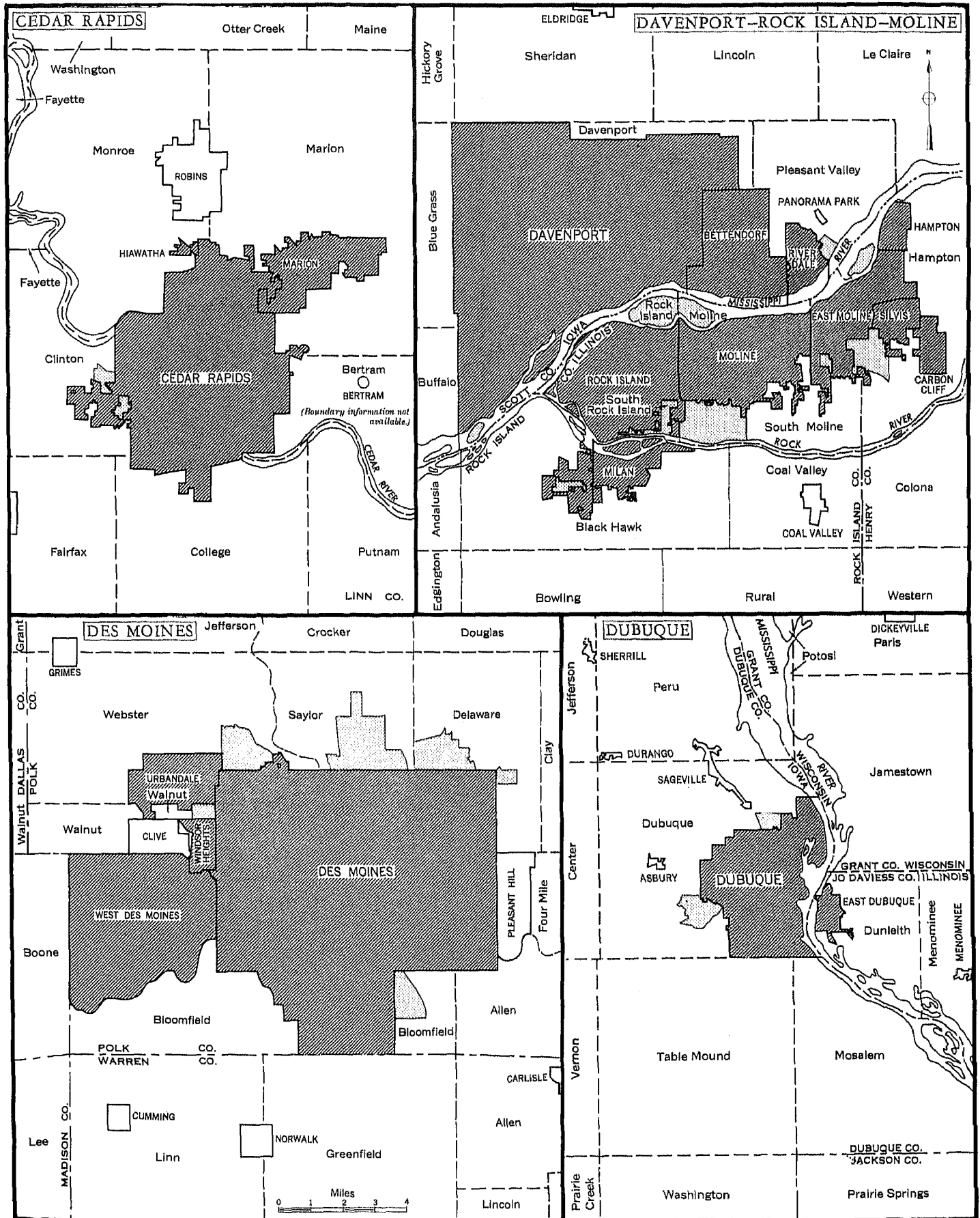

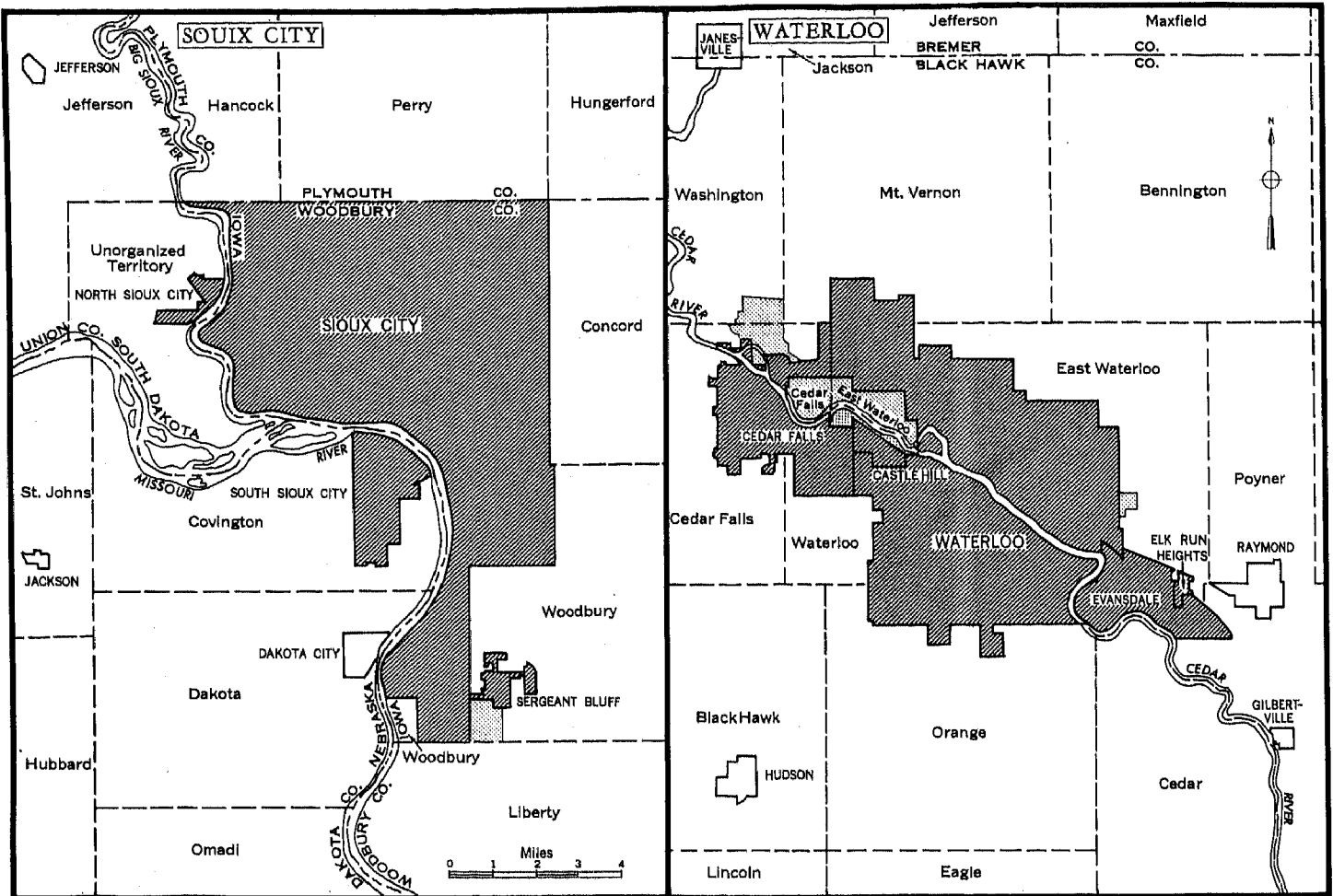

URBANIZED AREAS—IOWA






