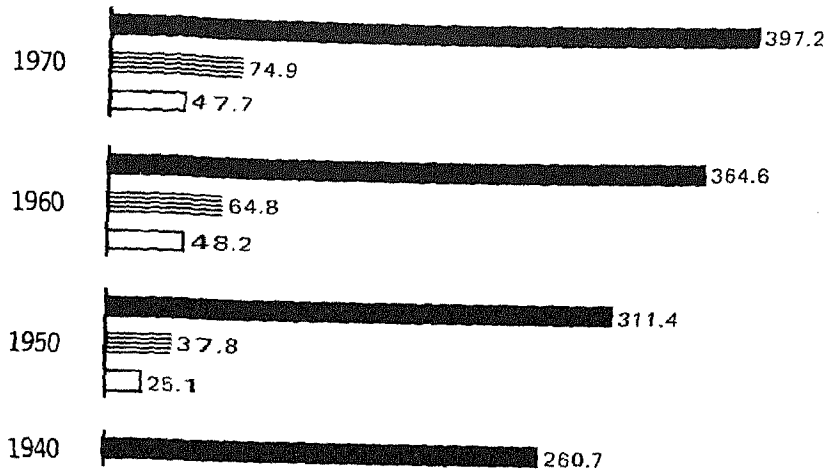

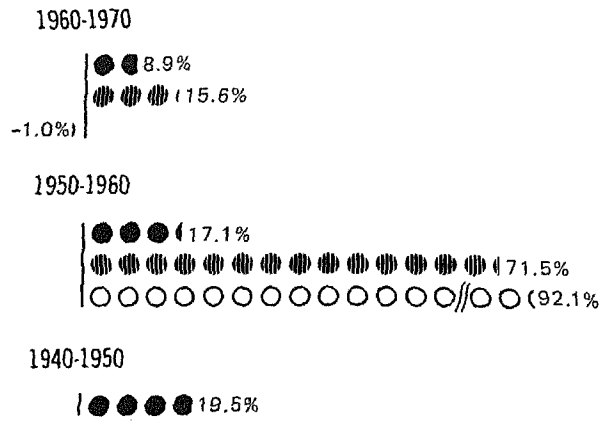

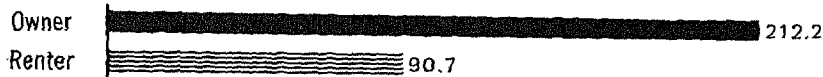

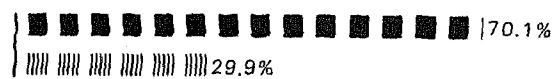

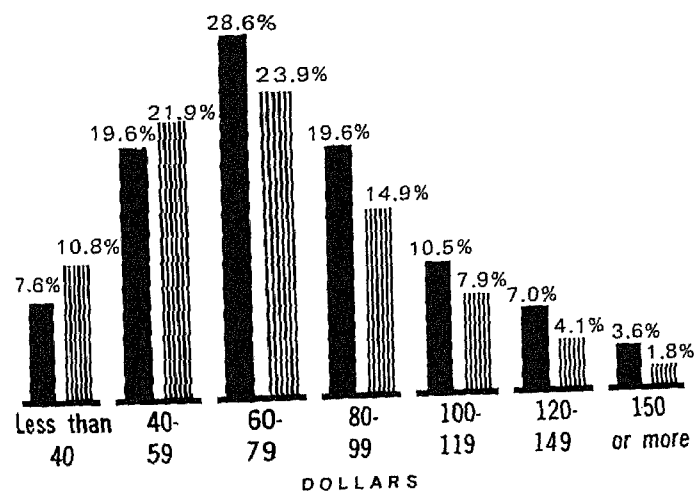

OWNER OCCUPIED ONE-FAMILY HOMES



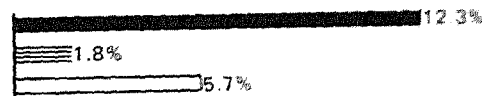
CONTRACT RENT: Percent Distribution

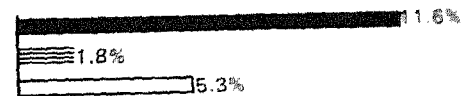

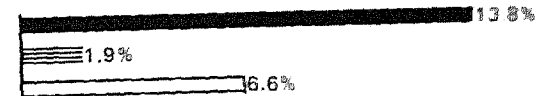

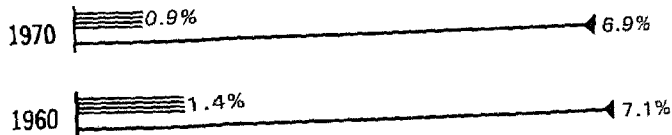
Vacant Housing Units: 1970 and 1960

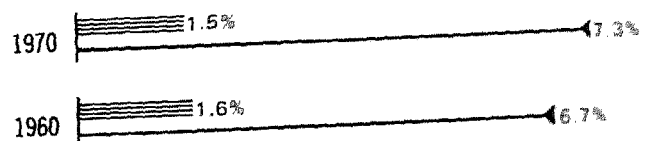

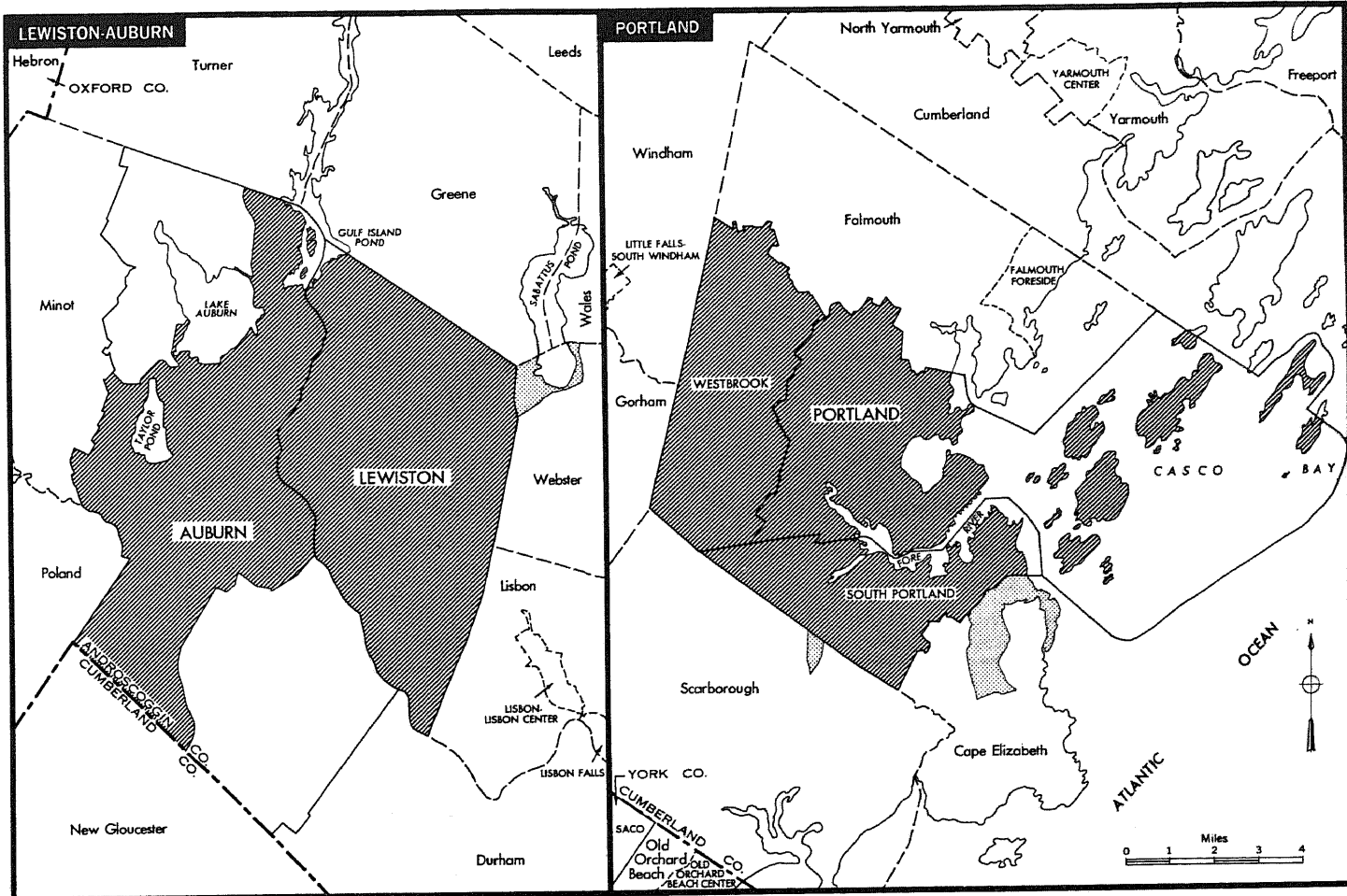
