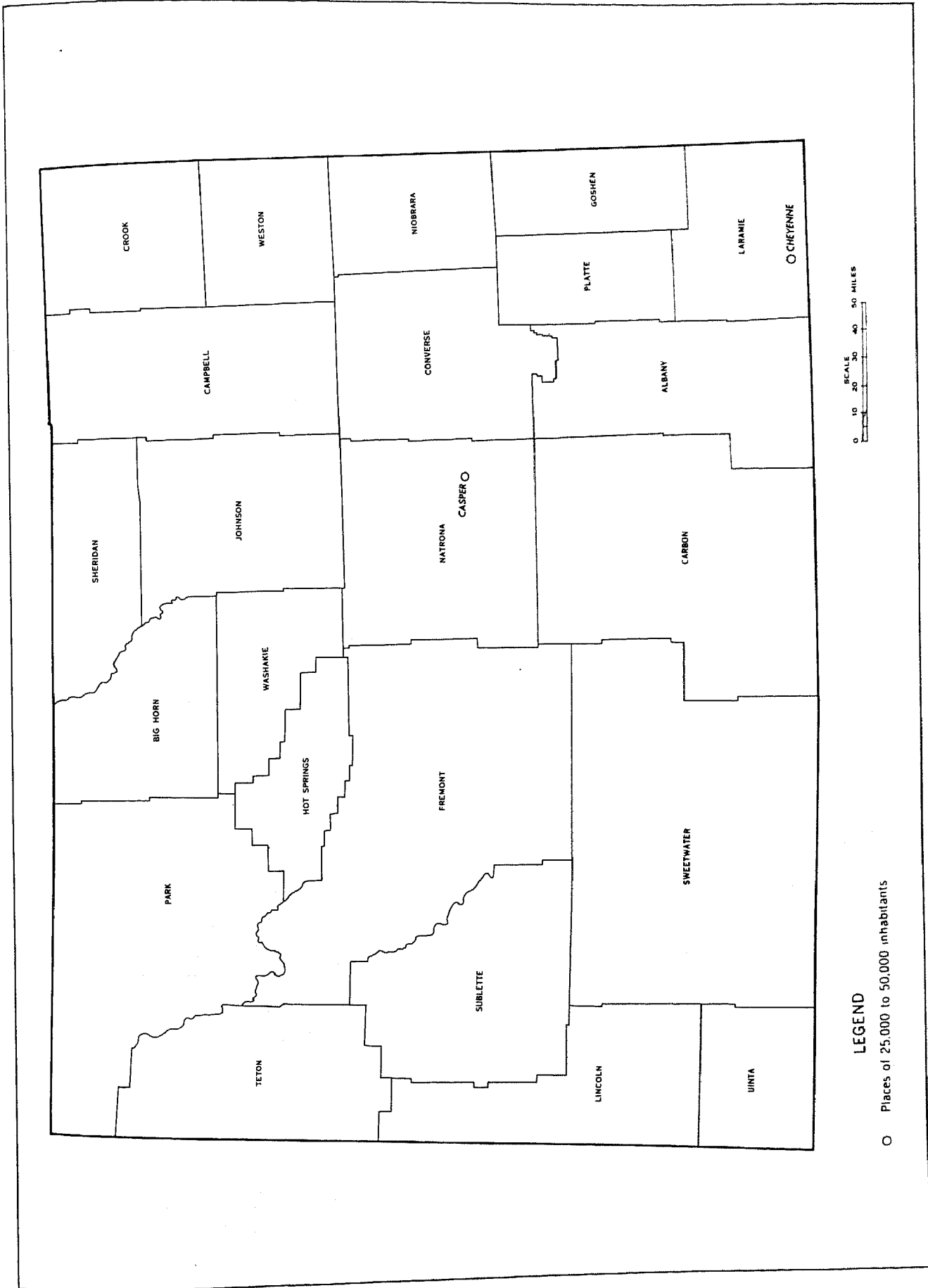

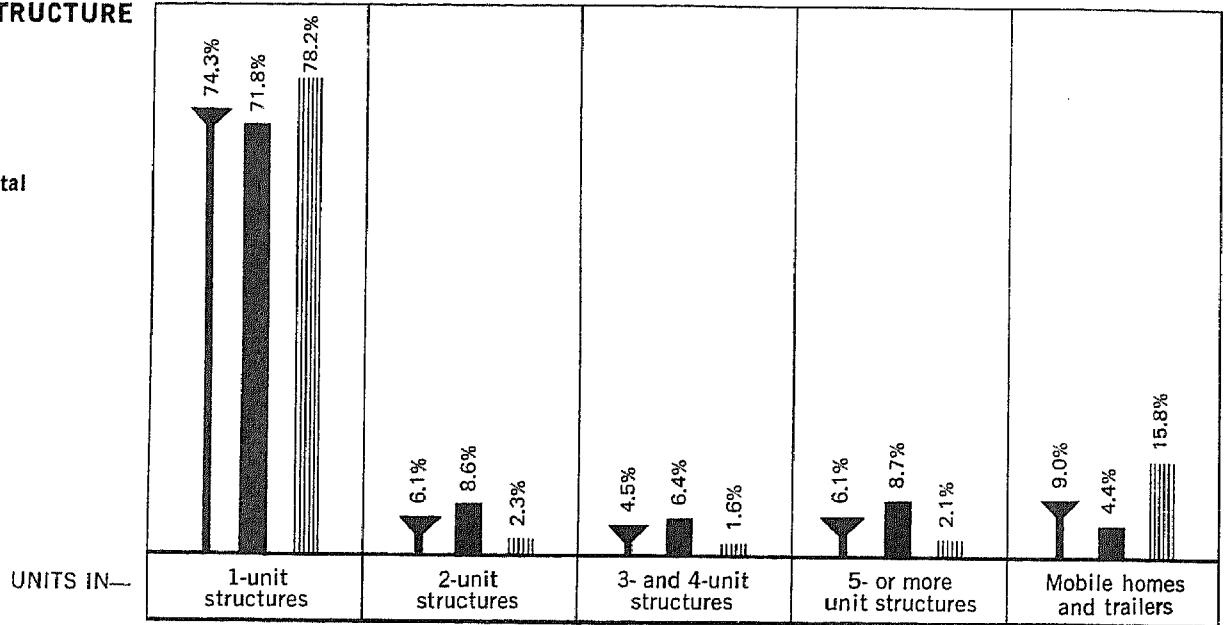

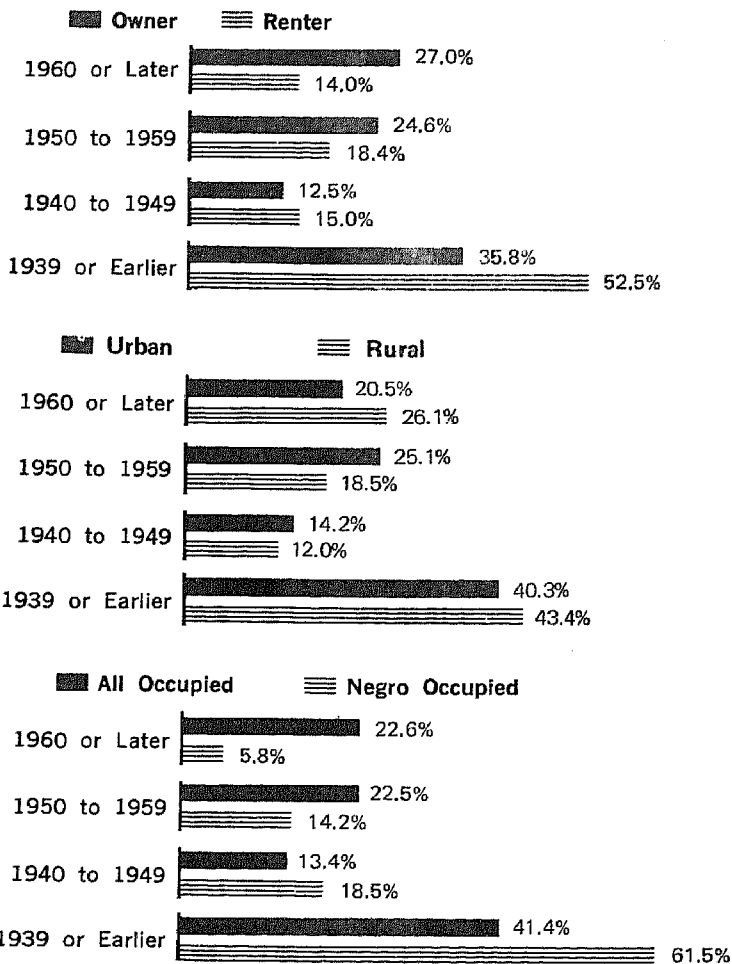

PERCENT DISTRIBUTION

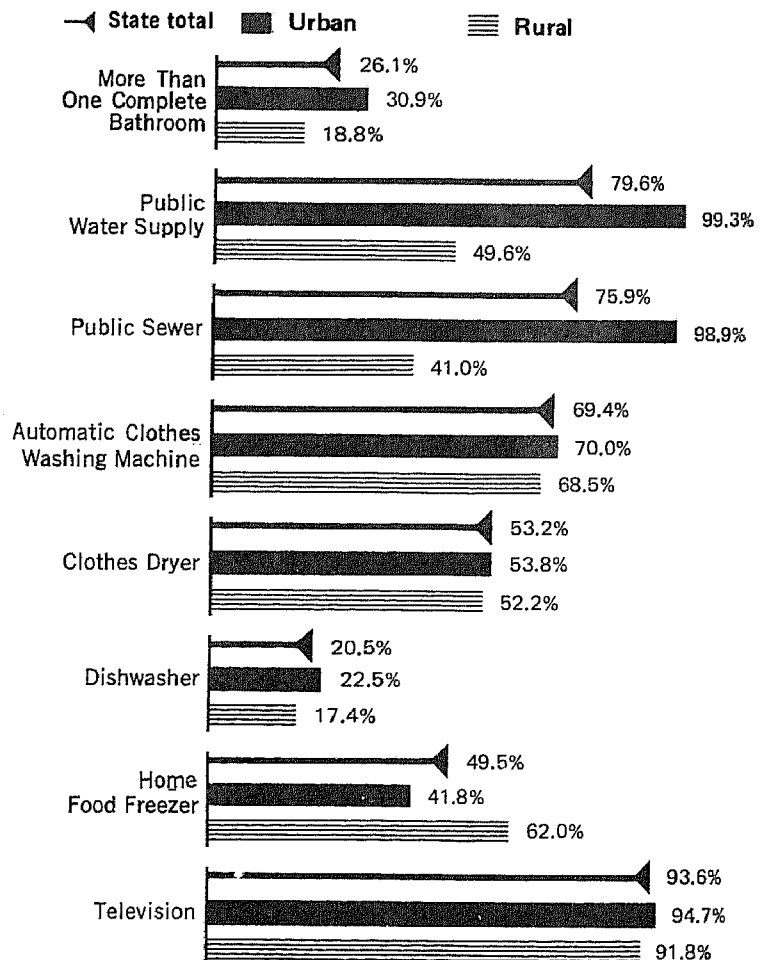
UNITS IN STRUCTURE

UNITS WITH SPECIFIED EQUIPMENT

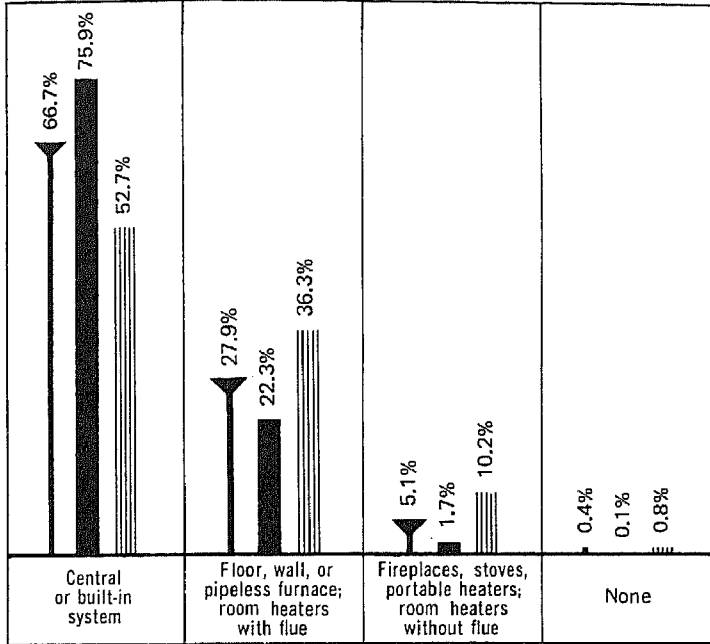

PERCENT DISTRIBUTION

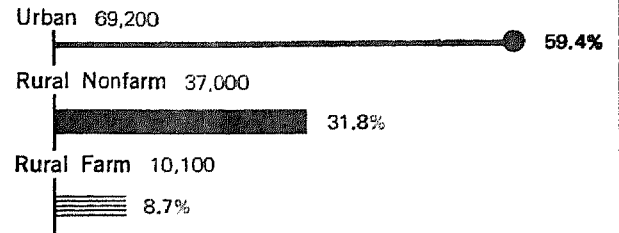
TYPE OF HEATING EQUIPMENT

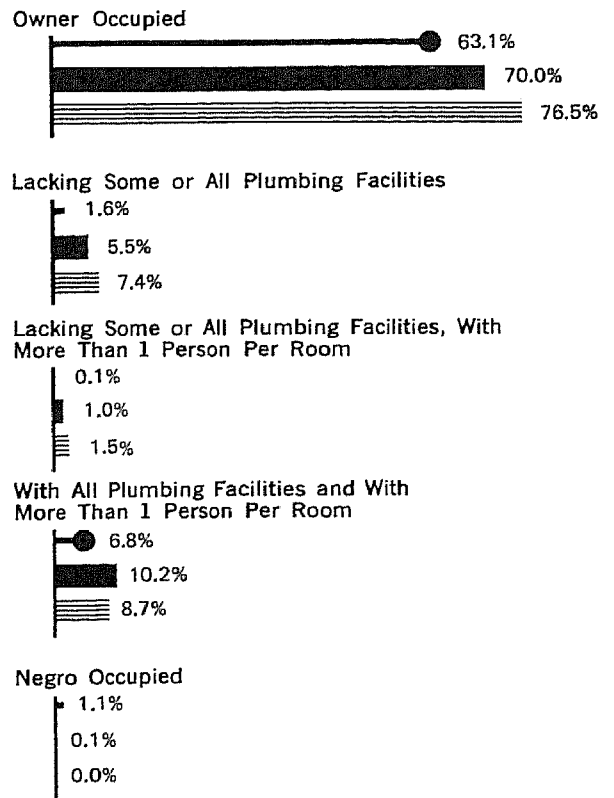


URBAN-RURAL RESIDENCE

NUMBER OF UNITS and PERCENT DISTRIBUTION

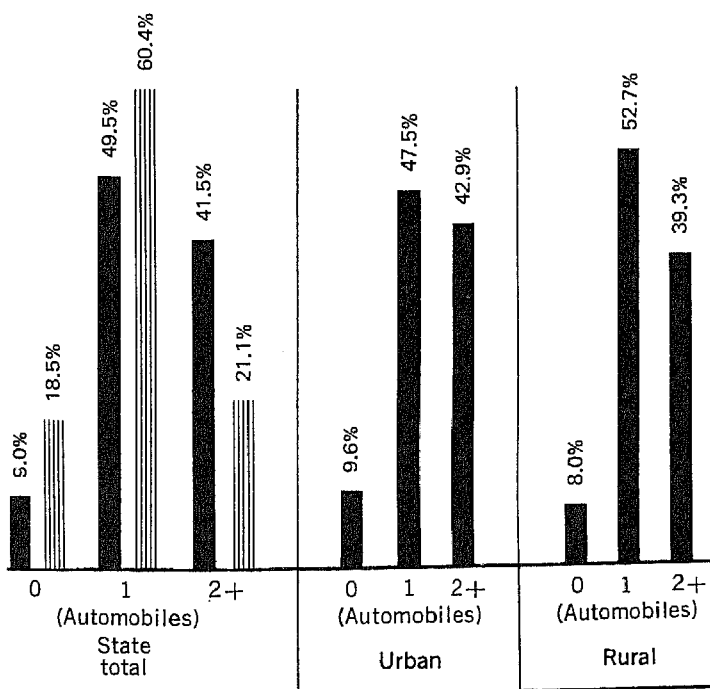


SELECTED CHARACTERISTICS Percent Distribution

CORRECTION NOTE

The tables in this chapter do not reflect corrections in the population and housing unit counts for certain areas as shown in the correction note on page 6, chapter A.

The classification by farm-nonfarm residence shown in chapter B is incorrect. The error consists of a misclassification between the farm-nonfarm components and is compensating between the two components. Therefore, data for the rural area as a whole are not affected; similarly not affected are data for urban areas and for the State as a whole. (Also not affected are the data for vacant housing units.) The table below provides corrected farm-nonfarm figures for the State and counties.
