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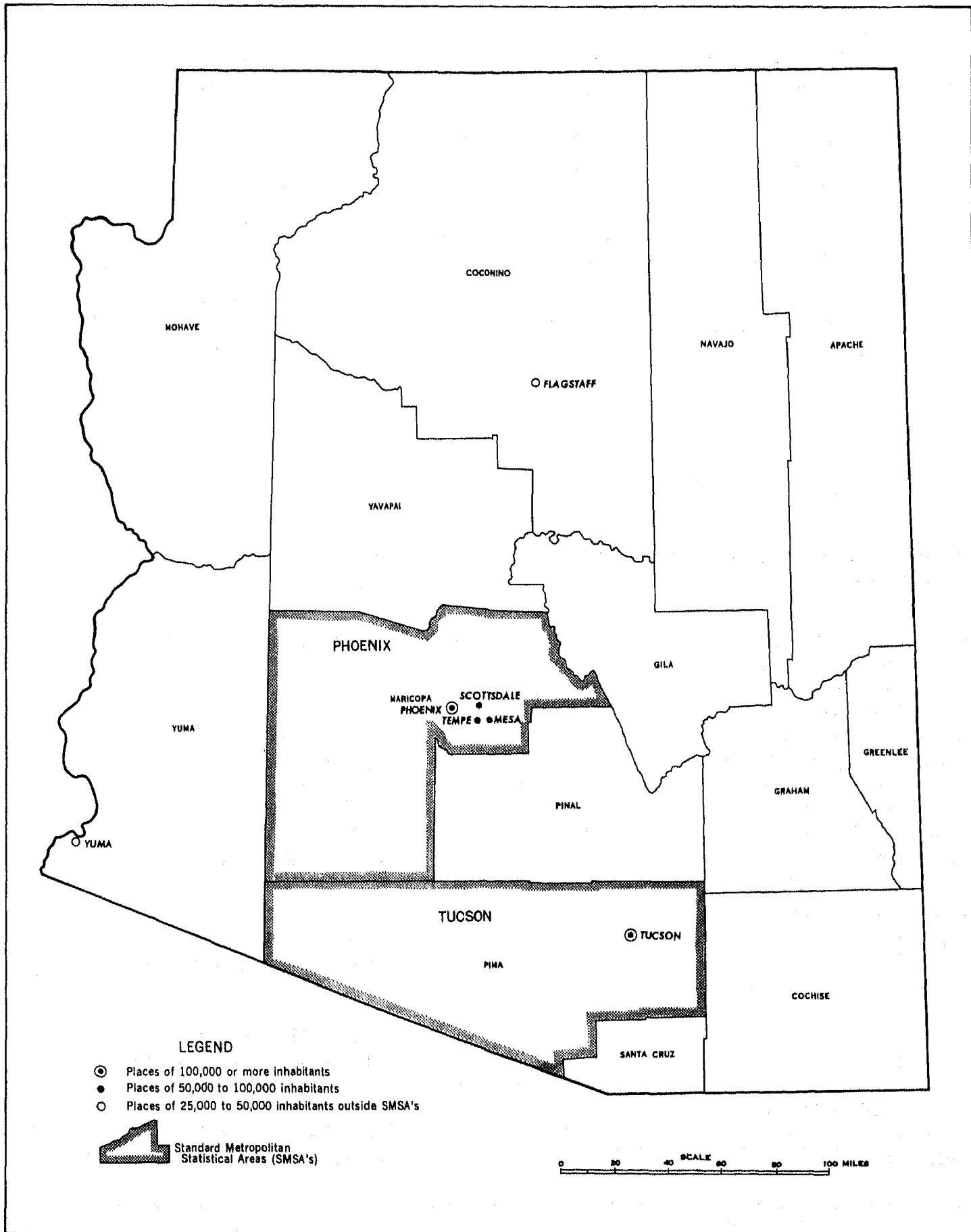

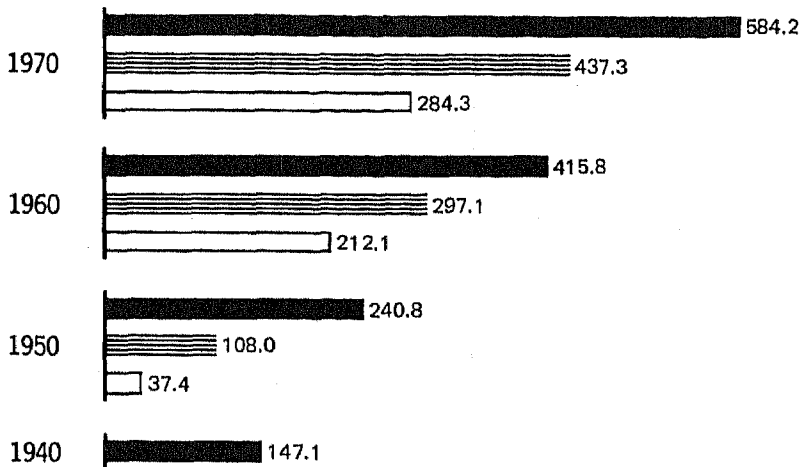

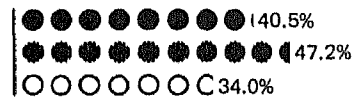

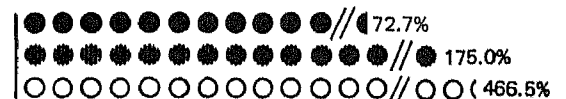

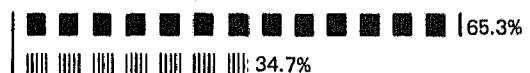

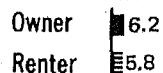

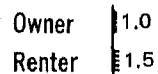

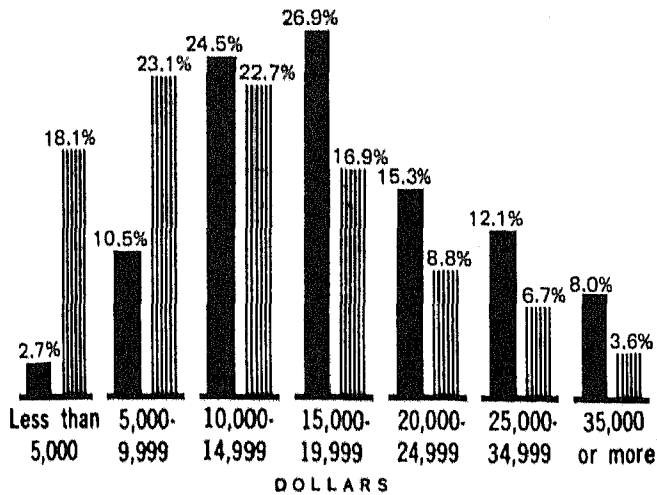

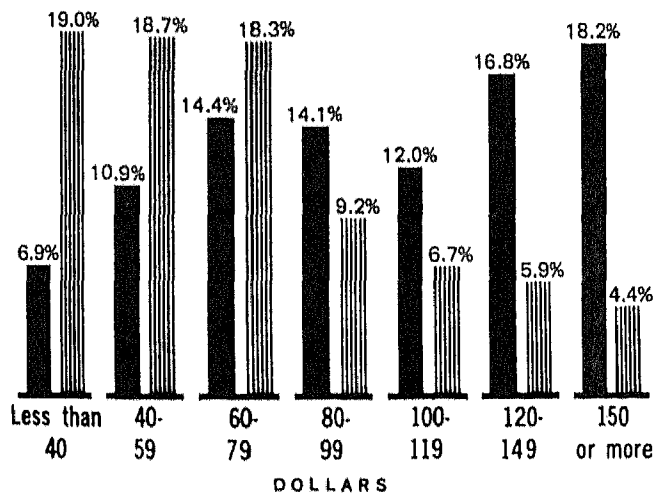

OWNER OCCUPIED ONE-FAMILY HOMES



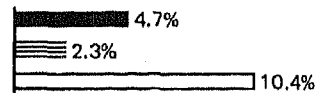
CONTRACT RENT: Percent Distribution

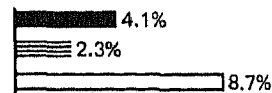
PLUMBING FACILITIES AND PERSONS PER ROOM: Percent

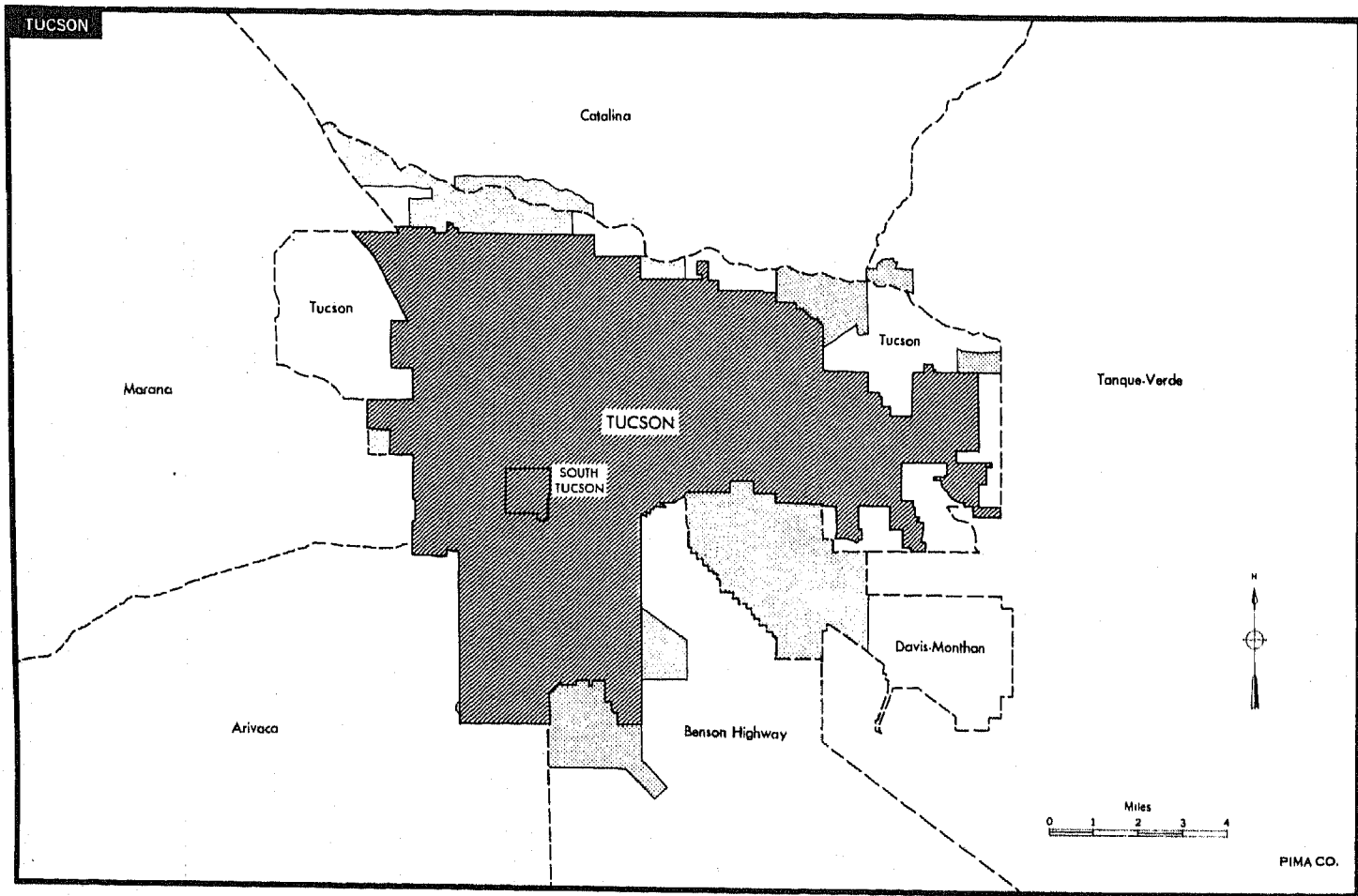
