## Population of Congressional Districts

This report presents 1970 census preliminary counts of the population of each Congressional District. The figures relate to the Congressional District boundaries used for election to the 91st Congress in November 1968. For the election of the 92nd Congress on November 3, 1970, six States (Arizona, Hawaii, Louisiana, Missouri, New Hampshire, and New York) will use a revised set of Congressional Districts; population figures for the new districts will be available in about 3 months.

The apportionment of Representatives among the several States for the 93rd Congress is determined by the final 1970 census counts. In January 1971, the President will transmit to the 92nd Congress the official 1970 census apportionment figures, to take effect with the election of the 93rd Congress in November 1972. On the basis of the 1970 census figures, most of the States with more than one Representative will redefine their Congressional Districts.

## PRELIMINARY REPORTS

### Population of Cities of 25,000 Inhabitants or More

This report presents 1970 preliminary population counts for all cities of 25,000 inhabitants or more in the United States. These figures were previously published in the individual State reports of the PC(P1) series. Also shown in the present report is the number of cities of 25,000 or more in each State classified by size category.

The preliminary figures presented here will be superseded by the final counts to be presented in Advance Report Series PC(V1). The advance reports, which will be published a State at a time, have already been issued for several States and all of them are scheduled for publication within the next 2 months. The final counts will differ from the preliminary figures mainly because certain categories of persons excluded here are added in the process of obtaining final counts.

## **Population of Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas**

This report presents a summary of the 1970 preliminary population counts for the 233 standard metropolitan statistical areas currently recognized by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget. These figures were previously published in the individual SMSA reports of the PC(P2) series. Shown in this report is the population total for each SMSA, subdivided by inside and outside the central city or cities, and by constituent counties (and minor civil divisions in the New England States). Also shown are the population totals for the two recognized standard consolidated areas: New York, N.Y.-Northeastern New Jersey and Chicago, Ill.-Northwestern Indiana.

The preliminary figures presented here will be superseded by the final counts to be presented in Advance Report Series PC(V1) and PC(V2). These two series of advance reports, which will be published a State at a time, have already been issued for several States and all of them are scheduled for publication within the next 2 months. The final counts will differ from the preliminary figures mainly because certain categories of persons excluded here are added in the process of obtaining final counts.
