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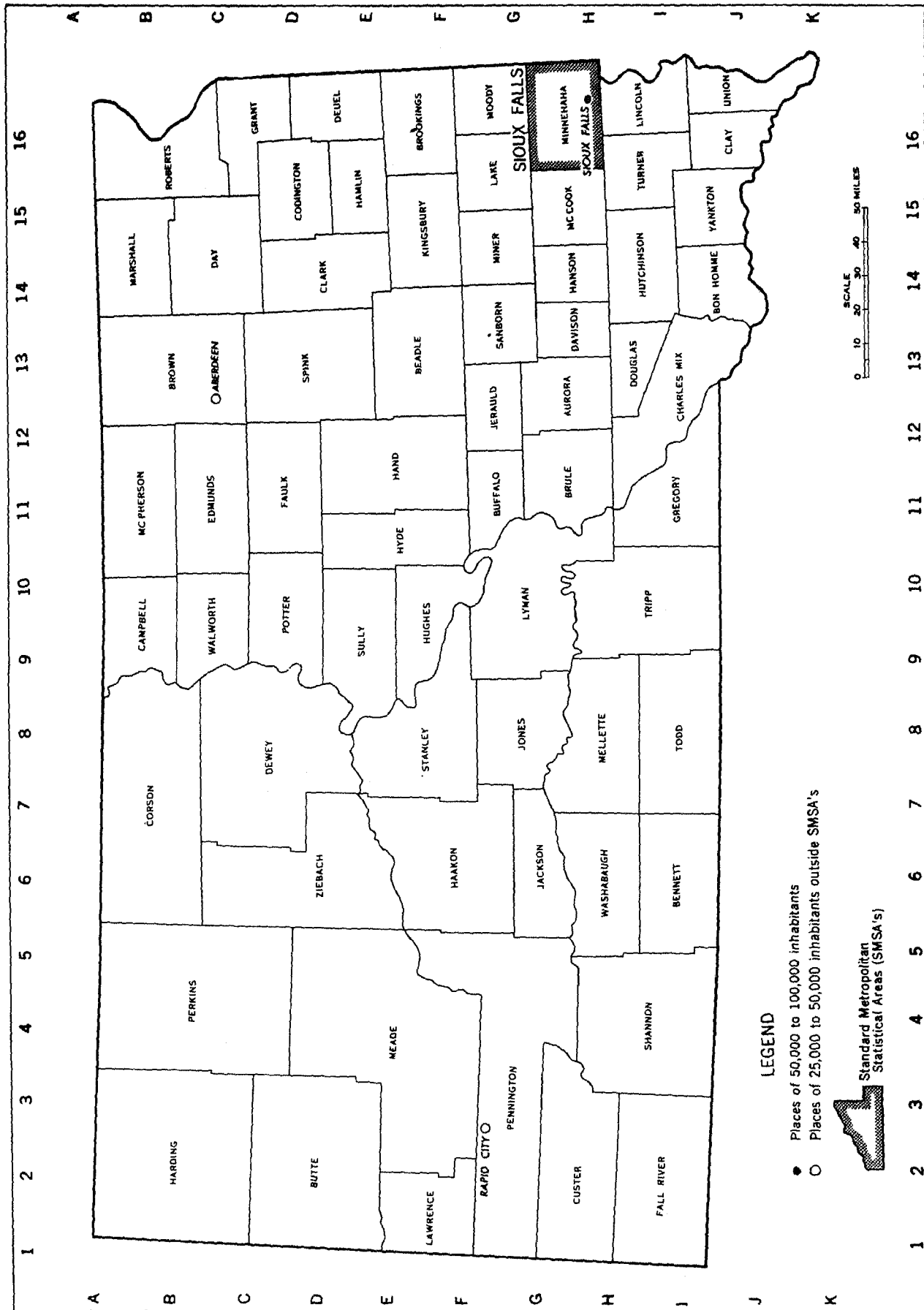

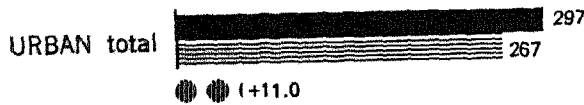

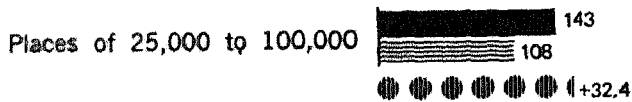

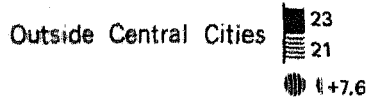
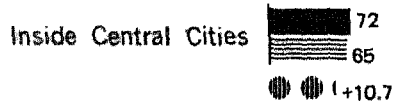
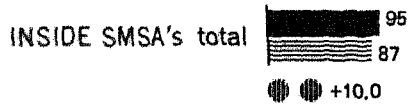


Places of 100,000 or more (NONE)



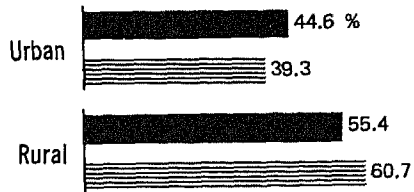
METROPOLITAN and NONMETROPOLITAN RESIDENCE

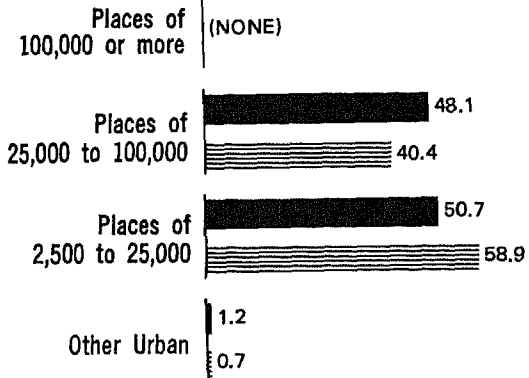


**Percent Distribution

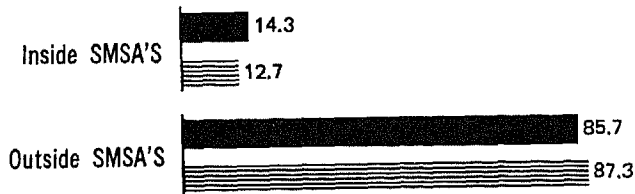

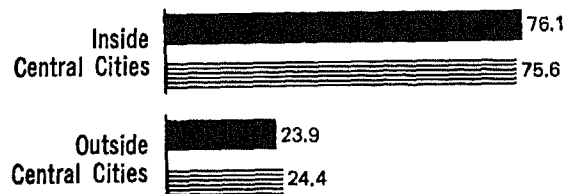

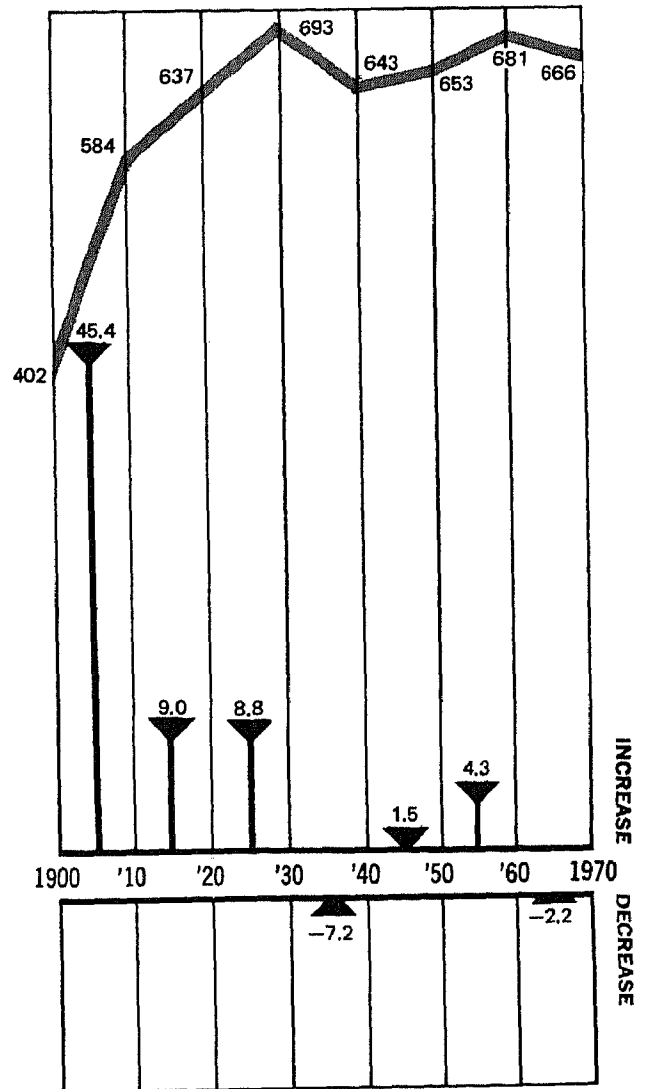

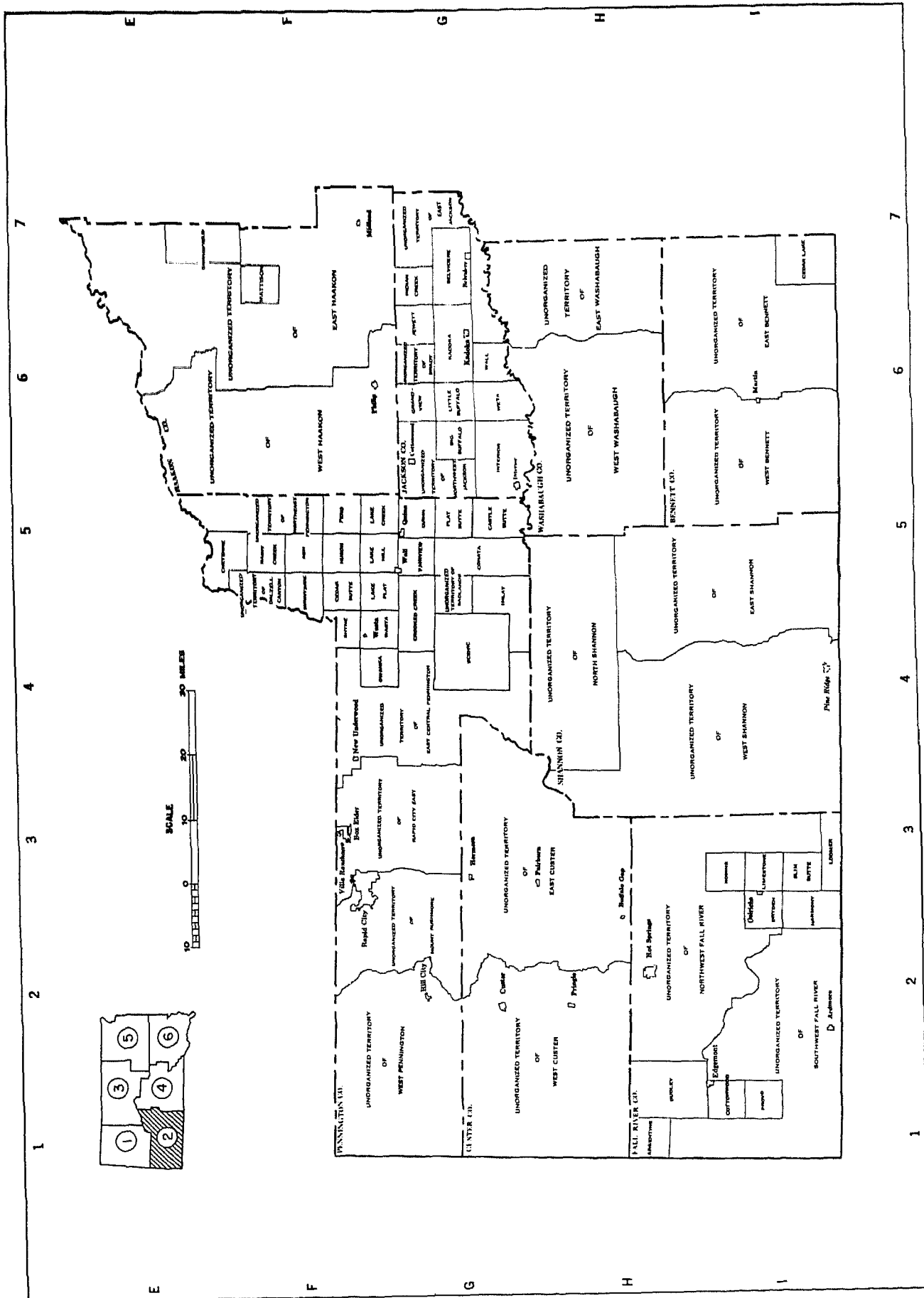

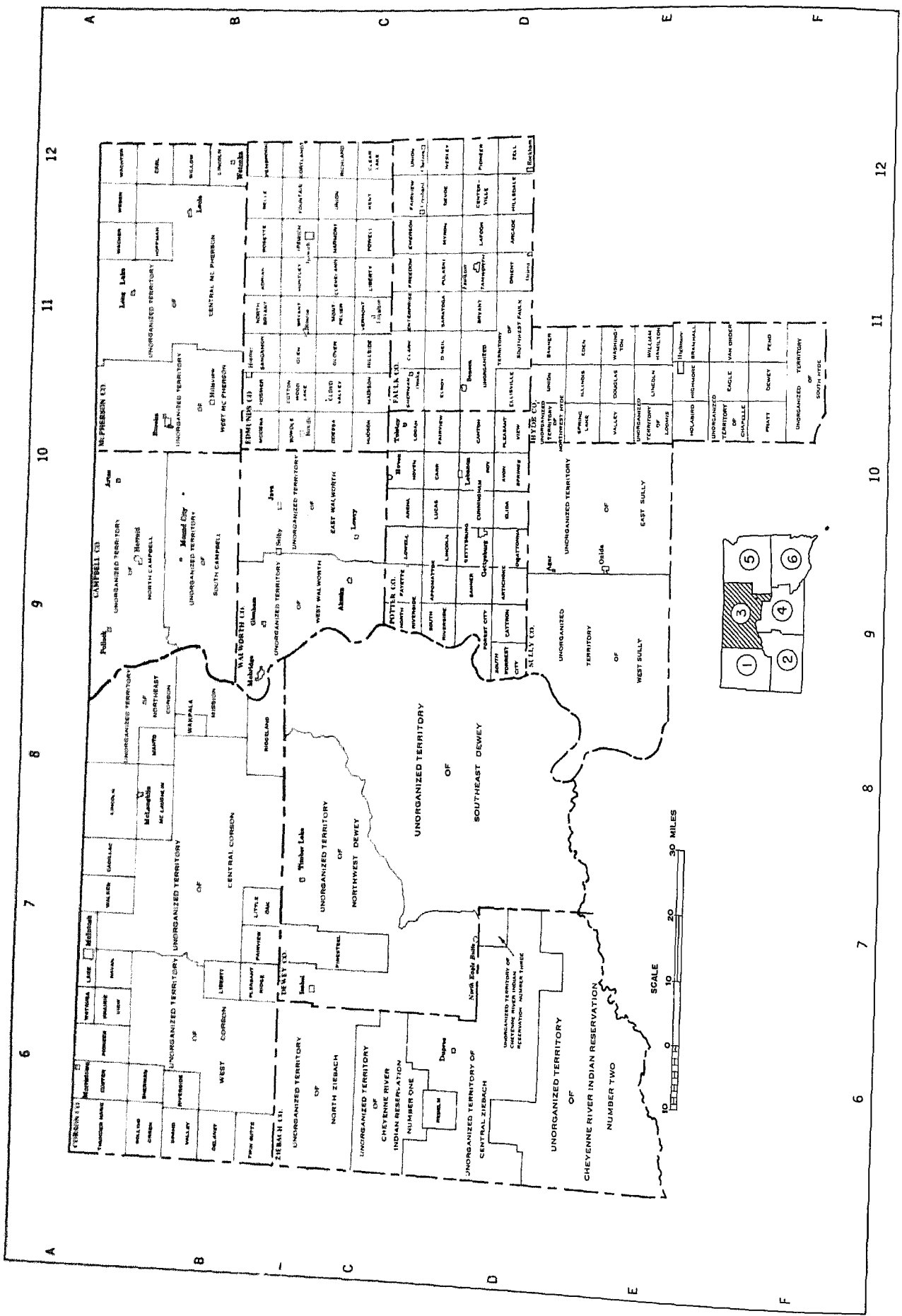

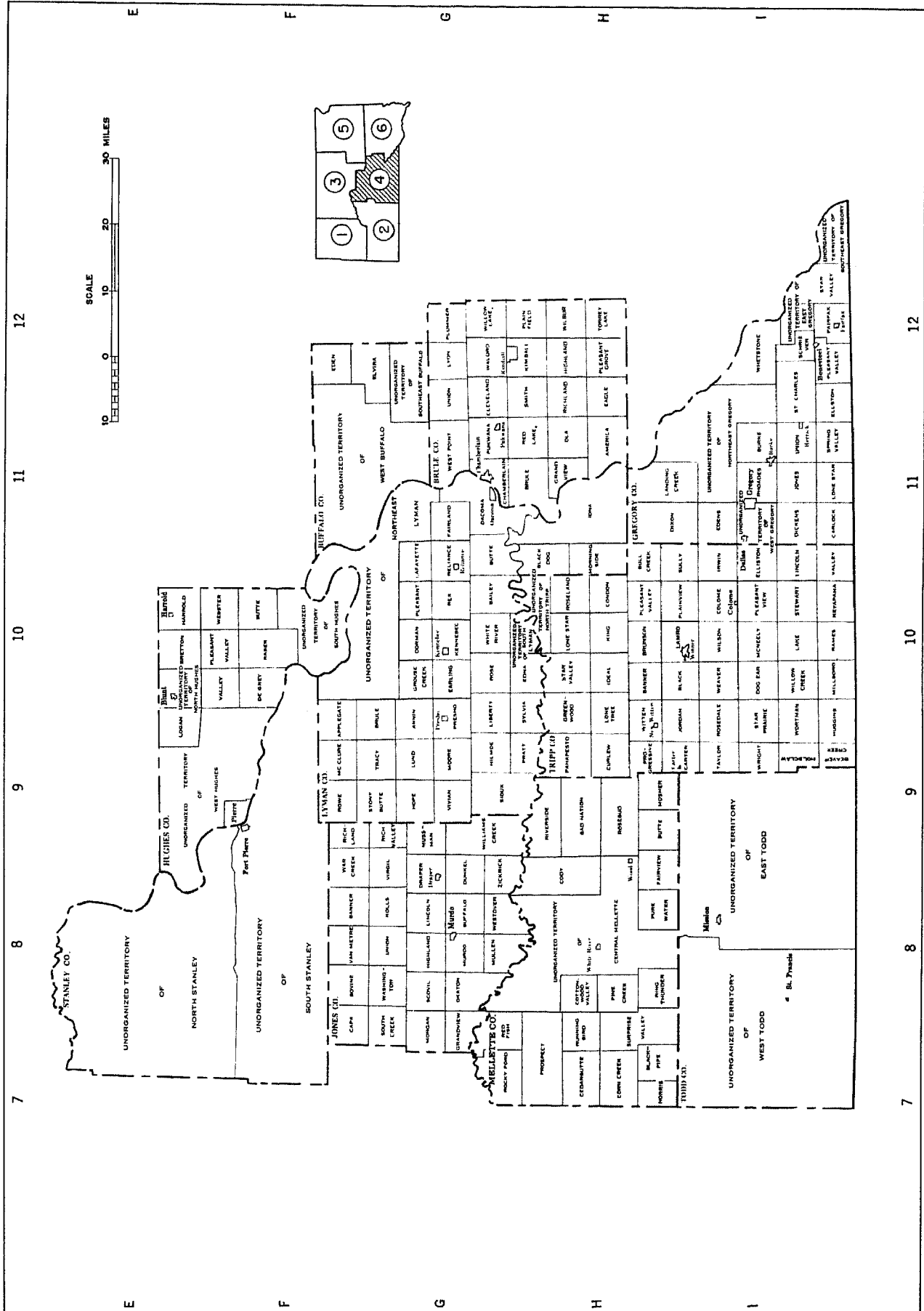

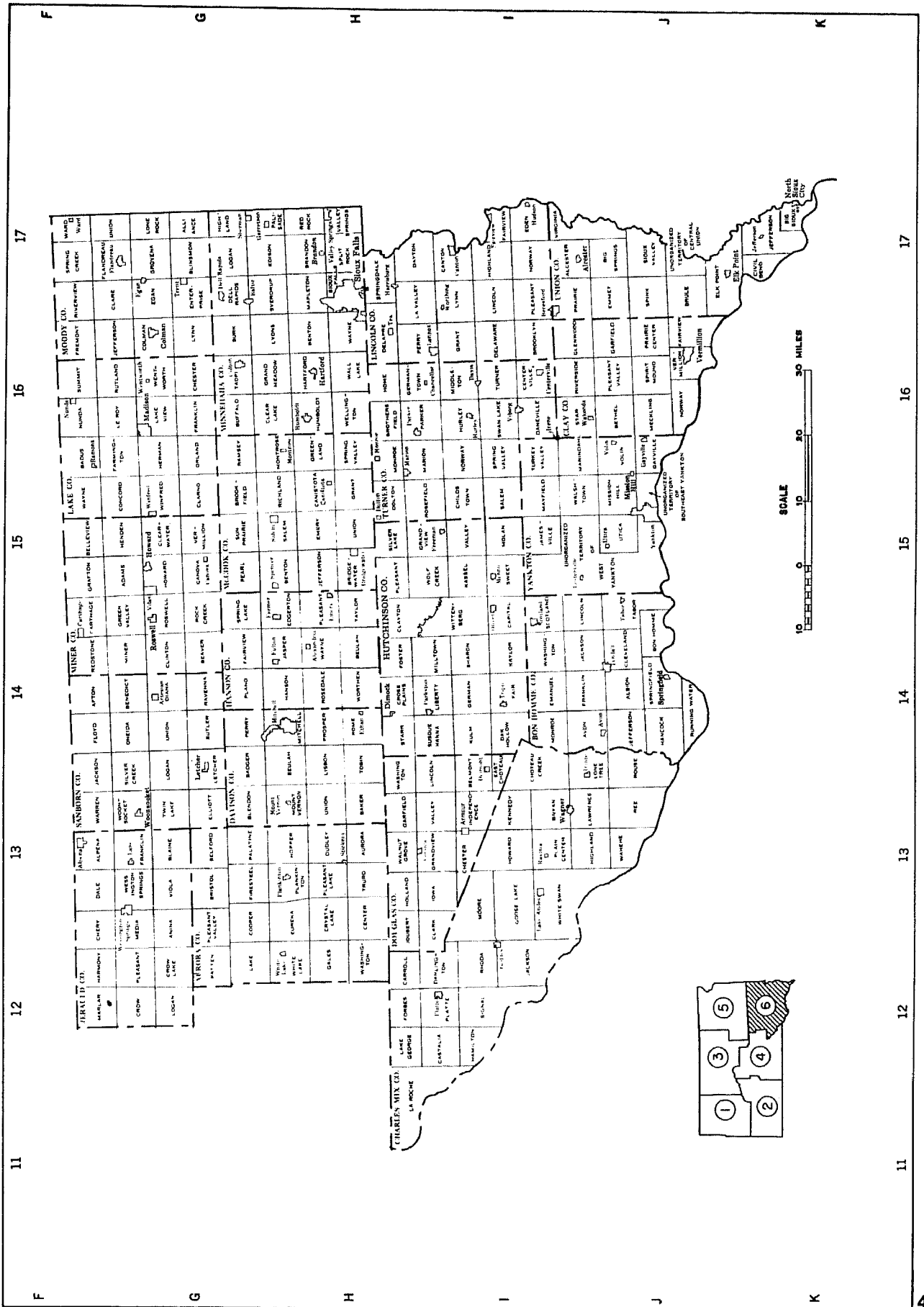
