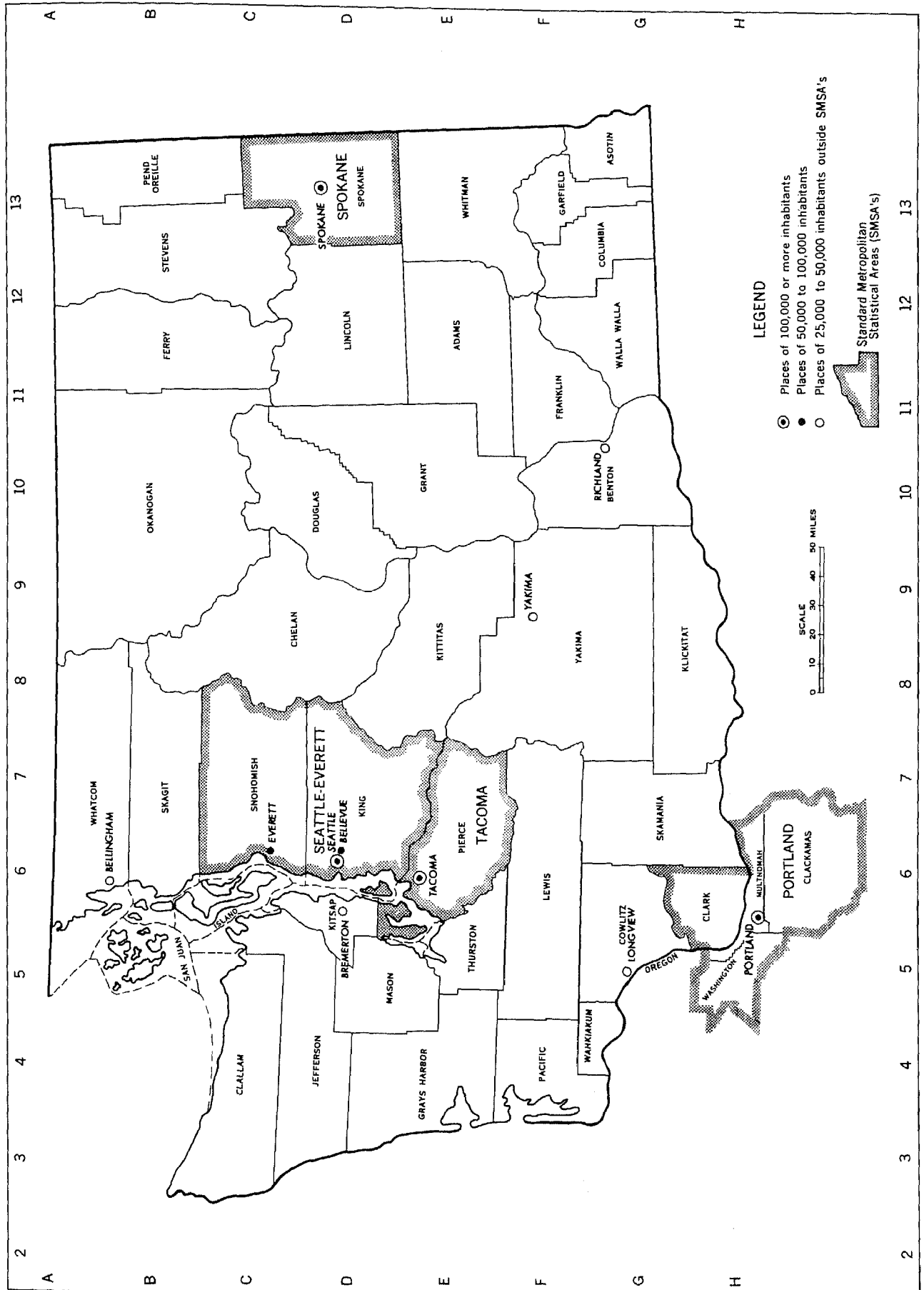

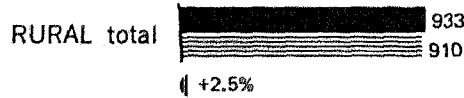
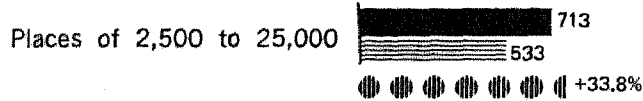

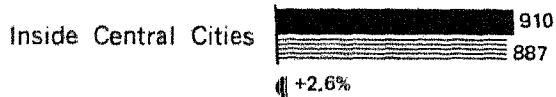
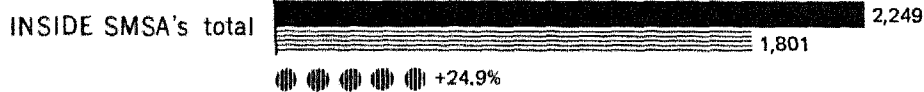


URBAN and RURAL RESIDENCE



METROPOLITAN and NONMETROPOLITAN RESIDENCE

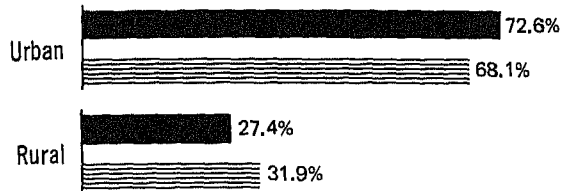

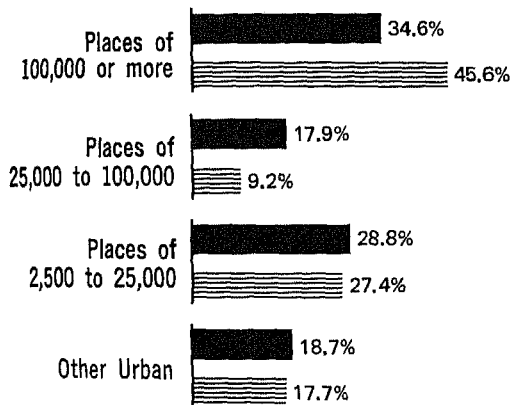
Percent Distribution by Place of Residence

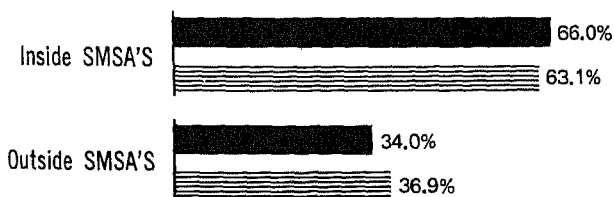

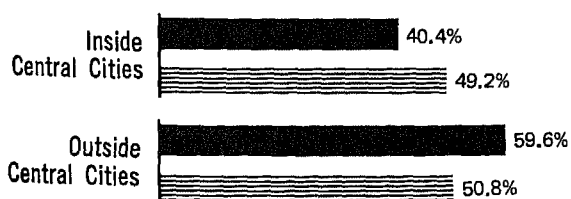

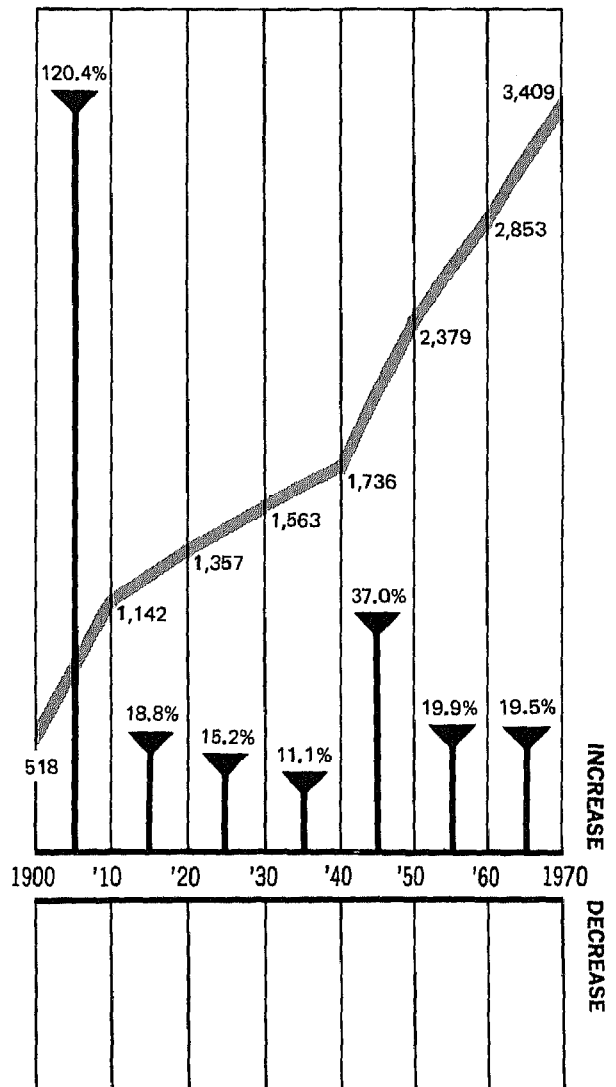

County Subdivisions/Census County Divisions and Places



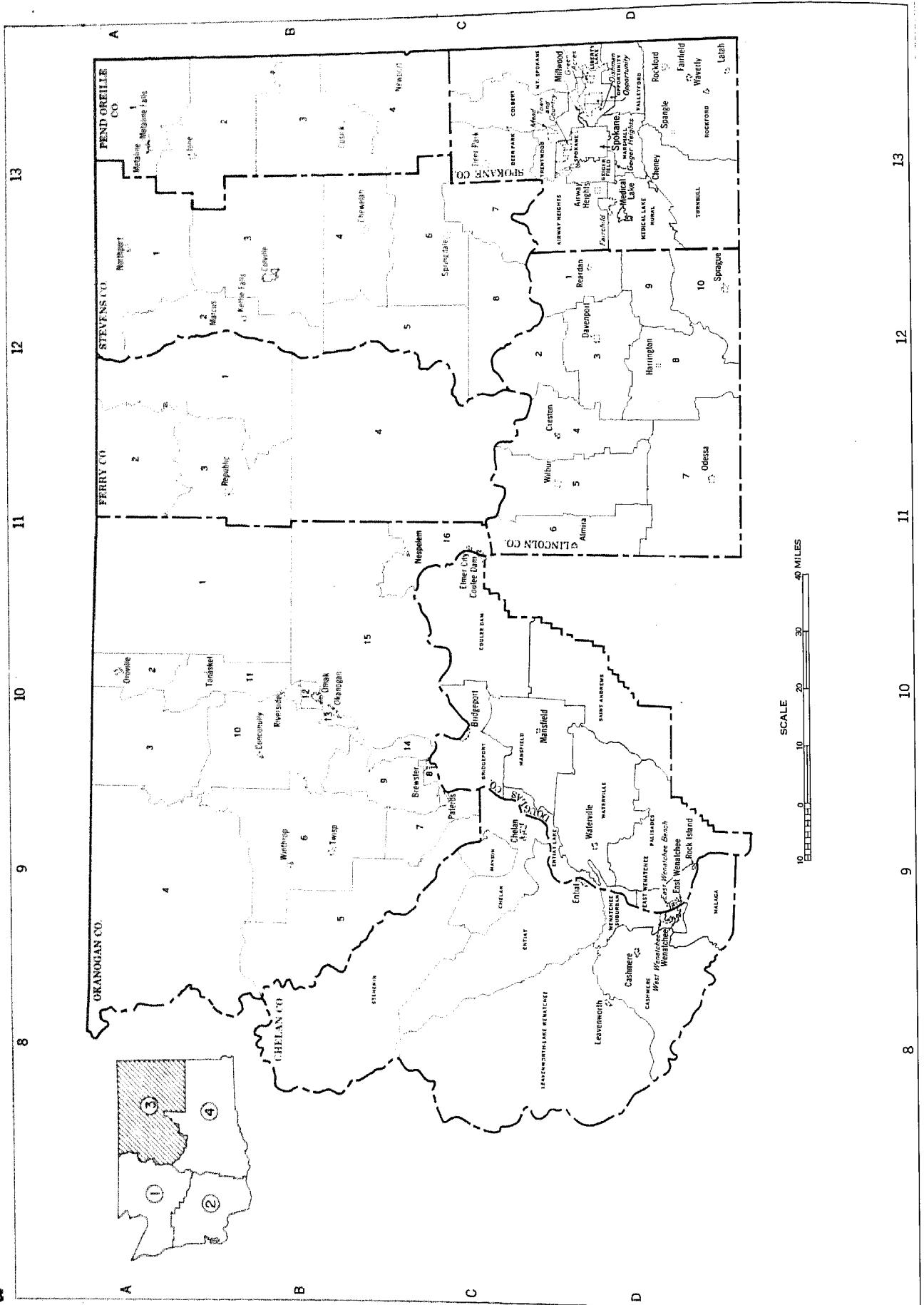

County Subdivisions/Census County Divisions and Places

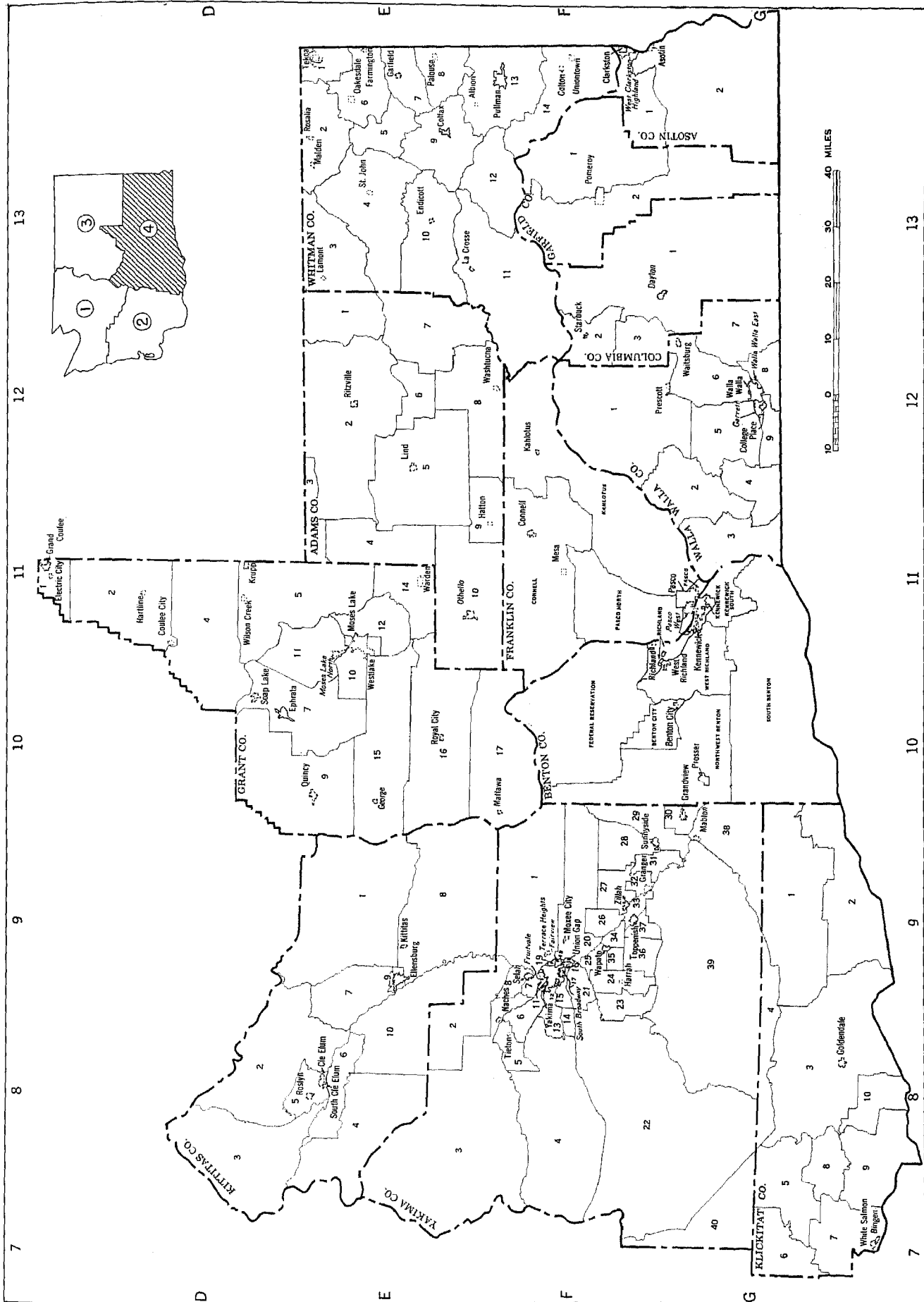
