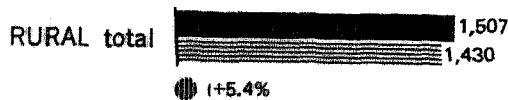

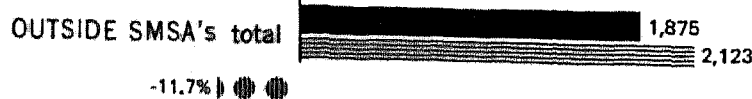
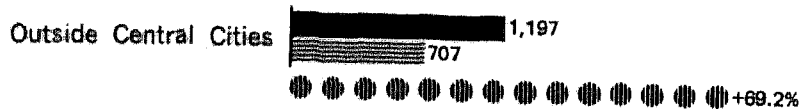


URBAN and RURAL RESIDENCE



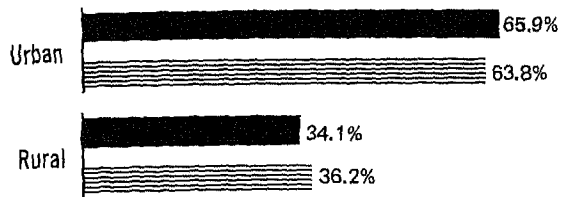
METROPOLITAN and NONMETROPOLITAN RESIDENCE

(SMSA's=Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas)

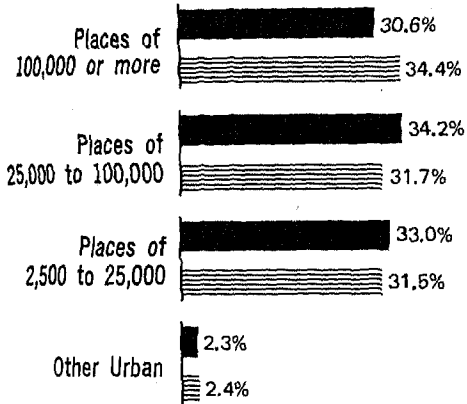


**Percent Distribution

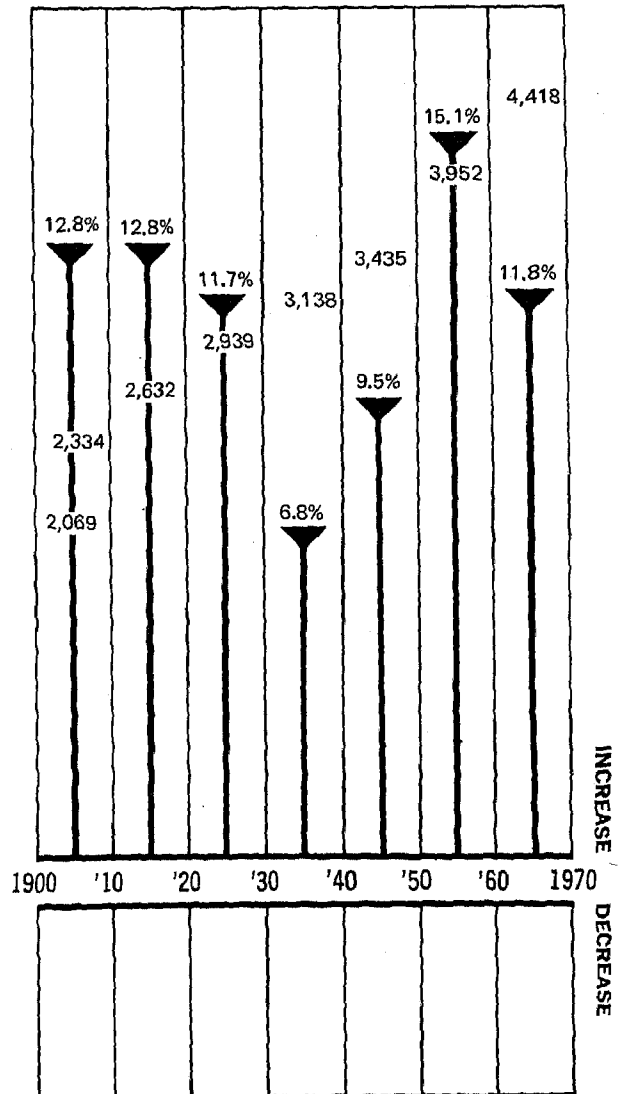
