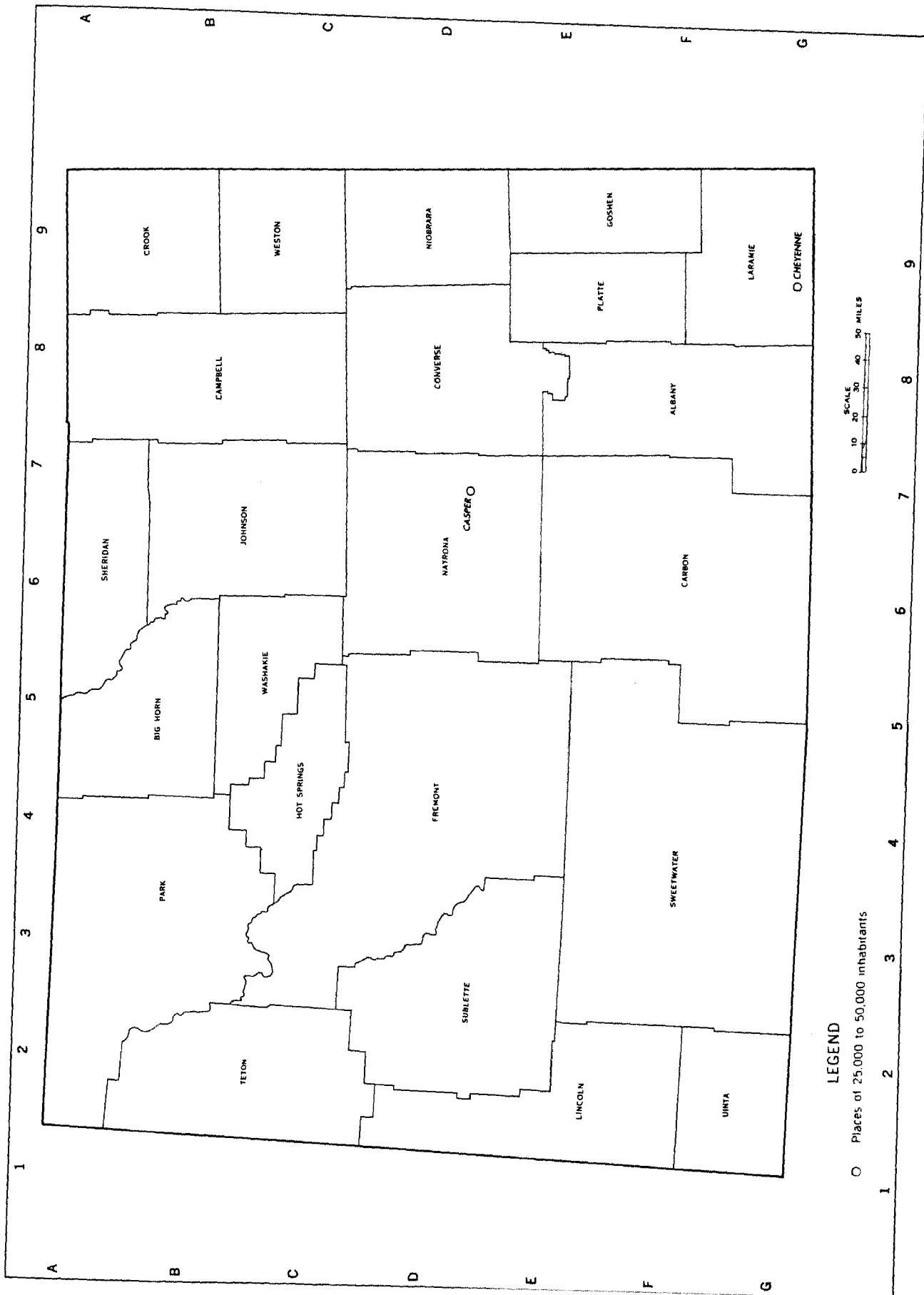

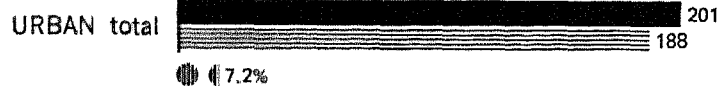

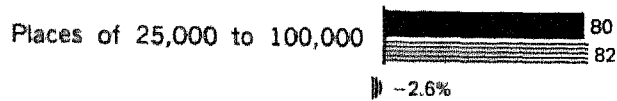

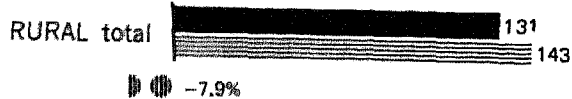

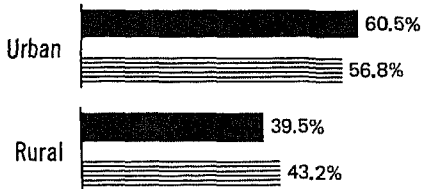


**Percent Distribution

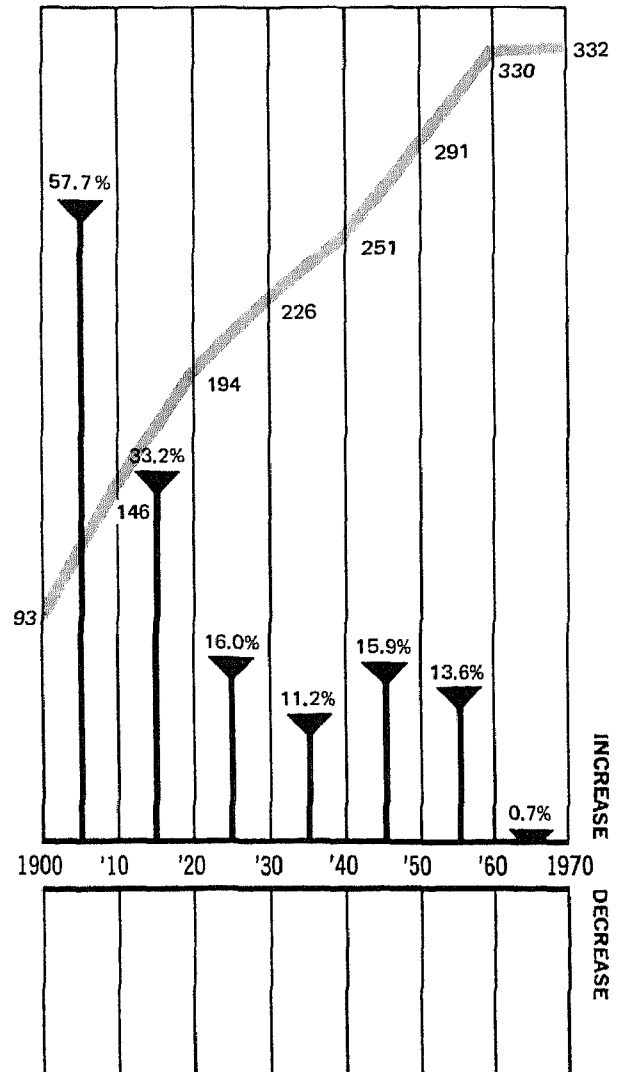
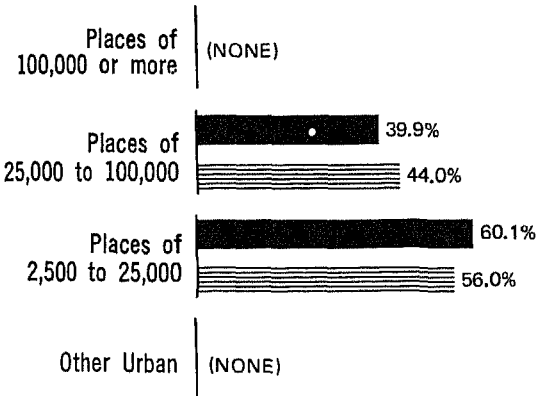

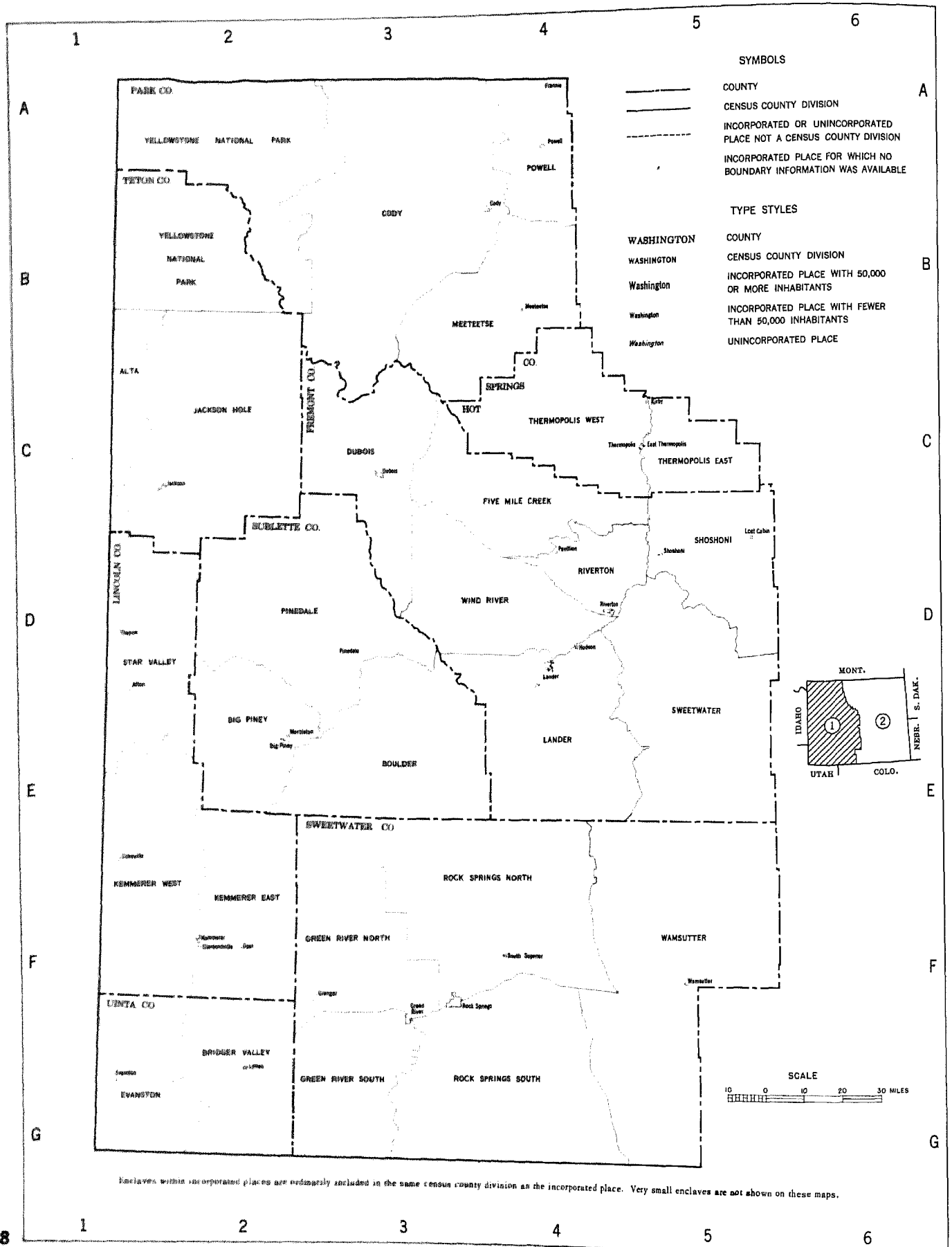
