

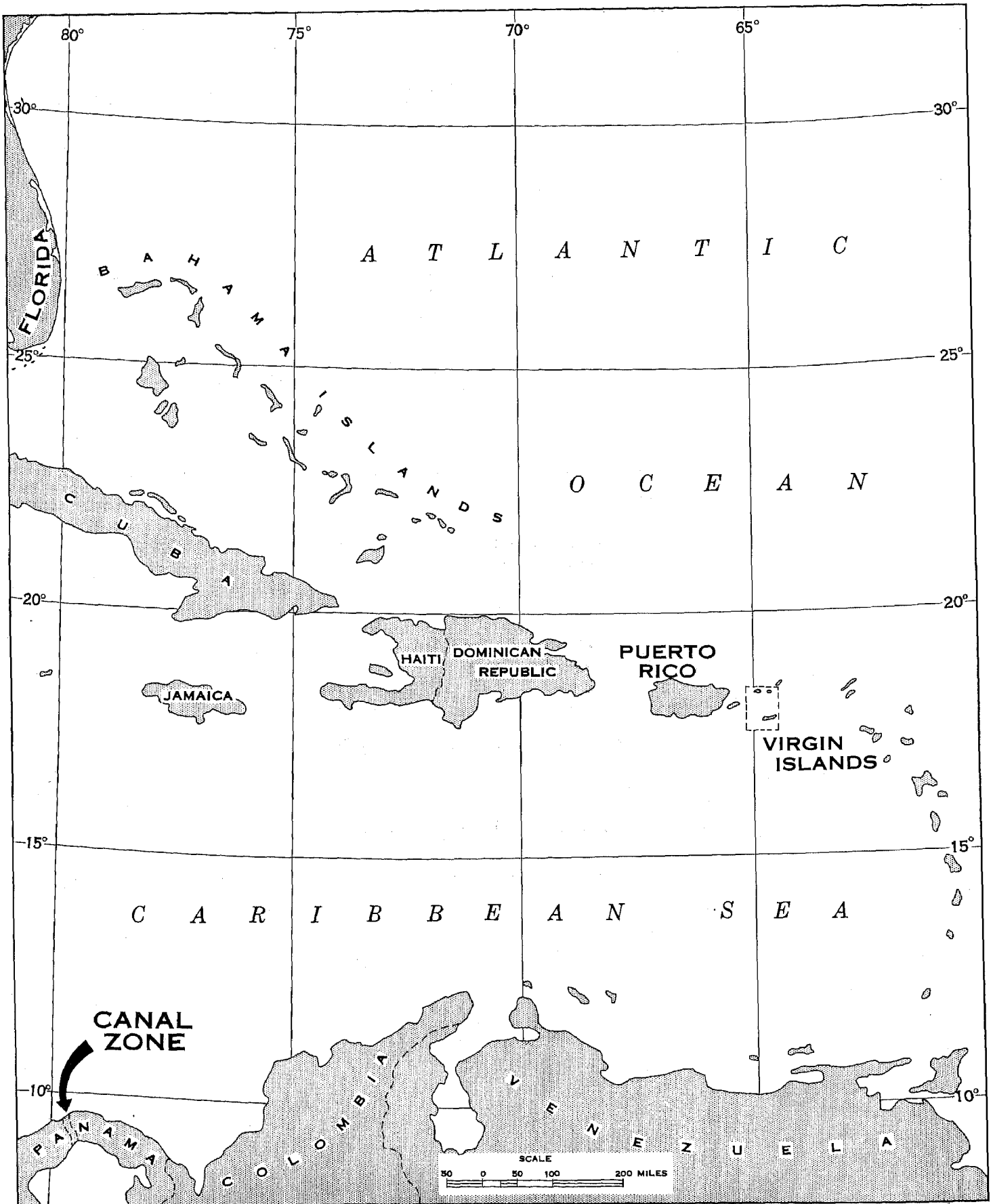

Court Districts and Towns

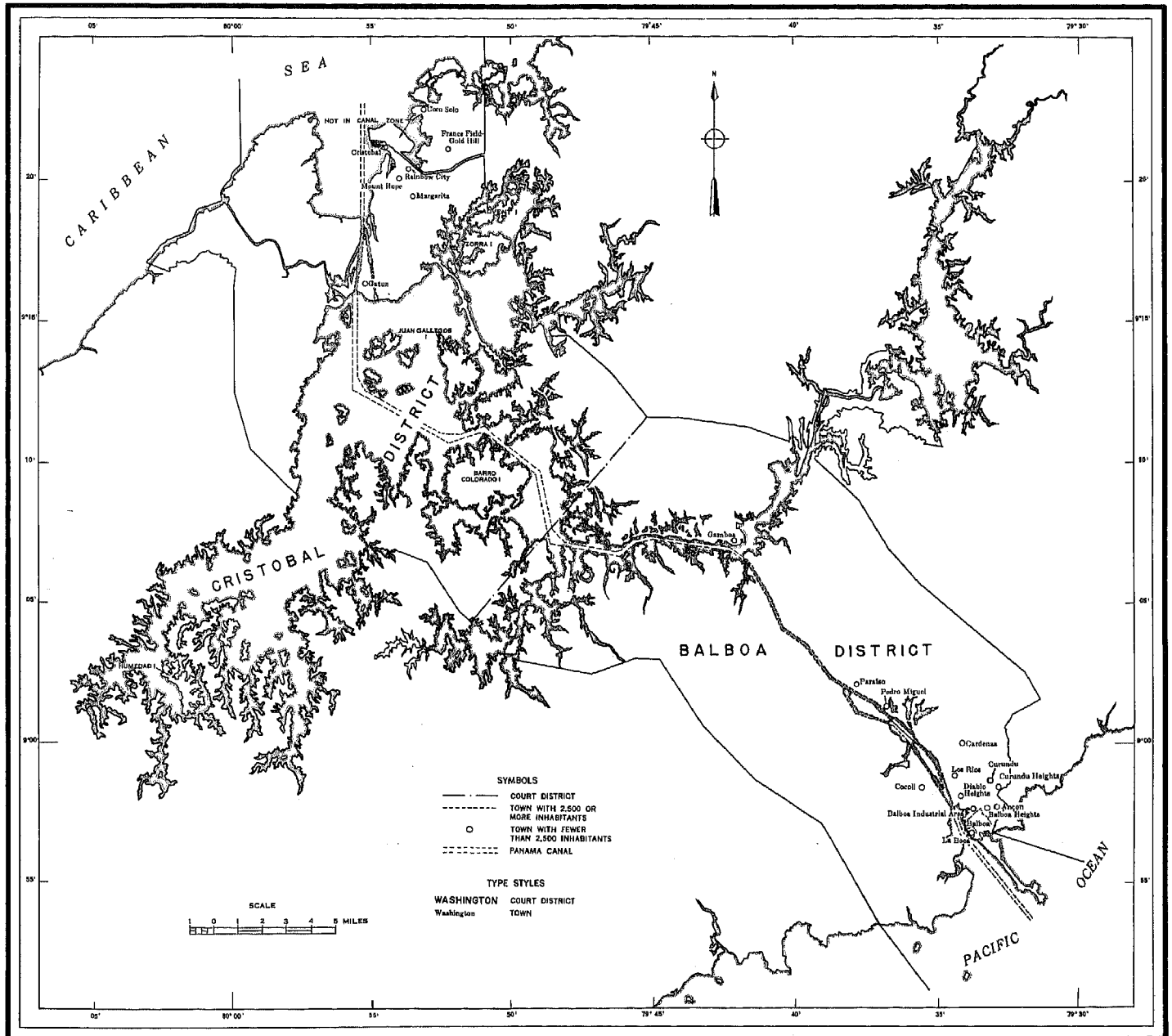

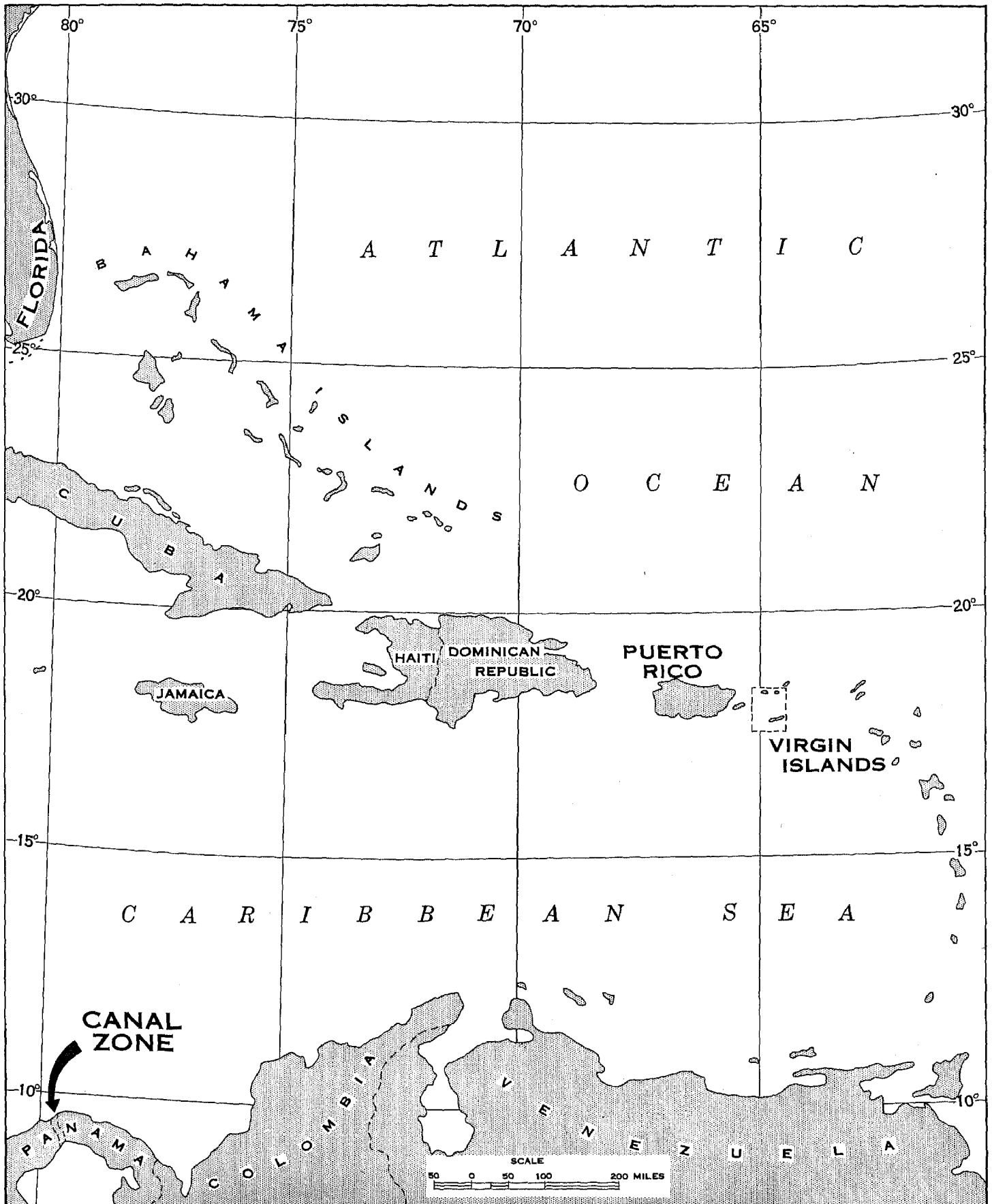
