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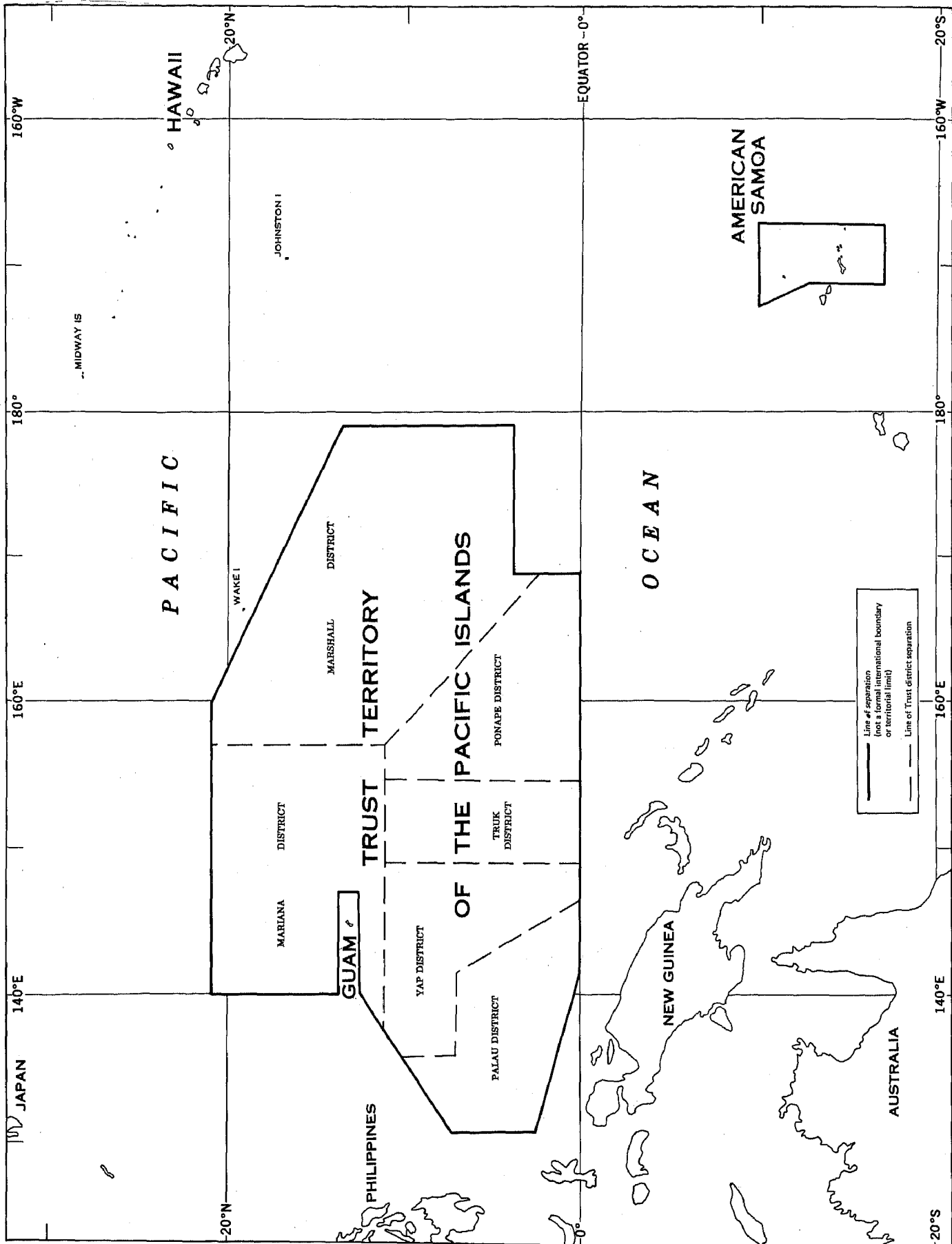
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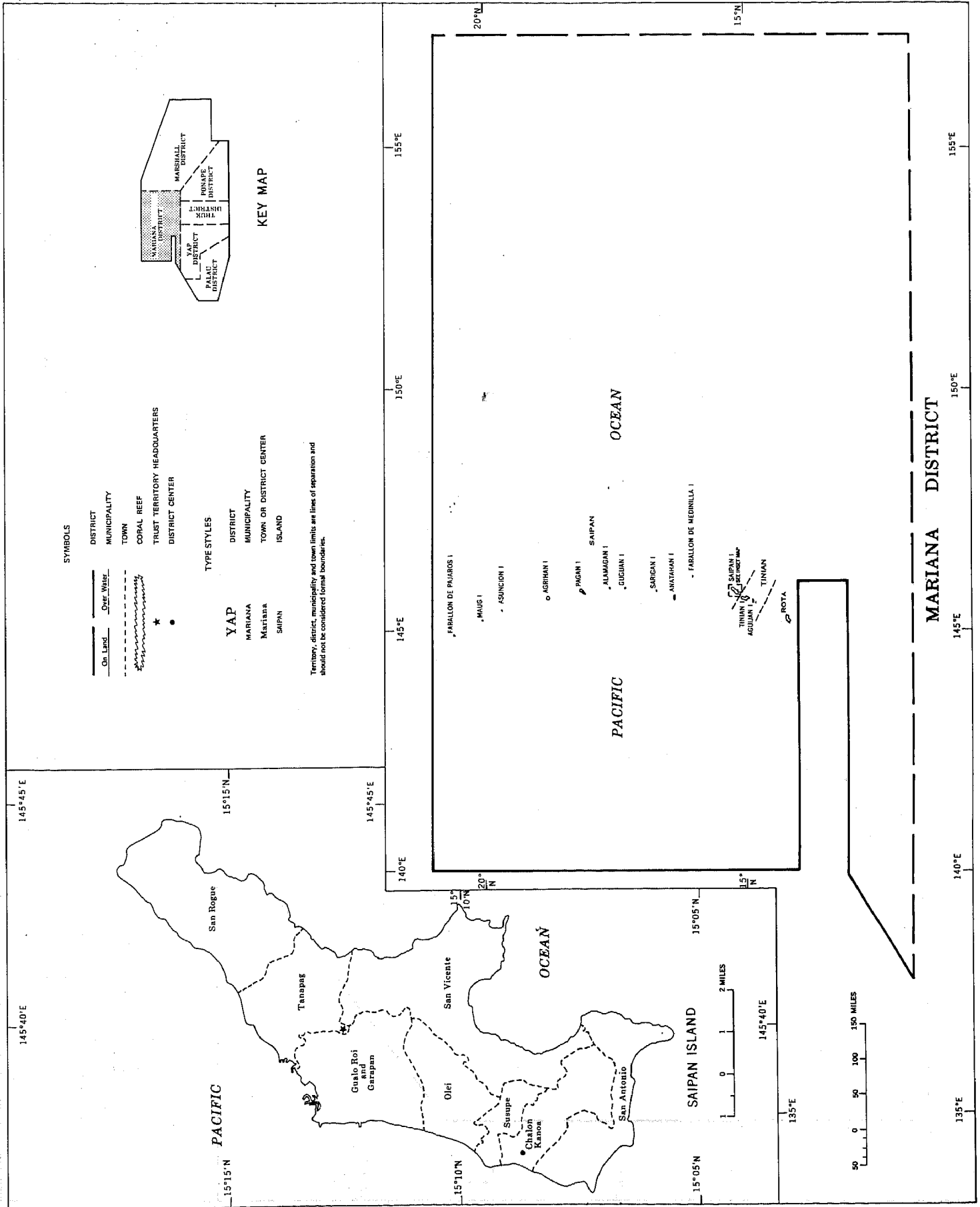

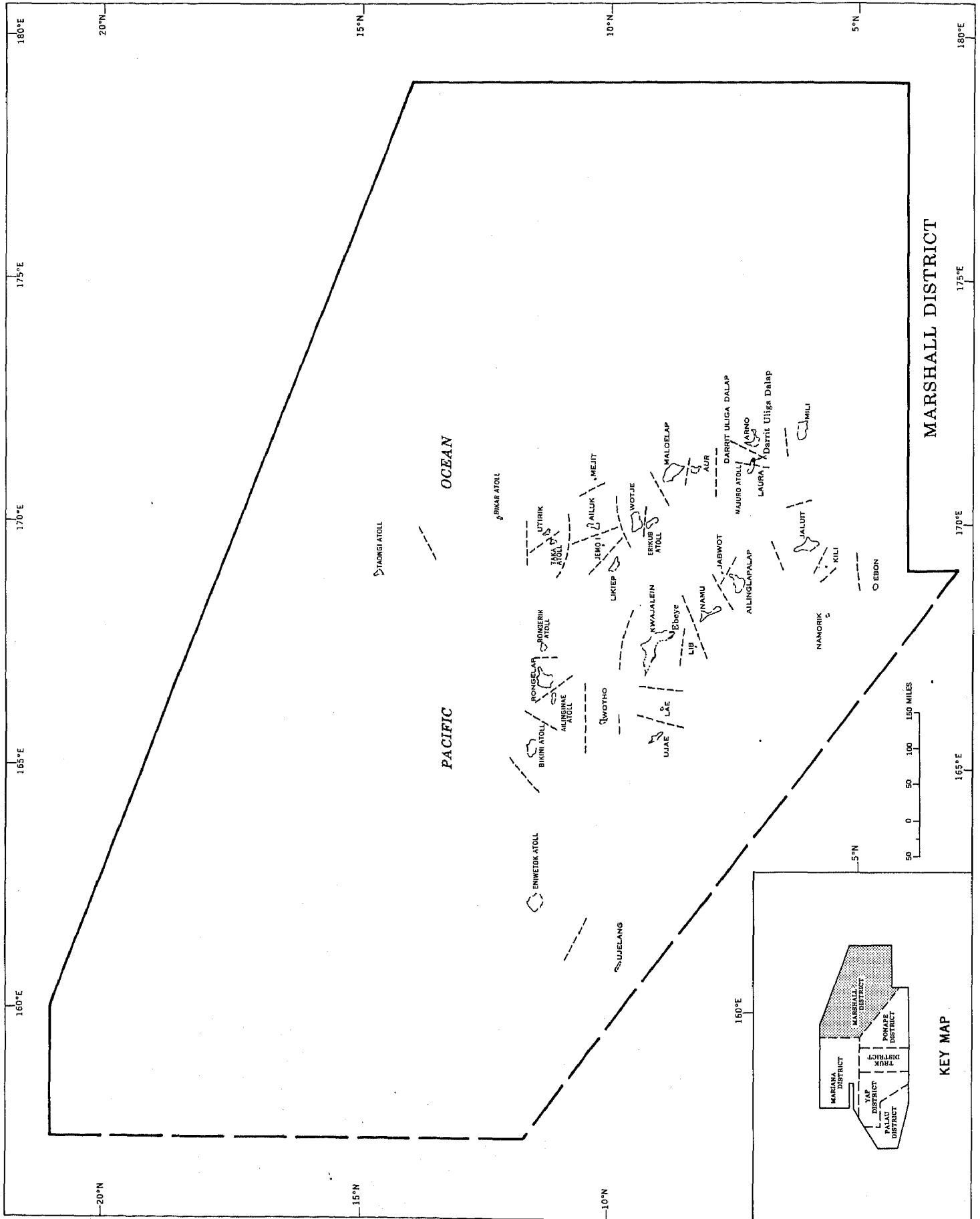

## Mariana District-Municipalities, Islands, Atolls, and Places



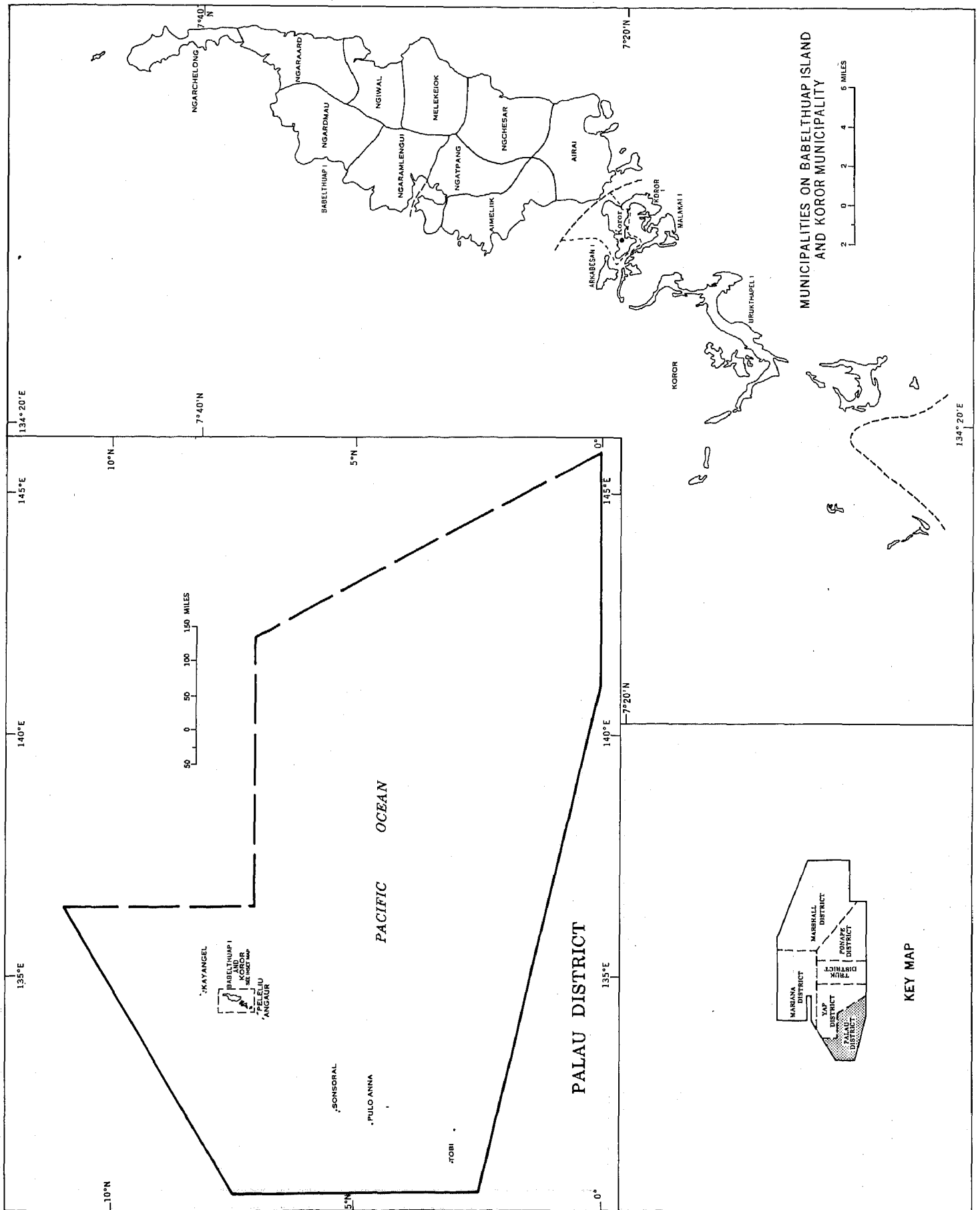

County Subdivisions/Townships and Places



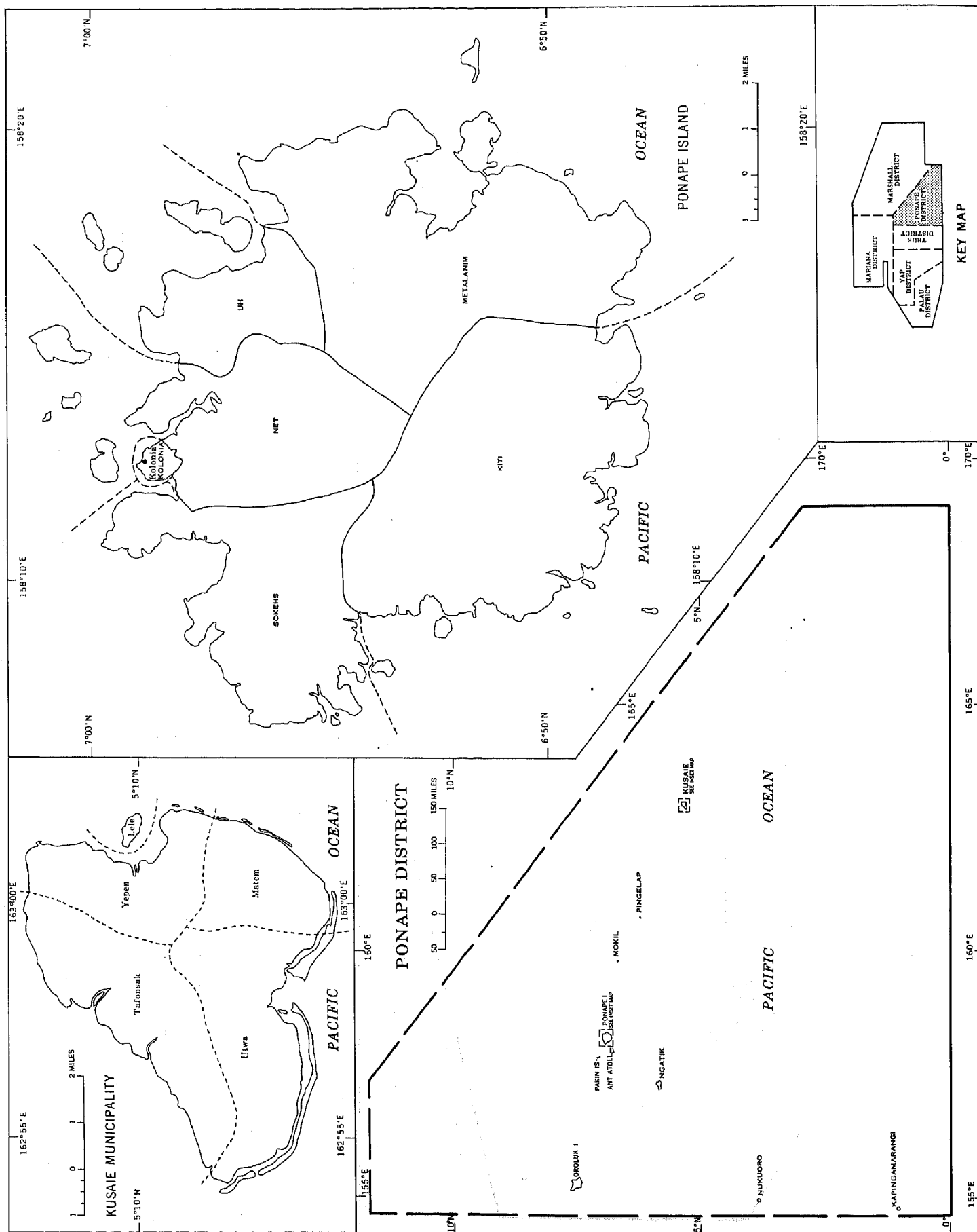

## Palau District-Municipalities, Islands, Atolls, and Places



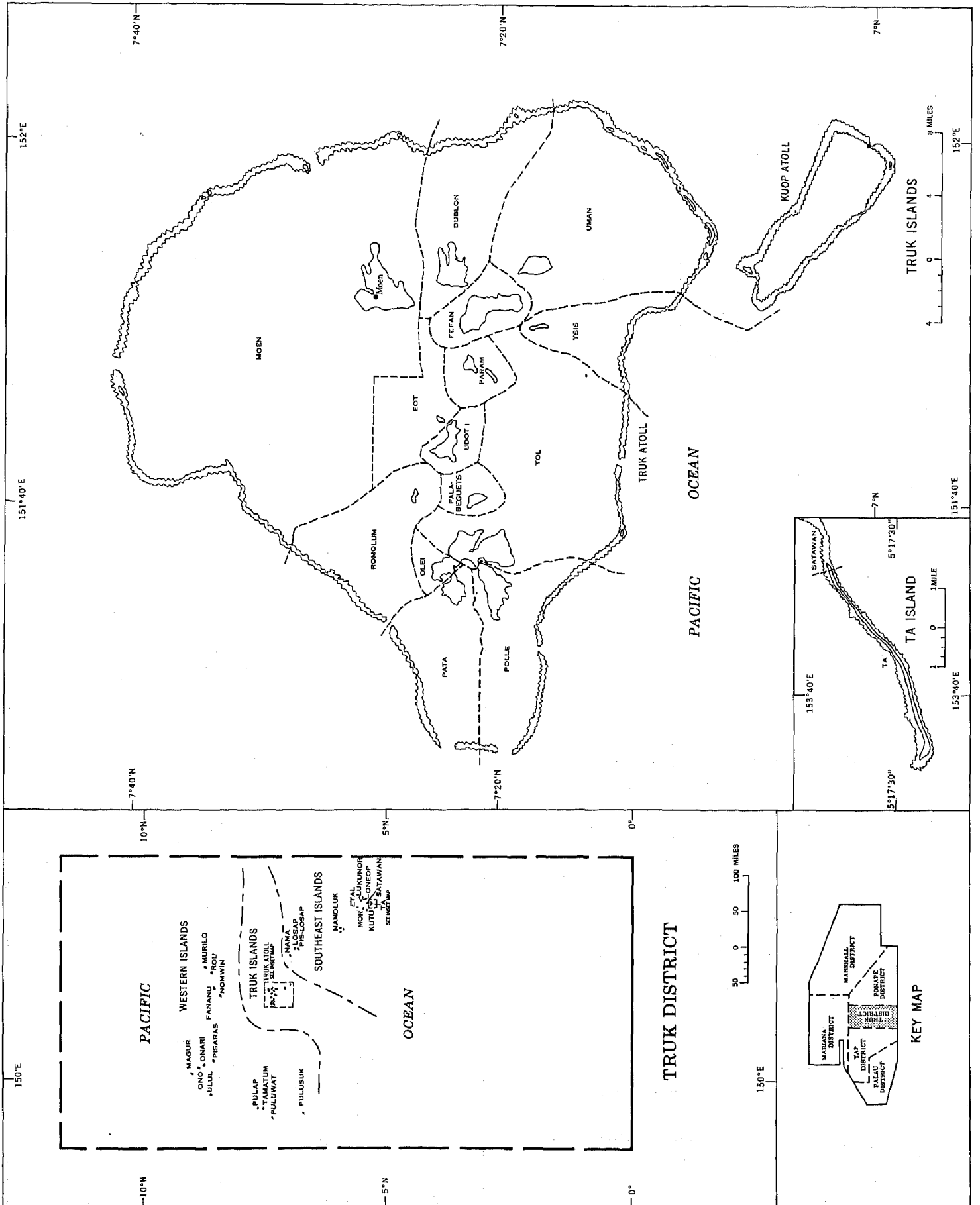

## Ponape District-Municipalities, Islands, Atolls, and Places



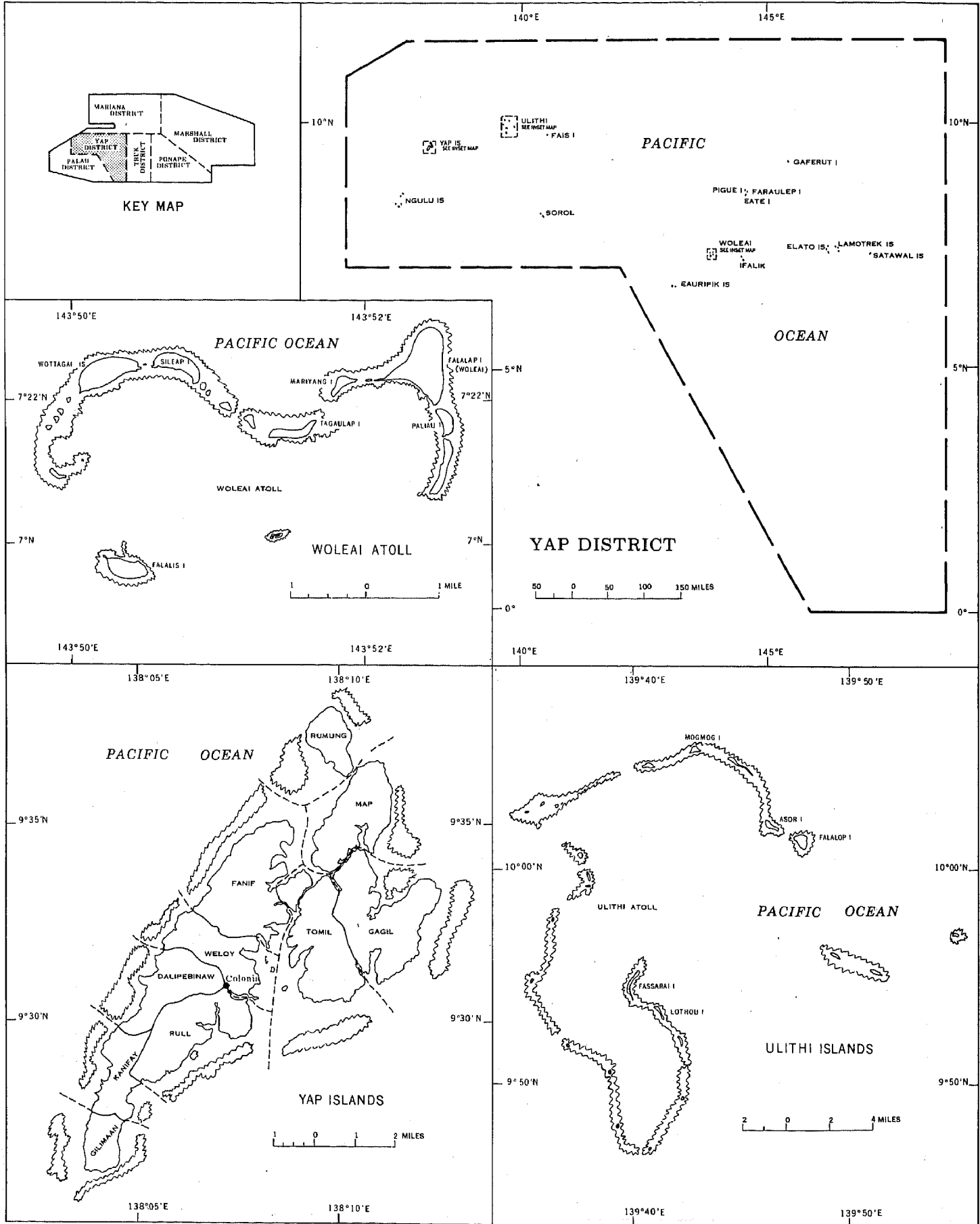

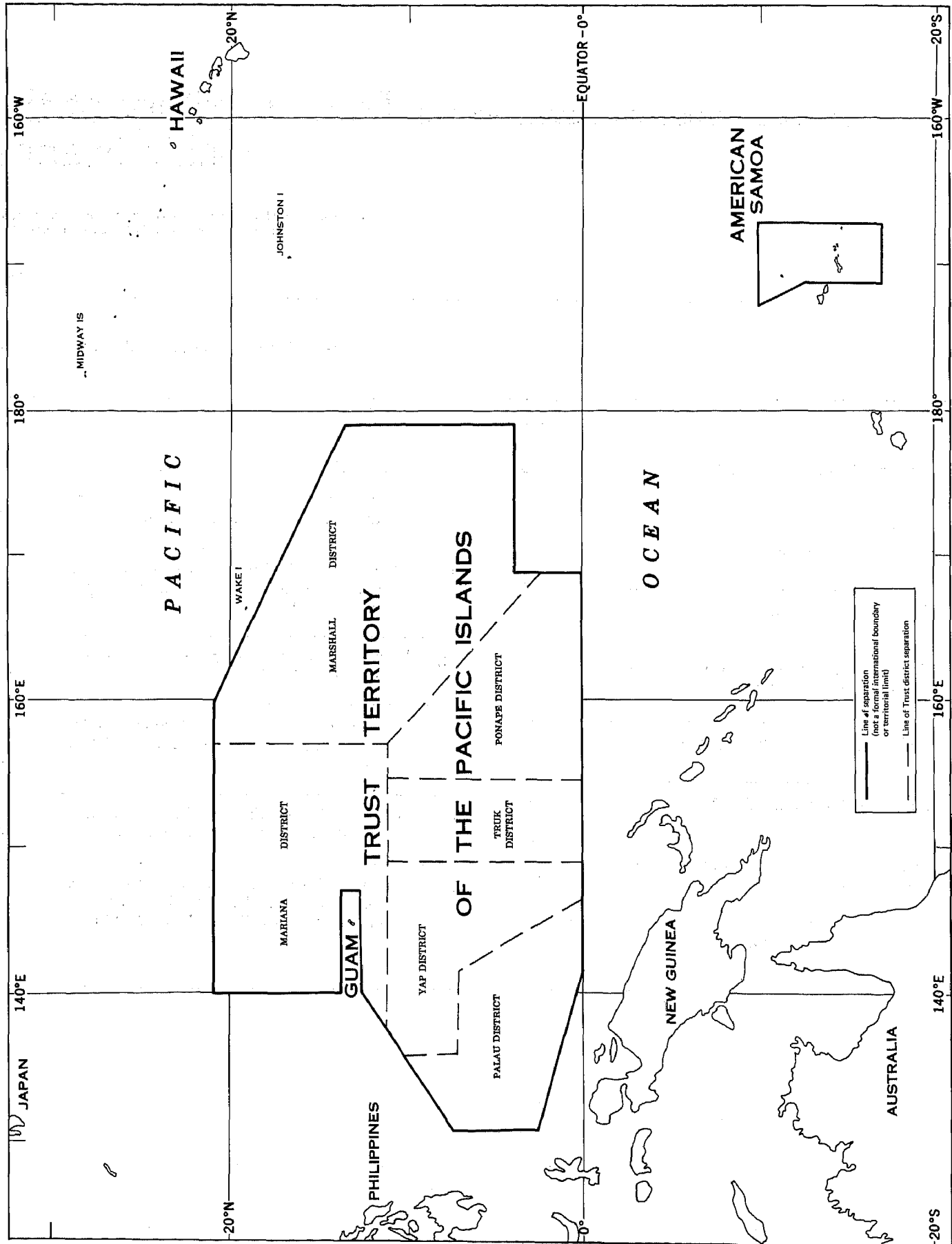
